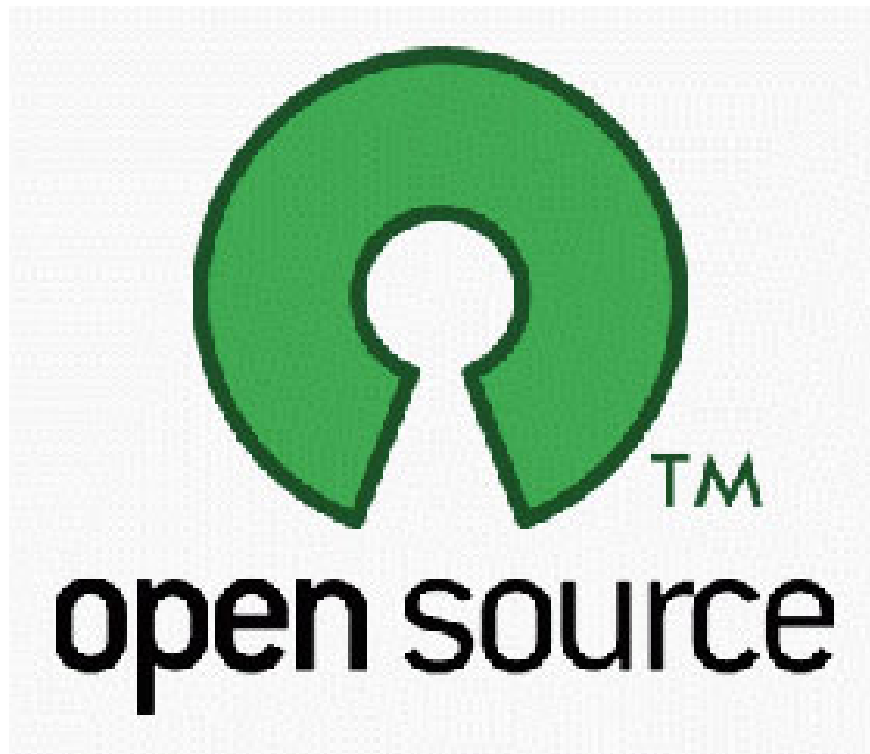

However, as we said above, there are quite a number of interesting applications developed and maintained in the open source community for the Windows operating system. Here we do not want to mention the famous open source applications that many users already know such as OpenOffice and Firefox but instead introduce 10 open source applications for Windows that may be very new to friend. You may not have heard of them, but these are really worth the try.

## 1. VLC

VLC is one of the most versatile multimedia players. It supports many formats for video files and music files like H.264, Ogg, DivX, MKV, TS, MPEG-2, mp3, MPEG-4 and aac, plus it also supports streaming issues. TV capture card. VLC is not limited to viewing multimedia files. It can also convert and transcode formats.

## 2. Gnumeric

Gnumeric is a spreadsheet part of the GNOME Office suite. This application currently has 520 spreadsheet functions (154 unique functions), runs faster than any spreadsheet application you've ever tried and in addition Gnumeric can read many spreadsheet formats. .



### **3. Abiword**

Abiword is also part of the GNOME office suite, which can serve as all the needs of word processing. With Abiword, you can create and collaborate on work. This is a fairly light, fast, reliable application and like other tools in the list introduced in this article, is free. Abiword can read and write both document formats of Microsoft Office and OpenOffice.

### **4. Audacity**

Audacity is a software for recording and editing audio. You can use it to record audio directly, convert analog signals into digital signals, cut / copy and join, change speed and pitch, import / export many formats. In addition, Audacity can also extract noise and add some effects. So if you're looking for open source for a recording studio, don't ignore Audacity.

### **5. Inkscape**

Inkscape is a very powerful graphics editor like Illustrator, Corel Draw and Xara X. It is faithful to the W3C standard SVG file format, so you can be sure that any SVG file created with Inkscape will do. work with any tool that requires standard formats. Another interesting aspect of Inkscape is that there are many tutorials that can be found directly on the Inkscape site or on some other sites.

### **6. X-Chat 2**

X-Chat 2 is one of the best IRC clients. Although many users quit IRC and prefer to use standard IM tools, IRC is still a valuable resource for IT professionals and administrators.

### **7. FreeMind**

FreeMind is a 'memory mapping' software, ideal for keeping more notes in projects, classes, thinking circuits, etc. The best thing about 'memory mapping' tools is they are not as restricted as standard 'task' tools or 'need to perform' lists. Note FreeMind is written in Java so you need to install this application to support.

## **8. TurboCASH**

TurboCASH is a personal finance manager and input level accounting software for Windows. It has also been used for many years so it has a fairly solid foundation like other large applications. TurboCASH has been used by more than 100,000 companies in over 80 countries.

## **9. Amaya Web Browser**

Amaya Web Browser is the browser you need to use for testing standard WC3 or want a different change. However, Amaya is not just a browser, it is a web creator.

## **10. ClamWin**

ClamWin is an antivirus tool for Windows based on ClamAV, the product is still used for the Linux operating system. ClamWin provides all the standard features you have used for an antivirus tool, such as the integration of Outlook and Explorer. However, the difference between ClamWin and its competitors (apart from the price issue) is that it does not use real-time scanning. In addition to scheduling, you must manually scan the virus for the files in your computer. Because of this, ClamWin is not a product for lazy people.
