## Notebook and pen

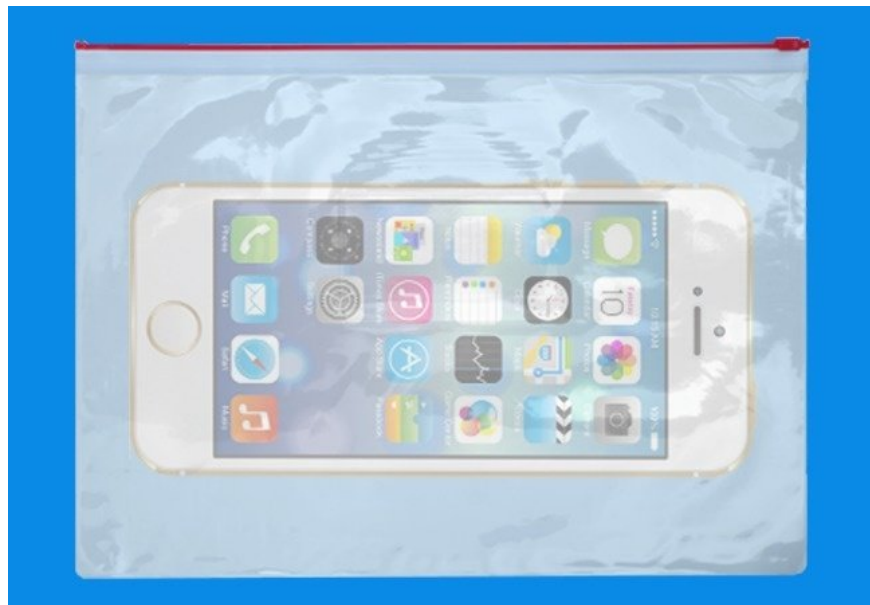
