For the purpose of making it easier for you to make decisions, we will introduce 10 most popular Android applications today.

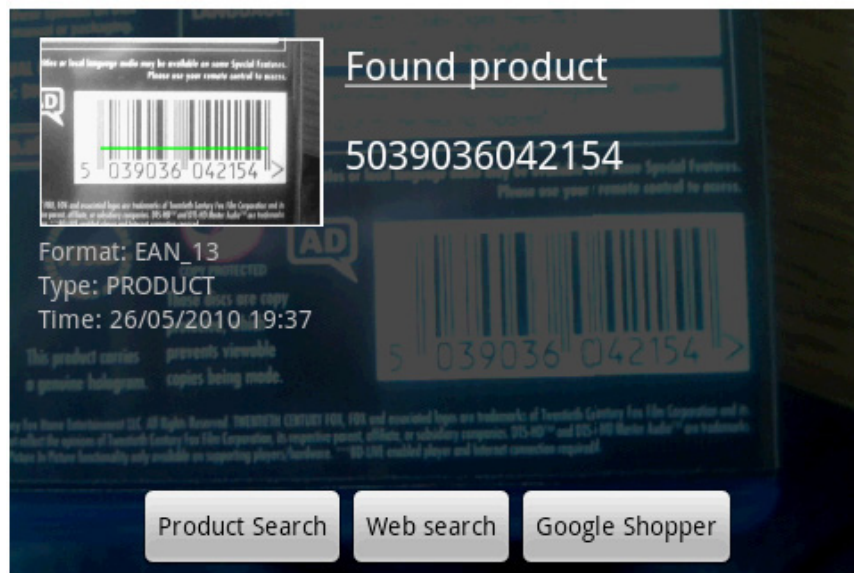
TipsMake.com - Android market will not be crowded with applications such as Apple's application market, but with more than 50,000 applications for users to download, it is easy to overwhelm you by this number of applications. For the purpose of making it easier for you to make decisions, we will introduce 10 most popular Android applications today.



1. ZXing Team - Barcode Scanner

Price: Free.

You can not always find a free application that saves you money. However, this is true for Barcode Scanner application. The concept of this app is simple: it makes it possible to use your phone camera and highlight a triangle in the center of the screen, where you can frame the bar code you want to scan. After everything has been adjusted, the app will capture the barcode information for you.



After that, the application will display with 3 options for you: Product Search, Web Search and Google Shopper, which you can use to find the lowest price for your favorite product on the Internet. This is a great idea every time you go shopping but don't want to pay much for things like a movie, a game or a CD.

Just like the 2D bar codes printed behind the product you find, the app can also read QR codes, allowing you to use to store contact information, phone numbers and URL addresses. This will help you avoid the trouble of having to manipulate them to record them.

Review: Barcode Scanner is one of the indispensable applications for your handheld Android.

2. Opera's software: Opera Mini 5 beta

Price: Free

You may feel comfortable with the Android browser standard, and there is no reason for it to become a good mobile browser. However, when you move and your phone doesn't catch 3G signals, your website will become miserable when running very slowly.



Opera Mini is a better option every time the bandwidth is limited because it uses the server gateway to compress the site before transferring data to your phone. The result is actually better when it can still run data quickly even when the phone has trouble catching the transfer speed is slowing down. This has proven itself worth your download because in many cases it can run better than your standard Android browser colleague.

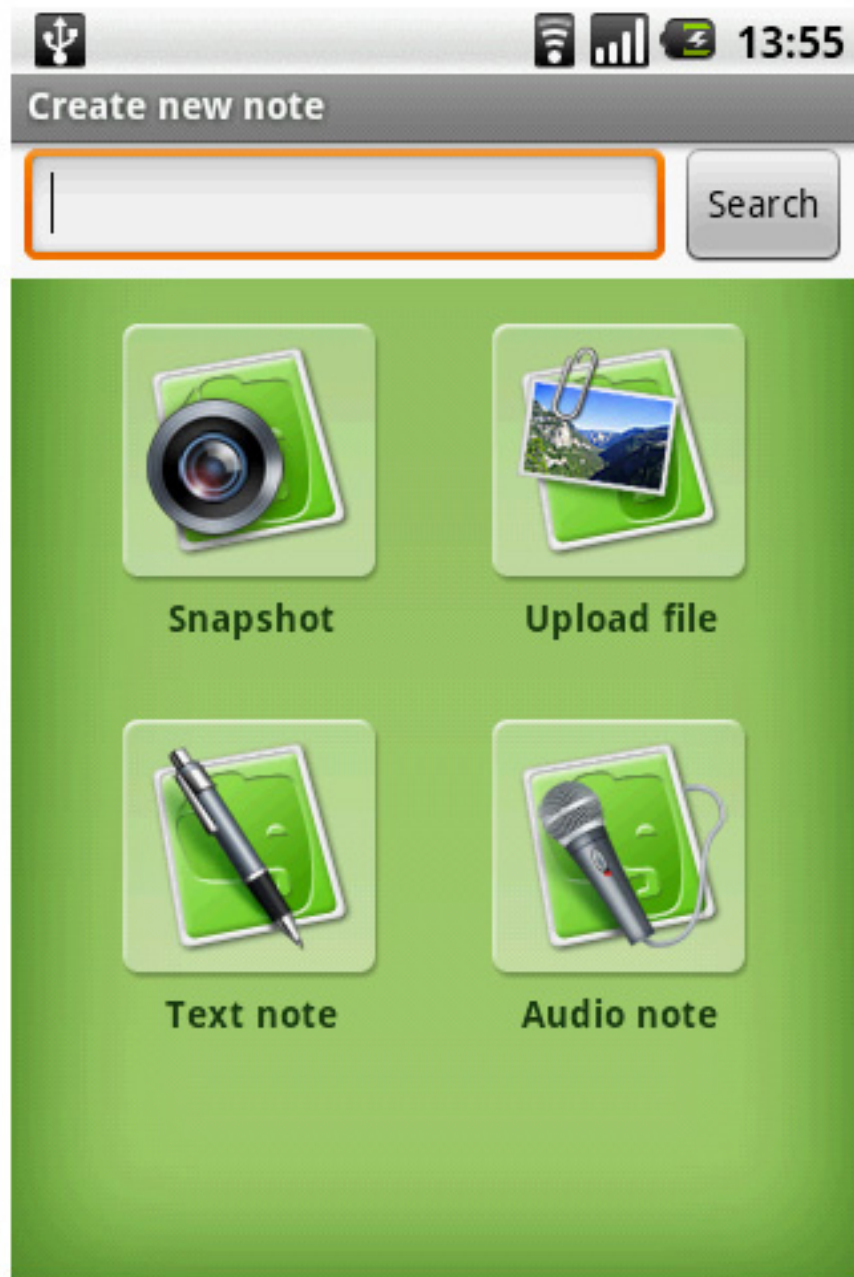
The first versions of Opera Mini on Android have a bit of a bug. But, with this version of Opera Mini 5, everything has been greatly improved. If you feel really interested in Opera, you can also use OperaBridge as your main browser. However, since Opera Mini uses an intermediary server, it is best not to use it for sites with sensitive information such as online banking.

Review: Opera Mini's smart compression is a great option whenever your phone has problems with slow data connection.

3. Evernote Group - Evernote

Price: Free

Evernote has taken note to a new level. This application allows downloading cap features and compressing them for easier interface use. You can use it to quickly perform a note such as speech, a text and image that the software will then record into the table of contents so you can search for them easily when needed.



In fact, one of the best feature applications you need every time you take a picture is Optical Character Recognition (OCR) to record the text in the image. From there, you can use the camera in your phone to capture your business card or notes during a meeting. After that, you can proceed to find information again thanks to what was recorded.

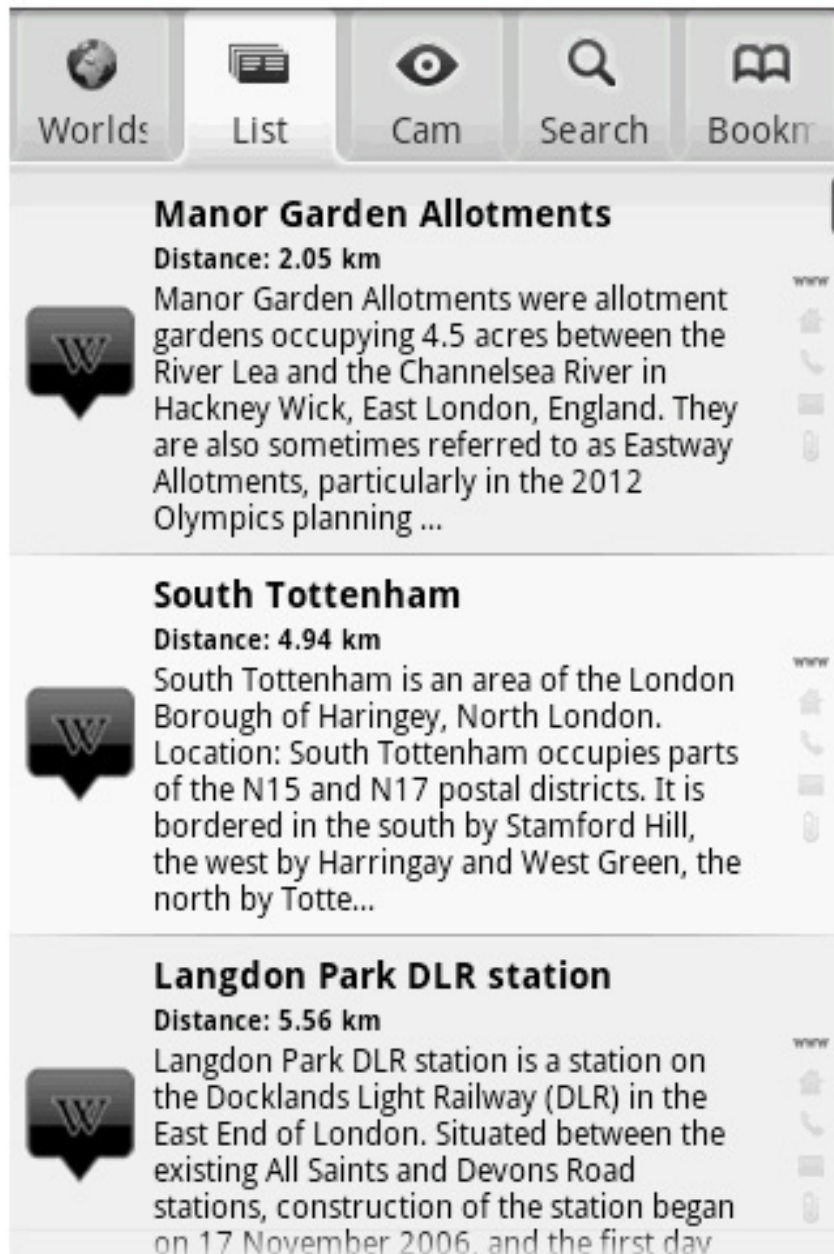
In addition, you can group the text, photos or image files back into different notebooks and these data will be automatically downloaded from your phone to Evernote's website. From there, you can use them on your computer or on your phone.

Review : The Evernote version of Android doesn't seem as refined as the iPhone, but Evernote's ability to record and manage is still something you need to have in this phone.

4. Mobilizy - Wikitude

Price: Free

More and more 'virtual reality' map applications are used, including a hyped browser like Layar, but most of these applications seem to be a trial version and don't have a bit of convenience. Any benefit. Wikitude may be a software that is not very sophisticated, but it seems that the utilities that it provides are enough to convince you to use it.



Instead of normally seeing the surroundings with a camera, with Wikitude, you will see more information such as shops, places, hotels, eating places . they are displayed. directly on the phone screen via icons and especially those icons that are precisely in the direction you need to go through the GPS navigation and navigation (Compass) functions in the phone.

Information about locations is downloaded directly from Wikitude to the phone from the Internet via information sites such as Wikipedia, Wikitude.me, Booking.com, 1800Travelbooking.com, Panoramio, Windfinder.com, Flickr, Youtube, Google Local and some social networking sites like Twitter and Qype. However, you can also easily choose your favorite sources and which sources you want to skip. Comes with the main information, there are still some specialized information like the database of Irish Pubs Worldwid. Essentially this is a search application, but it is also capable of marking famous places and areas. However, it is important to note that you must have an Internet connection when using this program.

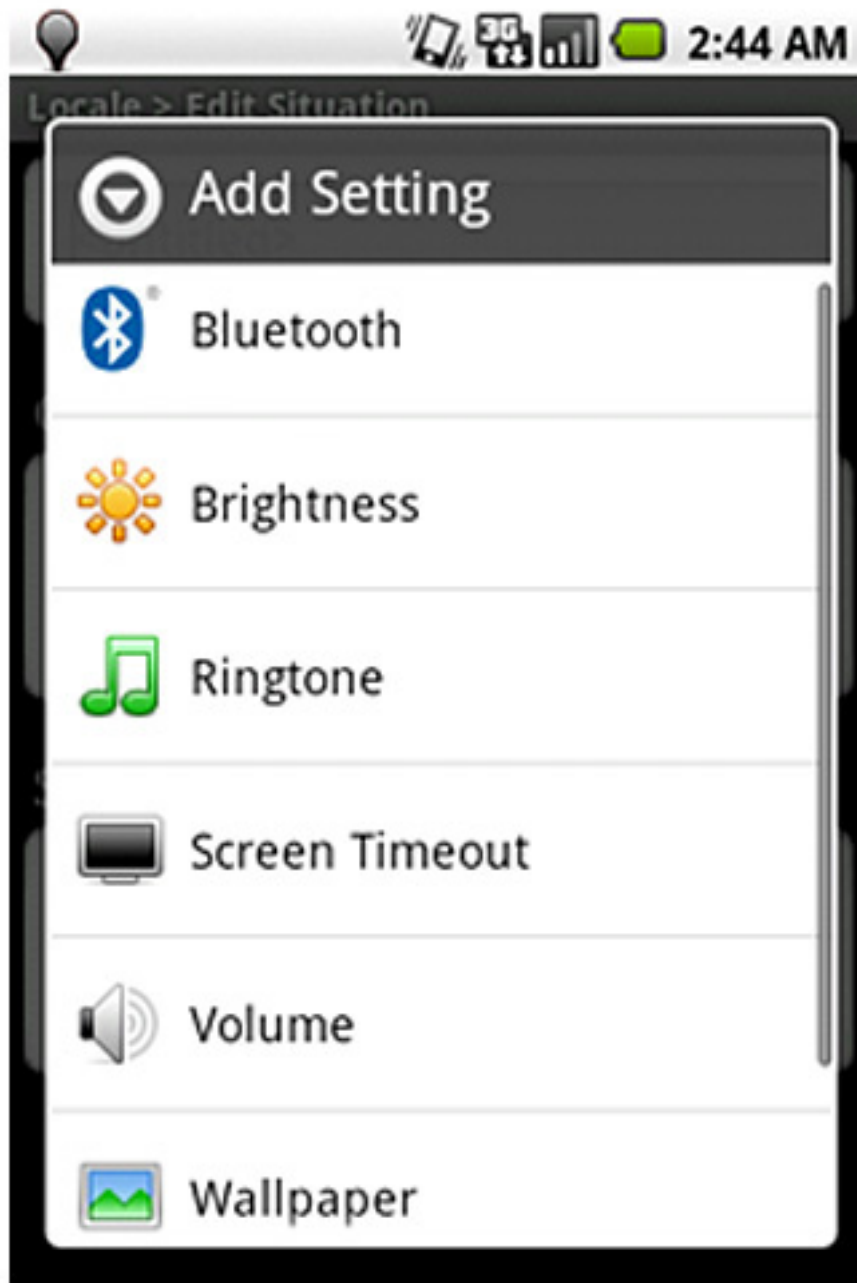
Evaluation: this app may run sluggishly on some slow devices, but Wikitude is still a handy resource to have on your phone.

5. Two Forty Four AM - Locale

Price: \$ 9.99

Locale has won the grand prize in the Android Developer Challenge market and this is not really difficult to know the reason. In essence, this software provides you a smart way to control your phone settings. While most phones allow you to create different profiles for work, home, office and outside, Locale can help you with customizing profiles in specific circumstances.

For example, Locale can be installed for your phone to automatically switch to silent mode when you are at the office (turn off the ring to avoid affecting the meeting), then set the ring mode again come back when you come home.



In the case of only about 20% of the battery, it will automatically turn off Wi-Fi, 3G network to reduce power usage. In addition, this program can update your ringtone. You can set up the program so it can prompt you to charge your phone as soon as you get home.

Not only that, this program can do even more things like changing wallpaper settings, based on your location and allowing you to set up VIP numbers that will ring enough for you to know even when power is on. Your phone is set to silent mode.

Review: Locale is really handy to connect it to quickly become one of the indispensable applications for you.

6. TenCube - WaveSecure

Price: free 7 day trial, \$ 19.99 usage fee per year

Android is still a young platform and one thing it still lacks is the ability to control the phone remotely to back up files, or lock and delete data if it is stolen. Apple provides its MobileMe service for the iPhone while Microsoft also has MyPhone, but Google has not had such services so far.



This is why you need WaveSecure. This application allows you to lock your device remotely and delete data to protect your privacy. In addition, you can back up files directly on your phone or remotely from the WaveSecure website and store them in a replacement device.

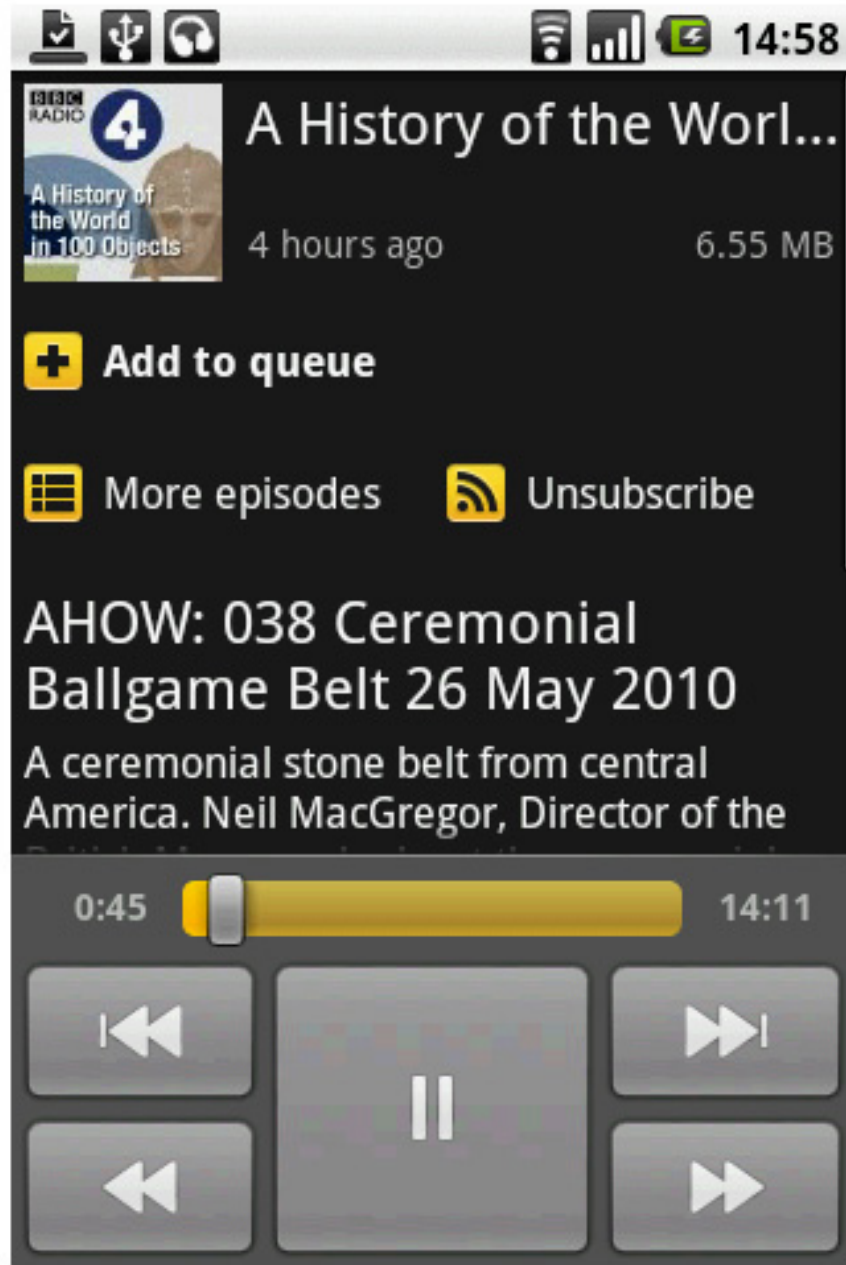
If your phone is lost or stolen, you can activate the GPS chip to format it on a map and even know outgoing calls from your phone or protect if a new Sim is installed. to enter. With an annual fee of only \$ 19.99, the service is much cheaper than Apple's MobileMe service for \$ 99 per year.

Review: WaveSecure is a great way to add security measures to your phone along with the data stored in it.

7. Google Labs - Listen

Price: Free

As you'd expect, the Android market has suffered from a large number of applications that can download and play podcasts. However, quality varies according to each application. Google Listen is a Google Labs product, which contains great applications.



While the software is still in beta, the easy-to-use interface and software features are clearly arranged, making it a great podcast application. In addition, the new Google Listen version allows you to save registration data to the

cloud using Google Reader, making it easy to synchronize podcasts between multiple devices.

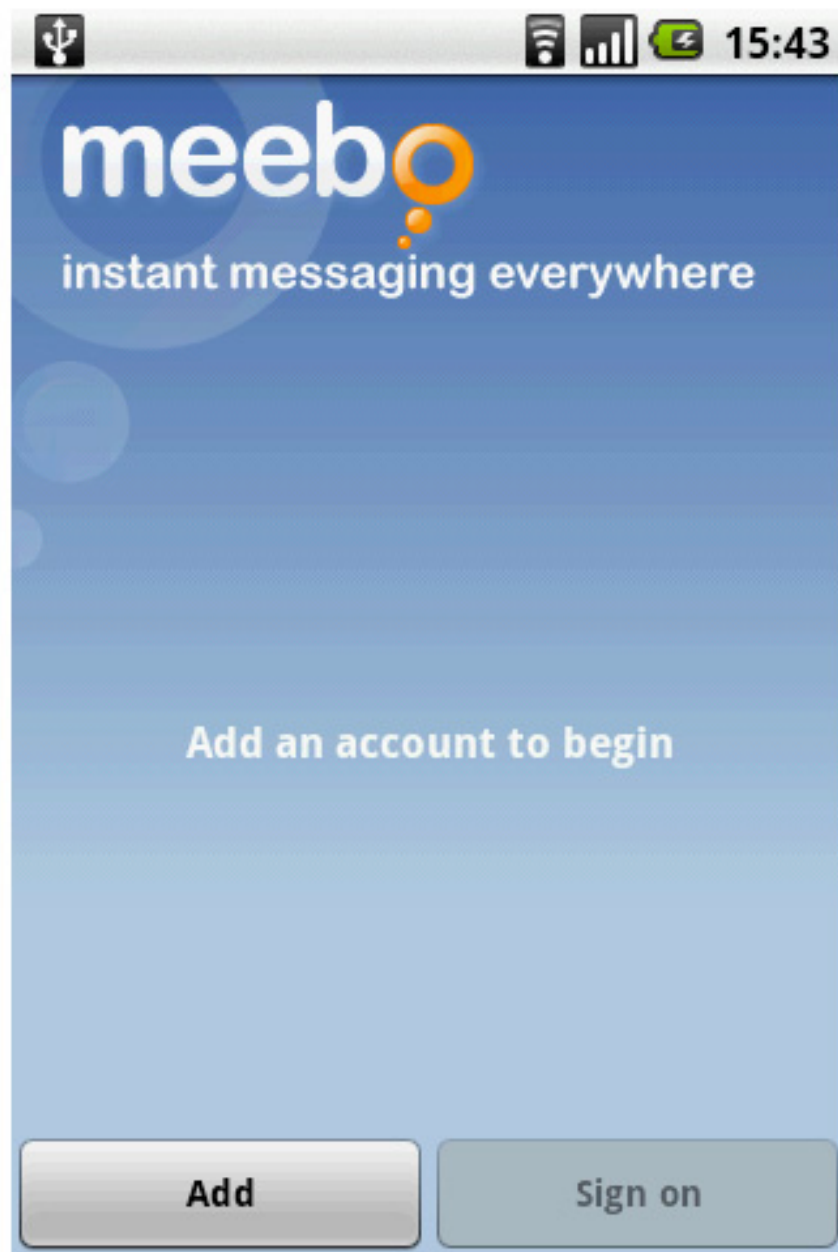
Listen also makes downloading podcasts easier when you just need to select Wi-Fi or can allow it to use both Wi-Fi and 3G. You can decide how much storage it is allowed to use to save podcasts in your memory card.

Review: Although still in testing, Google Listen is still one of the best podcast apps on your Android.

8. Meebo - Meebo for Android

Price: Free

Instant messaging (IM) is a common problem for different networks with a lack of compatibility between them. Do you have a lot of friends but they don't have the same instant messaging service?



While you can use a lot of IM accounts on a desktop computer, this is really hard on a phone when it can consume your lot. Meebo can solve the problem by supporting many different IM programs with just one application. Currently, this program supports many services such as Yahoo, Windows Live Messenger, AIM, ICQ, MySpace and Facebook.

The software is built with a common source of code that supports Pidgin earlier. As you might expect, Meebo allows you to do things like create chat status and send messages. Normally, you can use another application while running Meebo in the main screen and incoming messages will be displayed in the status bar at the top of the screen. The only problem is that you cannot send or receive friend requests through this application, nor does it support voice chat.

Evaluation: Meebo provides a great way for you to access multiple IM services at the same time.

9. ChickenBrick Studios - ProjectINF

Price: Free

This is one of the best games available in Android today. Basically, it is an online, multi-player, classified application where you can go around your city and shoot gunmen armed with other weapons.



In addition, you can customize your character to upgrade their power in different areas such as speed, vandalism or armor. One of the reasons this game works well is because the programmers have created simple, easy-to-use controls that are sufficient to be effective with handheld devices. You just need to tap the screen to move your character to a certain location and touch the opponent's character to shoot them.

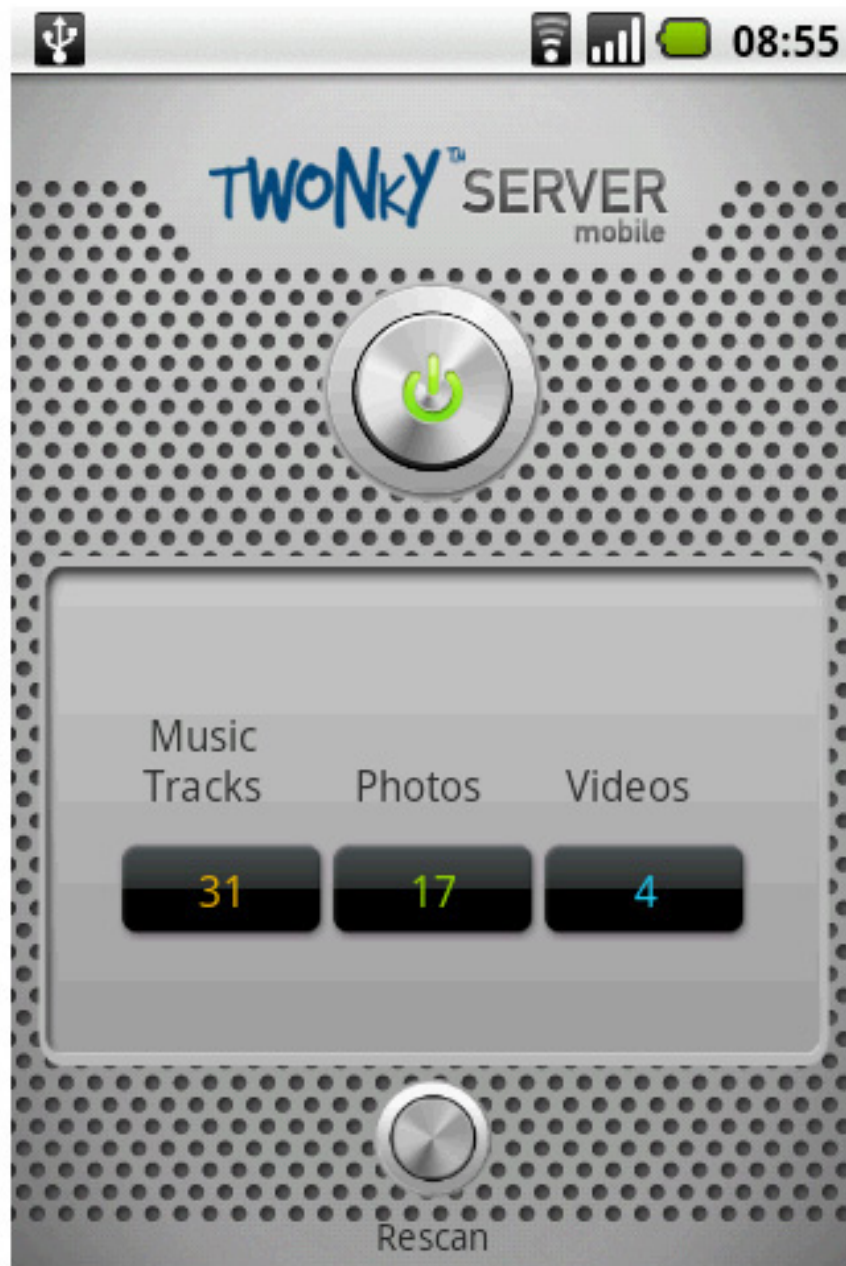
There are two types of battlefields for you to choose from: Deathmatch, essentially a melee team and Capture the Flag, where you work with some of your teammates to find your team's flag.

Evaluation: you might have a bit of a problem with the app's slow speed, but you'll quickly enjoy this game because of its unique style of play.

10. PacketVideo - TwonkyServer Mobile

Price: Free

The phone running the Android operating system when connected will have no problem, but when sharing photos, music and videos from your phone with other devices is a bit of a hassle. Usually, you either transfer files via USB or via the phone's memory card and plug it into the device you want to transfer files to. Both of these are not high-tech solutions.



A better option is to equip your phone with a uPnP media server device with the TwonkyServer Mobile application. This application will scan on your phone to search for photos, music and videos. After that, it will share these files via Wi-Fi network so you can access them via DNLA-certified devices such as Televisions,

PS3, Xbox 360 .

The instructions for using this service are also quite simple, but all you have to do is make sure your phone and device are on a Wi-Fi network, running the software on your phone. then search the server for the uPnP device.

Review: TwonkyServer Mobile is the best way for you to share media files with other devices in the same Wi-Fi network.
