

10 objects that do not separate themselves from Japanese ninja

Here are the indispensable items of each ninja, supporting them in their offensive, hiding, transmitting, and escaping activities.

Guess the time through cat's eyes



Time is very important for any special army or force including ninja. In their time, ninja used a very special but quite effective watch, cat eye.

During the training, all ninjas must learn nekome, a technique that helps them determine time by looking closely at the cat's eyes. The eyes of cats are very sensitive and their pupils can adjust the brightness according to the sessions of the day.

1. In the morning, to get more light, the cat's pupils completely opened, so they had a circle.
2. From about 8am to noon, to prevent light, the pupil of the cat narrowed.
3. When the sun rose to the highest position, their pupils became a straight line.

The Ninja relies on those changes to predict the exact time within an hour but how to learn how to observe the eyes of the cat is still a mystery. Are they always carrying a cat on their wrists?

Mizu-Gumo, the tool to go on water

Digging ditches around the castle is the way the ancients used to apply whether in Europe or Asia. In order to break into the castle, the ninja used a tool they called Mizu-Gumo - "water spider". Mizu-Gumo is made up of 4 curved boards, wooden or animal skin that can contain vapor, and a board placed in the middle.

The way the ninja used Mizu-Gumo is still a mystery to this day. There are many theories that come up as a ninja wearing a middle board on one leg to go on water or a ninja using Mizu-Gumo as a raft to cross the swamp, not to walk on the water .

Hikigane saoto, eavesdropping tool

Eavesdropping is an extremely important part of the ninja's work to learn information, listen to the sounds of the bodyguards to learn the target's schedule . To support the work, the ninja uses one The tool is cone-shaped and is made of metal or wood with different sizes called hikigane saoto. Ninja presses the head bigger into the wall so that the sound exaggerates and transmits into the ear.

Donohi, warm keeping tool

Ninja are professional warriors, so they are ready to perform their tasks in all circumstances and weather conditions. And to fight in cold weather ninja often use donohi, keep warm tools with bamboo, iron or copper. When storing flammable materials like alcohol, gunpowder and cloth. And to burn fuel, another item called tsuketake, a fire engine, was added. Donohi is a useful tool, it can burn for hours, even days to help ninja keep warm hands, do not let them numb, set fire, cook .

Kanzashi, dangerous weapon from hair brooches

One of the ninja's special abilities is that they can turn everything into weapons. And with normal kanzashi hair brooches, they are also used by ninja as a dangerous weapon to attack the target's weak points or nerve beams. Even the ninja embedded kanzashi into a poison to turn it into an assassination weapon. Kanzashi is the ideal weapon for female ninja (kunoichi).

Yatate, special weapons from pens

Yatate, a small metal or bamboo cylinder, consists of a small box for empty ink and cylinders to hold pen hairs, which are carried by the ninja when on duty. Especially in spy missions, the ninjas use yatate to record information about the target. In addition, the ninja often hide spikes, needles and poisons into yatate instead of pen hairs, making it a powerful and compact damage weapon.

Neko-te, weapons on the fingertips



Neko-te is the familiar weapon of the female ninja.

In Japanese, *neko* means "cat", while *te* is "hand". *Neko-te* is a metal nail used by female ninja. Metal nails are molded in the form of gloves or add a small iron ring to each nail so that the ninja wears them on each finger like a ring. *Neko-te* can be made of thin iron or bamboo. In addition, the ninja make their own hair clips and old jewelry into razor-sharp nails.

Use crickets to camouflage and hide

Ninja is the master of hiding and disguising, they often approach the enemy silently. But sometimes they encounter difficult conditions that can't help but make a sound like walking on dry, hard snow leaves . making them easy to reveal their hiding position and destroy the whole mission. To prevent and deal with such bad situations, ninjas often carry small cricket boxes and mixes of special chemicals to ensure crickets or silence according to their wishes. Their cries will hide the sounds of ninja generated.

In addition, insects and birds often stop singing when humans or carnivores come close, so even in the case of quiet movements, ninjas still need crickets.

Powder irritates eyes, nose and respiratory system in eggshell

In emergencies, ninjas often use powder to attack and escape. They often remove iron filings, salt, chili powder and powder causing eye irritation into the eggshell after removing all the contents through a small hole.

When necessary, the ninja will throw eggs at the opponent's eyes to neutralize the ability to see, irritate the nose and the respiratory system, disrupt the opponent and take the opportunity to counterattack or escape.

Transmission of information by rice

In order to perform well the spy and assassination missions, collecting and transmitting secret information is essential for every ninja. Their most common method is to use five-color rice - goshiki. The rice grains are

painted by ninja in red, blue, yellow, black, or purple and use them to send codes that only the ninja in a clan can decode from them. Based on a combination of colors or the number of rice grains, ninjas can create more than 100 types of codes. In addition, the use of color paints for rice also ensures that birds will not eat rice grains.
