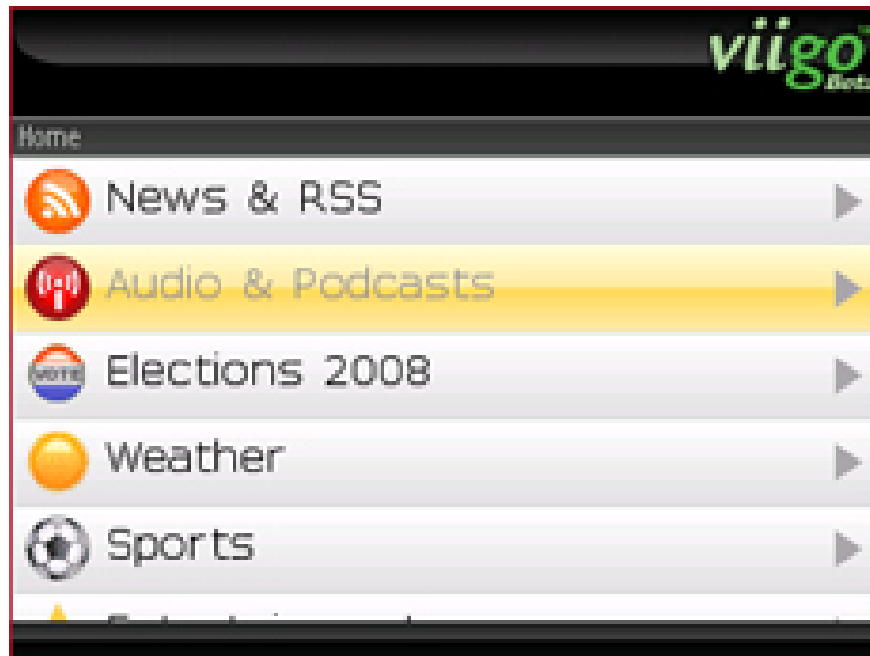

Besides the paid apps, there are some applications that have perfection but are still available for free. In this article we will introduce to you, who owns these BlackBerry 10 handsets, this useful free application.

Viigo

Viigo is a full-featured RSS feed reader, which allows you to read your favorite feeds and quickly update important news wherever you are.



Choose Viigo's accompanying feeds or add your own feed

You can add your own feeds (Viigo's 'auto-detect' auto detection function can detect feed addresses on most websites), but Viigo is also equipped with a variety of content on technology, politics, sports, fashion and other feeds.

Pre-configured feeds also allow you to easily set up traffic alerts, stay up to date on flights and check packages from UPS, US Postal Service, FedEx and DHL . The new version, currently in beta, adds support for customized search warnings, even podcasts.

Vlingo



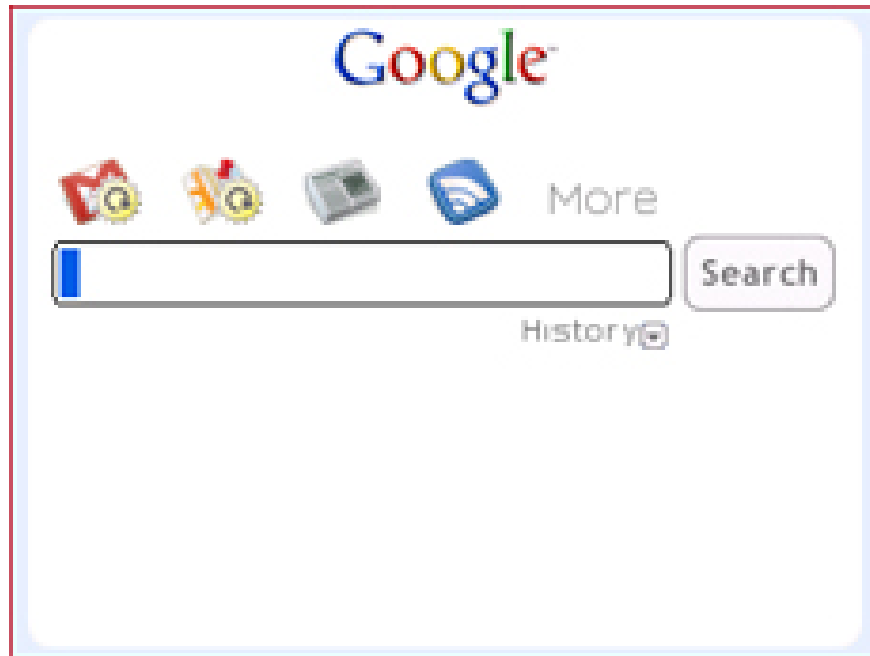
Vlingo voice recognition application

Although BlackBerry needs this support for voice dialing, the Vlingo voice recognition application shows its superiority compared to dialing from your name to your address.

Just use your voice, you can launch web searches, launch BlackBerry attachment applications (such as Open Calendar), edit emails and send written notifications.

The operation of the application here is very good, so you don't need to worry about checking before sending. Vlingo takes over the application key on your BlackBerry and makes it easier to access while using the phone.

Google Mobile

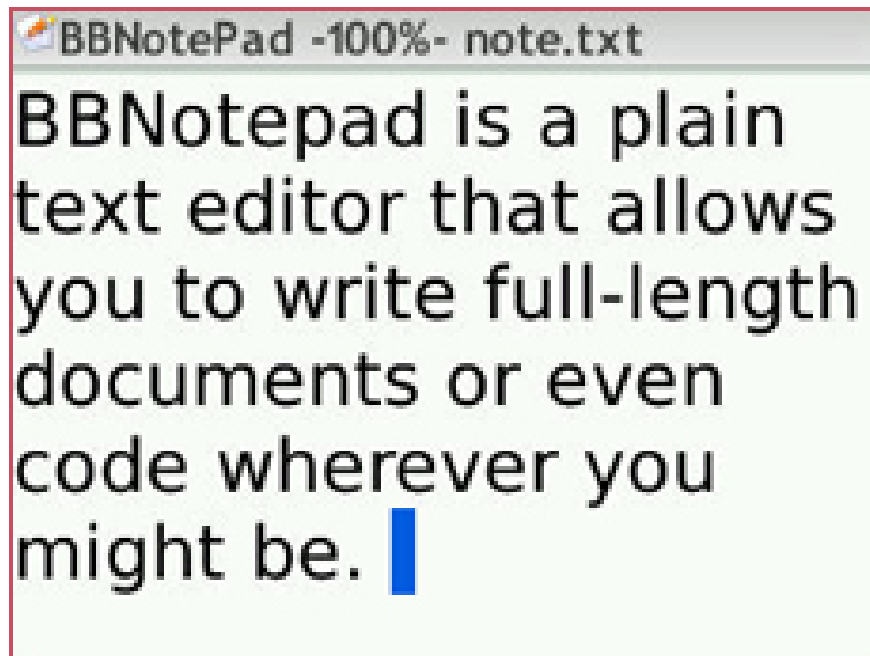


Google Mobile gives easy access to Gmail, Picasa, Google Maps, Google Sync, .

Access all of Google's friendly mobile services with Google Mobile. A separate interface gives you one-stop access to Google's Gmail and Map applications (can be integrated with your attached GPS tool if BlackBerry allows).

The tool also includes links to Google services like search, Google News, Google Reader, Google Docs (read only on mobile devices), Picasa photos and Google Notebook, all of which are is opened in BlackBerry's attached web browser. Google Mobile also includes Google Sync, a service that allows two-way synchronization between the schedule in BlackBerry and Google's Web Calendar.

BBNotePad



Write documents long enough with BBNotePad.

BBNotePad is a text editor that allows you to write rich documents or even code anywhere.

BBNotePad supports three text sizes and it stores files under the .txt extension so it can be opened directly on any computer, stored on BlackBerry internal memory or on an external memory card. This is a useful tool for sending notifications and memos on Bluetooth to other hands-on devices.

GridMagic Community Edition



GridMagic allows you to create spreadsheets or run complex calculations

If you need to run complex calculations or need to organize some information into a table, GridMagic Community Edition by Simprit Free Software Community allows you to create spreadsheets easily despite being on the road.

GridMagic supports a wide range of math functions, allowing you to add formatting to keep things clear and easy to read. Typical spreadsheet functions like squares, row and column selection and copy -paste capabilities are also allowed here. Spreadsheets can be emailed as Excel .xls attachments via a menu item in the BlackBerry email editor screen.

Opera Mini

Although the web browser is in BlackBerry, it really lacks the power and features that allow you to surf the web in the best way. Opera Software's Opera Mini browser lets you surf standard web sites and render quickly.

Opera Mini's secret to success is that it handles requests through Opera's servers. The browser cache is quite good, allowing you to return almost immediately to the previous page; This is really a useful tool for checking search results.

Opera Mini includes great bookmark features as well as the ability to view pages when they appear on a full-size computer screen, which can zoom in or zoom out easily.

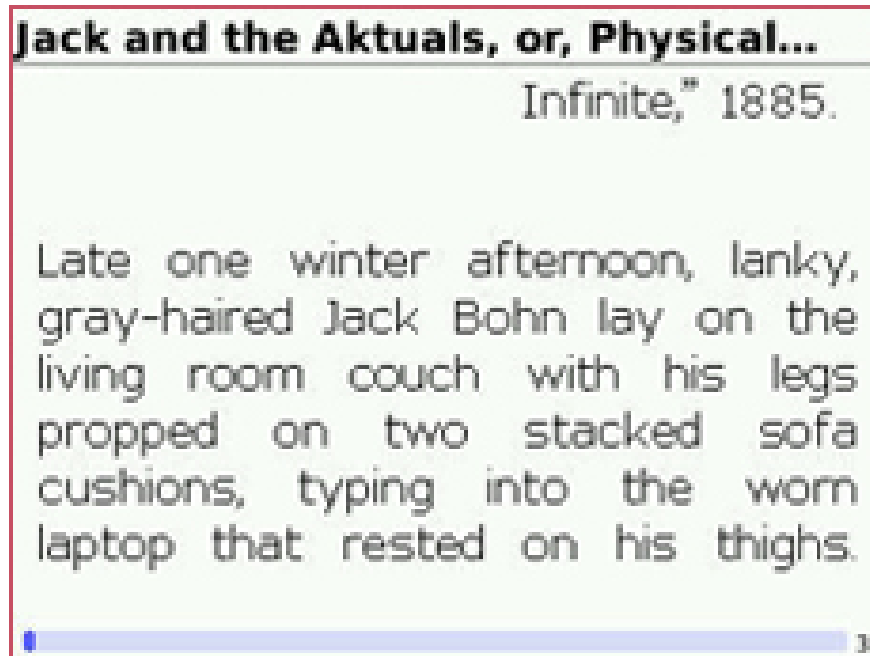


Opera Mini is a full-featured mobile web browser

Mobipocket Reader

You will always have something to read with Mobipocket's e-book reader. Text is easy to read, even on the BlackBerry small screen, and you can add your own animations if you wish.

Mobipocket offers a wide range of criteria for purchasing through its product store (accessible from your computer or directly from your BlackBerry), however the .mobi format is a standard provided by virtually all e-book sellers.




Mobipocket Reader brings ebooks to BlackBerry.

You can also use desktop software to convert documents from PDF, HTML and text file formats to your BlackBerry, making Mobipocket Reader an ideal tool for reviewing tasks, work as well as personal documents.

iSkoot

Send and receive Skype calls on BlackBerry using iSkoot's Skype client feature. The sound quality here is better than you would expect - even on slower 2G Internet connections - iSkoot's tagged interface makes it easier to navigate, besides iSkoot also allows you chat in writing if you like.



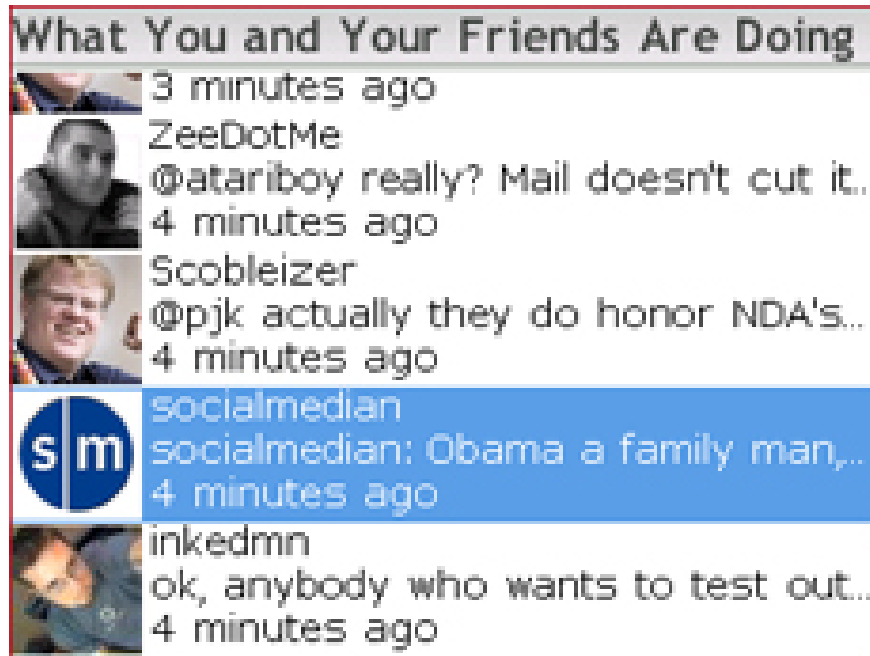

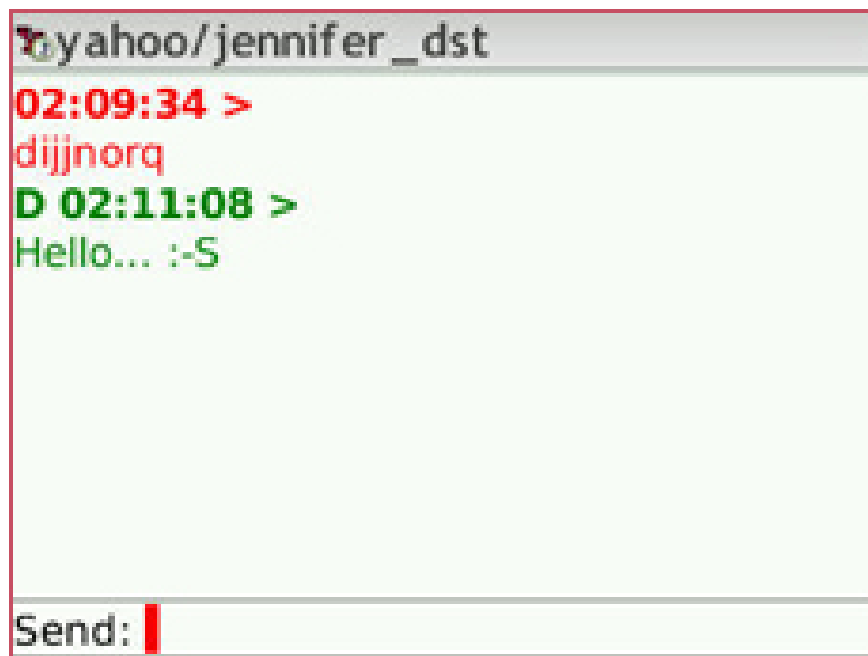


TwitterBerry allows you to stay informed on the road easily

You need to create a "master" account to log in to the software, but once logged into WebMessenger you can still log in to your existing accounts with AOL, Google, ICQ, Jabber, MSN, Skype or Yahoo.

WebMessenger downloads your buddy list so you can easily see who is online and can chat with them instantly. Depending on the capabilities of each network, you can chat with groups, send messages to multiple recipients, add or remove contacts, so you work with the desktop client - create WebMessenger into a tool. effective chat tool.
