Lignum Vitae wood



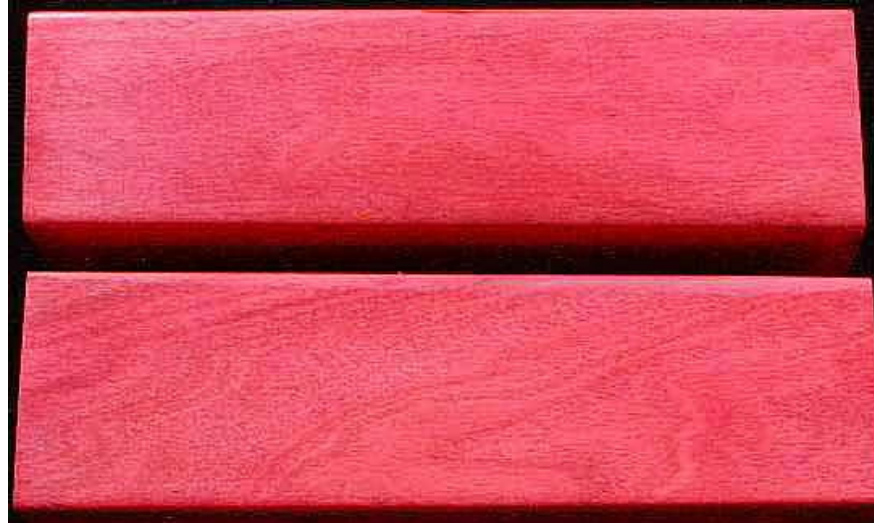
This type of wood is very hard, durable, so it is very popular. Lignum Vitae grows very slowly so it is very rare.
