

10 reasons you should buy a business laptop

Of course, more expensive doesn't mean better, but obviously business laptops give you more advantages than the mainstream.

Of course, more expensive does not mean better but obviously business laptops (business laptops) give you more advantages than the popular product line (consumer laptop).

Here are the criteria that explain why you should invest in a laptop business instead of the mainstream laptop .

1. Better texture

Obviously, you'll *end up with* a laptop with a lighter material like carbon fiber or aluminum alloy rather than a cheap plastic case. For example, the Lenovo ThinkPad T400 is priced at under \$ 700, and it seems to be affordable for the average user, but it has a durable and beautiful carbon-fiber cover. Meanwhile, the popular IdeaPad Y450 is priced under \$ 500, and obviously looks much more squishy.

2. Better screen

Manufacturers believe that mirror screens will attract users' attention because of their sleek styling and sharp images. However, the bad thing about the mirror screen is that it is often blurred. Imagine when you surf the web, instead of clearly seeing the text on the screen, you see your own reflection. Some business models have mirror screens but often have anti-glare features. For example, the Dell Inspiron 13 has a wide-screen mirror screen, while the Dell Vostro 13 also has an anti-glare feature.

3. Keyboard and touchpad better



Here, we are not saying that the keyboard and touchpad of the mainstream laptop is not good, but it is clear that business laptops have the superiority in this regard. Their ability to respond better to effective use of the user. For example, the 13-inch IdeaPad U350 (850USD) has a fairly responsive keyboard. Or like the 12-inch Thinkpad X200s (comparable price) also has a very good keyboard. Meanwhile, the HP Pavilion dm3 for high-end users has a bad touchpad. Opposite to Pavilion dm3 is HP's ProBook 5310m, but there's a very accurate and convenient touchpad.

4. Less 'junk' software included

Of course, businesses do not have time to uninstall the software that they bought. Understanding this, computer distributors avoid installing software in their business with unwanted software. Of course, you can still find some test software versions, such as security, but in limited numbers. That is why the laptop entrepreneurs often launch faster than the average laptop.

5. More control mouse options

Although it is difficult to name exactly the average laptop model with only one mouse keyboard to control, but obviously for business laptops, this option is much more. Lenovo ThinkPad, for example, has a mouse pointer (red mouse control button in the middle of the keyboard), as well as the HP ProBook, Dell Latitude, and Toshiba Tecra models all have a more flexible mouse control mechanism.

6. More storage options

Want to add a solid-state drive (SSD) or a high-speed hard drive (7,200 rpm) to speed up the laptop? For business laptops, this capability is possible, and with affordable laptops, there are few options. For example, the 16-inch Satellite A500 laptop only has a 7200 rpm hard drive option; only the 18.4-inch Satellite P500 has an SSD option. Most lines of Tecras and Porteges for businessmen have the option of SSD drive and 7,200 rpm hard drive.

7. Better security tools

If you are a popular laptop, chances are you will not receive security tools like business products. These laptops (enterprises) are equipped with security software to enhance the security of passwords, encrypt hard drives, and safely remove sensitive files on the system. You can find the Protect Tools security tool on the ProBook business line, not ordinary Pavilions. Many business laptops are also equipped with fingerprint readers, which allow for faster login to Windows. Although some affordable laptops have facial recognition software, most of them work inefficiently. Processing time with this technology is too long, so enter the password sometimes even faster.

8. Many options to expand

Most business laptops have the ability to expand and upgrade features, such as adding batteries, adding hard drives, or extending warranty. Meanwhile, you can hardly find these options on the mainstream laptop.

9. Looks better

Business laptop has many features that have been designed more elaborate. For example, the HP ProBook 5310m has an aluminum alloy case; Or, the ThinkPad T400s is thin and made of carbon fiber; or like the ultra-slim design of Dell Vostro V13. In addition to design and features, the business laptop series has a lot of colors for users to choose from.

10. Watch movies, play games

If you want to make the laptop a home theater and use them to watch Blu-ray movies, it's best to equip yourself with a business laptop. However, if you only need simple entertainment tasks like watching DVDs, streaming video, listening to music or playing simple games, just a popular Laptop is enough.

Regarding the price factor, according to common logic, higher-end laptops are always more expensive. With business laptops, too, they are usually more expensive than mainstream laptops, but there are also cheaper laptops. For example, the 15.6-inch IdeaPad G550 (2.2-GHz Intel Core 2 Duo CPU, 4GB RAM, 320GB hard drive, Nvidia graphics card) only costs about \$ 550; Or like the ThinkPad SL510 with a better keyboard, the price is only 499USD.

Sometimes the more expensive Laptop entrepreneurs don't mean they're more advanced. For example, the HP ProBook 5310m, a few hundred more expensive than Pavilion dm3, but in terms of quality, keyboard, security tools . it is no more than a lot.
