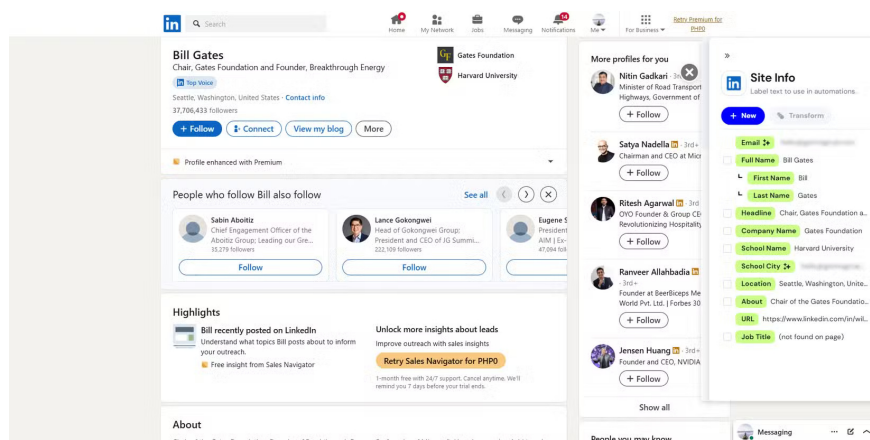


10 AI-powered Chrome extensions to save time

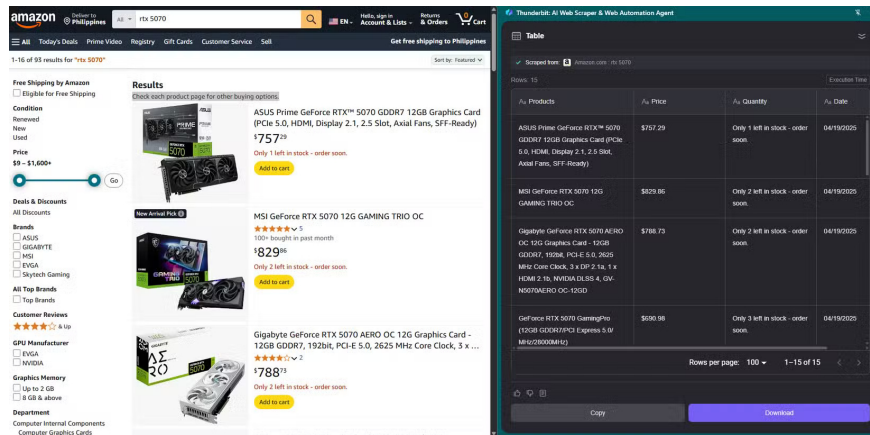
10. Magical

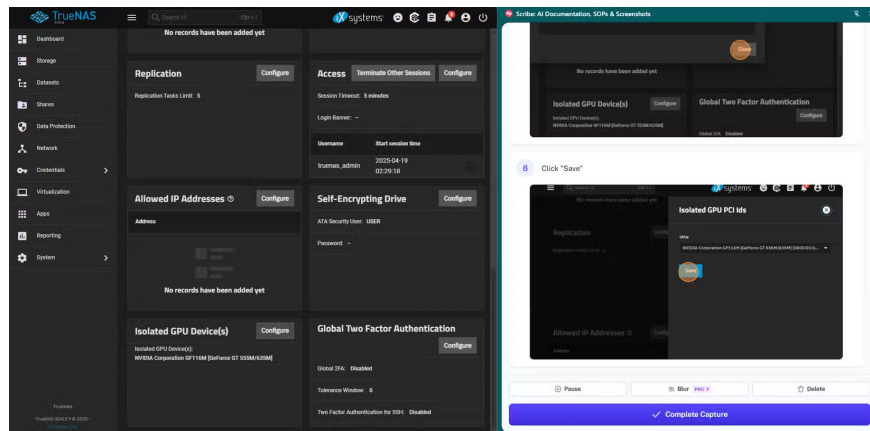
9. Thunderbit

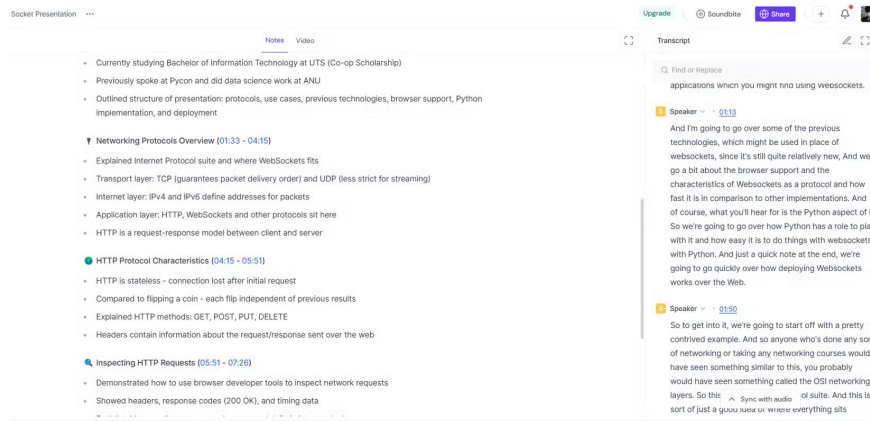
8. Scribe

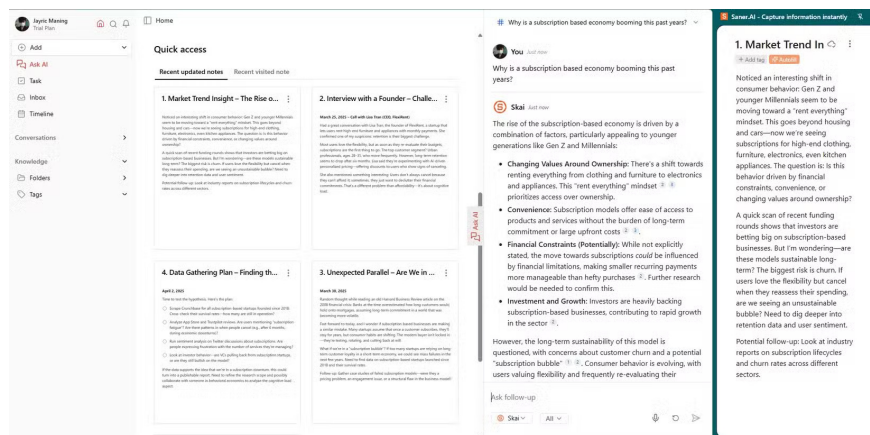

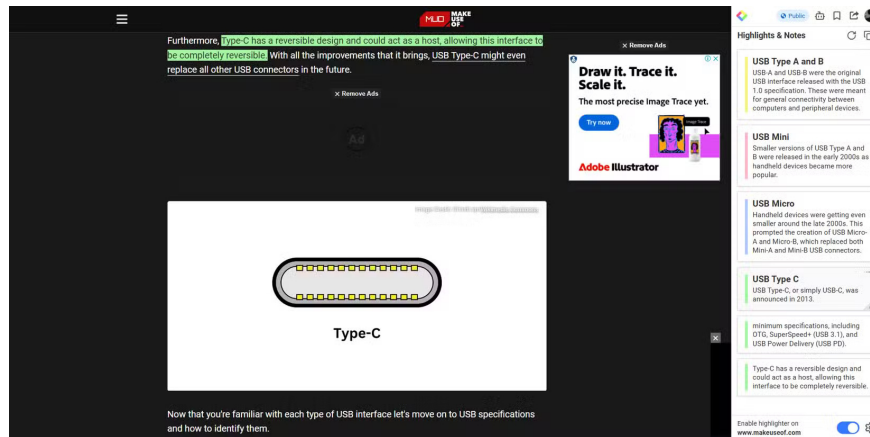
6. Saner.AI

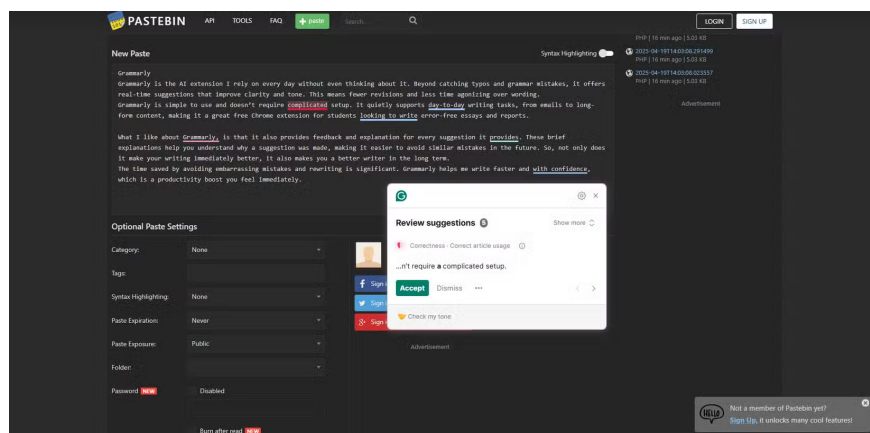
5. Glasp

If you're tired of losing track of important information or juggling multiple apps, Glasp keeps your research neat and accessible, saving you valuable time.

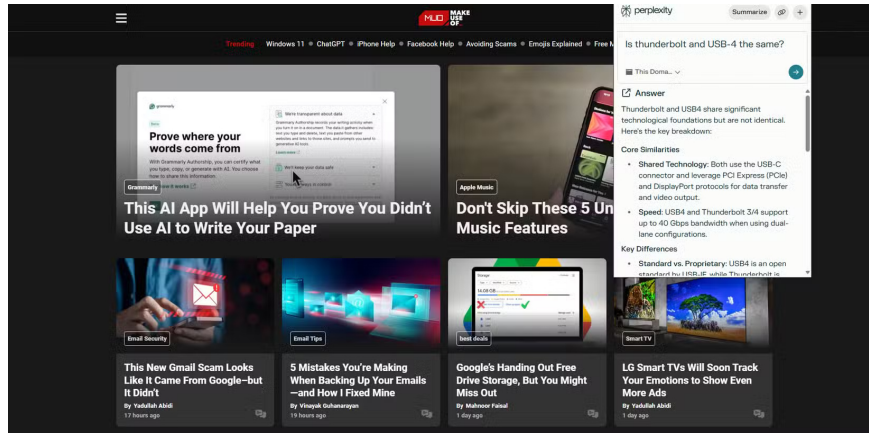
4. Grammarly

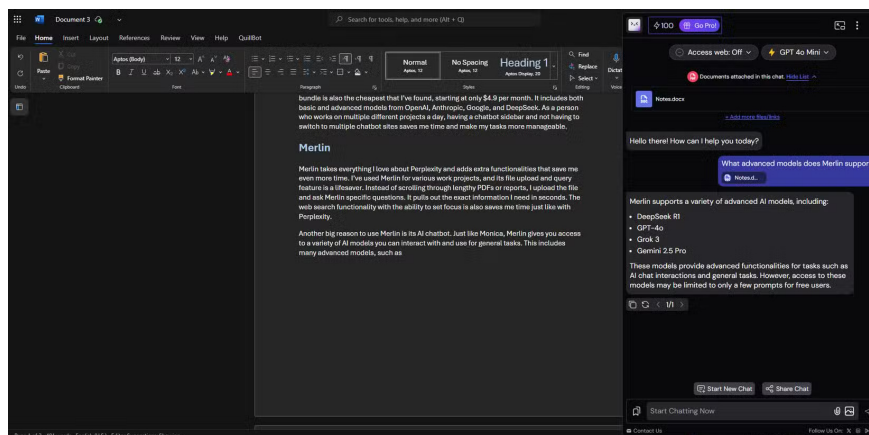
3. Perplexity
