

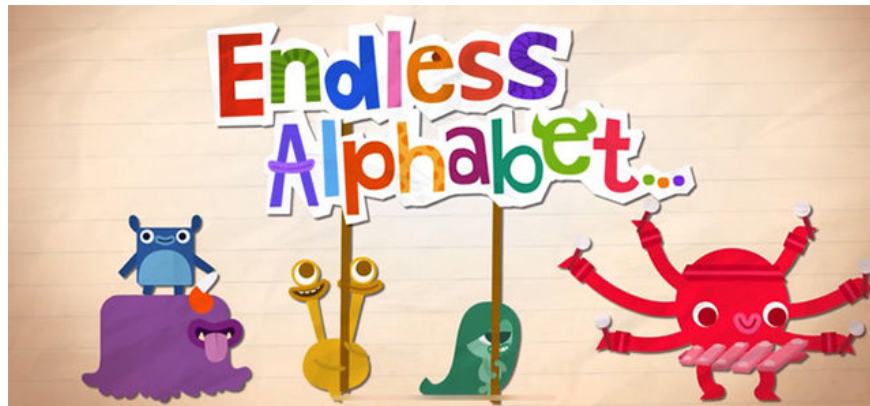
10 fun educational apps for kids on the iPhone

The alphabet will come alive in Endless Alphabet. With over 100 words, the application builds interactive puzzle games involving letters and vocabulary.

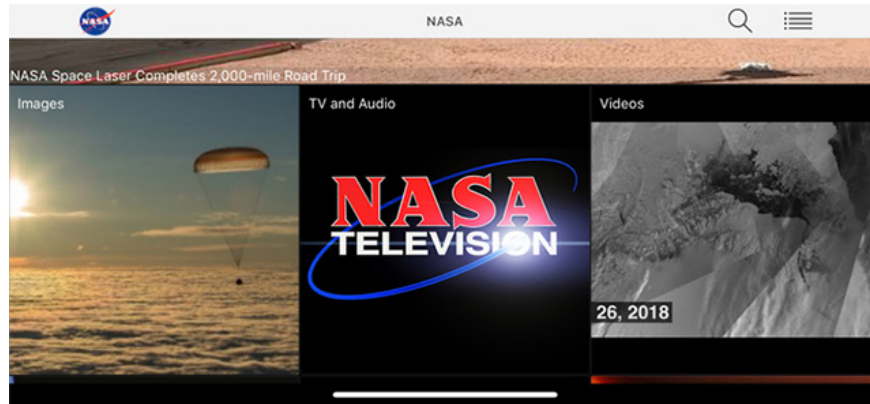

3. Peekaboo Barn



An iconic educational app, the Peekaboo Barn is still a perfect way to entertain and educate young children and even toddlers.

After starting the app, children will be taken to visit a small barn, hear an animal inside a cage and guess their names, touch the screen to see the answer. Parents can tell the narrator voice in a child's voice or an adult voice in English or Spanish.

4. Thinkrolls



With 26 fun characters, Thinkrolls combines a platformer game and puzzle game to help young minds learn and have fun. Application has 207 levels with different puzzles. All quizzes allow children to experiment with practical scientific concepts including gravity, heat, buoyancy, speed, elasticity, friction, and many other physical concepts.

And although the game is created for children, parents can also play with them because the game can be up to 9 players at a time. Children aged 3 to 5 years can choose the level of play easily and children between the ages of 5 and 8 can choose the difficulty level.

5. Sesame Street



Children can visit Sesame Street anytime if they want with this great app. In addition to video clips featuring celebrities like Elmo, Cookie Monster, Abby Cadabby, etc., this app also has many educational games.

Children can access their recently viewed videos, save their favorite shows to watch later, and even search for characters or topics. Mom and Dad can also search for specific videos for children's learning goals such as science, literature, health, math, emotional development and more.

6. Toca Lab: Plants



Consider the Toca Lab: Plants as Horrors' Little Shop without more gore and education scenes. Children start the application with a tree and can perform various experiments to breed 35 different tree characters with separate personalities.

The application has 5 different locations such as watering cans, developmental lighting, mirrors, nutrition stations and breeding rooms to move the plants to these locations. Although basic knowledge of biology can be explored, children can know plants of five different types and gain more knowledge about the scientific names of plants on the earth.

7. Stack the States 2



Even topics that are less interested in geography become interesting with the Stack the States app 2. As you might guess from its name, Stack the States 2 is an application for 50 states in the United States. .

Children can learn about the capital, cities, maps, landmark, flags, and other great information about the United States. Great interactive map with big cities and provides 3D views for each state. Each state also has its own flash card with important information.

8. Sago Mini Puppy Preschool

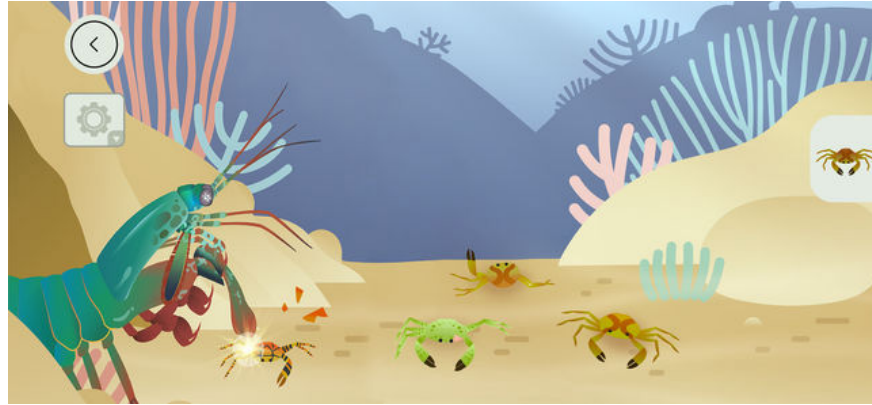


Another great game for both children and elementary students, Sago Mini Puppy Preschool has a variety of topics including numbers, face recognition, music connection and play.

An interesting feature of this game is that children can learn to count in more than 15 languages. The application is used while offline is suitable for picnics or flights.

9. Coral Reef by Tinybop

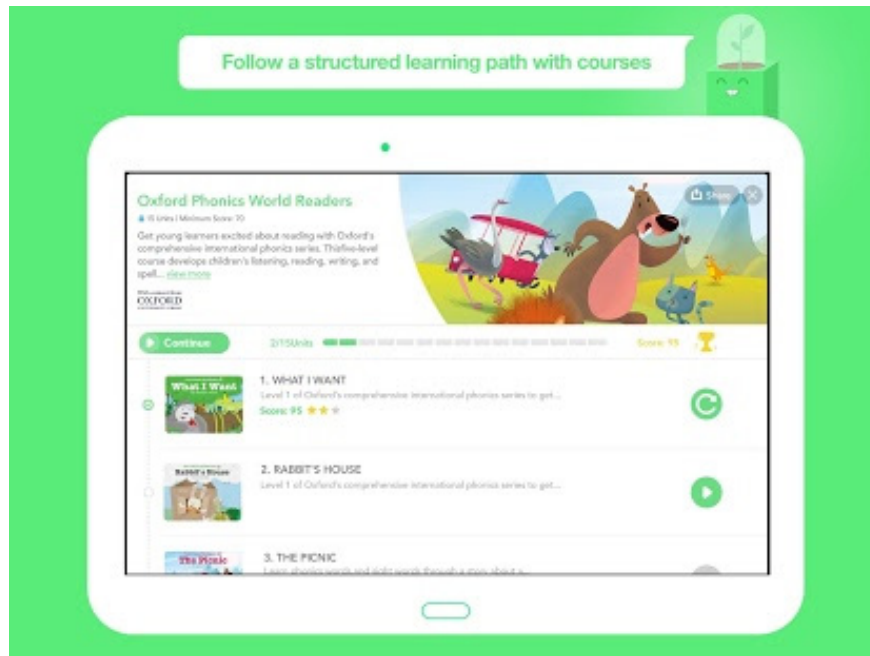

Parents can even download a special handbook from Tinybop about the interesting facts about organisms in the field, suggestions and discussion questions to help children make the most of the application.

10. TinyTap, Games by Teachers



TinyTap is a comprehensive learning suite, offering games and learning content from Oxford University Press.

The most interesting feature of the application is the ability of children to turn ideas from educational games into reality without any coding skills and can share results right on the application. And that will certainly give a child the confidence to take a leap to learn important code skills in the future.

The content in the app is for ages 2 to 8, parents can choose a special curriculum of the game for their children. There are also a number of areas for young children to learn such as English, math, social skills and science. There is even content for learners with special needs. Although the application is free to download, you need to register to get the most out of features and applications.
