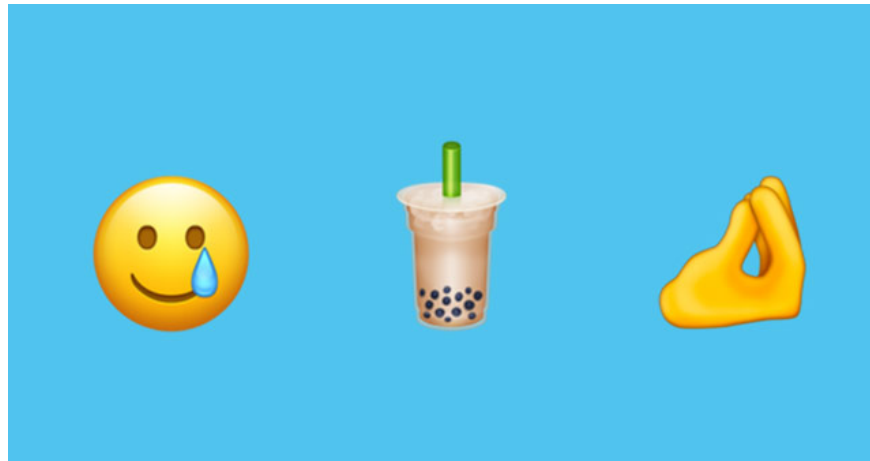
According to the latest announcement, 117 new emojis (emoticons) for 2020 have been officially recognized and added to the global emoji library for the whole world.
