

10 free entertaining games on Android and iPhone

Whenever you have some free time with nothing to do, check out these fast and free mobile games to have fun. From fun arcade challenges to puzzling puzzles, these games will keep you entertained.

All games are available for free on Android and iOS, although they have optional in-app purchases.

1. iSlash Heroes



Sharpen your blade and prepare for iSlash Heroes. Your goal is to slash the board pieces until the meter reaches the red ribbon. The trick is to pay attention to the bouncing ninja stars because if you hit one, you will lose your life.

The more pieces you remove, the less space there is for the stars to move.

2. Fishing Break



Fishing Break is a colorful challenge. You jump on a boat and travel to different underwater worlds, catch fish and create a collection. Swipe to throw, then tap and hold to spin your line. Just be careful not to pull them in too quickly or you could break the wire.

You can earn coins from the fish you sell and use them to unlock better fishing spots.

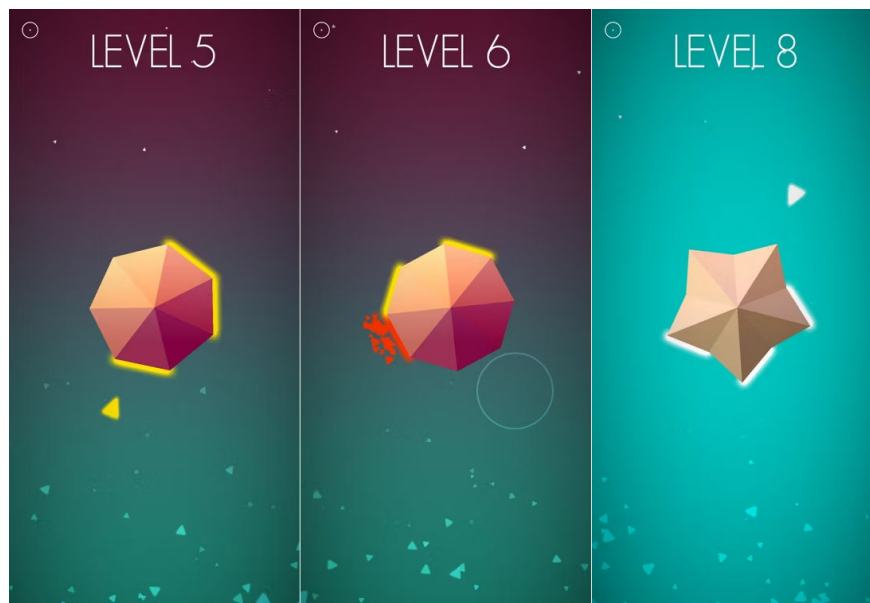
3. Doodle Jump



Doodle Jump has been on smartphones for many years but it's still as addictive as ever. The aim is to control a small creature to jump, tilt your phone to avoid enemies, collect power-ups like jetpacks, and see how high you can get.

There are lots of different themed levels to play, missions to complete and global leaderboards to strive for.

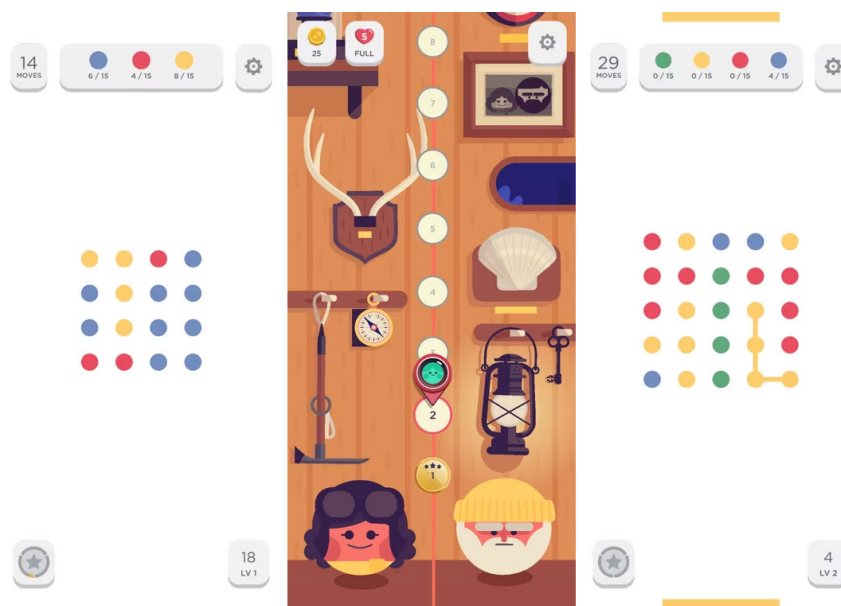
4. Polyforge



Polyforge is a relaxing mobile game. As the crystal spins, you time your taps on each edge using the color. But be careful - if you tap the same edge twice, you have to start over.

Each correct press produces a beautiful musical melody, but an incorrect press produces an out-of-tune note.

5. Two Dots



Containing thousands of levels, Two Dots allows you to connect dots of the same color to collect and clear them from the board. You have limited moves and lives, and can use boosts to help you get out of a sticky situation.

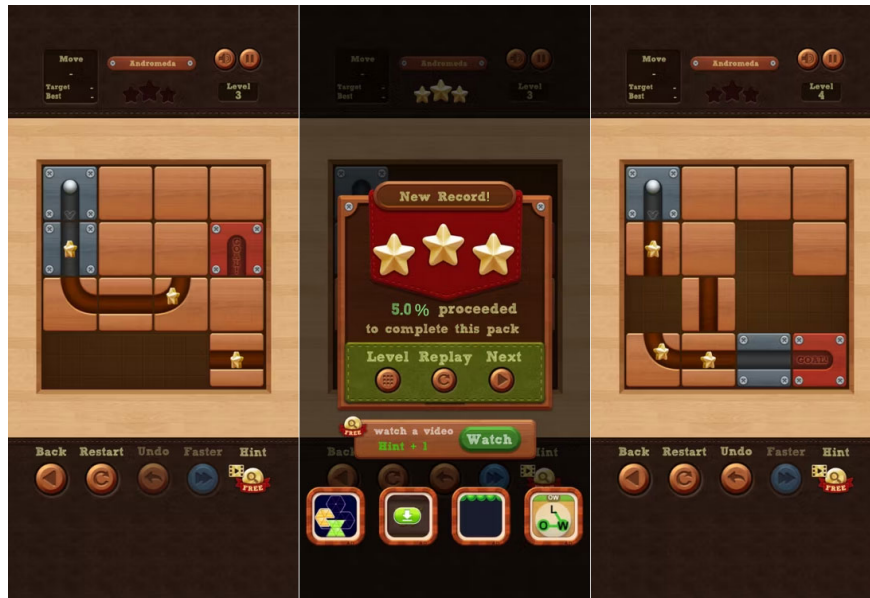
6. Angry Birds Blast



You don't have to be an Angry Birds fan to have fun with Angry Birds Blast. In this matching game, you pop adjacent balloons of the same color to release the birds. Gather large zones to create bombs and laser guns to pop balloons, and use power-ups if you get stuck.

You must be strategic because the number of moves is limited.

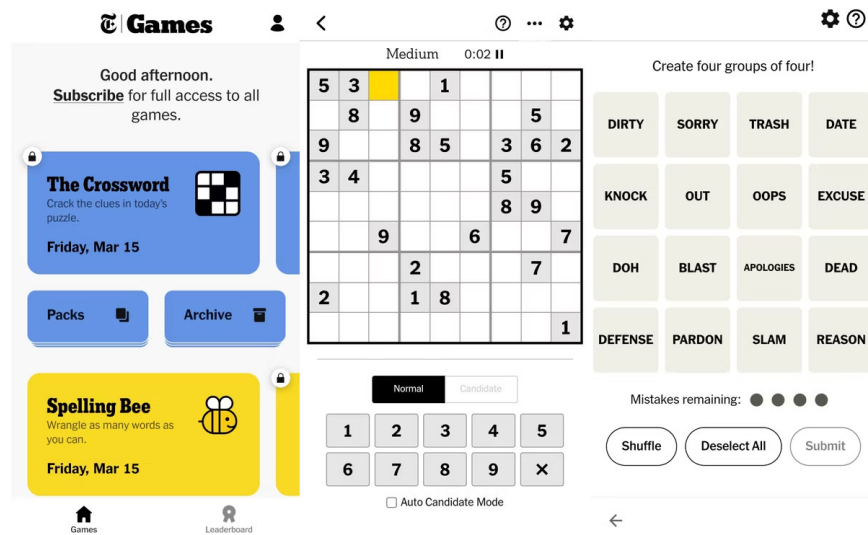
7. Roll the Ball

Try your best to arrange the tiles so that you can collect 3 stars in each level. There is no limit to time or number of moves, so play at your own pace.

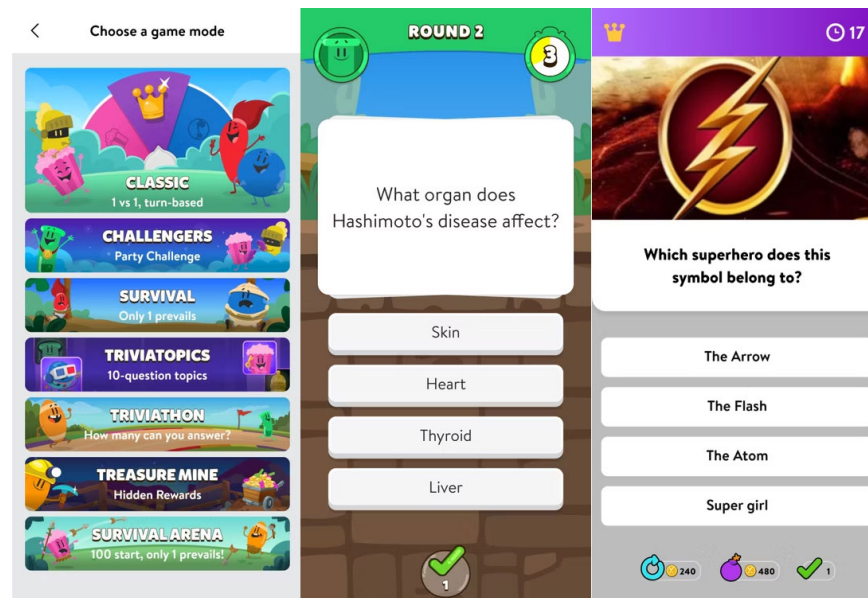
8. NYT Games
