## Safe mode (safe mode)

Like Windows computers, when you encounter a problem that cannot be solved directly on the regular user interface such as a bug or need to remove the application, for example, you can switch to **safe mode**. ( *safe mode* ) to try again. The operation is as follows: Press and hold the power key until a power-off icon appears ( *"Off" or "Power off" on the screen* ), then continue to press and hold the icon if you want to open the device. safe mode.

## Use offline maps

The use of Mobile services Mobile internet on the move can be very expensive. But what if you get lost and need to use electronic maps? The best solution for you is to **download maps of prepared locations so you can use them without an Internet connection**. Turn off Internet service on the phone but still turn on GPS. Your location is still displayed on an offline map using satellite data without paying any fees.

Usage is as follows: Go to **Google Maps** and search the map of a city or somewhere, go to the menu below and select Download. This feature is available on both iOS and Android.

## Use as a credit card replacement payment method

## Use smartphones as a handheld scanner

Did you know that you can scan any document or photo with the smartphone camera? To make the most of this feature, you need to download some special applications, which not only identify documents but also save them in the cloud and send copies to recipients.

If you regularly store documents in digital format or share documents via the Internet, supporting applications such as Adobe Scan, Office Lens or CamScanner will turn your smartphone into an extremely portable document scanner. That convenience.

## Unlimited search

With the Google Goggles app you can search for anything you want with your phone's camera instead of typing each word on the toolbar, whether it's images, text translation or barcode scanning. This is really convenient if you regularly perform searches related to food or household goods.

## Connecting two smartphones together



With the **One-Touch-Go ( OTG )** or **USB On-The-Go** special cable, you can connect any smartphone, including peripherals. This exchange requires connecting a phone with a *USB adapter ( female connector )* and another phone with a micro-USB cable. After the phone recognizes the cable and adapter, you can safely connect them together.
