

10 best screenshot tools for computers

With the 10 best screen capture tools shared by Taimienphi below, such as Snagit, FastStone Capture, or Snap..., you can save images displayed on your computer or laptop screen, then edit them with the available tools to create tutorials, settings, or wallpapers.

Taking screenshots is a common activity when using a computer. Screenshots are used for a variety of purposes by users.

Nowadays, most operating systems provide built-in tools for taking screenshots. The most common is the Print Screen button, followed by the Snipping tool on Windows 7, Windows 8, and Windows 10.



However, if you want to take screenshots more professionally, check out these 10 apps. These are all new, modern applications with many editing features, allowing you to use just one software for taking screenshots.

1. MegaBackup

To take a screenshot, select the area you want to capture on the screen and save/share the image directly. Or press the Shift key to edit the captured screenshot. In the editing area, you'll find many interesting features such as adding text, adding arrows, blurring, changing colors, etc.

2. Jing

Jing is a free application from TechSmith, the creator of familiar screen recording and video editing software like Camtasia and Screencast. Jing is primarily used for capturing, editing, and sharing screenshots. The application also allows screen video recording with a 5-minute limit.

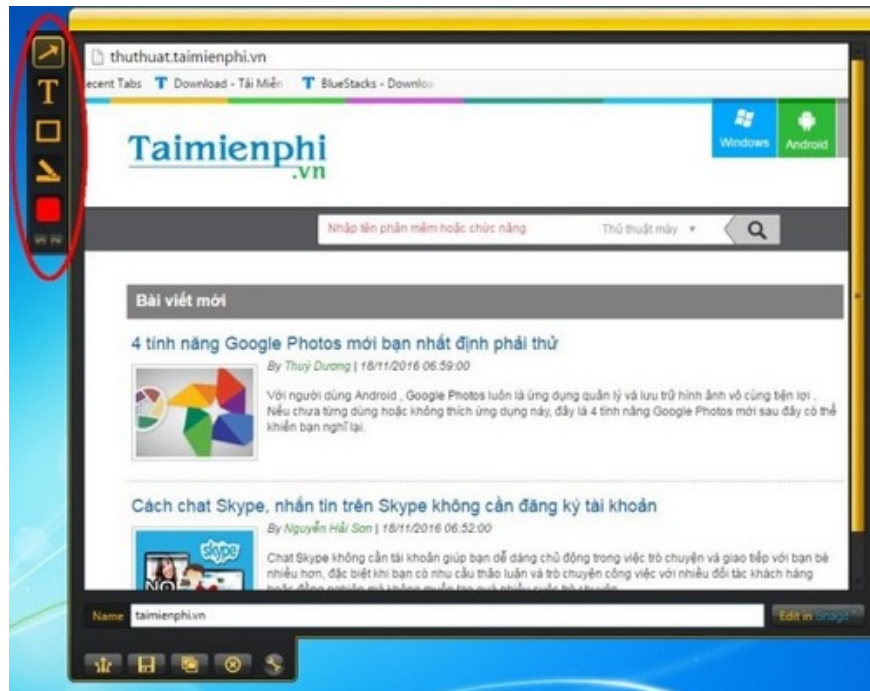

After installing Jing, a yellow sun icon will appear at the top of the screen.

Hover your mouse over it and select Capture. Select the area you want to capture on the screen, then select Capture image (photo icon) to take a screenshot or Capture video (film reel icon) to start recording a video.



After taking the photo, you can edit it immediately using tools such as adding text, titles, arrows, highlights, and many other features.



3. Snagit

Snagit is also a product from TechSmith. Whether you want to capture the entire screen or just a small area, Snagit will help you with just a few clicks.

Turning your screenshot into an idea or message to share with others has never been easier.

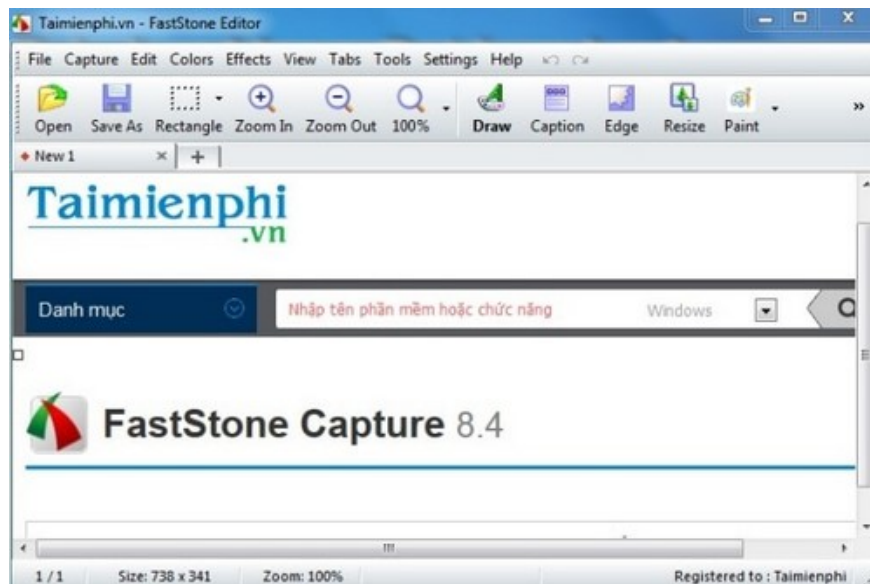


Besides taking photos, you can also write comments on the photos, add arrows, highlight necessary areas, and add shapes to express your ideas.

The software also integrates editing tools such as adding text, annotations, arrows, and several special effects to enhance image quality and allows direct uploading of the product to Facebook or YouTube.

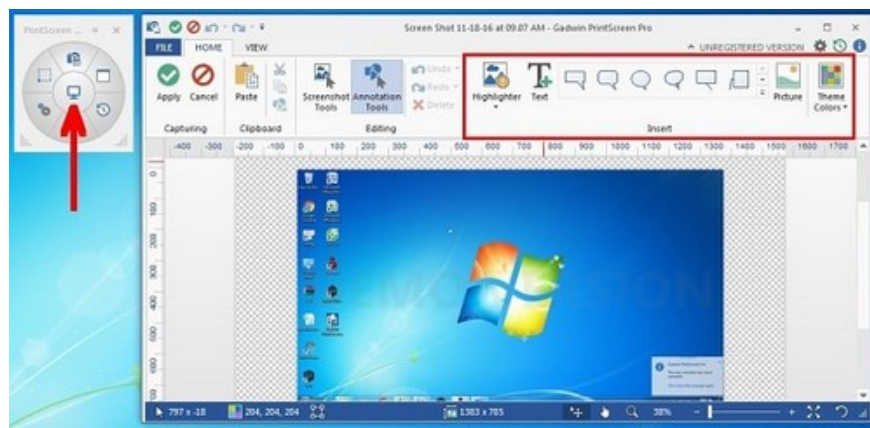
6. *Gadwin PrintScreen*

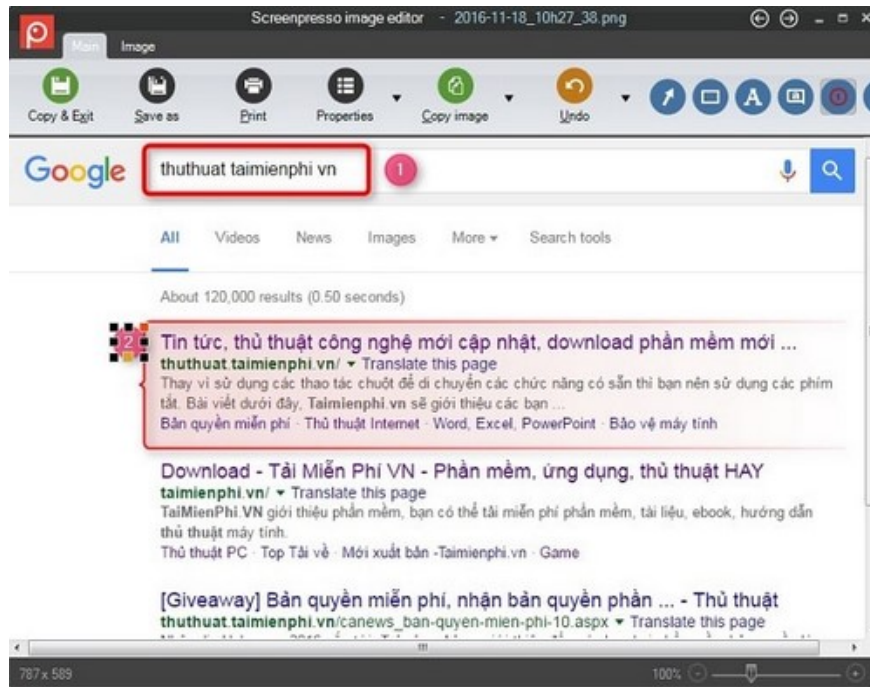


To take a screenshot, in the application menu, select Capture Fullscreen (the circle in the middle) to capture the entire screen, Capture Windows (to capture a window), or Capture Rectangular Area (to capture a custom rectangular area). After pressing capture, you will be taken to the image editing window.

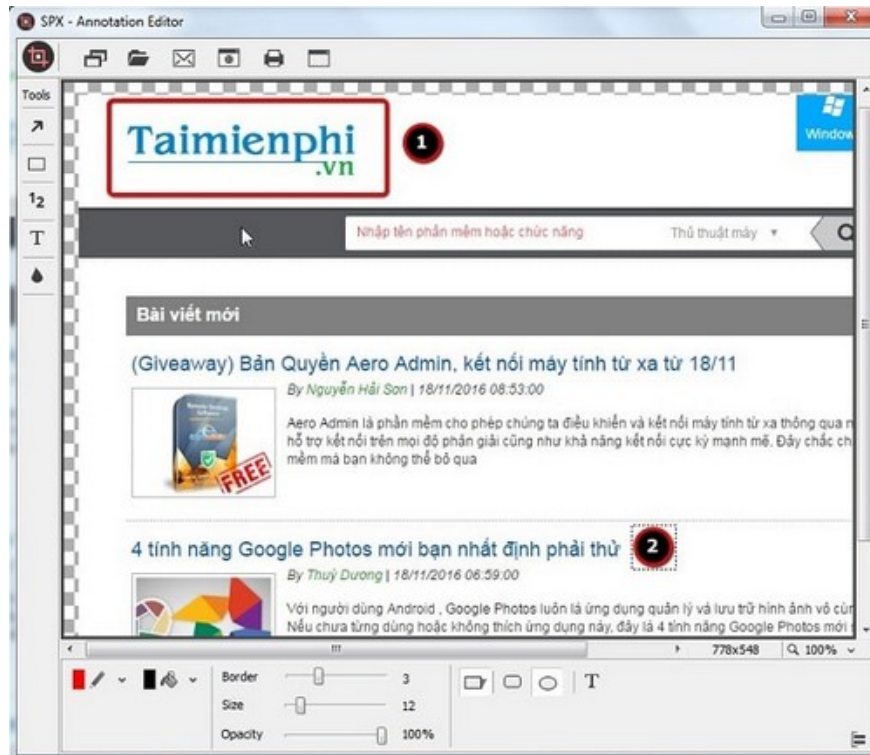

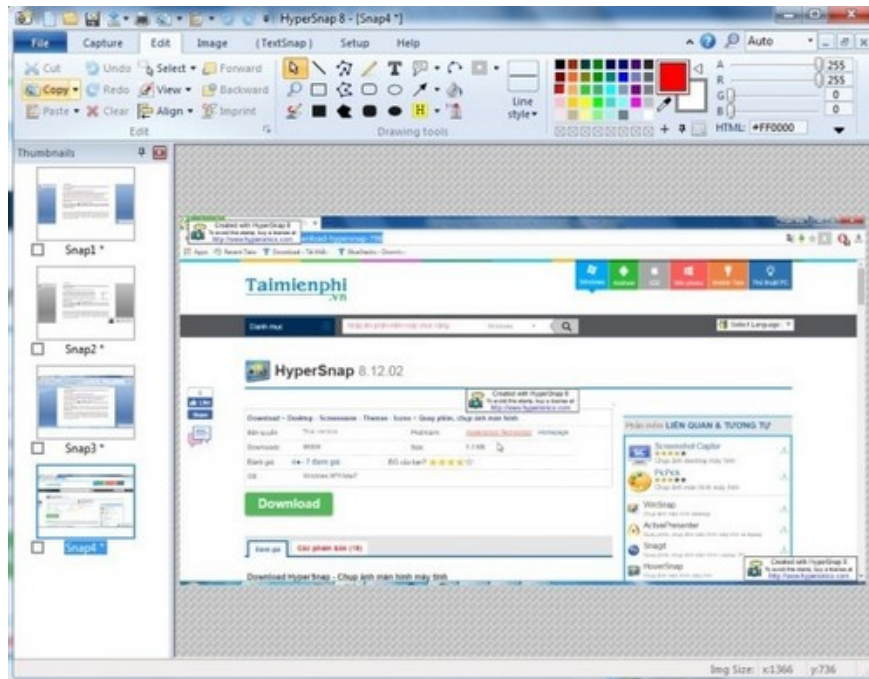
10. *HyperSnap*

And finally, there's HyperSnap – the perfect combination of ultra-sharp screenshot capabilities and powerful editing features.

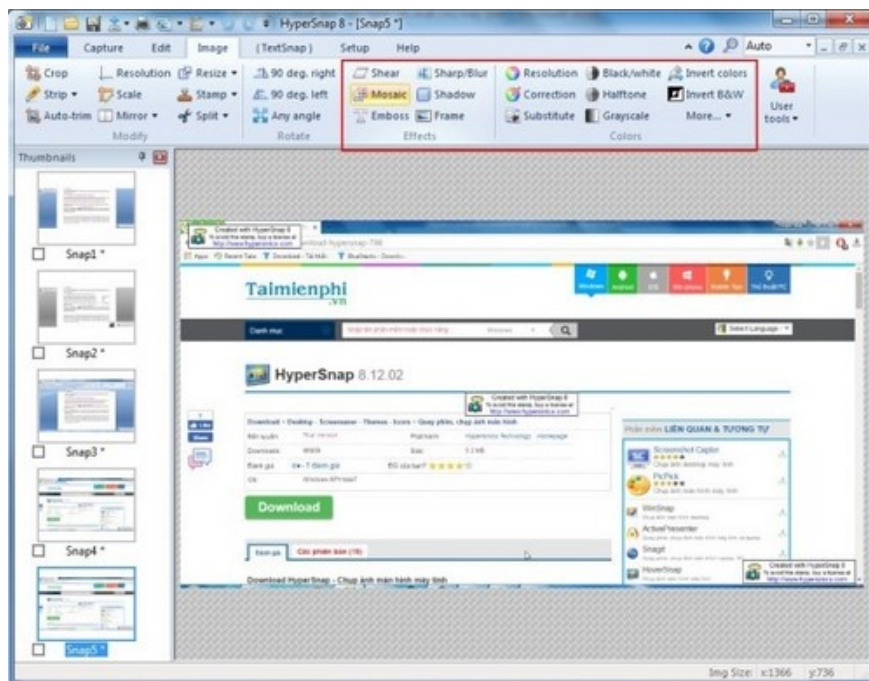

To take a screenshot, go to the Capture tab and select one of the capture types: Full Screen, Windows, or Region.



Edit photos using the tools in the Edit tab; there are many options such as adding text, captions, shapes, arrows, etc.



In addition, HyperSnap also has the ability to retouch and adjust image colors (image manipulation). Go to the Image tab and use these various customization options to improve the quality of your photos.
