**1. Roses will last longer if you put half of aspirin in the water.**



Roses will last longer if you put half of aspirin in the water, it also works with chrysanthemums, carnations and roses. Without aspirin, you can add a little salt or vinegar to the flowerpot.

**2. Help the child hold the pen properly with a rubber band.**



This is the correct way to hold a pen, especially for children when they first start writing. Use elastic band, attach a pen, rotate 180 °, the pen will be in the right position and help your child write letters evenly and more beautifully.

**3. Sprinkle salt on oil, grease on clothing as quickly as possible.**





Salt will absorb most of the grease that adheres to clothing. Just sprinkle salt on the stain and wait for 15 minutes, then clean. A large stain will be easily cleaned and a small stain will quickly disappear.

**4. Dry nail polish can be diluted with nail polish remover.**





When your nail polish bottle is dry, use nail polish to make it more beautiful. However, do not pour too much washing water into the nail or it will be easily diluted and pale.

**5. A burnt pan can easily be washed by boiling salt water.**



If your pan is burnt black, the best solution is to add a few tablespoons of salt to boiled water for about 15-20 minutes. Salt water can also easily clean the surface of greasy.

**6. Wash your hands with lemon.**



This is an extremely effective tip while cooking, your hands are stained with sugar beets or berries. You just need to rub the fingers with the lemon, it will remove the color quickly.

**7. Eggs will not crack when boiled if you boil them in salt water.**



When boiling eggs, add a little salt to a pot of boiling water to avoid cracked eggs and white outflows. Salt will not affect egg cracking, but it will prevent egg whites from escaping, leaving a natural flavor.

**8. To avoid breadcrumbs when cutting, dip the knife into boiling water.**



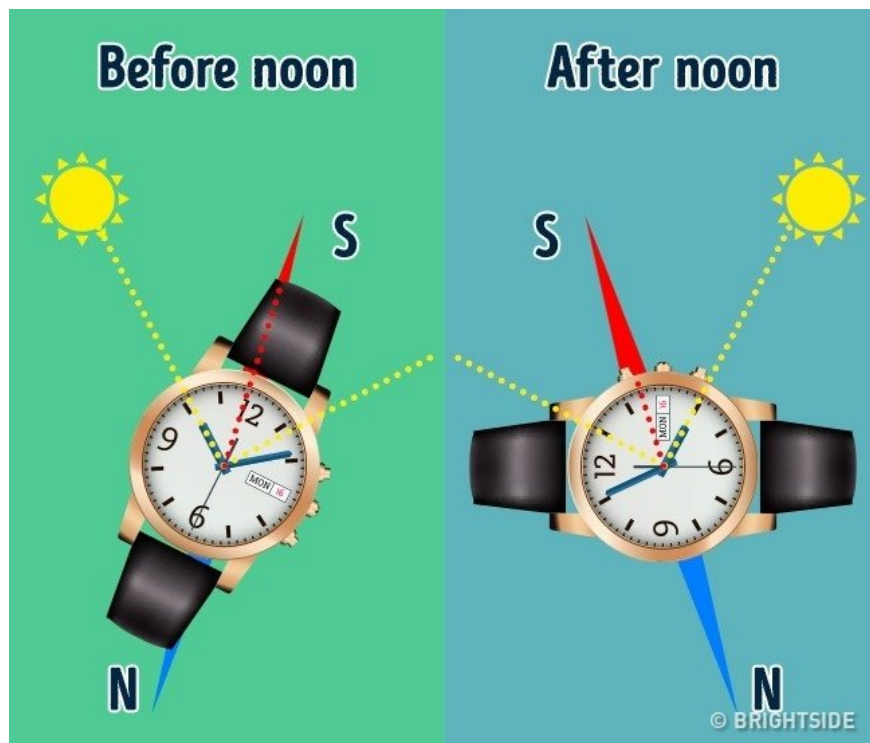
To make sure that the bread is not crumbled, dip the knife into the pot of boiling water or pour water from the jar. Then wipe the blade and cut each slice smoothly.

**9. Potatoes help eliminate irritation and inflammation caused by insect bites.**



Take a small potato, wash it, cut it and apply it to the damaged skin. Use fixed tape at that location. Potatoes help eliminate irritation, red inflammation reduces itching effectively by insect bites.

**10. Determine the direction with your watch.**



Rotate the clock so that the timer points towards the sunrise. Then, divide the angle between the hour hand and the number 1 into equal angles. The bisector line will point south.

1. Before 12 o'clock: south of the sun.
2. After 12 o'clock: south of the sun.
