However, Acer is still the leader in sales in the Asian laptop market.

Acer Aspire 4736G



Aspire 4736G consecutively is the hunt target of Asian computer users. Design inspired by the Gemstone series of entertainment computers, Acer's 14.1-inch laptop has a high resolution of 1,366 x 768 pixels and is equipped with Nvidia GeForce G105M graphics card quite powerful, making it easy to take over handling 3D graphics,

games or complex applications.

Configuration: Core 2 Duo P8600 2.4GHz speed; 14.1-inch LCD; Nvidia GeForce G105M graphics card; DVD reader; Windows 7 Home Premium operating system.

Asus N43Jf



The N43Jf is one of Asus' new laptops, featuring an eye-catching and impressive design. The N43Jf is highly regarded as one of the first laptops to be equipped with Nvidia's latest 400M graphics card line.

Laptop is equipped with Core i5-520M processor with 2.4 GHz speed, 4GB RAM and up to 500GB hard drive. N43Jf has a 14-inch screen, uses Nvidia GeForce GT 425M graphics card, DVD player and runs Windows 7 Home Premium operating system.

Asus N43Jf has not been offered in Vietnam.

Acer Aspire TimelineX 3820TG



While Acer's previous Timeline laptops use only Intel CULV processors, the TimelineX 3820TG "winds up" with the powerful 2.4GHz Core i5 520M. The device impresses with the body that is covered with a polished metal cover. In addition, the battery life lasts up to 8 hours.

Lenovo G460



Designed for small business market is small but Lenovo G460 still owns many entertainment features. G460 allows users to log on to the computer using face detection and it also uses Lenovo's Enhanced Experience technology to enhance the performance of laptops running on Windows 7 operating systems.

Acer Aspire 4741G

The Aspire 4741G has a multi-touch touchpad, which makes scrolling, rotating, zooming in or zooming out images simple and easy with just two fingers.

Samsung N150 Plus



Netbooks with many colorful Samsung are selected by many Asian users. It has a 10.1-inch LED-backlit screen with 1024 x 600 pixel resolution, 1 GB DDR2 RAM, 250 GB hard drive and Intel Atom N450 processor with speeds up to 1.83GHz. In addition, the N150 is also equipped with a webcam, dual speakers, three USB 2.0 ports, a 3-in-1 memory card reader, a 6-cell battery and support for Bluetooth, WiFi, VGA connections.

Acer Aspire 4745G



Aspire 4745G is designed in black tones and slim design. It also has other business-friendly support functions, such as the P key, which helps users access their favorite programs quickly and easily.

Configuration: 2.26GHz Core i5 430M processor, 14-inch screen and ATI Mobility Radeon HD5650 graphics card, DVD burner, Windows 7 Home Premium operating system.

Price is about 12 million VND.

Samsung R480



Samsung was the first in the market to have a LED-backlit display for an entire model, and the R480 followed this tradition but was powered up by the Core i5 processor.

The combination of 16: 9 HD LED display with the latest graphics card nVIDIA GeForce GT 330M 1 GB helps R480 maximize the ability to process and display images. In addition, the R480 also allows users to charge the battery from the USB port even when the phone is turned off.

Configuration: Core i5 2.4GHz, 14.1 inch screen, Nvidia GeForce 310M graphics card, Blu-ray combo drive, Windows 7 Home Premium operating system.

Price: 21.8 million.

Asus UL20A



UL20A is one of the laptops using Asus' new power-saving processor. This netbook is advertised for up to 12 hours of battery life. Netbook case is designed from thin aluminum alloy. The device is equipped with a 12.1-inch screen and uses a Core 2 Duo ULV SU7300 clocked at 1.3GHz

Toshiba Qosmio F60



Qosmio F60 is Toshiba's memorable milestone because it is the company's most popular desktop replacement entertainment computer. It is equipped with Core i3 330M processor, 2.13GHz speed and 4GB RAM. Most prominent is that users have the option to upgrade to Blu-ray drives inherent in high-end laptops.

Configuration: Core i3 330M 2.13GHz, 15.6 inch screen, Nvidia GeForce graphics card 3305M, DVD reader, Windows 7 Home Premium operating system.
