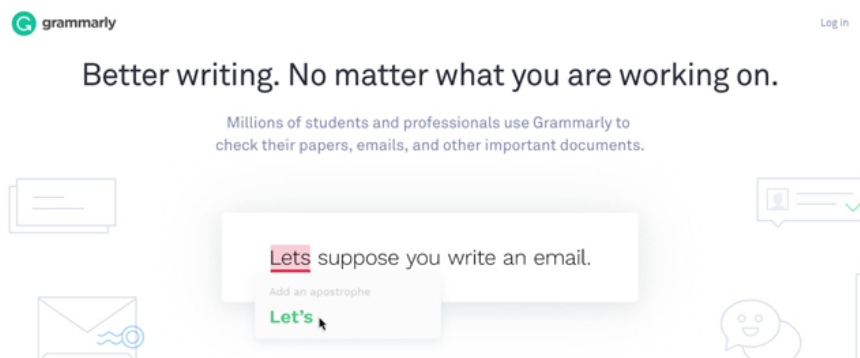

Here are some of the best spelling and grammar checking tools you can use to perform all tasks such as spelling, grammar, punctuation, sentence correction, and vocabulary enhancement, improve writing skills.

1. Grammarly.com

Grammarly is one of the most popular spelling and grammar checking programs, favored by millions. This tool provides an online text editor and a free browser extension for Chrome, Safari and Firefox, capable of editing more than 150 types of errors. When logging into Grammarly, you will have two options: enter text or write right in the tool.



When entering or copying, pasting text, errors are automatically flagged. Grammarly has the ability to detect errors such as punctuation, grammar, writing style, contextual spelling and sentence structure. With all errors, Grammarly will explain your error and provide a way to correct or replace the error. It supports different writing styles such as blog posts, business texts, academic essays.

In addition, this tool supports both English and American English. If you use words specific to a specific topic that Grammarly cannot identify, you can add them to the dictionary so they don't flag when used next time.

You can use the main Grammarly tool for free. If you want to own other advanced features, you can upgrade to \$ 30 a month. Grammarly Premium tests more than 250 types of grammatical errors, detects plagiarism and provides citation suggestions.

2. WhiteSmoke.com

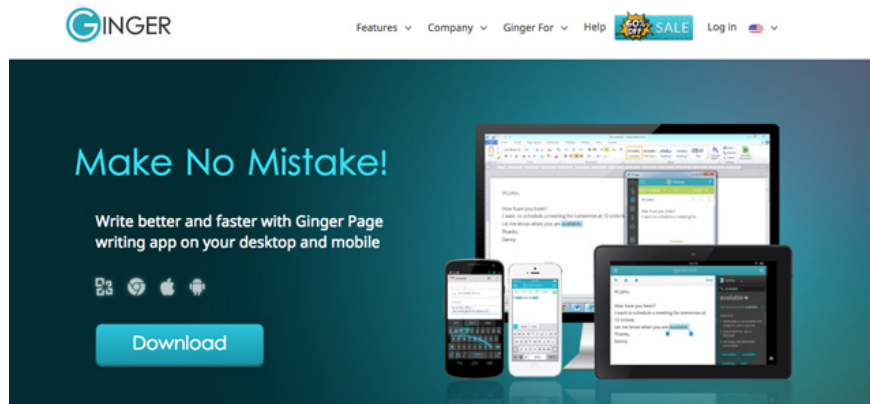
In addition to checking spelling and grammar, WhiteSmoke also creates a report to review and review your posts. This assessment is based on different criteria: sentence structure, words, expressions, length, etc. While correcting errors, WhiteSmoke also provides suggestions for the text you need to improve.



This is one of the best software solutions to check grammar, syntax and spelling. It does all this in real time, so you don't have to cut and paste text from one program to another to test it. Although this is not an online tool, it can edit content when you write something online.

3. Ginger

This is a spell and grammar checker tool similar to Word but has many useful features and options. This is a useful tool for English language learners. Ginger has free, basic and advanced versions. The first version is of course free, while the basic version that costs \$ 5 a month or a lifetime purchase costs \$ 40.



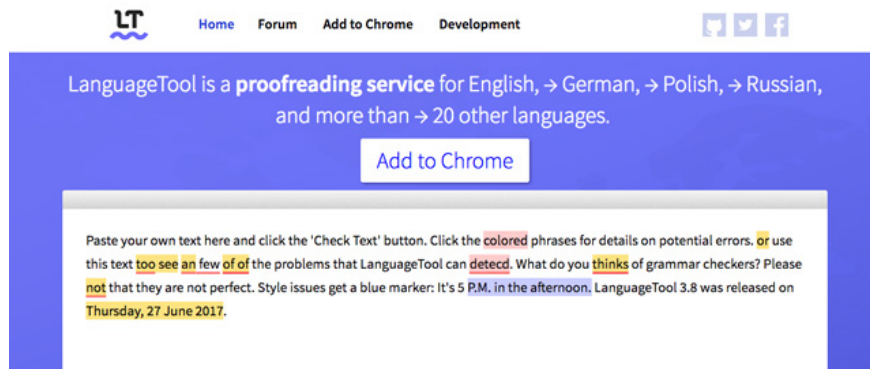
You can buy the premium version for a lifetime for \$ 90. Another popular feature of Ginger is that it integrates with MS Word. You don't have to upload the document to the tool or copy and paste it into Word, Ginger will check your document inside the Word document. Ginger supports English English and American English.

What makes LanguageTool stand out from competitors is that it can edit grammar for many languages. Another special thing is that you can download its software for the most complete use. But they provide new users with a free online trial version to test grammar.

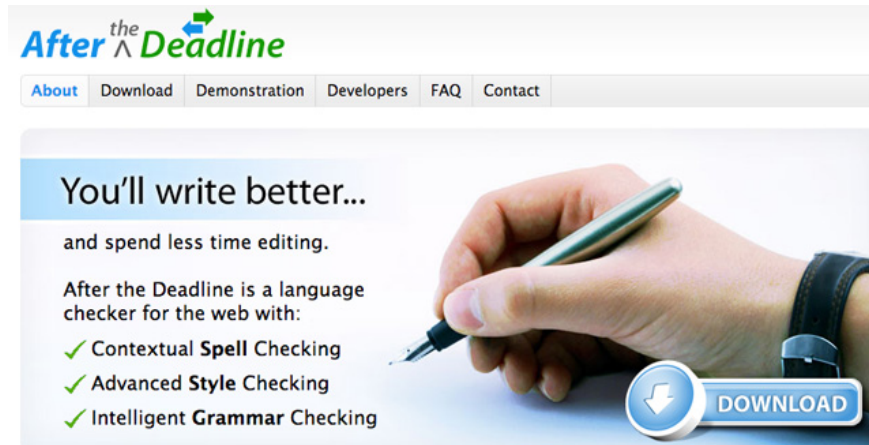


This way you can try it out, see how it provides and works before deciding to download the software and use it on your computer. LanguageTool does not have many features but is flexible. Many users commented on this tool being able to find grammatical errors without a tool that could be found.

This tool is for everyone, you just need to download and install the software on your computer. The site offers three different types of downloads so that users can choose the most appropriate version.

5. Afterthedeadline.com

Spelling and grammar checking tool with online version and plugin for different applications. You can use the online version or its web address. After the Deadline works like other tools, copy and paste or enter the text you want to check into the content field and then click the **Check Writing** button at the end.

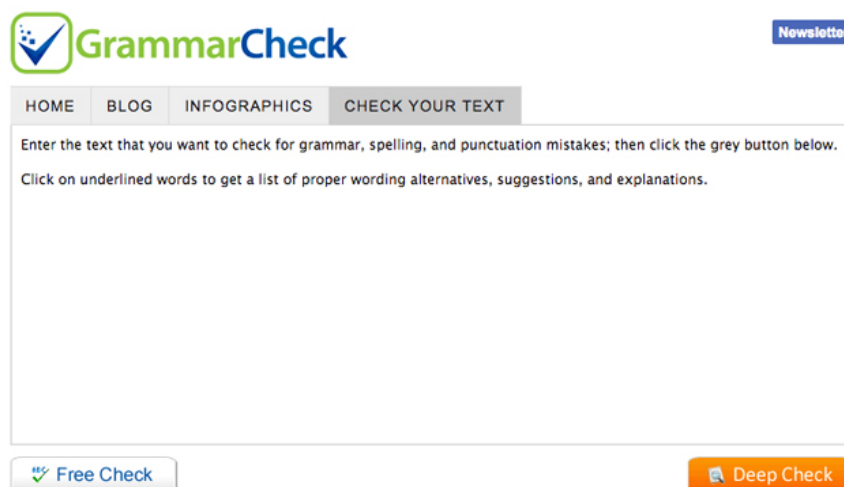

The amazing thing about this tool is that it comes in many forms and integrates with different software solutions. Many bloggers use this tool because it integrates with WordPress, one of the most popular blog content management systems.

6. GrammarCheck.net/editor/

When you first look, you will see that the GrammarCheck tool is nothing special but in fact this is one of the most traditional spelling and grammar testing tools in the world. Why? Because it is easy to use and works well. You can check spelling in seconds.



You can also import documents or write directly in the tool. It also supports different formats, so you can upload many types of documents without any problems.

7. Onlinecorrection.com

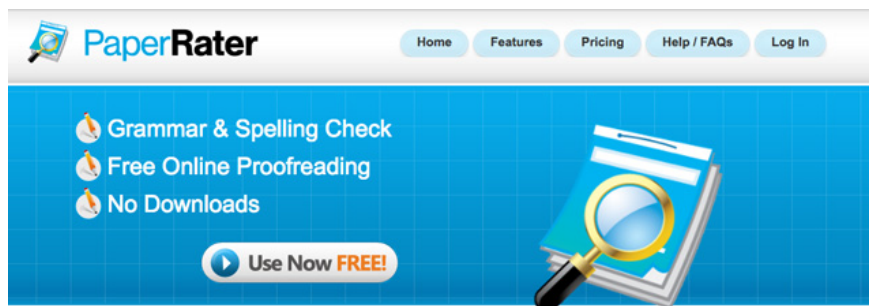
Online Correction is an online spelling and grammar checking tool. It has the ability to find grammatical errors, spelling and style recognition in text. When opening the website of the tool, you will see a minimalistic text editor to enter the text you want to check into.



Online Correction has auto correction feature. All corrected errors will appear in a separate page. This tool also provides some English dialects such as English English, American English and Australian English. Thanks to the simple design, making it one of the best solutions for those who do not want to use more advanced options.

8. Paperrater.com

Paper Rater is one of the most popular online spelling and plotting tools. In addition to the fact that it works well, Paper Rater is also a completely free tool online, meaning you don't have to download and install the program.



Many freelance writers, bloggers and students use this grammar and spelling test tool daily, and a lot of them recommend it. Paper Rater has more than 10 billion documents stored on the server, and it can compare them with the imported text to find out if the writer has plagiarism. In addition to being able to check the articles that have been copied, it can also find articles on topics that other authors have published.

9. SpellCheckPlus.com

SpellCheckPlus is an online grammar testing tool designed for English language learners. When comparing SpellCheckPlus with other tools, it uses another type of system to analyze documents.



SpellCheckPlus offers a free version, but with limited features. It will not make suggestions, perform further analysis or explain why the error is incorrect. This means you do not receive suggestions or feedback to correct errors.

The method used by SpellCheckPlus is similar to other tools. You can enter the text you want to check and run it. If you want to get all the SpellCheckPlus features, you will have to upgrade to the professional version for \$ 15 for a personal license.

10. Hemingwayapp.com

This application can correct errors and analyze your writing skills and give you readability score (readability score). If you don't know, readability score is the degree of clarity of the text. The higher the score, the easier it is to read and understand.

Hemingway has two versions, a free online version and a desktop tool that costs \$ 10. In addition to giving you suggestions on how to improve your writing style and improve your word usage, this app also calculates the number of adverbs in the text. In addition, it counts passive structures and provides a hint on how much you should use, based on your writing time.

To choose the right tool to use, you need to know your needs and understand the features that those tools provide. For example, if the tool is too simple, it will not detect errors when you write technical content or complicated content.

Take your time and see each tool, try them out and see which one suits you best. Although these tools can be quite helpful, they can't make you a good writer unless you put in a lot of effort.
