## 1. Vimeo



Even if you access YouTube regularly, you should also consider using Vimeo . This website was the first on the web to support high-definition video, and although the app includes some fees, the high-quality content remains a major selling point for users.

Among its many diverse content options, Vimeo features a number of popular movies and TV shows, such as E!'s The Royals, Spike TV's Blue Mountain State, and Netflix 's Orange Is the New Black .

The website also features a search function that helps sort videos by category and channel. If you're not sure what you want to watch, the regularly updated content on Vimeo can help.

All you need to do is sign up for a Vimeo account. As a Basic member, you can:

1. Upload a maximum of 500MB of content per week (total storage limit of 5GB per account).
2. Access basic embedded features
3. View some analytics for your video.
4. Download the converted video files.
5. Access some privacy controls for your videos.
6. Upload a maximum of 10 videos per day.
7. Create 1 channel, 1 group, and 3 promotional programs.
8. Publish organic videos to social media and e-commerce accounts.

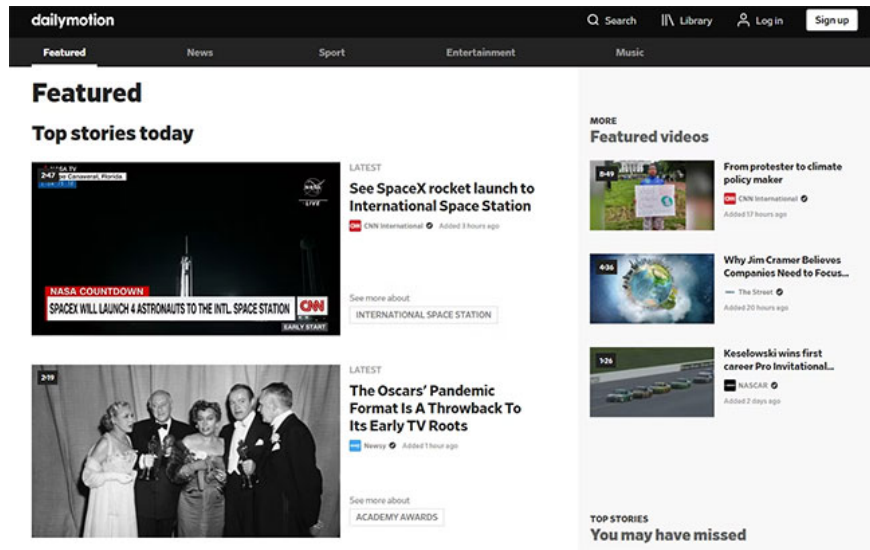
The main differences between Vimeo and YouTube are as follows:

1. Vimeo is known for its higher-quality videos and for promoting artistic and meaningful content. Therefore, the platform is a bit more selective about what content is uploaded.
2. YouTube is free for both viewers and creators; however, Vimeo charges for premium features, allowing you to upload more videos.
3. Videos on Vimeo are ad-free like those on YouTube, but some videos are available on a pay-per-view basis called Video on Demand (VoD). Here, you can rent, buy, or subscribe.
4. Upload limits vary.
5. YouTube has a larger audience.

**Note :** These are just a few of the differences, so do more research if you only want to stick with one of these two video sharing platforms!

Vimeo is a powerful video sharing platform that has introduced many creators to diverse audiences. This article strongly recommends using Vimeo to build your following and share content you love with an audience who will love it too. You can always start with a basic account and get acquainted before opting for a Premium account. If you're looking to create creative, high-quality content and want to find an easily receptive audience, why not give Vimeo a try?

## **2. Dailymotion**



Dailymotion is a video-sharing website that allows users to browse, share, and upload videos. It is a French company owned by the Vivendi mass media group. Dailymotion has over 300 million monthly users, is available in 25 languages worldwide, and has produced 43 localized versions.

Dailymotion is very similar to YouTube, but its content focus is slightly different. YouTube is primarily powered by user-generated content, while Dailymotion features more professionally produced content.

You can stream live on Dailymotion if you have a paid plan and use encoding software like OBS Studio or Restream Studio. After the live events end, other Dailymotion users can watch them as video-on-demand (VOD) on your Dailymotion profile.

Dailymotion became increasingly popular and built relationships with top content creators like Max and Showtime. In 2012, when Dailymotion (and several other video websites) were blocked in India for copyright infringement, the platform became the focus of attention.

To remain competitive with other giants in the field like YouTube and Vimeo, Dailymotion is investing in advanced video technology. This provides users with a wide range of UHD (4K), Full HD (1080p), and HD (720p) content. The site has also automatically improved the audio quality encoded at 720p for the few films currently available in high resolution.

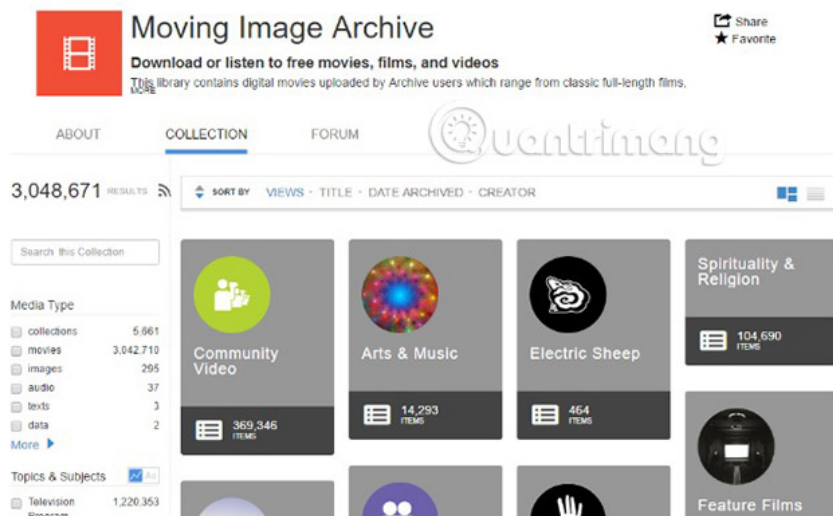

## 4. The Internet Archive



As its name suggests, the Internet Archive is a web-based library containing all kinds of free content, including books, music, software, and of course, movies. Launched in 1996, the Internet Archive is a non-profit organization with a stated mission of 'universal access to all knowledge'. With this in mind, the organization provides free public access to digitized materials, including websites, books, audio recordings (including live concerts), videos, images, and software programs.

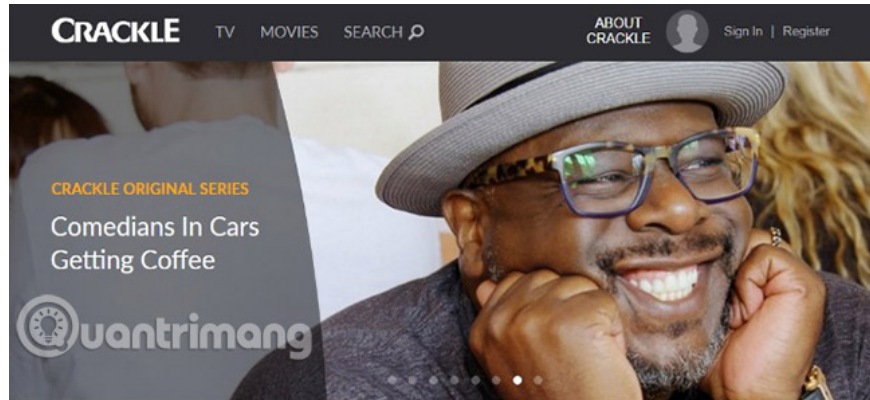
The Internet Archive (IA) has preserved over 1.9 million websites, books, videos, and other digital content since 1996. Its Wayback Machine allows users to access archived websites and is used by millions of people worldwide. The Internet Archive's mission is to preserve knowledge and cultural heritage for future generations. By archiving books, films, and other materials, the IA ensures that these resources are always available for future generations to study and enjoy.

Just as you can combine a physical library with research, one of the strengths of The Internet Archive's video content is its vast scope. While The Internet Archive does feature some new content, some of its best videos are news reports, old and lesser-known TV shows, or films that are often difficult to find on other websites.

Like many other websites, users can also upload videos to The Internet Archive. When uploading videos to this site, H.264 is the common video encoding format used.

The video archive is organized much like a book collection. There are also special collections organized around an event, individual, or organization. A particular section includes television news clips whose authenticity has been verified by FactCheck.org, PolitiFact, The Washington Post's Fact Checker, or other organizations.

## 5. Crackle



Owned by Sony Pictures Entertainment, think of Crackle as a streaming service that offers both original web programming and Hollywood movies and TV shows from various networks.

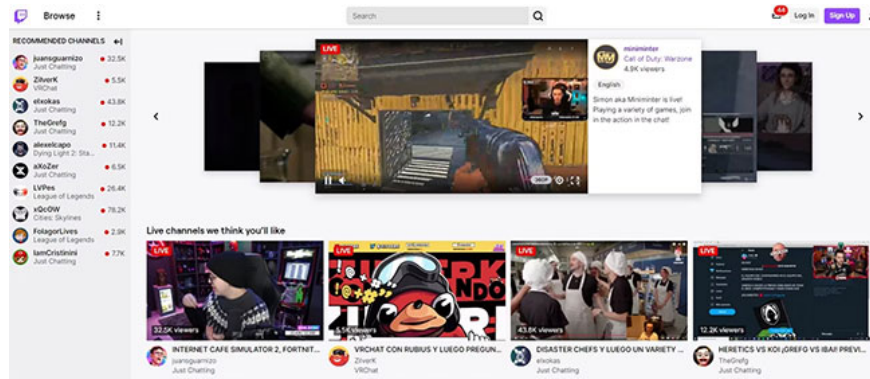
Some of Crackle's early content garnered significant acclaim, including the series *Comedians in Cars Getting Coffee* starring Jerry Seinfeld. It also features a range of television shows that received positive viewer feedback, such as *All in the Family*, *227*, *Firefly*, *Mad About You*, and *News Radio*. Additionally, the site is a great place to find older movies you may have missed, such as *Night of the Living Dead*, *Animal House*, *Paranormal Activity*, and *Rudy*.

Many of Crackle's movie selections tend to change frequently. Some shows are only available on the service for a month before temporarily disappearing. Thankfully, the TV show selection is a bit more stable. Currently, you can watch shows like *Third Rock from the Sun*, *The Real Ghostbusters*, *NewsRadio*, *Hell's Kitchen*, *Charlie's Angels*, etc.

Crackle is definitely worth subscribing to if you're looking for premium streaming services on a moderate budget. You'll occasionally see ads, but that's a common trade-off for accessing such a service. While you won't have access to the newest and best exclusive streaming shows and movies available on Netflix, Disney Plus, Hulu, or Max, there's plenty of content on Crackle to keep you entertained.

Although this service is free to use without an account, the article recommends signing up for a free Crackle account to unlock more features, including parental controls.

## 6. Twitch



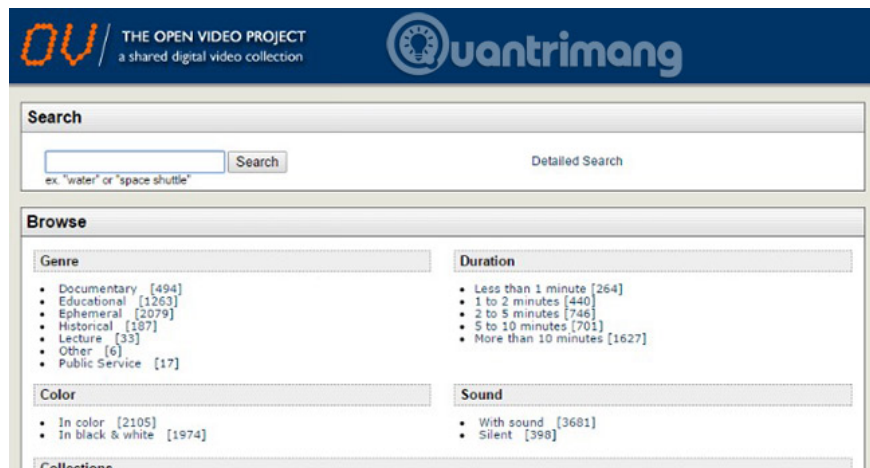
Founded in 2011, Twitch is a live video streaming platform offering almost anything you want to watch, from cooking and music to Q&A sessions and – its top traffic driver – video games. It initially started as a subsidiary of Justin.tv, with a primary focus on gaming. Twitch became so popular that it led to a complete rebranding of Justin.tv, becoming Twitch Interactive in 2014. Later that year, Twitch Interactive was acquired by Amazon.

Twitch is the best live streaming platform on the web. As mentioned above, the site is currently owned by Amazon. Twitch's main focus is live streaming video games, eSports, and game-related talk shows. There is also some non-game content. Most notably, Twitch has streamed a number of live music videos from festivals and concerts. International DJ Steve Aoki famously streamed his entire show from Ibiza in 2014. Currently, Twitch is the official streaming partner for Ultra Music Festival in Miami.

On average, Twitch has over 30 million daily active users, with over 9.2 million broadcasters per month as of 2022. Twitch is available for streaming across multiple platforms. You can access the official Twitch website to watch streams or use the app available on iOS, Android, Windows, Mac, PS4, PS5, Xbox One, Xbox Series X/S, and devices like Chromecast and Apple TV. If your device has internet access and supports the app, you can use it for Twitch.

There are also **IRL (In Real Life)** and **Creative** categories.

## 7. The Open Video Project



A future with access to vast digital video libraries is becoming a reality. Anticipating this future, much research is focused on methods for browsing and retrieving digital video, developing algorithms to create alternative video content options, and creating interfaces to display result sets from multimedia queries. Research in these areas requires individuals to collect and digitize video for their studies, as the multimedia information retrieval community lacks a standardized video collection for research purposes. The main goal of The Open Video Project is to create and maintain a shared digital video archive and experimental collection to meet these research needs.

The Open Video Project is a shared digital video archive and experimental collection designed to meet the needs of researchers in a variety of digital video-related fields. Its aim is to collect and provide a digital video content repository for digital video, multimedia retrieval, digital libraries, and other research communities.

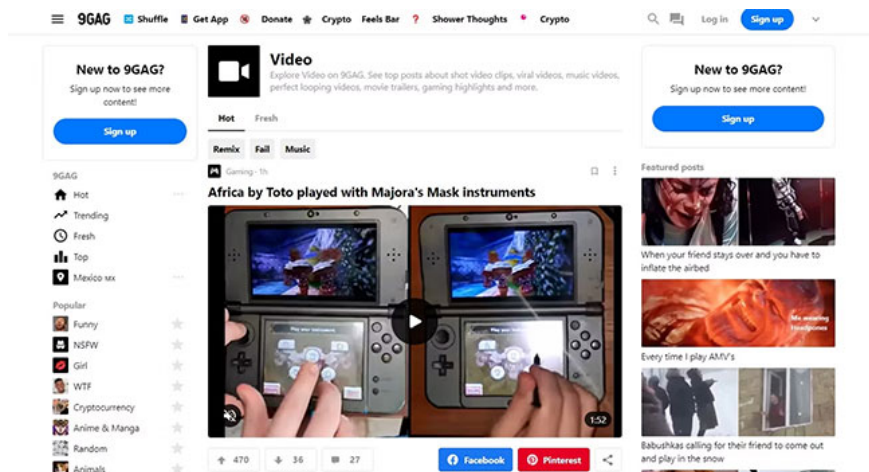
Researchers can use video to study a variety of issues, such as testing algorithms for segmentation, automatic summarization, and generating alternative representations that describe video content; developing facial recognition algorithms; or creating and evaluating interfaces that display sets of results from multimedia queries. The Open Video collection currently contains video or metadata for 1,843 digitized video segments.

The Open Video Project was developed in the interactive design lab at the Chapel Hill College of Information and Library Science in North Carolina. The website is targeted at the research community, including those working with digital libraries and multimedia retrieval.

With that in mind, most of the videos found on The Open Video Project are educational. There are many videos from the NASA archives, as well as a collection of classic television commercials and educational films dating back to the 1950s. If you're looking for and researching historical video content, consider checking out The Open Video Project.

## 8. 9GAG.com

On July 1, 2008, Ray Chan and his brother Chris Chan launched 9GAG, starting it as a fun "side project." In 2012, they raised \$2.8 million in venture capital. That same year, 9GAG launched a mobile app for Android and iOS, offering users streamlined web versions as well as the ability to send messages to other users.

On December 24, 2014, 9GAG released an Android game, Redhead Redemption, a gyroscope-based shooter. As of August 2017, 9GAG's Facebook page had over 36 million likes and followers; its Twitter account had over 11.8 million followers; and its Instagram account had over 21 million followers.


9GAG is a meme-sharing website based in Hong Kong but hosted in the United States. Launched in 2008, the site's content mainly consists of reshapes of many popular memes. 9GAG is a collection of all things fun: funny pictures, GIFs, video games, memes, anime, etc.

The website uses the same image-sharing style as sites like 4chan, Reddit, and Funnyjunk, but allows people to post using their Facebook accounts and has a "like" system (similar to the system on Reddit and Funnyjunk) on individual posts.

Most of the content is lighthearted and satirical. Video titles include "Compilation of the best commercials starring the Star Wars cast" or "This high school romance will warm your heart."

It's the kind of content you can hardly resist clicking on and spending hours enjoying. Before accessing, please note: the website contains some slightly risqué videos and may not be suitable for viewing at work.

## 9. TED Talks



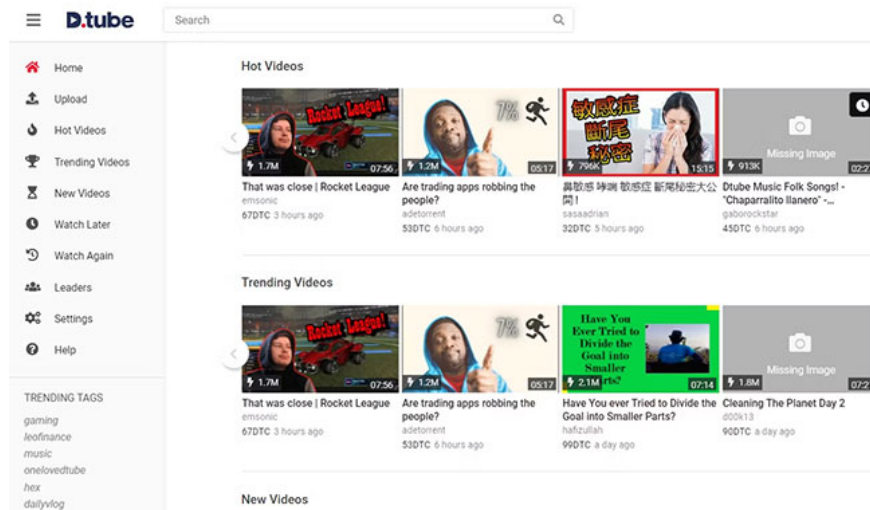

If you're not already familiar with TED, now's a good time to get acquainted with it. The TED website features over 2,300 talks on a wide range of topics, such as technology, business, design, science, and global issues.

Some talks bring joy to viewers, while others move the audience. Most of the content on this site is primarily for entertainment (although there are a few special programs with educational value). However, the common thread among all TED videos is that you can find something memorable in each one.

The TED website is especially useful if you're short on time. Videos appearing in the menu are tagged with a prominent red bar if they are shorter than 6 minutes.

## 10. DTube

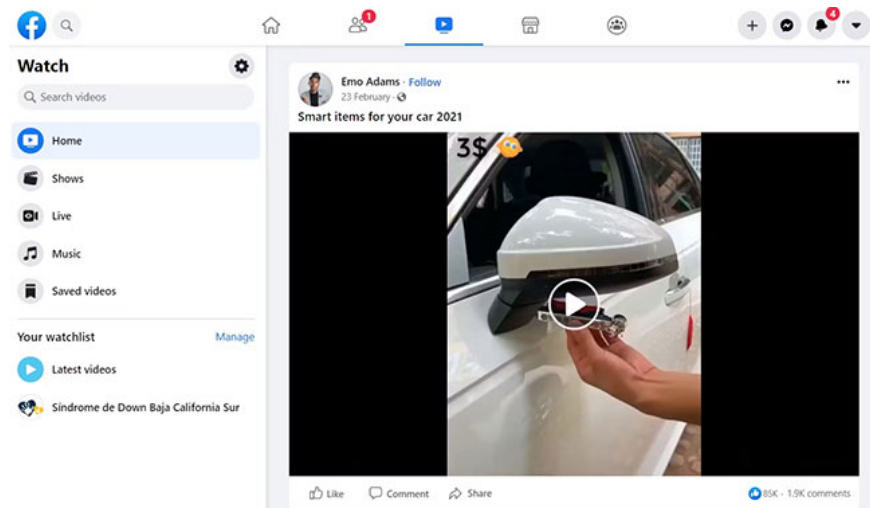


DTube, short for Decentralized Tube, is a video website similar to YouTube. However, instead of all videos being stored on a central server, the entire website uses the STEEM blockchain and is therefore decentralized.

Users who upload videos to the website will earn STEEM cryptocurrency, which they can transfer to their own cryptocurrency wallet or sell for cash on a cryptocurrency exchange.

One minor change on DTube is how the metrics are displayed. Instead of showing the number of views per video, the website shows the amount of cryptocurrency each video has earned.

## 11. Facebook Watch



Like YouTube, Facebook Watch provides a list of relevant video content for you to explore.

Finding content is a bit harder than on YouTube, and it also lacks the countless categories or subscription features. But if you enjoy spending hours scrolling through lists of easy-to-watch videos, then it's definitely a YouTube alternative worth considering.

YouTube is the leading video website for several reasons, including its vast video collection and its huge partnership with Google.

However, the video websites listed above are also worth considering as they also have content you should explore.
