#3.1. ColorPick Eyedropper

The ColorPick Eyedropper will display values for any color when you point your mouse at it.

This extension supports reading in color from text, images, and nearly anything you see on a website (including ads). When you mouse over an object you want to color, the ColorPick Eyedropper will display the HTML, RGB and HSL values of that color, in great detail.

#3.2. ColorZilla

The ColorZilla extension is a collection of Eyedropper, Color picker, and Gradient Generator, along with many other tools for design work.

#4. Image Downloader

There are quite a few sites that limit or do not allow you to download photos (eg Instagram, Behance .) So sometimes it is difficult to download images to put in the moodboard as a reference. Well, the Image Downloader utility will help you solve this problem!

#5. SVG-Grabber

This extension is very suitable for those who specialize in UI / UX Designer because it will help you get the icon and sticker templates on the website in the form of SVG files. You can easily edit and apply to your other projects.

#6. Dimensions

The Dimensions widget allows designers to easily measure the height and width of any element or object on the targeted page, making it easy to recreate existing pages and test existing designs. in.

#7. Windows Resizer

Window Resizer makes it easy for you to resize the web browser window, the purpose is to simulate different screen resolutions.

This extension is especially useful for web designers and developers by helping them test the layout of the website on different browser resolutions.

#8. Pixlr Editor

Pixlr Editor is probably very famous already, this is an extension that supports editing photos right on the web browser, you can easily control the image quality, including layers and effects.

Not only that, this utility also contains advanced features commonly found in specialized graphic design applications / software on computers, such as layers, lasso tools, brush controls, multiplication copies and

filters....

#9. Palette Creator

Palette Creator is an extension that allows you to create a palette from any image. You just need to right click on the image and select the option of Palette Creator and you are done, very simple.
