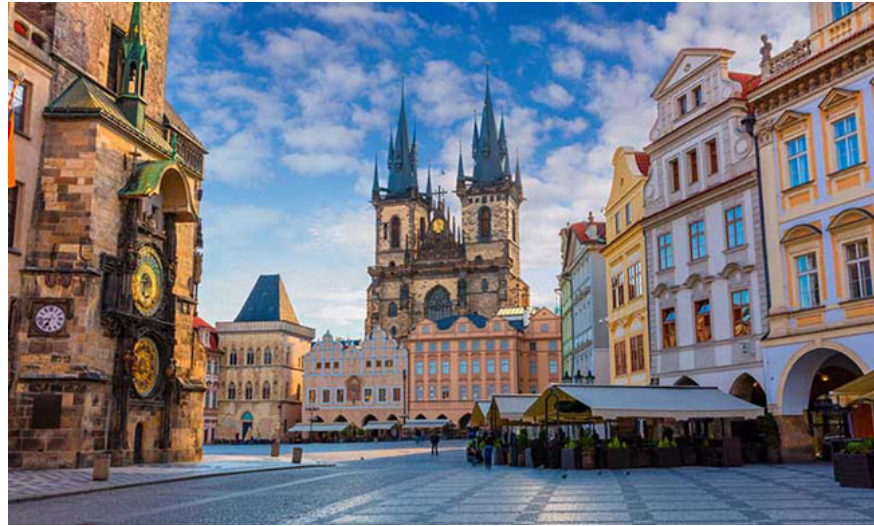
6. Amsterdam
