6. PewPew

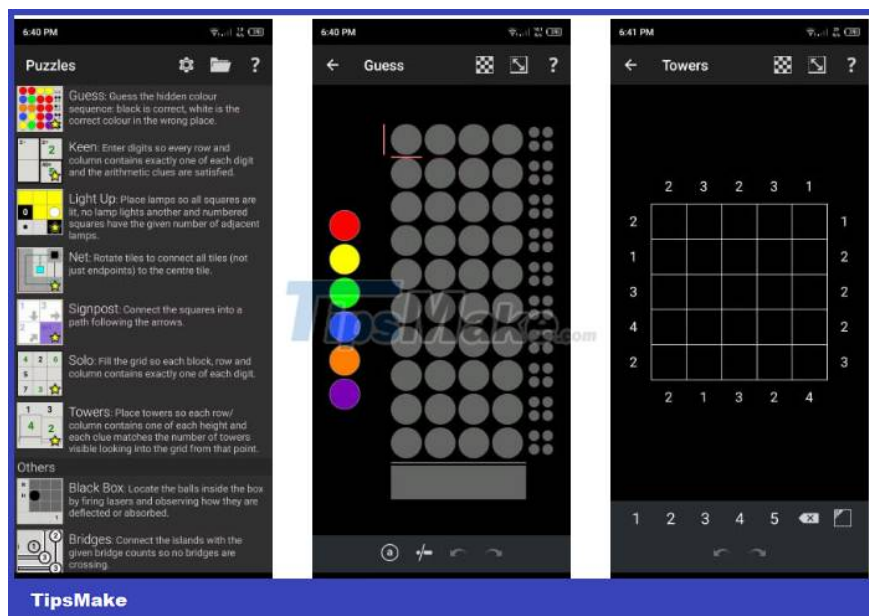

9. Cytoid: A Community Rhythm Game

Another very different option is Cytoid, subtitled a "community rhythm game" with a Guitar Hero/Let's Dance approach.

10. Unciv



Unciv is open source, meaning it will be free and ad-free forever. Unciv emulates the popular strategy games of the 90s, in which you work to build your civilization and defeat your enemies.
