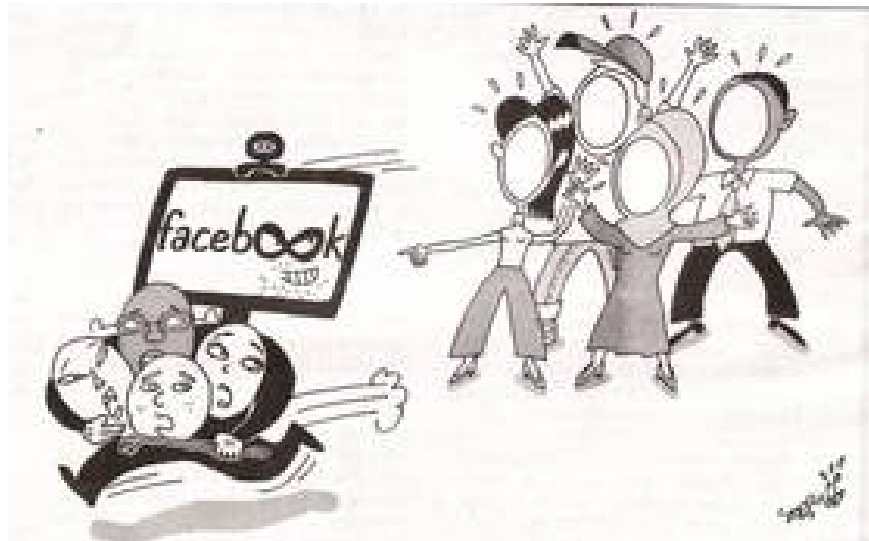


10 things to keep in mind about security with Facebook
