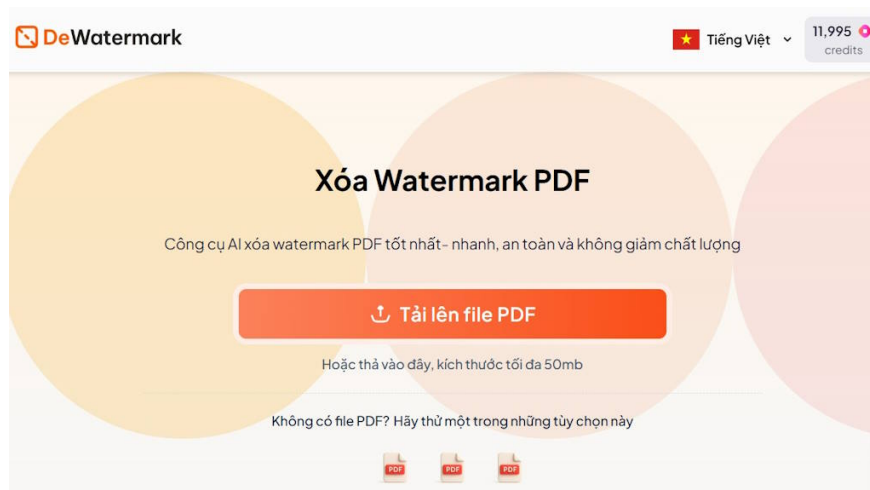

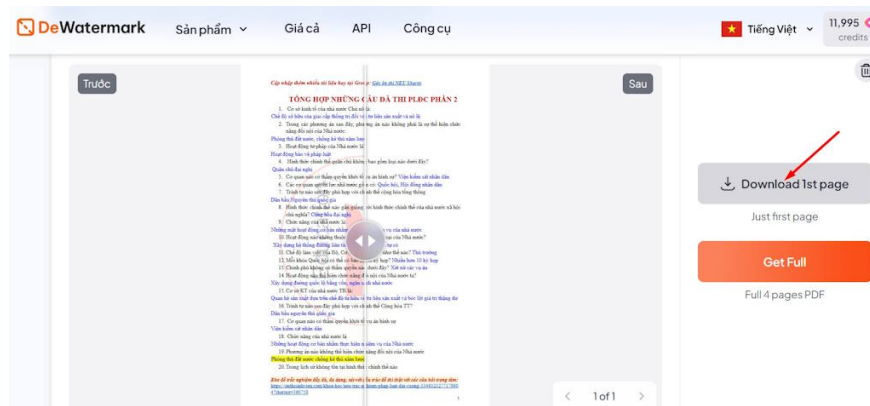
How to remove watermarks from PDF files using Dewatermark

Dewatermark is an AI-powered watermark removal tool that can handle not only images and videos but also PDF files. The highlight of Dewatermark lies in the fact that the entire removal process is automated using artificial intelligence, providing a simple, fast, and accurate experience. Here's how to use it:

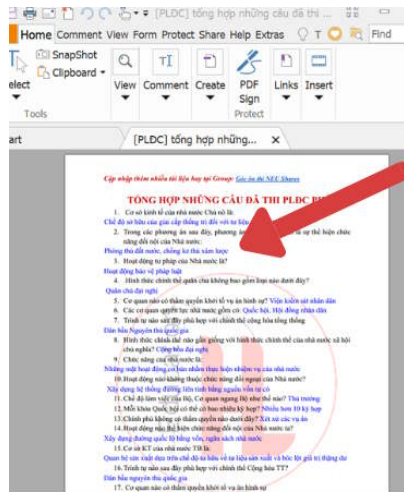
1. Access the website: <https://dewatermark.ai/vi/pdf> . If you don't have an account yet, please register.
2. Click the **Upload PDF button to begin.**



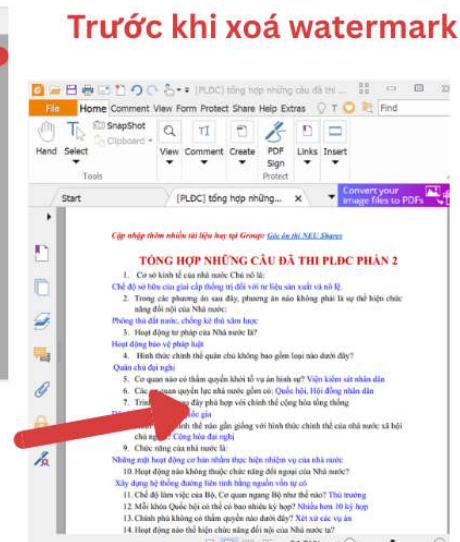
3. Next, you can click the **"Get 1st page"** button to see the AI's watermark removal result on the first page.



- If you are satisfied with the results, you can click **Get Full** to have the tool remove all watermarks from all pages and download the full version to your computer.
- Double-check the results to ensure the AI hasn't deleted any text or damaged any part of the document file.

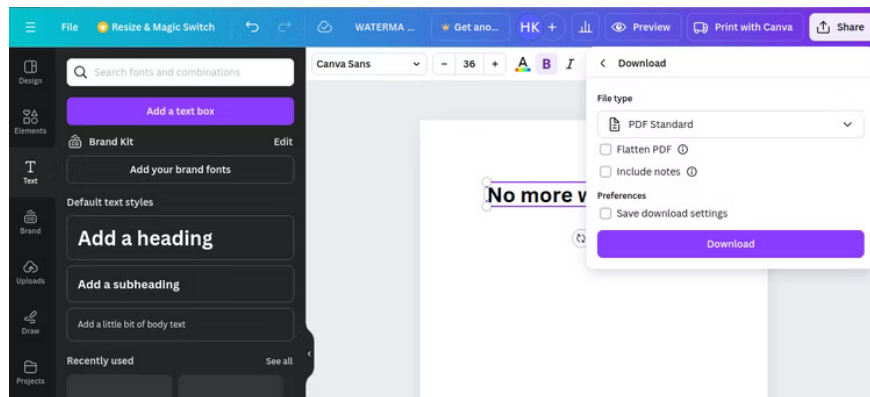

Thanks to AI applications, removing watermarks from PDF files has become incredibly easy. You simply upload the document and download the processed version; no manual steps like selecting the area to remove or adjusting the layout are required.

However, because it still relies on AI, the tool also has certain limitations. For example, Dewatermark may struggle with complex watermarks or embossed text, meaning that completely removing watermarks from PDF files is sometimes not perfect.

How to remove watermarks from PDF files using Canva

Canva is a powerful online tool ideal for creating presentations and graphics, but it also has the ability to remove watermarks from PDF files for free. To remove watermarks from PDF files using Canva, follow these steps:

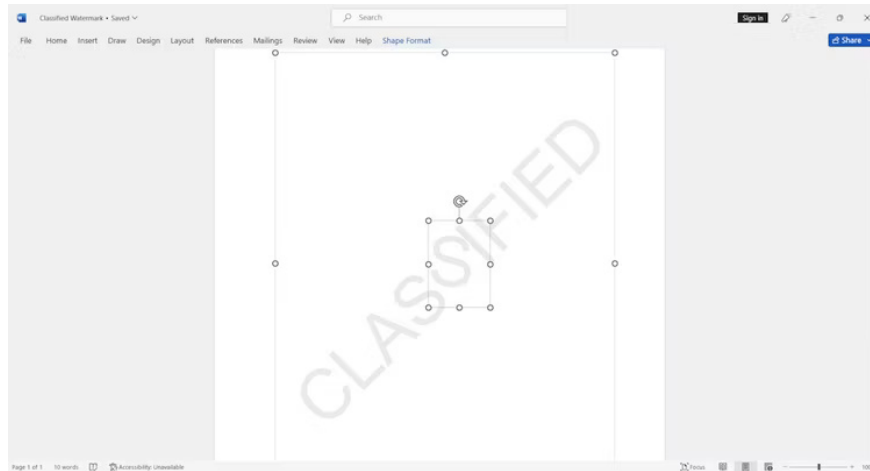
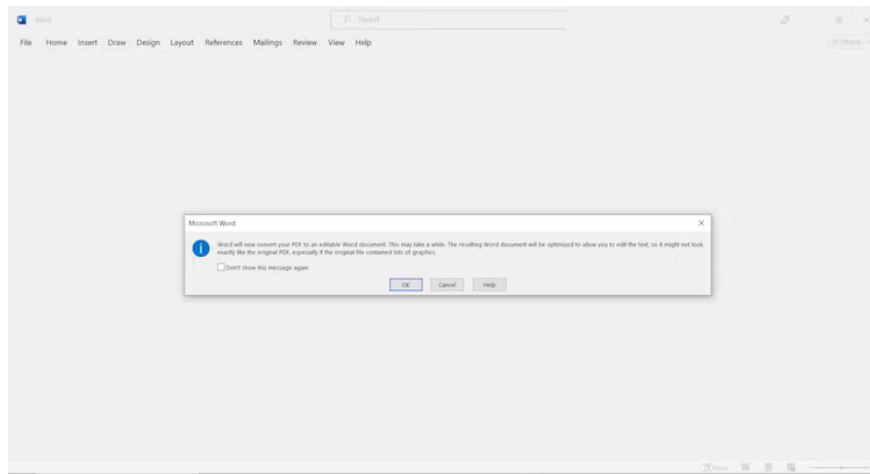
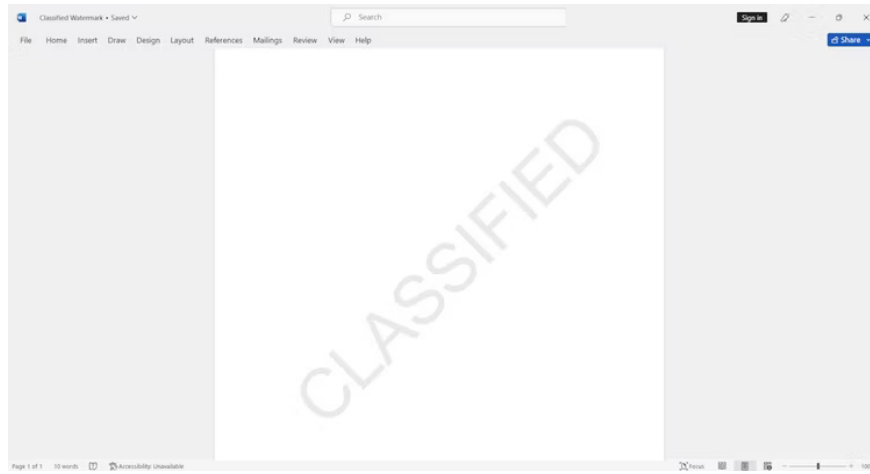


1. Create a free Canva account or log in to an existing one. If prompted, you don't need to purchase any subscriptions – basic PDF editing is completely free.
2. Next, upload the PDF file with the watermark by clicking on **Create a design** and then selecting **Import file**.
3. After uploading the PDF file, click on it to open it in Canva's built-in editor.
4. Click on the watermark to select it.
5. Press the **Backspace** key to delete the watermark. If you accidentally delete the wrong object, you can press **Ctrl + Z** to undo the last edit and try again.
6. Once you've finished removing the watermark from your PDF file, click **Share** in the upper right corner of the screen.
7. Select **Download > PDF Standard** from the **File type** drop-down menu to ensure the PDF file is downloaded correctly.

Finally, click the **Download** button to download the PDF without a watermark.

How to remove a watermark from a PDF file using Microsoft Word

Microsoft Word is one of the most popular word processing tools on the planet. You can also remove watermarks from PDF files using Microsoft Word super easily and simply.



1. Launch Microsoft Word and click **Open** .
2. Select the PDF document and click **OK** when the dialog box appears. This will convert the PDF document into a Word document.
3. If you want to edit or delete individual letters in the watermark, simply click on any letter and press **Delete**.
4. Otherwise, click anywhere on the page outside the watermark. This will select the entire page.
5. Now, press **Delete** to remove the entire watermark at once.

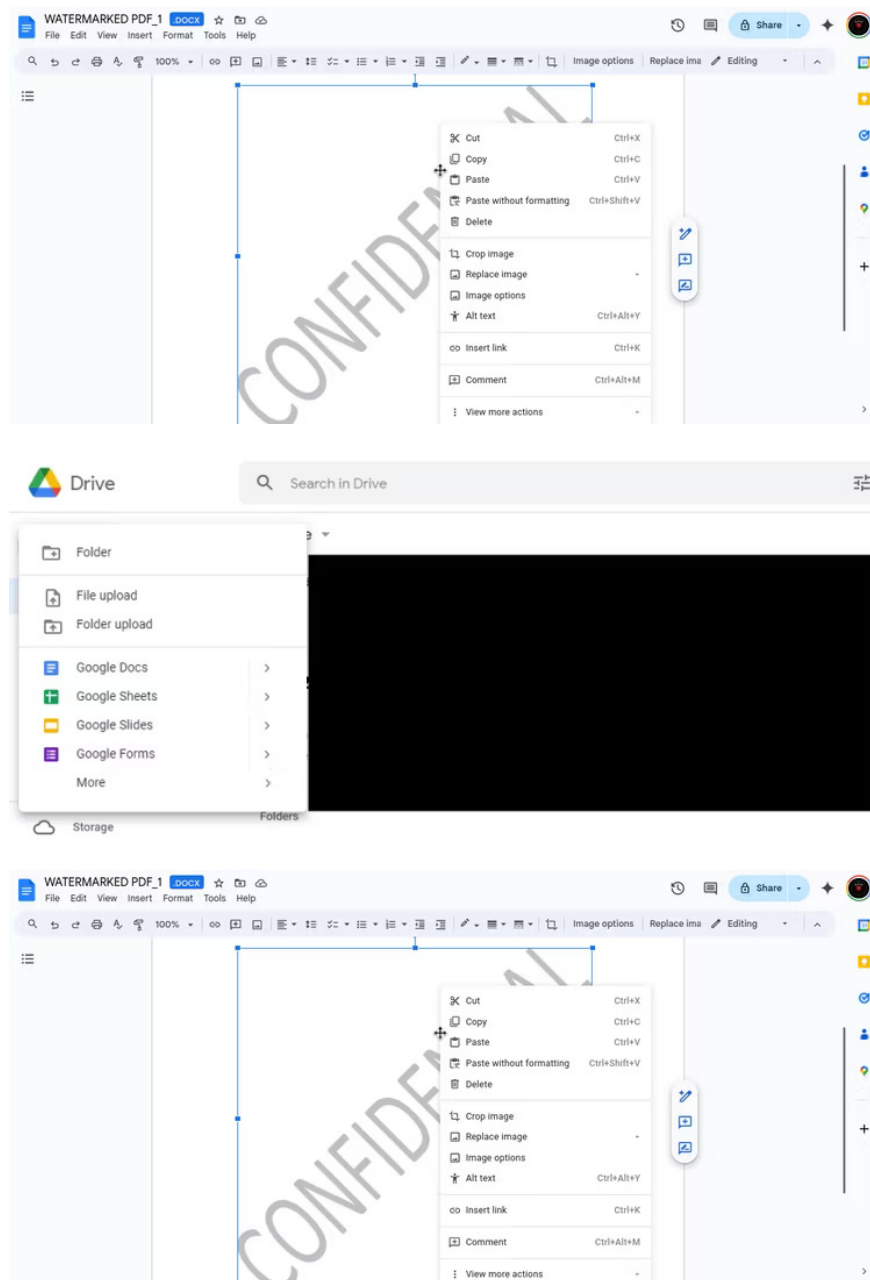
When finished, simply press **Ctrl + S** and save the document without a watermark.

How to remove watermarks from PDF files using Google Docs

If you're looking for an alternative to web tools like Canva, Google Docs is a very suitable option, but you'll need to convert your PDF file to a DOCX file before you can upload it and have it display correctly in Google Docs.

That's where Adobe Acrobat's online PDF to DOCX converter comes in handy. Before opening Google Docs, you need to upload your PDF file to the Adobe website, log in, and download the new DOCX file using the Download button in the upper right corner of the screen.

Now that you've prepared the file, here's how to remove the watermark from a PDF file in Google Docs:



1. Log in to your Google Drive account and click the + **New** button .

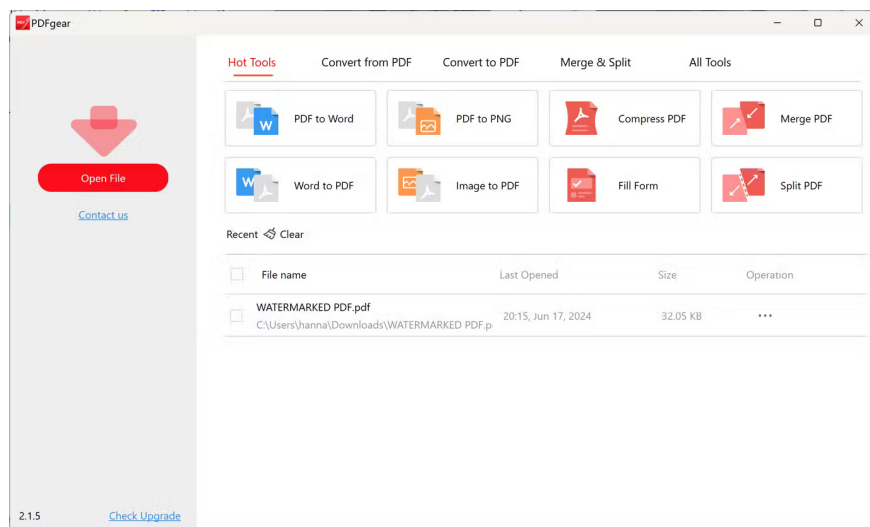
2. Click on **File Upload** and select the DOCX file with the watermark.
3. You will see the message " **...upload complete** " in the bottom right corner of the screen. Click on the file name.
4. If the file doesn't open automatically, click the **Open with** drop-down menu at the top of the page and select Google Docs.
5. If the watermark isn't automatically deleted, select it and press **Delete** on your keyboard.
6. Click on **File** , select **Download** , then click on **PDF Document** , and the PDF file without a watermark will be saved to your computer.

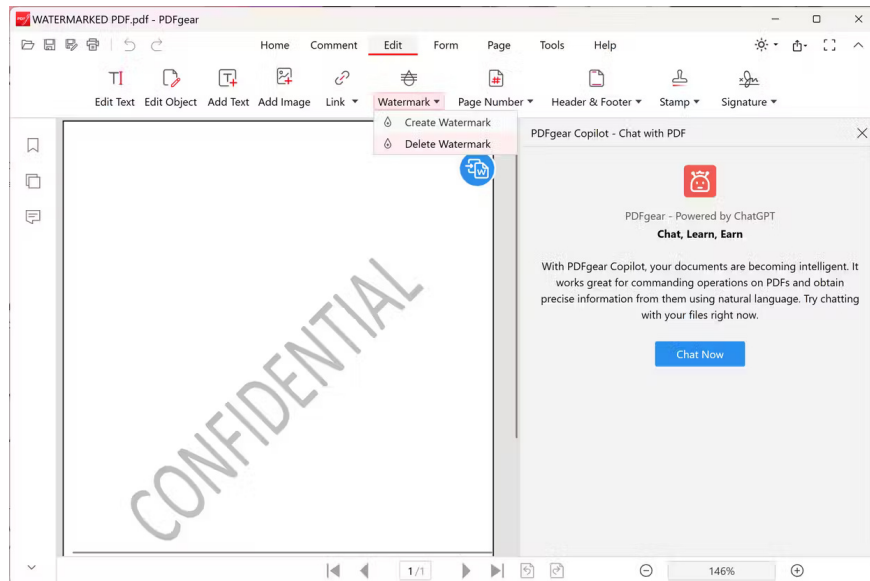
Note : If the PDF file is encrypted, you need to unlock it before you can remove the watermark.

How to remove watermarks from PDF files offline using PDFGear

If you want to remove watermarks from PDF files without an internet connection or Microsoft suite products, the best option is PDFGear. Although the portable version of this application has limitations, you can remove watermarks from PDF files for free using PDFGear on Windows or macOS.

After running the installer from the PDFGear website, you can remove the watermark from the PDF file by following these steps:





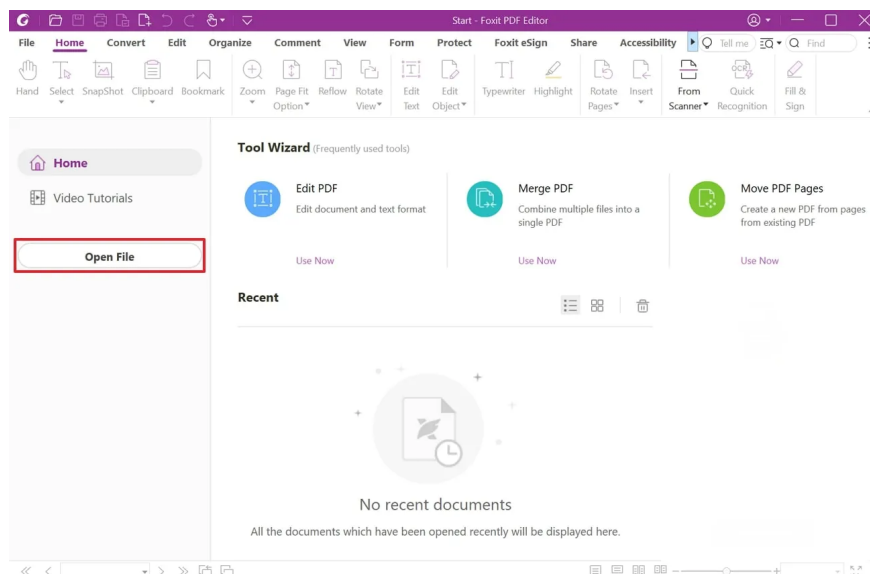
1. Open PDFGear , click **Open File** , and select the PDF file from the file browser to open it.
2. Select the **Edit** tab .
3. Click the **Watermark** drop-down menu and select **Delete Watermark** .
4. Click **Yes** when prompted, and PDFGear will attempt to remove the watermark from the PDF file.
5. Finally, press **Ctrl + Shift + S** simultaneously to save the edited PDF file as a new file.

Warning : PDFGear isn't always successful at removing watermarks. It's useful when you don't have an internet connection, but tools like Canva are generally more reliable.

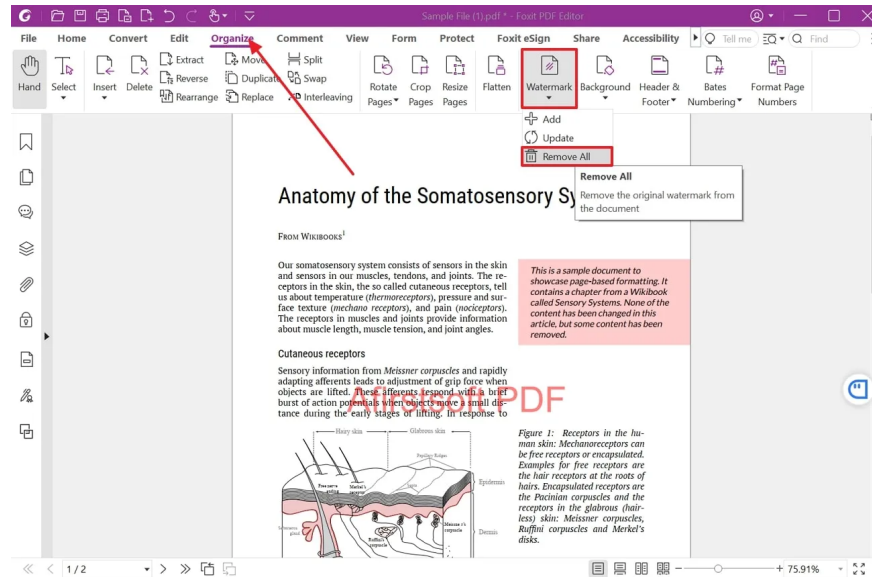
How to remove watermarks from PDF files using Foxit PDF Editor

Foxit PDF Editor is an advanced solution for removing watermarks from your PDF files. Users can access the tool's watermark feature to remove all watermarks from their documents instantly.

Step 1. To begin this process, access the main interface of Foxit PDF Editor and click the **Open File** button to import the PDF file with the watermark.



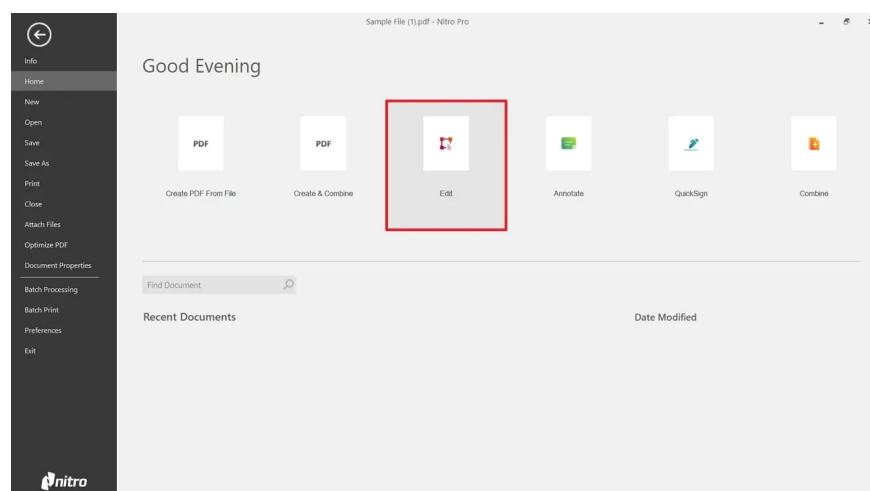
Step 2. After importing the PDF file, you will be redirected to the Foxit PDF Editor editing window. Here, click on **Organize** from the top menu bar and navigate to the **Watermark** tool to select **Remove All** from the drop-down menu.



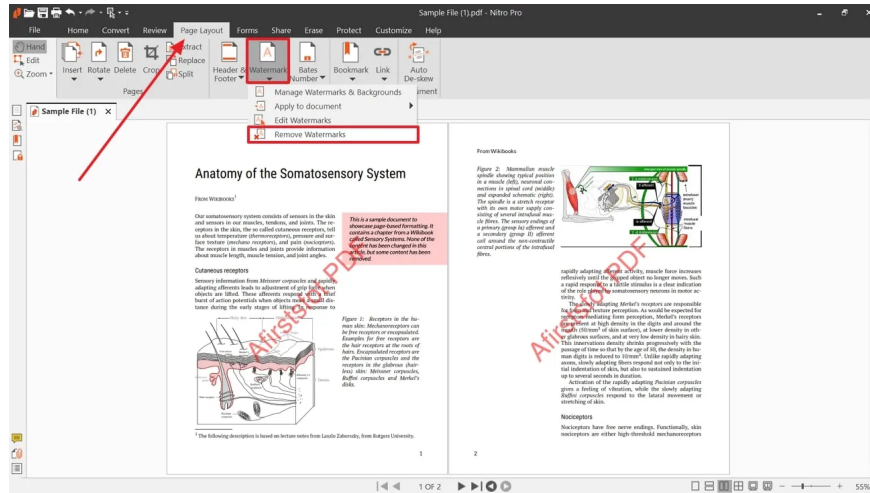
How to remove watermarks from PDF files using Nitro PDF

Furthermore, you can change the opacity, font, and color of the watermark to your liking. Follow the steps below to learn how to remove watermarks from PDF files using Nitro PDF :

Step 1. Begin the watermark removal process by accessing the software on your computer. Click the **Edit** option from the main interface to import the PDF file from which you want to remove the watermark.



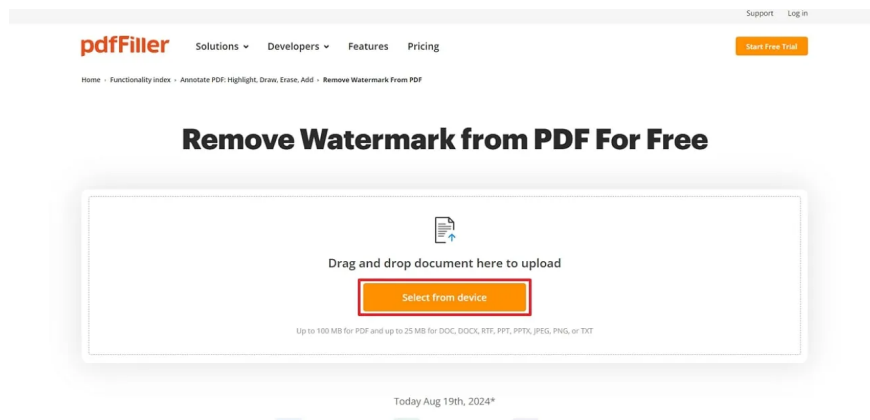
Step 2. In the Nitro PDF editing window, navigate to the **Page Layout** tool from the top navigation bar. Next, select **Remove Watermarks** from the Watermark feature to remove all watermarks.



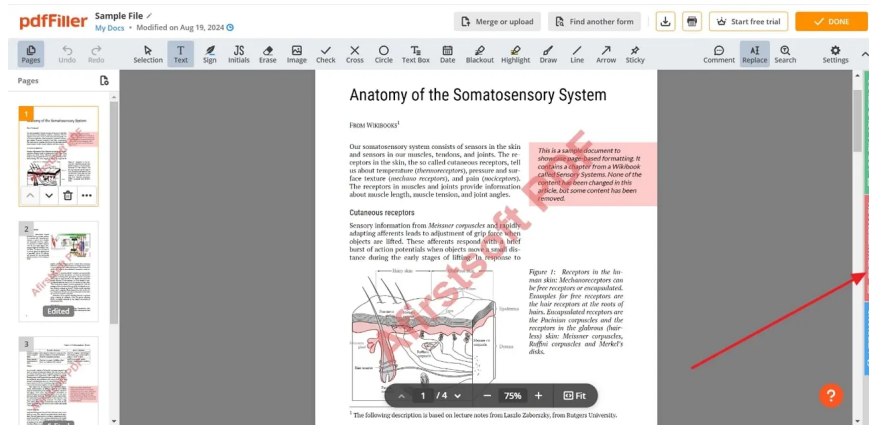
How to remove watermarks from PDF files using pdfFiller

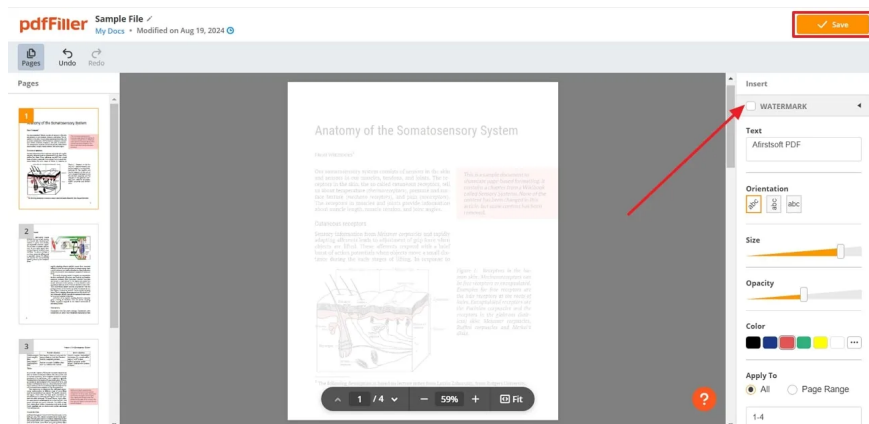
Step 1. Begin the process by accessing the watermark removal function from the official pdfFiller website. Next, upload your PDF document using the **Select from Device** button.

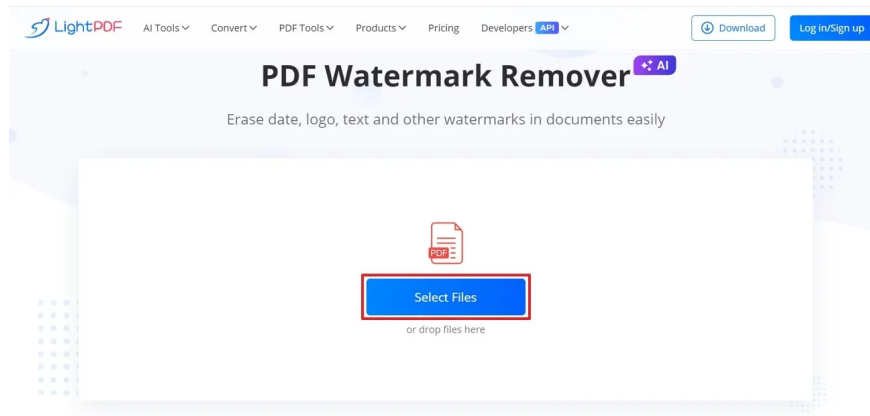
Step 3. Next, uncheck the **Watermark** checkbox in the **Insert** section and click the **Save** button in the upper right corner to apply the changes you have made.



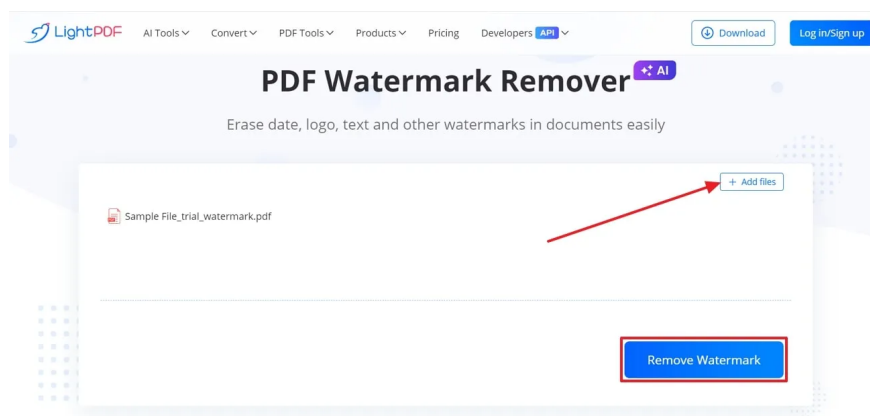

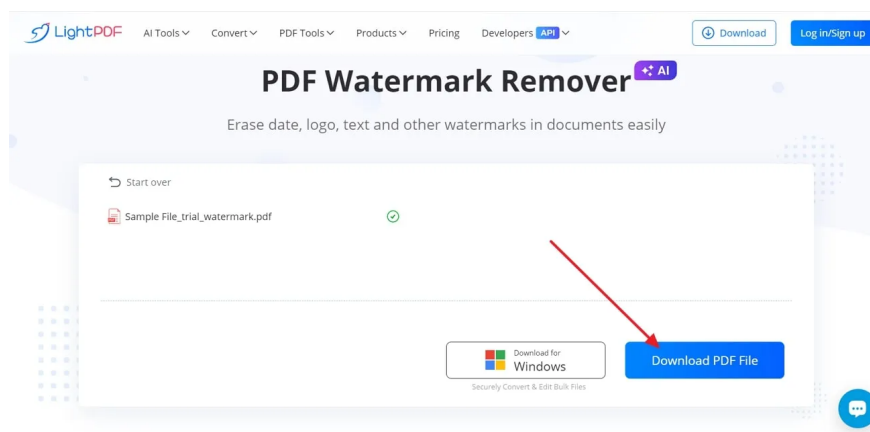

Step 3. In the next interface, the new version of the file with the watermark removed will appear. Finally, click **Download PDF File** to save the document to your computer.

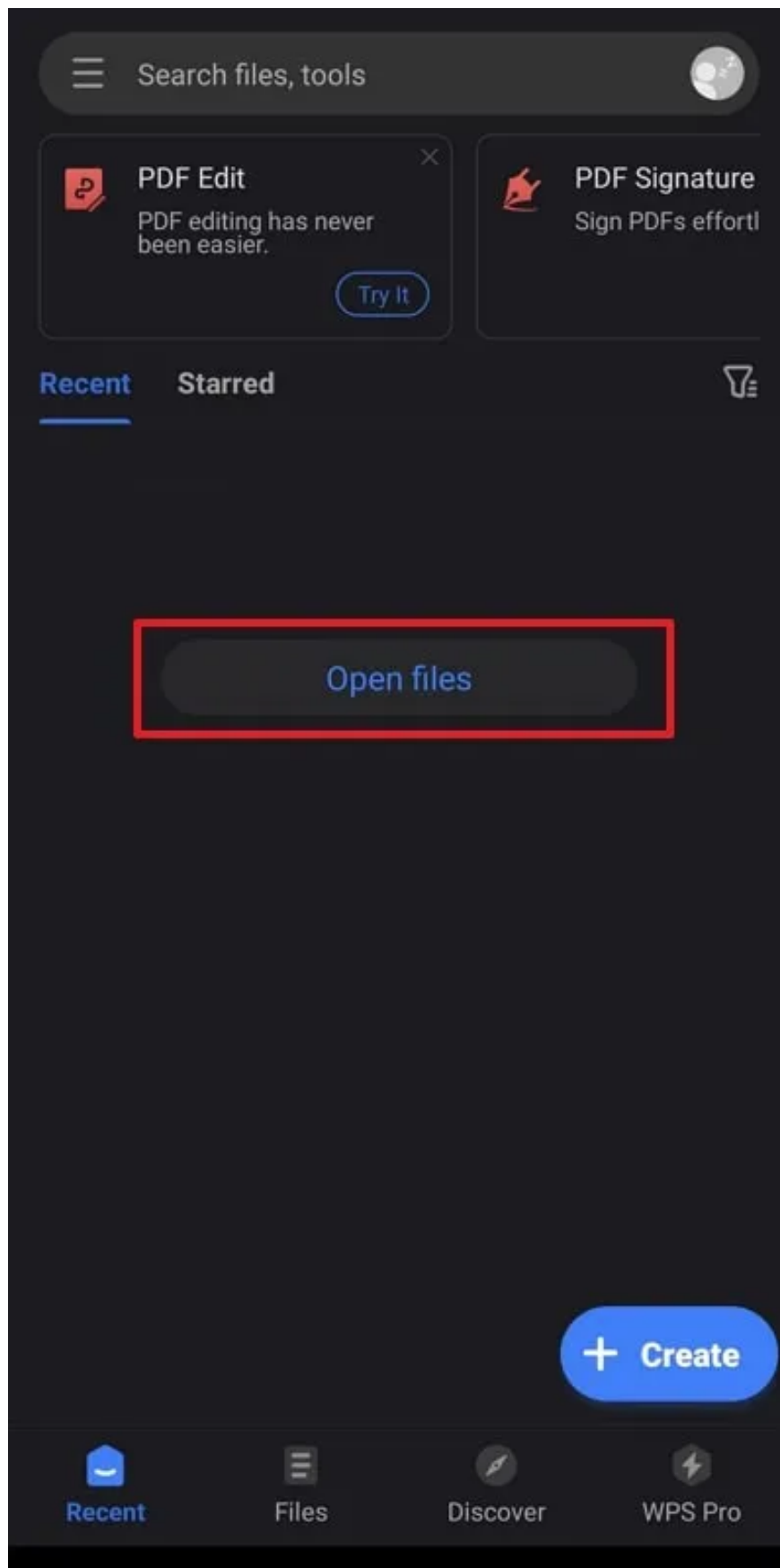


How to remove watermarks from PDF files using WPS Office

Furthermore, new watermark text can be added if desired to replace the current watermark. See the steps below to learn how to remove watermarks

from PDF files using WPS Office:

Step 1. Download the mobile app on your device via the App Store or Play Store to import PDF files. Then, tap the "**Open files**" button to import the PDF file and remove the watermark with just one click.



Step 2. Once your watermarked PDF file is in the software, a new screen will open where you can begin the removal process. Then, click the Watermark icon on the bottom menu bar of the screen.

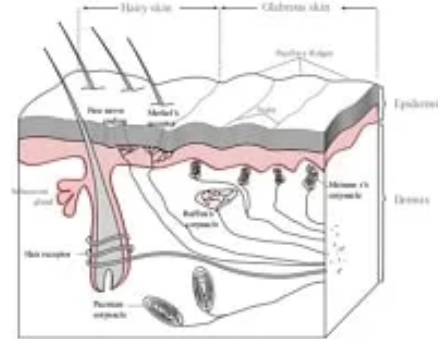
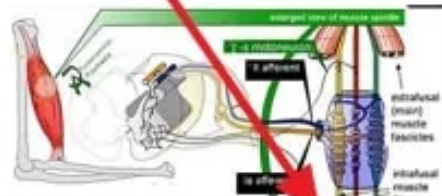


Figure 1: Receptors in the human skin: Mechanoreceptors can be free receptors or encapsulated. Examples for free receptors are the hair receptors at the roots of hairs. Encapsulated receptors are the Pacinian corpuscles and the receptors in the glabrous (hairless) skin: Meissner corpuscles, Ruffini corpuscles and Merkel's disks.

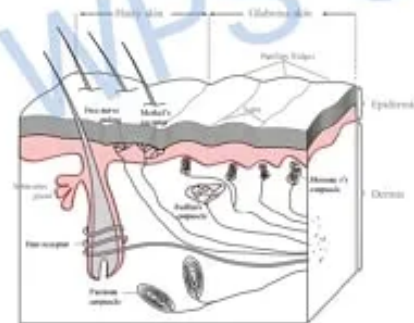
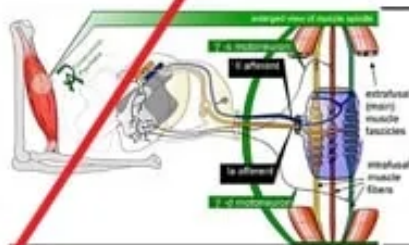


Figure 1: Receptors in the human skin: Mechanoreceptors can be free receptors or encapsulated. Examples for free receptors are the hair receptors at the roots of hairs. Encapsulated receptors are the Pacinian corpuscles and the receptors in the glabrous (hairless) skin: Meissner corpuscles, Ruffini corpuscles and Merkel's discs.

How to remove watermarks from PDF files using PDF Watermark Remover

With the help of this mobile application, users can remove existing watermarks from their PDF documents for free. PDF Watermark Remover allows you to remove all types of watermarks from files. This application also features cloud storage, where your previous PDF files are saved in My PDFs.

Step 1. Access the main interface and import the PDF file you want to work with by selecting the option that best suits your watermark criteria.
