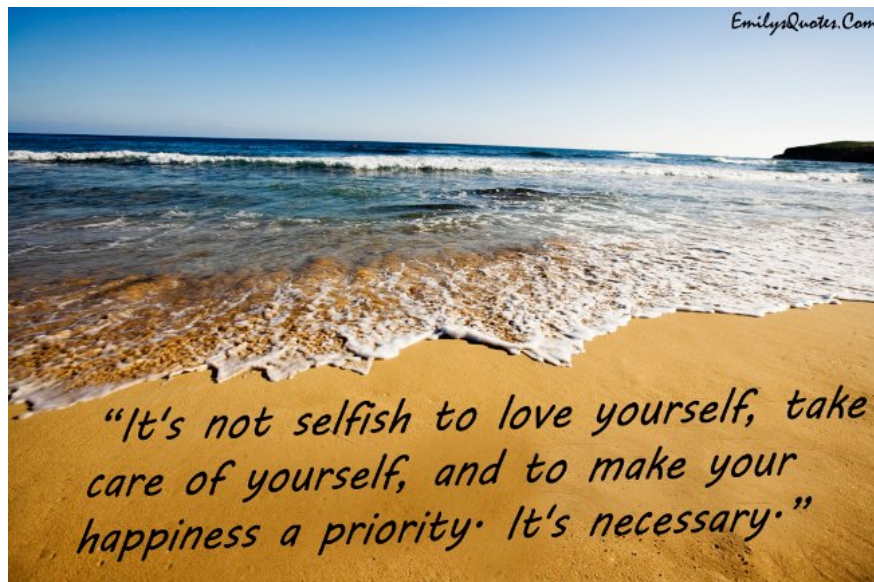
9. Mistakes are fine, as long as they don't repeat
