

12 Chrome Flags useful you should activate on Android

By using Chrome Flags, you can easily activate hidden features to enhance your Android browsing experience.

Chrome is the default browser on Android. Although this browser is quite good, it has many hidden features that have not been activated yet. By using Chrome Flags, you can easily enable these features to enhance your browsing experience. This article will show some of the best Chrome Flags you should turn on Android.

How to activate Chrome Flags

Before going into the details of every Chrome flags, you need to know how to activate these flags. How to turn on Chrome Flags is relatively easy, just copy the Chrome flag URL you want to activate, paste it into the address bar and touch the **Go** button. Under that flag, select **Enable** from the drop-down menu and restart the browser.

Note: Depending on the version of Chrome and Android, some flags may not be available on your device.

1. Control on media player

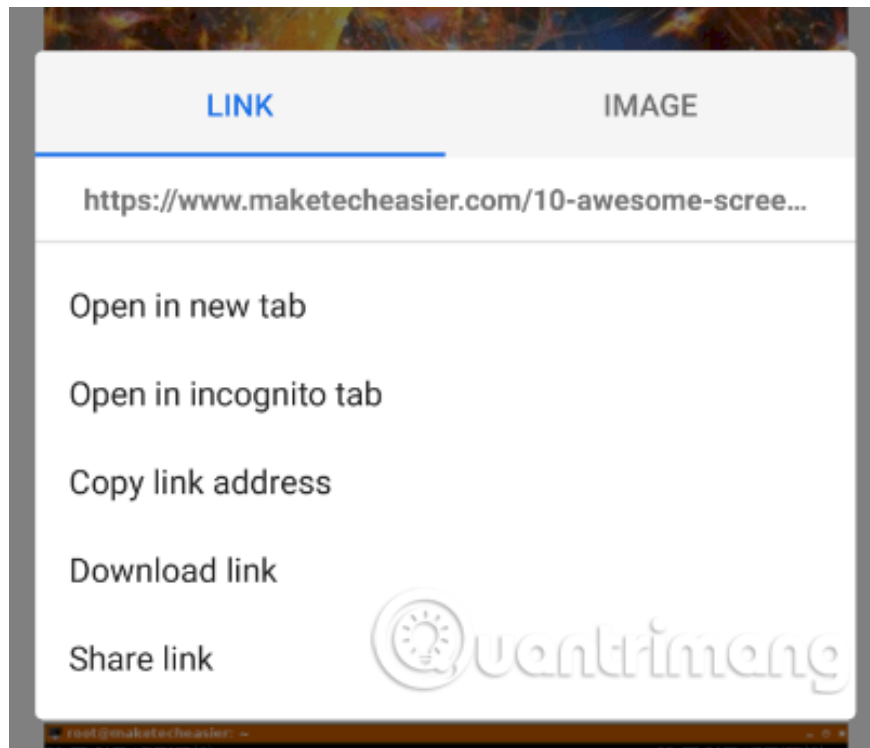
`chrome://flags/#enable-modern-media-controls`



The integrated video player in Chrome browser is quite basic. In fact, this default player doesn't even have gesture control. With this flag, you can turn on the original gesture controls such as double tapping to pause and play, rewind, and backward

2. New context menu

`chrome://flags/#enable-custom-context-menu`



Unlike the commonly used contextual and click context menus, this flag will display the context menu with the appropriate option depending on the pressing and holding item.

3. Download in parallel

`chrome://flags/#enable-parallel-downloading`

If you regularly download large files on Chrome, this Chrome flag will increase download speed. With this enabled parallel download feature, Chrome will start with multiple connections, so you can download the file into multiple parts at once and link them together when the download is complete.

4. Sneak Peek feature

chrome://flags/#enable-ephemeral-tab

Browser Password Managers: Are They Good Enough? - Make Tech Easier

Whatever your browser of choice is, you'll often get an option that asks: "*Save password for this site?*" If you have several passwords or can't remember the last combination, browser-based password managers are terrific time-savers and make life more convenient. Most major browsers like Chrome, Firefox, and Opera all come with a built-in password manager. The question is, how reliable are they?

Are Browser Password Managers Safe?

As much as they're convenient and save time, browser password managers offer a false sense of security, especially in the event of a browser breach. Let's look at how some of the top web browsers fare.

Firefox



If you're reading a long article or on a page with lots of distractions, you can use this new reading mode to simplify the view. To activate the new reading mode, select **Always** or **All Articles** from the drop-down menu and restart the browser. You should now see a new option **Simplified View** at the bottom, touch it and the page will reload in this simple reading mode.

6. Search on the Omnibox bar

```
chrome://flags/#enable-search-ready-omnibox
```

When touching the search bar if there is already a URL in it, Chrome browser will highlight this URL. You must manually touch the small X icon to remove the address bar. With this flag you will no longer have to manually delete the Omnibox bar.

7. Move the page navigation bar below the screen

```
chrome://flags/#enable-chrome-duet
```

Two-factor authentication

Most services you may use, including Google, banking platforms and social networks offer an extra layer of protection. This can be in the form of a code that you get via SMS to your phone. You can also use YubiKey or Google Authenticator.

Other ways you can stay safe include:

- Update your device software to get crucial security patches.
- Don't install software from anywhere other than the official device manufacturer or OS provider like Apple, Microsoft, or Google-managed app stores!

Today's smartphones are so big, you almost can't access all four corners of the screen with one hand. When this flag is turned on, Chrome will switch all necessary controls such as search buttons, option buttons, tab converters, etc. down to the bottom of the screen to easily use the phone with one hand.

8. Dark mode

```
chrome://flags/#enable-android-night-mode
```

Chrome has a built-in Dark mode and can be easily activated by enabling this flag. However, this mode is not complete, so you will see some inconsistencies.

9. Mute the tab

```
chrome://flags/#sound-content-setting
```

You feel uncomfortable when the site automatically plays video with audio? Do you always have to use the volume button to reduce the sound level? With this flag, you can quickly mute the tab with simple options.

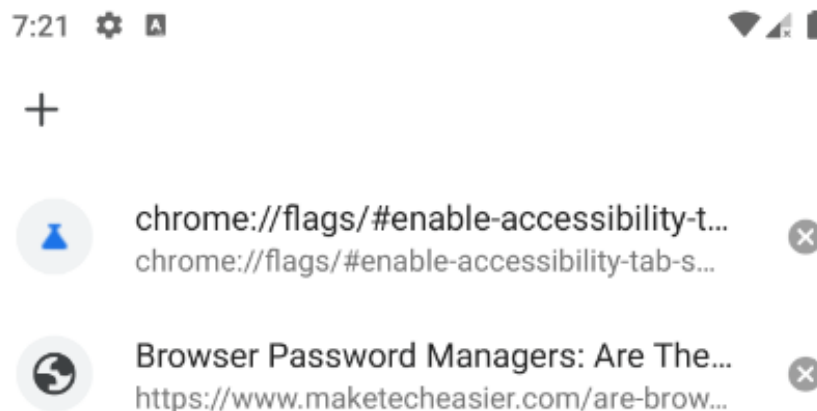
10. Block page navigation

```
chrome://flags/#enable-framebusting-needs-sameorigin-or-usergesture
```

One of the annoying things about using a mobile website is that it often redirects without notifying the user. You can block redirection by enabling this flag.

11. List tabs opened

```
chrome://flags/#enable-accessibility-tab-switcher
```



In general, when clicking the tab switch icon, Chrome will display all tabs according to the card layout. If you open a few tabs, you will see that the tabs are open, but it is very confusing if there are multiple tabs. You can enable this flag to force Chrome to display a list of alternate tabs in the form of tags as default.

12. Scroll Anchoring feature

```
chrome://flags/#enable-scroll-anchor-serialization
```

Normally, Chrome has a "habit" of jumping a special page when scrolling long pages with lots of text. When this flag is turned on, the page jumping issue will be resolved.
