3. Winchester Cathedral



This flower originating from England hatches in the shape of tea cups that look extremely fancy. Each Winchester Cathedral rose has about 80-85 wings, with an average size of about 5.7 cm. Winchester Cathedral roses have a sweet scent combining honey and almond flowers. This flower blooms seasonally, when summer comes the first flowers will appear and bloom continuously until autumn.



4. Red Rose Eden



Eden red roses belong to a climbing rose family with bright red flowers, each flower can have up to 110 petals, with an average diameter of 12.7 cm. Eden Red Rose has an intense aroma and is one of the most fragrant flowers in the world. Eden red roses will start to bloom from spring and last until the end of the summer.





5. Albrecht Durer



This is a beautiful rose with large flowers that possess a blend of orange. Depending on the seasons of the year, the orange intensity on the petals will change. Specifically, in winter instead of the usual orange red, Albrecht Durer rose petals turn dark pink.

In addition to seasonal discoloration, Albrecht Durer roses are also known for their gentle, pleasant aroma.



6. Victor Hugo



Victor Hugo roses with large crimson flowers are among the most beautiful red roses in the world. Each flower has about 25-30 wings. Victor Hugo roses emit a passionate fragrance that makes many people in the world fall in love.

Roses Victor Hugo will begin to bloom from spring and last until autumn.

7. Rhapsody



Rhapsody roses bloom in clusters with large, vibrant flowers. The newly hatched Rhapsody rose will have a purple plum color and over time the color of the flower will turn blue when it is near.



8. Gold Metal



This is a special rose because they do not have thorns and possess an extremely attractive scent. Gold Metal roses are bright yellow, blooming in clusters, each flower has about 30-40 wings. Starting in the spring, beautiful Gold Metal flowers will bloom and bloom continuously until summer.

This rose species possesses extremely fancy and charming black flowers. The rose petals Baccara are covered with natural velvet, making them even more special. Each flower carries about 45 petals and when blooming, it can reach 10.2cm.
