

10 ways to open a bottle of wine without a opener

Wine now has many types such as white wine, red wine . with origins from many different places. Although different wines have similar cork structure made of wood and sealed into the bottle neck.

If you have a dedicated wine opener, you can easily open it by swirling it in a gentle light. However, if you do not have a corkscrew (chicken spiral shape), you can refer to **10 ways to open the bottle of wine when there is no opening** in this article!

1. Use some indoor tools

If you find a toolbox, you can open the bottle of wine with spiral nails, screwdriver, hammer or pliers. Put the spiral nail on the top of the cork, then use a screwdriver or pliers to tighten the stopper, about 1 inch from the stopper. Then use the back of the hammer (not the head) or pliers to pull both the spiral nail and the stopper. (Note: Use spiral nails large enough to open more easily).

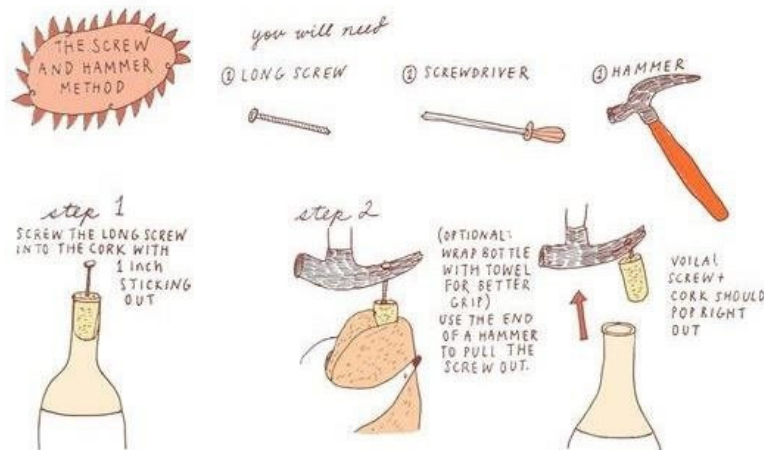

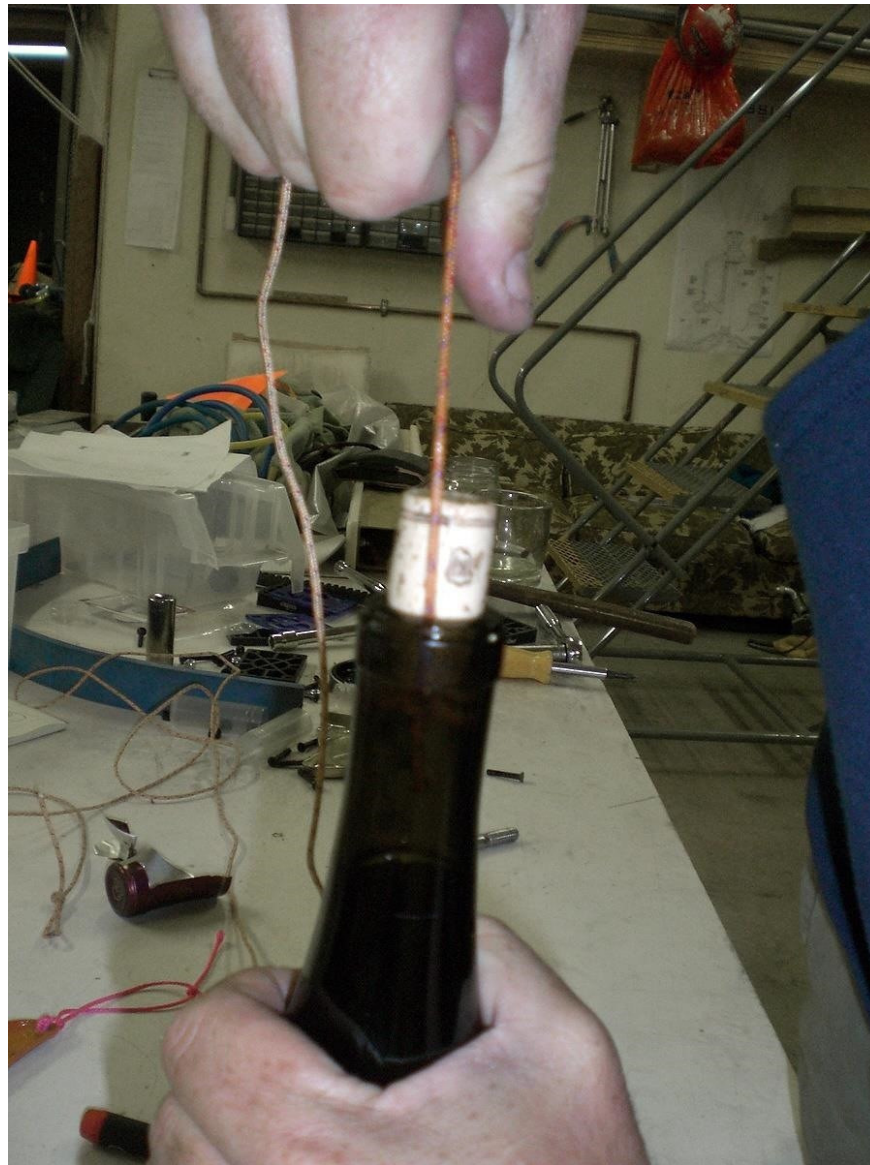
In addition, you can also use ordinary nails without spiral nails.

2. Use the spoon to push the cork down

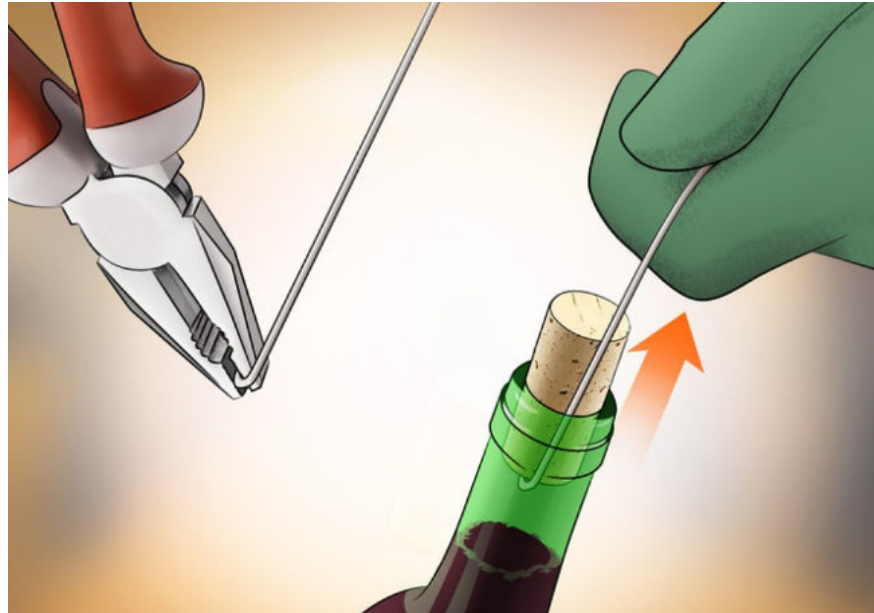
Under the Food Bite video below, you just need to use a spoon with a wooden elongated handle to place the cork down below. Remove the glossy paper covering the bottle and use the push of the stopper to the bottom.

3. Use a hard steel wire to pull the stopper out





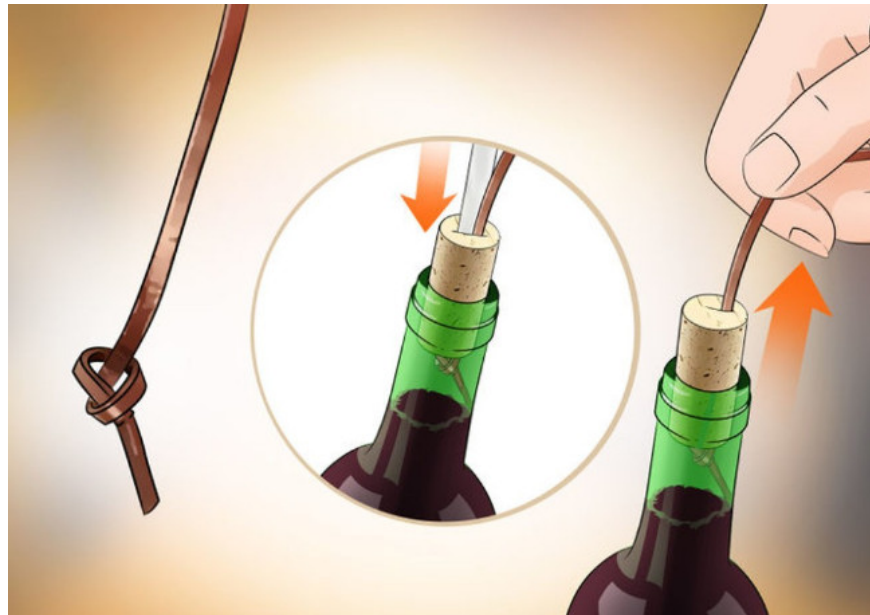
Use a zinc-iron bar to bend, then close the edge of the stopper and twist it up.



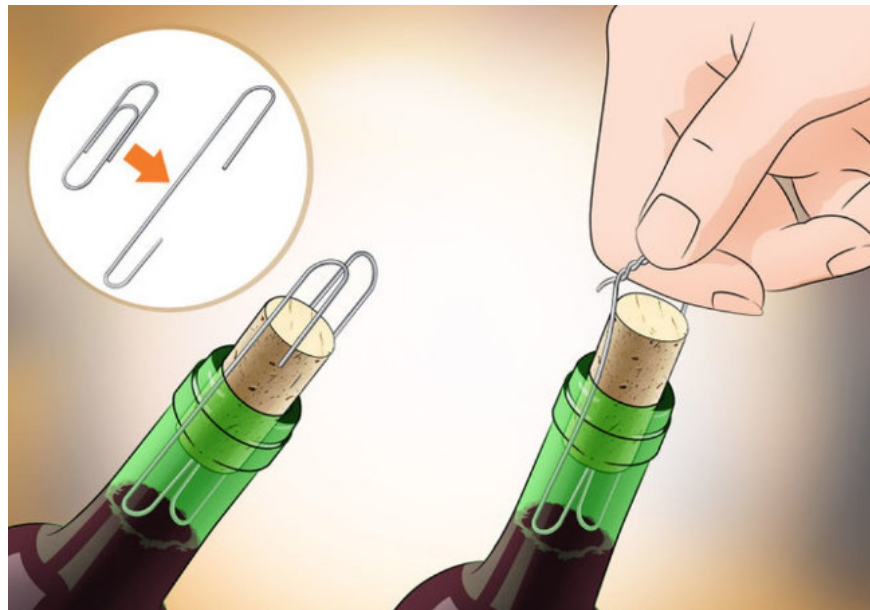
If there is a piece of steel with a spiral tip, you can make it like a wine hatch.



Punch and then put the rope in and pull up.



In addition, you can use paper clips to unfold the bottle as shown below.



4. Hit the wall to push the cork up

If you are worried about not having a corkscrew, just wrap the bottle in a towel and gently hit the bottom of the bottle against the wall.

Place the wipes on the bottom of the bottle and hold it firmly, then slap the bottom of the bottle into the wall. You have to beat along the direction of the cylinder, which means beating the bottle perpendicular to the wall. Repeated many times with the pounding force increased, the stopper will slowly drop out of the bottle.

If you don't have a towel, you can use thick-soled shoes. Simply remove the shoe and place the bottom of the bottle in the shoe, so that the bottle fits perfectly into the shoe. Keep the bottle fixed in the shoe, put the shoe on the wall so that the shoe sole is flush with the wall. A few hard punches on the wall will help you open the cork successfully.

Note : cork can pop out completely, make wine shoot everywhere. When the cork has stuck out enough to hold, you should stop and pull it out with your hand.

Instead of hitting the wall, you can hit the door frame, but the door frame must be solid and have a flat surface.

In addition, you can also just use a book.

5. Flap the bottom of the bottle

If you are worried about hitting the wall, it will damage the wall or door, you can replace it by using your foot with a shoe.

Sit down and place the bottle upside down between your thighs. Hold the bottle tightly when pressing the bottom of the bottle with the shoe flat. Keep doing this until the cork relaxes a bit. Once the cork has slipped far enough, you can use it to pull it out.

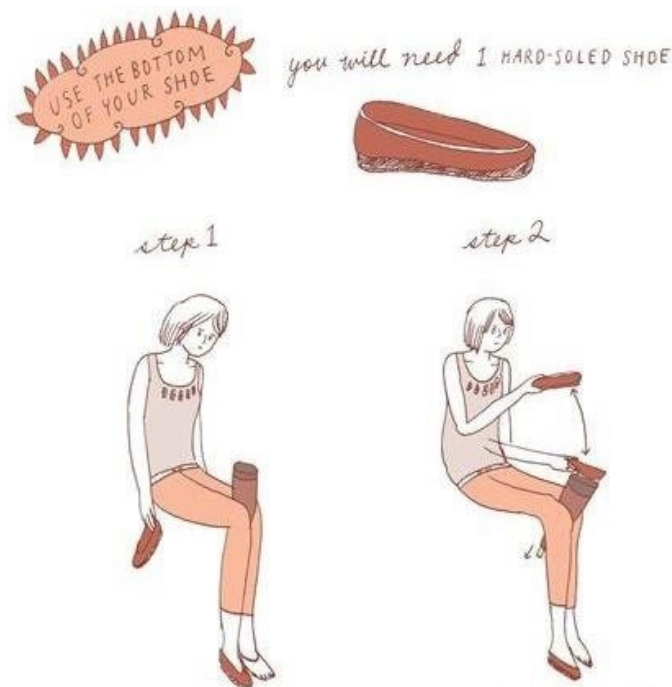

6. Create pressure by bicycle pump

Bike pumps can also be a great tool to open cork like Kristy Kreme presented on YouTube.

Attach bicycle pump to cork and pump. When you squeeze air in through the cork, you will put enough pressure to make it pop out of the bottle.

7. Use the car key to open the bottle

" *Just a metal key, you can open the wine stopper* ," according to Kent Yammo.

As the video below, plug your key into the cork at 45 ° angle until sure. Then start spinning and pull the cork upwards; The stopper will start screwing up and finally you can open it.

8. Use a paring knife

If you do not have a key and have tried the above methods, you can use a paring knife. Just like the key method, you simply plug the knife in, then use the force to twist the bottle and the stopper will slowly open. However, you should choose knives with a bit of thickness that will not be difficult to implement.

According to CrazyRussianHacker, gently insert the knife into the cork and slowly rotate it in a circular motion. When twisted and pulled up, the cork will start moving up.

9. Open the bottle with "sword"

This procedure is called sabrage or sabering, which can be done with a knife, sword or razor. Obviously, this should be the last resort because it is quite dangerous, but Alton Brown shows how easy it is to be done properly. (Also, you can use spoons if you have enough skills.)

10. Heat up the bottle

To remove the cork, just boil the water and put the bottle in . the lid will automatically expand and pop out.
