These simple, web-based games are ideal for killing time without downloading anything. Here is a list of 10 of the funniest Google Doodle games you can try.

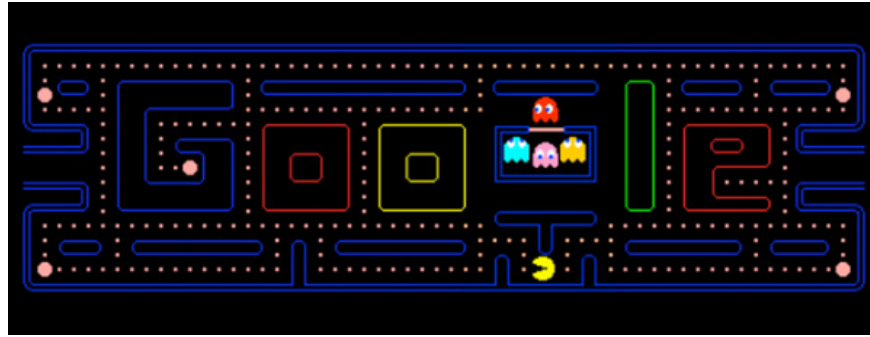
1. [Baseball](#)

In The Scoville Game you have to beat a green pepper with ice cream. You will learn some knowledge about the Scoville scale over the course of the game.



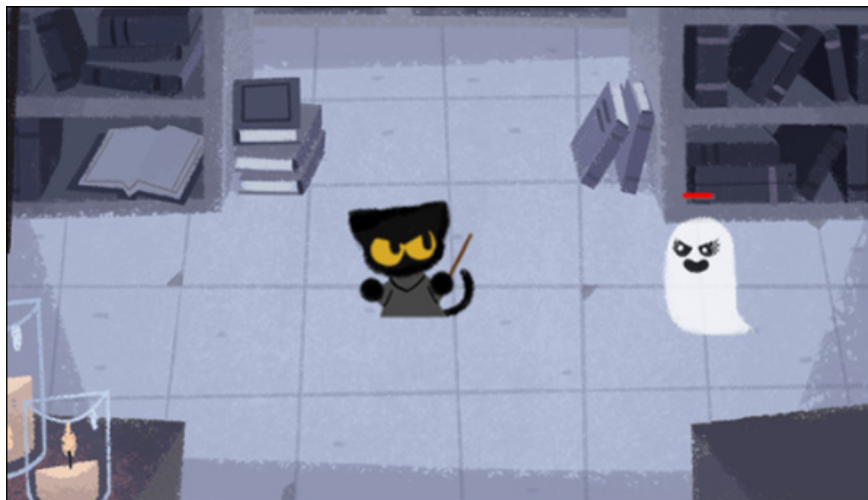
5. [Basketball](#)

Here's another classic sports game. With just 24 seconds, see how many balls you can throw in the basket.



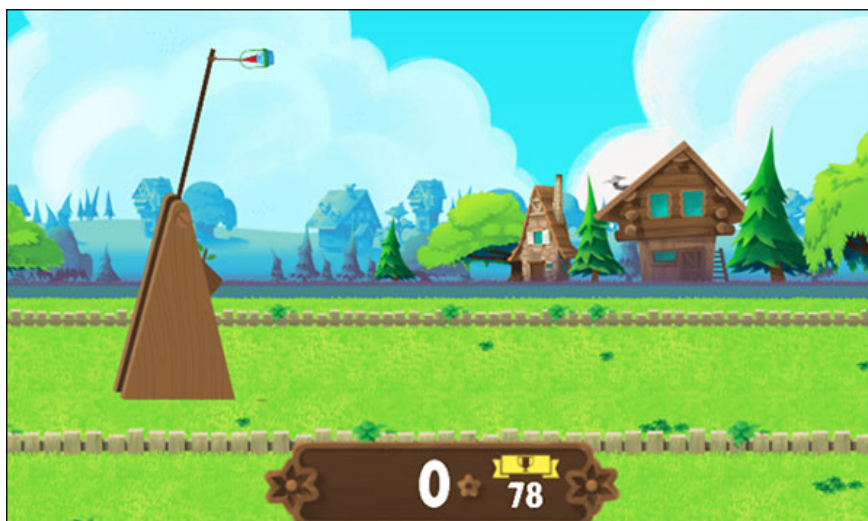
6. [Halloween](#)

This is a pretty fun game from Halloween 2016. You have to use a cat's wand to defeat the ghosts.



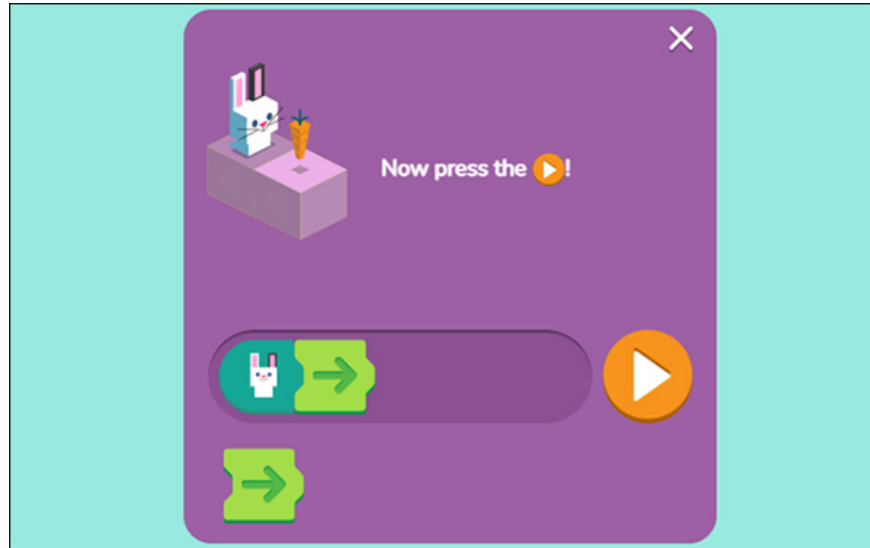
7. [Garden Gnome](#)

The aim of this Garden Gnome game is to launch a dwarf that keeps the garden as far away as possible.



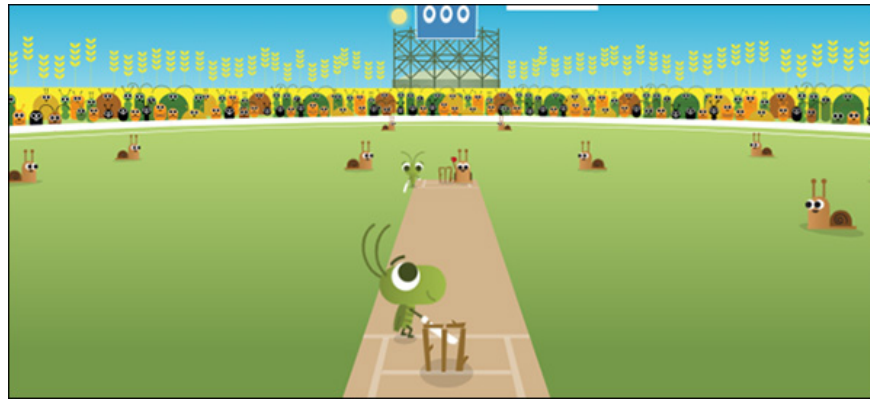
8. Coding Rabbit

Coding Rabbit is a great game that introduces code to children. The goal is to use basic block-based coding concepts to help rabbits obtain carrots.



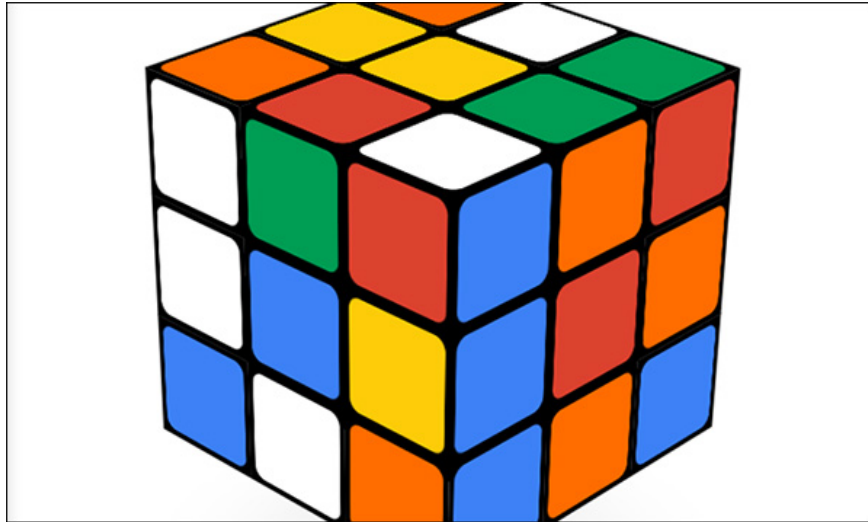
9. Cricket
