And another benefit of using Magisk is that it supports modules. These small apps customize, enhance and add functionality to your Android device. You can use it to increase battery life, install iOS emoticons on Android phones, etc. This article will show you how to install Magisk module and introduce 10 best modules.

## How to install Magisk module on Android

If Magisk is not installed, read the article [How to root your Android phone using Magisk](#). In case your phone is rooted using the old SuperSu method, you can unroot and then root again with Magisk.

There are two ways to install Magisk modules, automatically and manually. Both use Magisk Manager application and the implementation is very simple.

### Method 1: Install Magisk module automatically

**Step 1.** Open Magisk Manager, slide the bar to the left of the screen and select **Downloads** .

**Step 2** . You should now see a list of available Magisk modules. Click on a module to read more information, including any additional instructions on how to install or use it.

**Step 3** . To install the module, click the download icon. Here some options are provided:

1. **Download** : save module to phone memory
2. **Install** : download and install the module in one step.

**Step 4** . Select **Install** . This process does not take a long time, although it depends on the size of the module.

**Step 5** . Click **Reboot** when prompted and the phone will restart with the module installed.

Now comes with companion App Systemizer application written by [@loserskater](#), which lets you pick any user-installed app to be converted to a system app (reboot is required after you select apps to be systemized). THIS MODULE CANNOT BE INSTALLED FROM RECOVERY! Install from Magisk Manager only. Check [Support thread](#) for additional information.

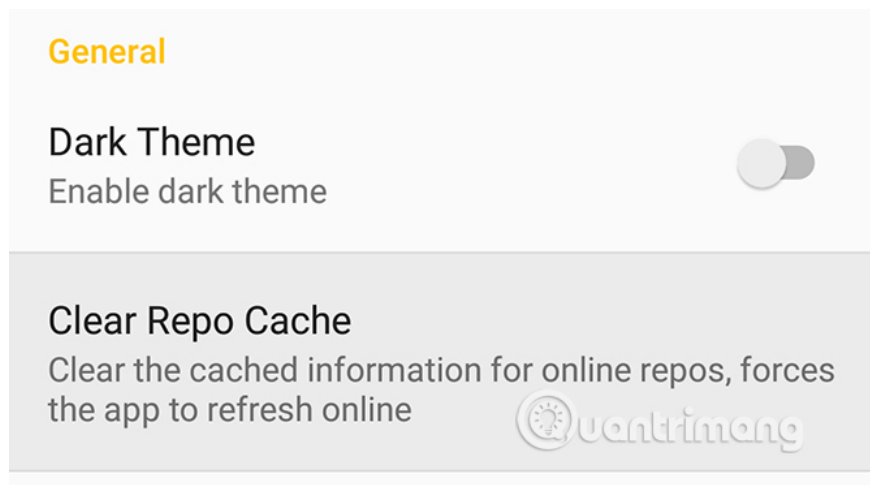

## Method 2: Install the module manually

Use this second method if you download the module manually. You can find many modules on Magisk GitHub or XDA Developers forum.

**Step 1** . Download the module to phone memory.

**Step 2** . In Magisk Manager, open the sidebar and select **Modules** .

**Step 3** . Click the plus icon, then find the downloaded module.

**Step 4** . Click and hold on the module and select **Open** . It will start installing immediately.

**Step 5** . Restart the phone when prompted.

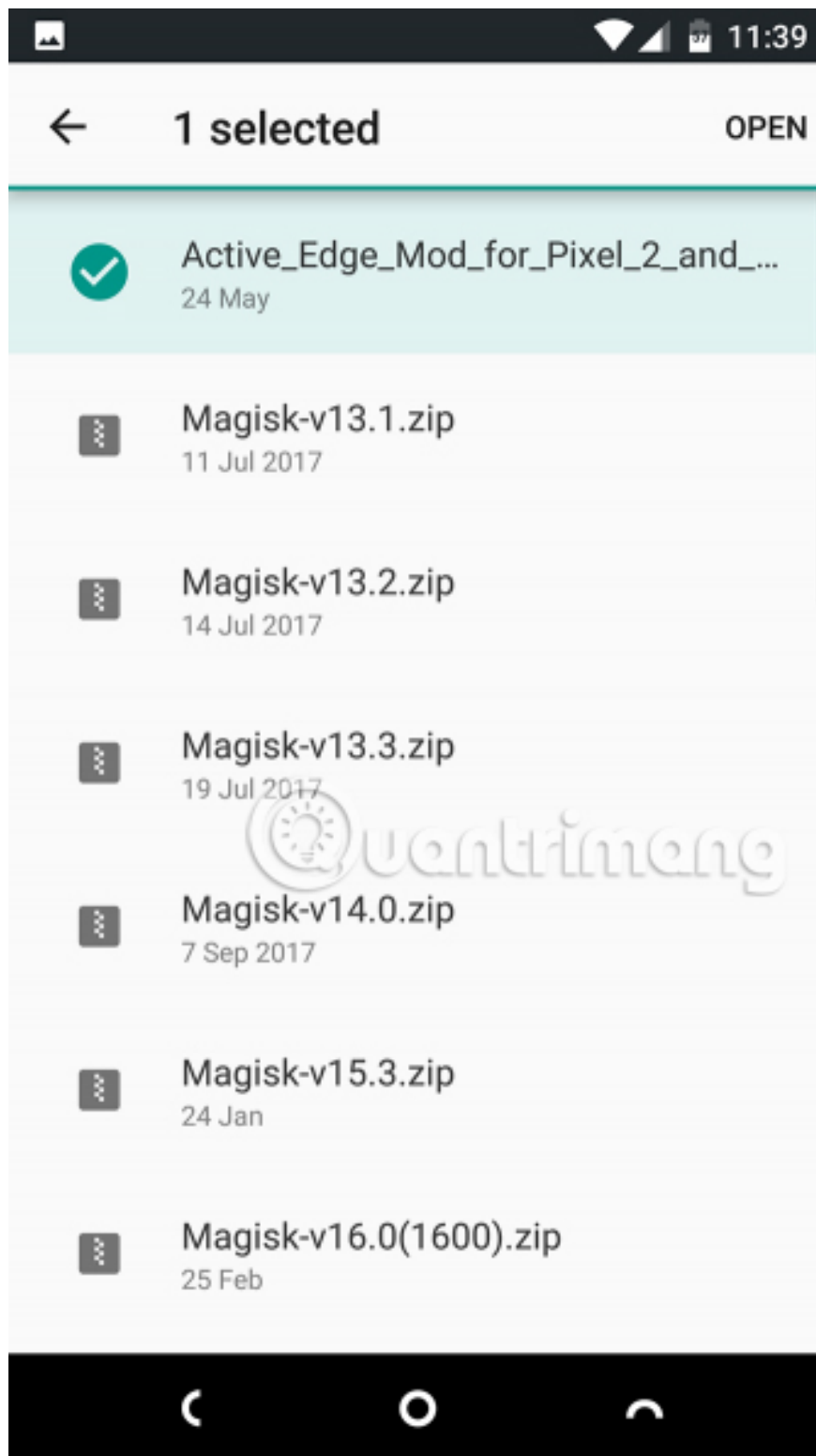

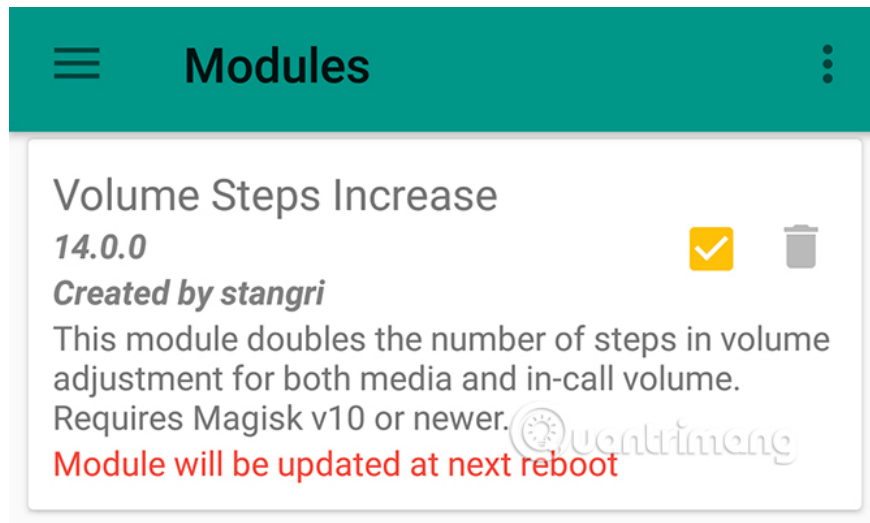


## How to uninstall Magisk module on Android

To handle problematic modules, install the Magisk Manager module for Recovery Mode so that you can delete any module in **Recovery** mode.

To uninstall or disable the module, go to **Modules** in the Magisk Manager application:

1. Uncheck the box next to a module to disable it, then restart.
2. Click on the trash icon to completely delete the module, then reboot to complete the process.



Now that you know how to use the module, and below are 10 Magisk modules you should consider and install them. To install you just need to search on the **Downloads** menu.

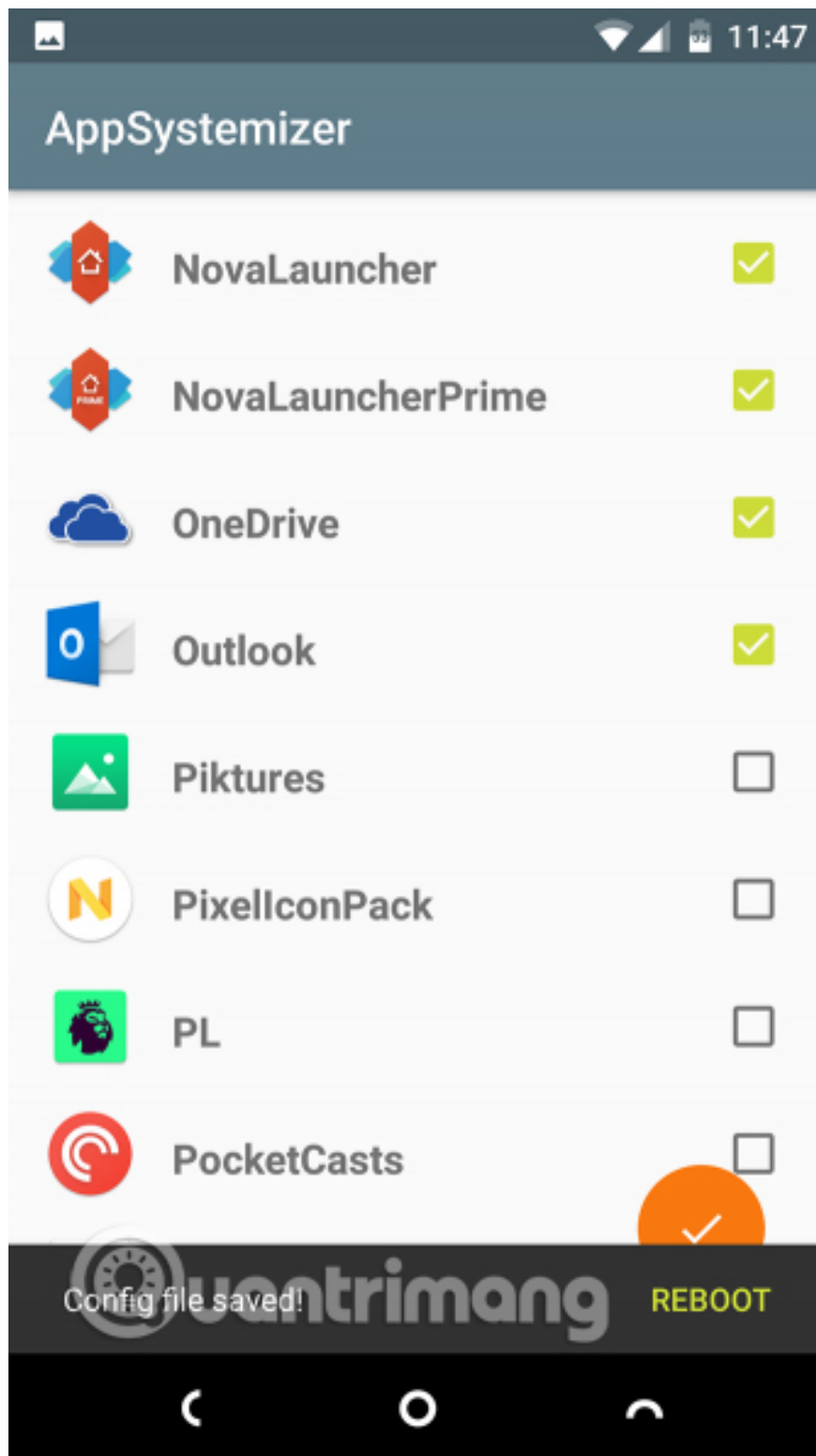

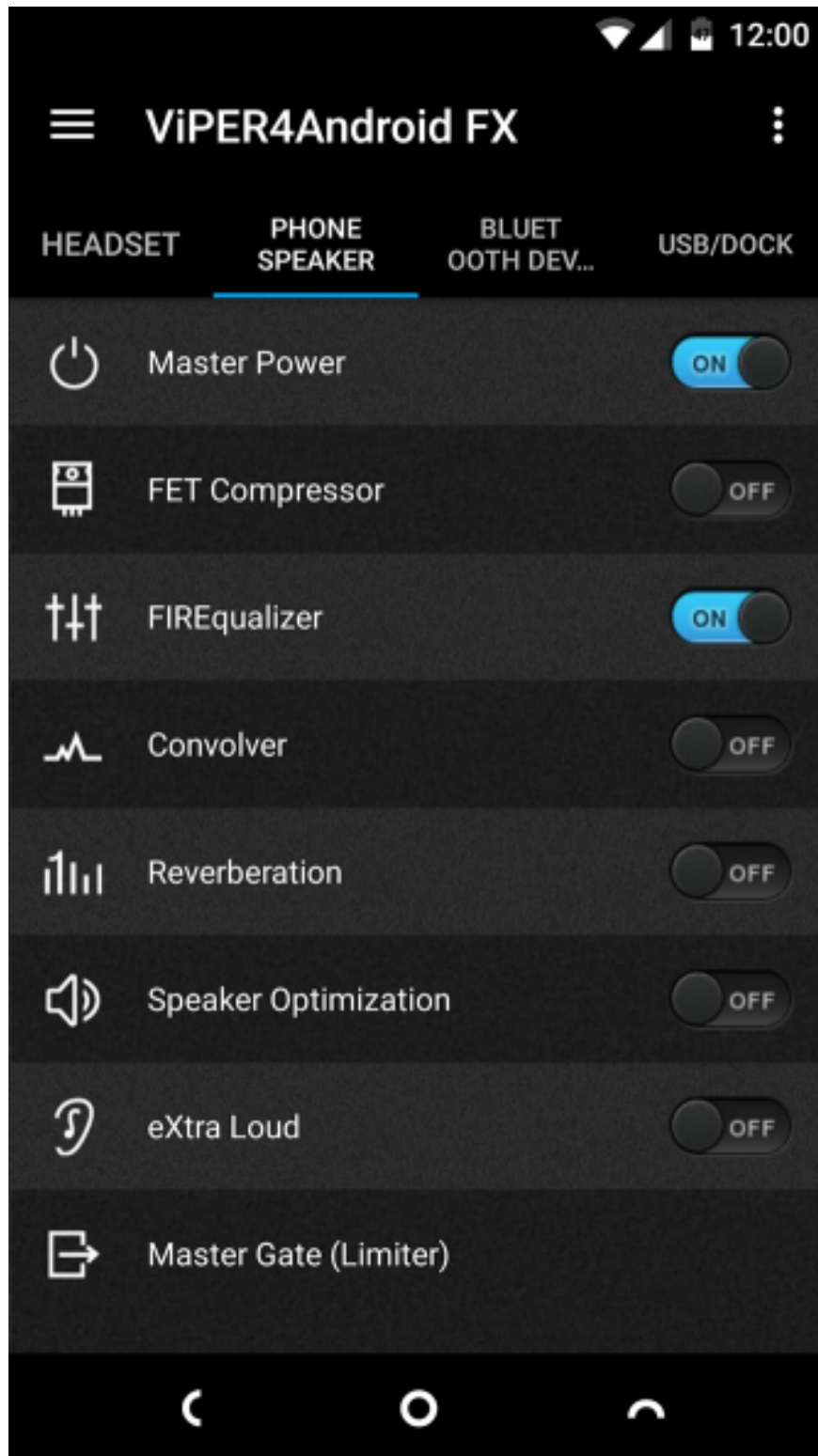




App Systemizer allows users to install certain applications as system apps. There are several reasons you should use this module. As you know, it is not easy to uninstall the system application, so you can add a layer of protection for security applications. Some gadgets like battery optimization work better with additional privileges for system applications.

App Systemizer does not modify the system partition, so you cannot use it to save the phone's internal memory. The application will automatically update via Play Store as usual.

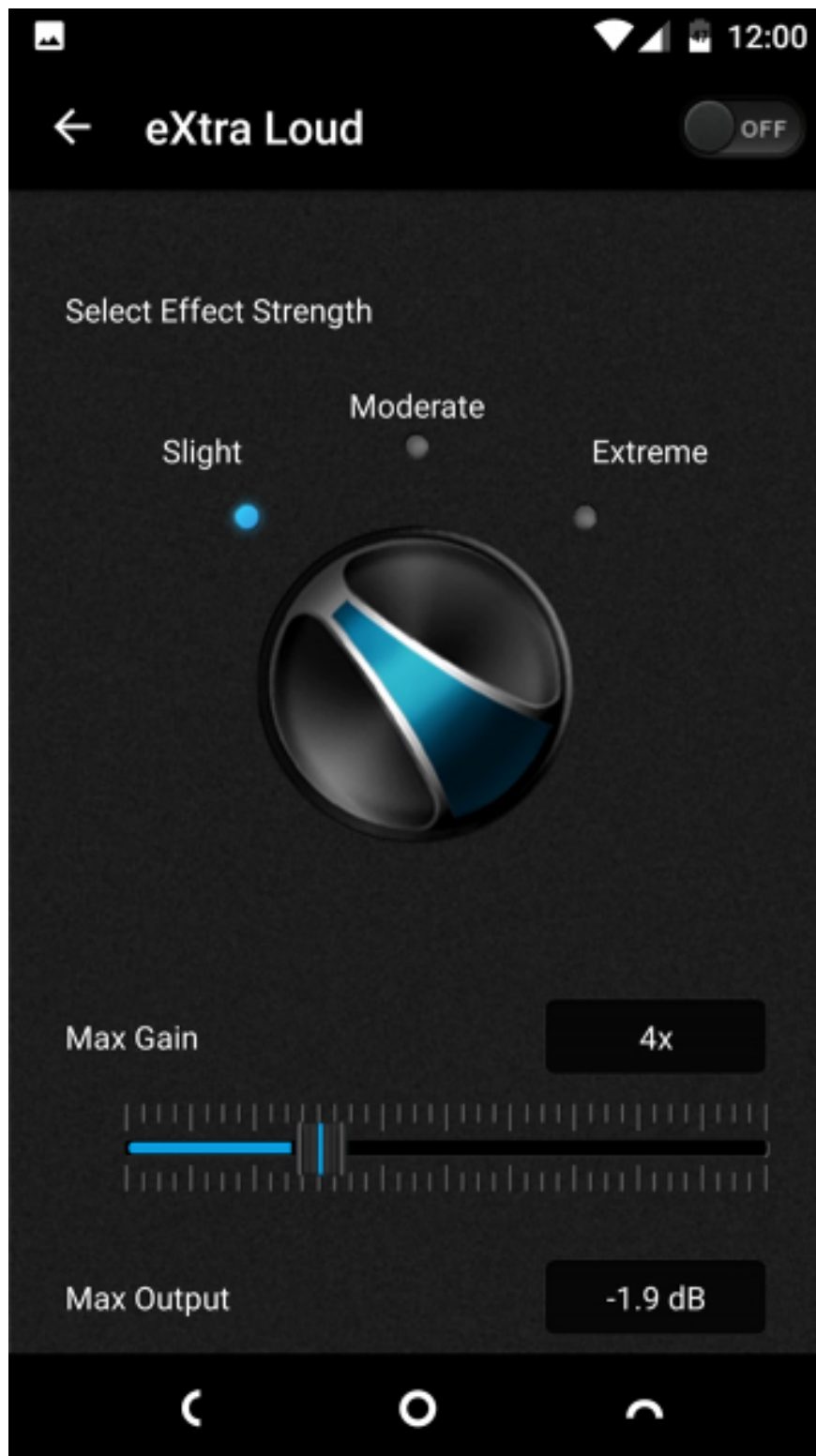

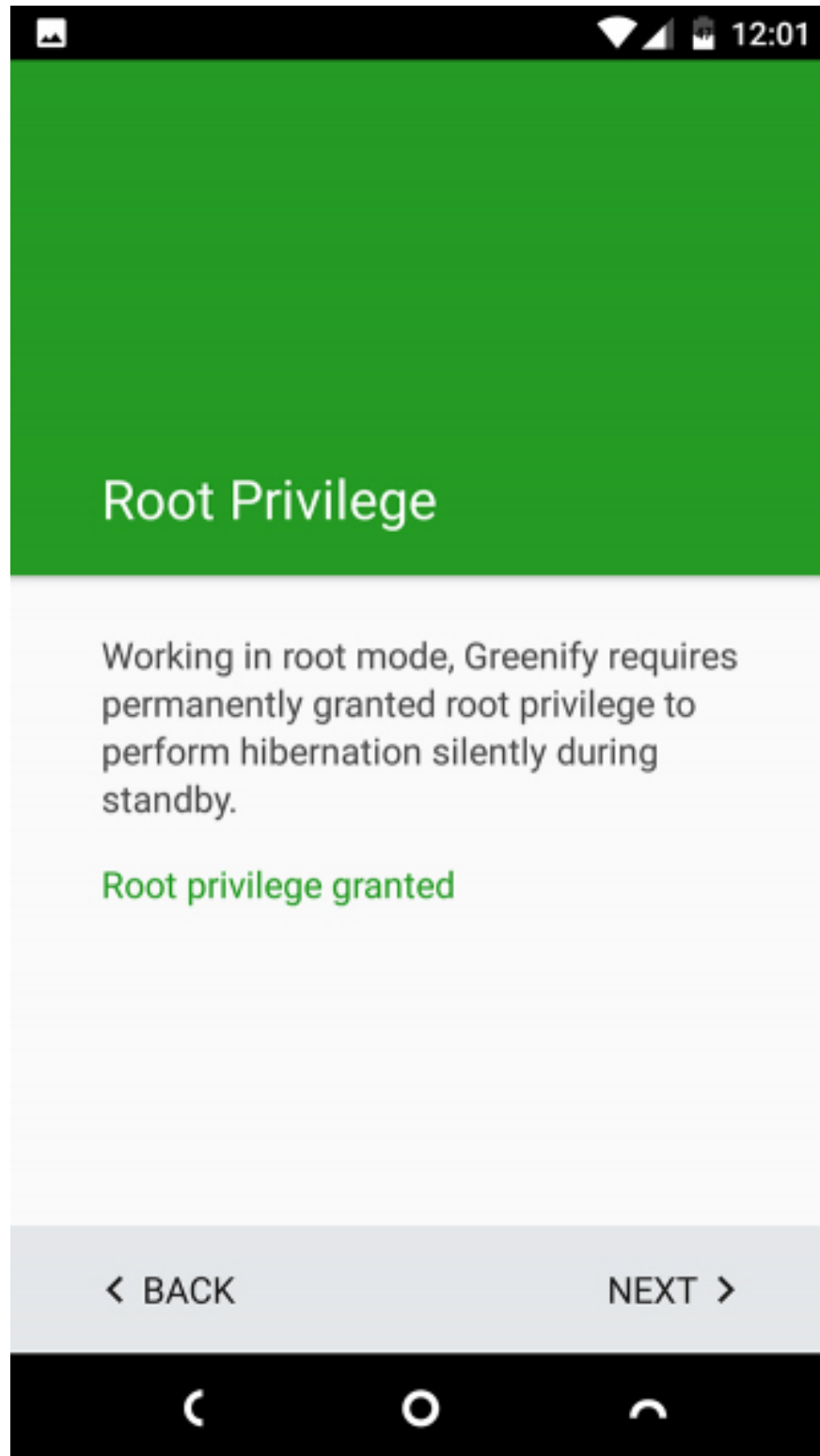




Viper4Android is the best audio adjustment app for Android phones. It allows you to increase bass, treble tones or increase the maximum volume of your phone while minimizing distortion.

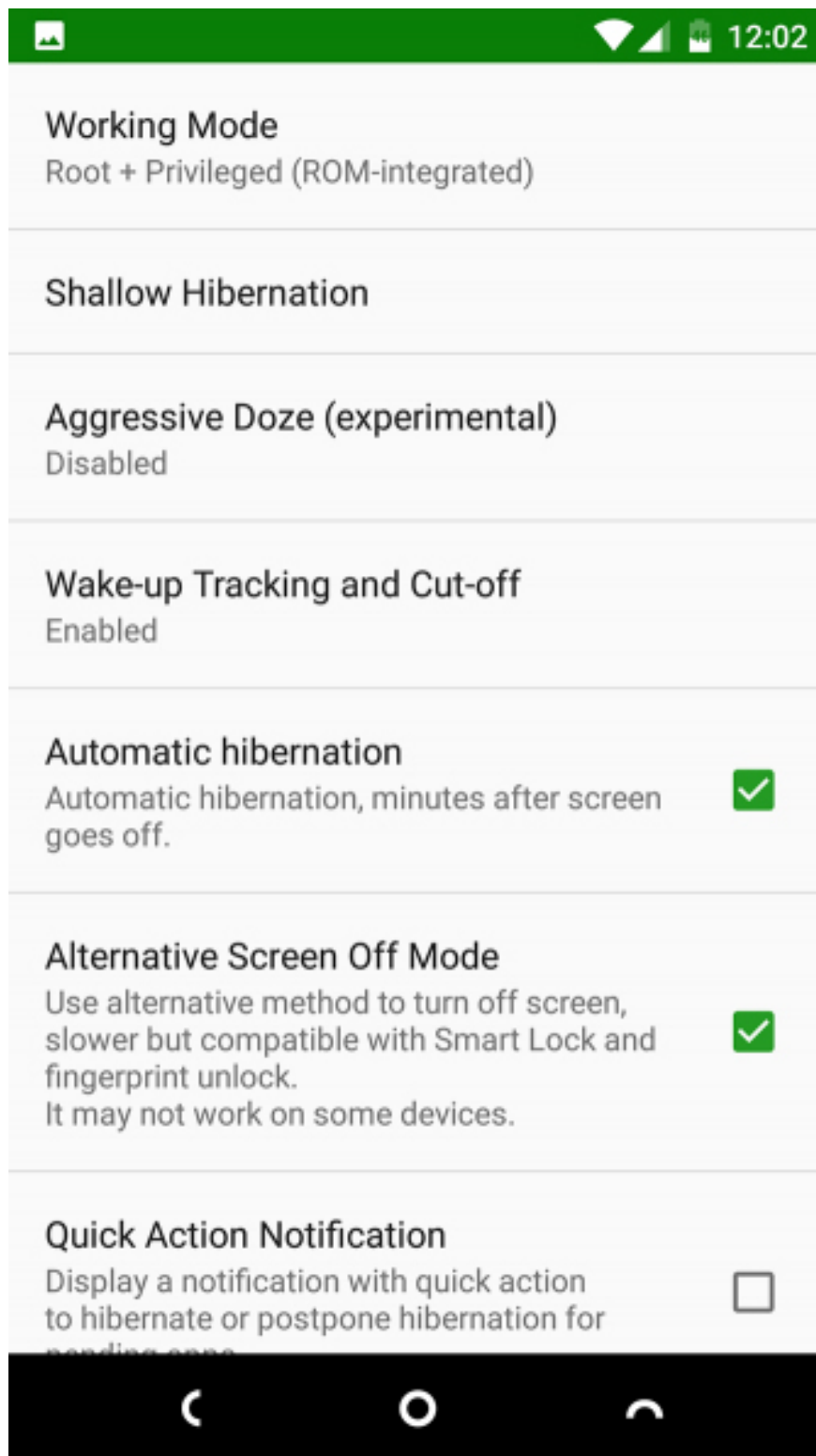

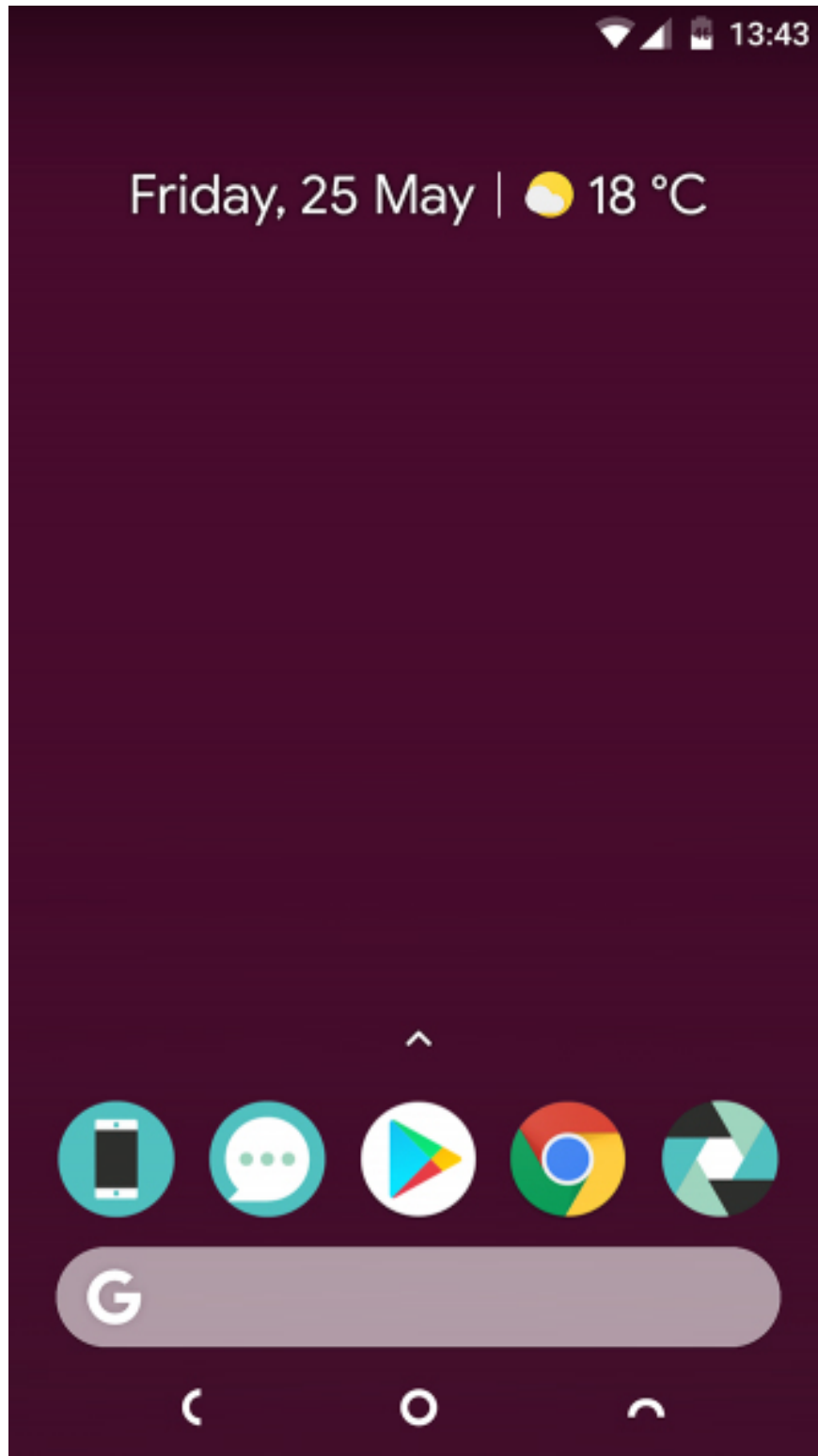

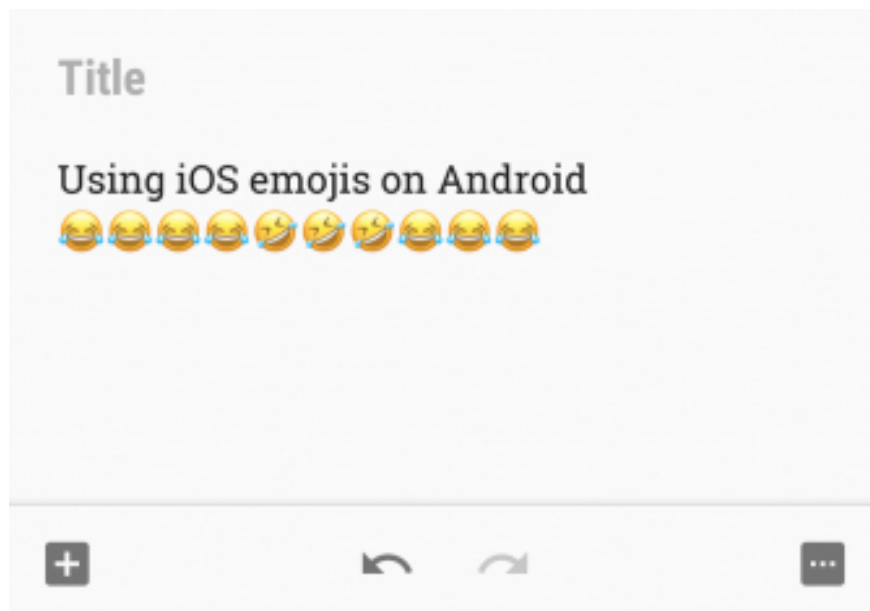
## 5. Volume Steps Increase

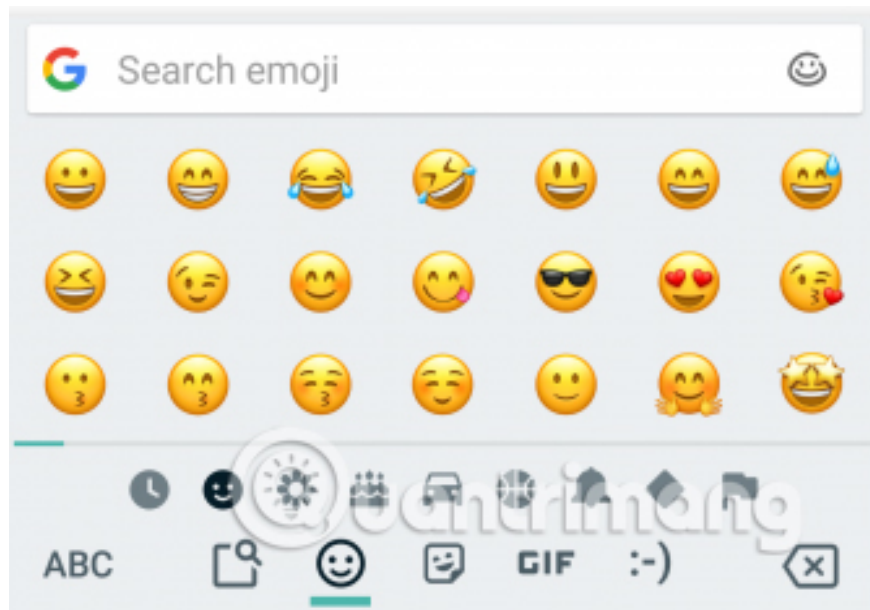


By default, Android volume has 15 levels from quiet to maximum. Sometimes adjusting the volume increases to two levels, which is too big, especially when listening to headphones.

The Volume Steps Increase module doubles the volume level, meaning that there were 15 levels in the past to 30 levels for media and call volume. You will now adjust the volume more accurately.

Want to download the latest iOS emoticons on Android? The iOS11.1 Emoji module for Magisk is the fastest and easiest way to do it.

Just install it via Magisk Manager application and when rebooted, you will no longer have to use Google emoticons. And if you want to re-use these icons, just uninstall the module and you're done. You should update the module to be able to own new characters from the latest iOS versions.
