In the age of digital technology, the Internet is growing, the need to use social networks and share photos has become an inevitable thing in today's life. " Great " photos *are* really the brainchild of photographers, the " *source of life* " of Facebook and Instagram user communities.

Taking pictures is simple but not everyone knows how to take beautiful photos, especially to become a photographer is even more difficult. On the Bright Side page, you have **12 tips to help you easily save great moments with friends and relatives with your smartphone** . Invite you to consult!

1. Use headphones to take pictures



You can use the volume up and down button on the headset to take a picture, which will minimize camera shake and is very effective when you place the camera in a corner and use the headset to take pictures.

How to do it : Connect the headset to your smartphone device, open the camera application and press the '+' button on the headset to take a picture.

2. Selfie does not need to hold the phone



In the past, taking photos with your friends was difficult because it was not always possible to capture a perfect photo: some people were always outside the frame, your hand covered the image or the angle was not beautiful. But don't worry, now you can solve this problem by following the instructions below.

How to do it : Take an unused plastic sheet, bend twice as shown in the picture so that the phone can be fixed in the middle and use a headset or set a timer to take a photo.

3. Use the Panoramme feature



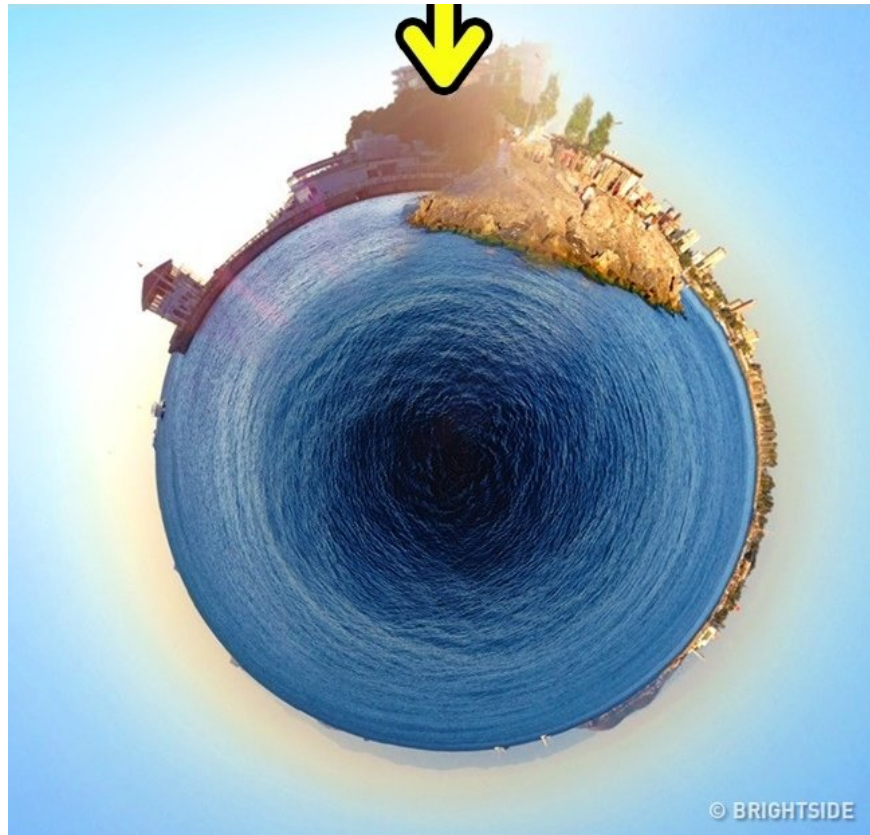


You can use **the built-in "panorama"** feature on your phone to make a double photo in one shot without editing the image. This mode is used in case you cannot cover all of the common photos.

How to do it : Select panorama mode, let the photographer stand in position and start moving the phone in any direction. When the person is taken out of the frame, you let the camera pause. Meanwhile, the person who was photographed moved and walked to the next frame.

4. "RollWorld" application





In addition, you can use different applications to add interesting effects. For example, **the RollWorld application** can create a miniature image of the Earth in any picture. "*RollWorld*" is an application that helps you create interesting effects for photos.

How to do it : Download the application, upload a panorama you captured. You will get a very unique and interesting photo.

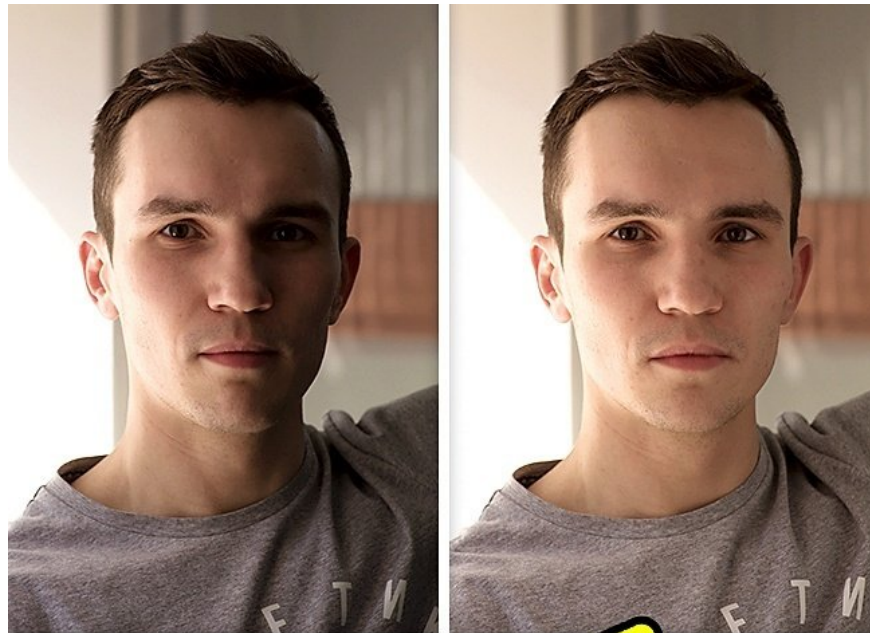
5. Take photos underwater

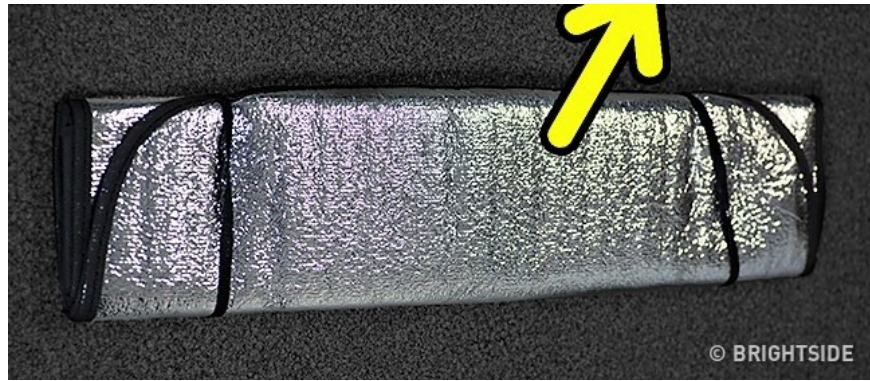


Shooting underwater with a smartphone is much more convenient than shooting with a camera and you don't need a protective cover.

How to do it : Put the phone in a glass cup with no water, then put the cup of water on the water (*do not put water in the cup*) to take a picture. Besides, you can use headphones to take pictures. For deeper underwater photos, wrap the phone with a transparent plastic bag or condom: not waterproof but still sensitive as usual.

6. Use reflective panels





Taking portraits sometimes requires a bit more light so that the picture has more depth. At that time, just a reflective plate is enough.

How to do it : Take a reflective sheet or a normal tin sheet. The reflector will make the area brighter and shimmering a few times more.

7. Use HDR shooting mode



HDR abbreviation of the phrase **High Dynamic Range** . HDR technology will help digital cameras expand the ability to recognize this dark difference. The camera will record images at 3 different and combined brightness levels, balance the light so that the picture does not get too dark when shooting backlight and enhance details on the subject. This process is done completely automatically. HDR shooting mode is responsible for making your image look better, looks like what your eyes see, but also depends on how you use it.

How to do it : Open the camera, turn on HDR mode and shoot.

Tip : Photos taken in this mode take up a lot of memory in a mobile device, so this feature should only be used on special occasions.

8. Attach the phone to the balloons

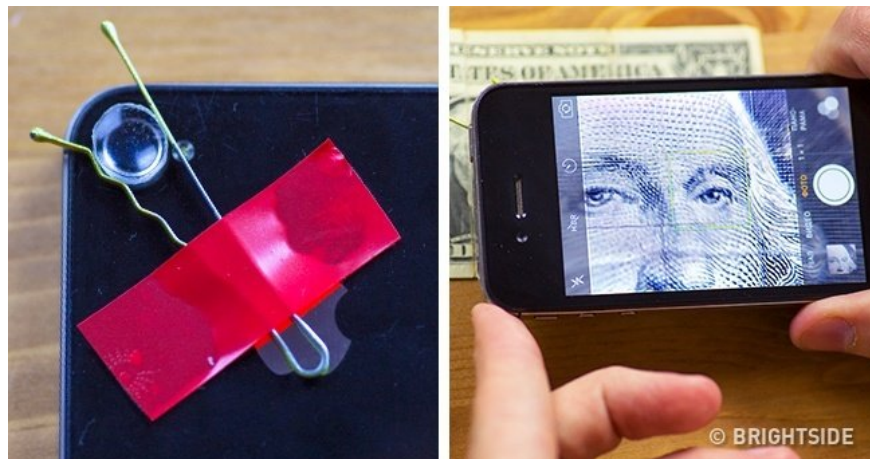


No need for an expensive drone to take aerial photography, you can **attach your phone to balloons** . Then, set the timer to have a really sparkling photo.

How to do it : Blow a big balloon with helium gas. Carefully attach the phone to the ball with a sturdy cord. Release the ball and shoot with the timer.

Tip : Wrap the phone protection cover and turn on the phone's search feature in case something goes wrong.

9. Take macro photos



Macro shooting is understood by taking close-up shots to subjects in photos that are enlarged by or larger than the real subject outside. When you love photography, love to be creative, you can hardly ignore the magical and fascinating world through macro lens.

Macro photography, also called **zooming**, is not the most powerful feature of a smartphone, but you can improve it using a small lens.

How to do it : You can find lenses in laser watches or pocket flashlights. Fix the lens to your smartphone with clips and tape. Now, you can take some enlarged photos.

10. Get sunglasses as polarizing filter



When taking photos with sunglasses, you will no longer have to face the blazing sun, the water is clearer and the sky is more beautiful under the view of the glass.

How to do it : Put your sunglasses in front of the camera lens, adjust to create a polarizing effect, remove glare and press.

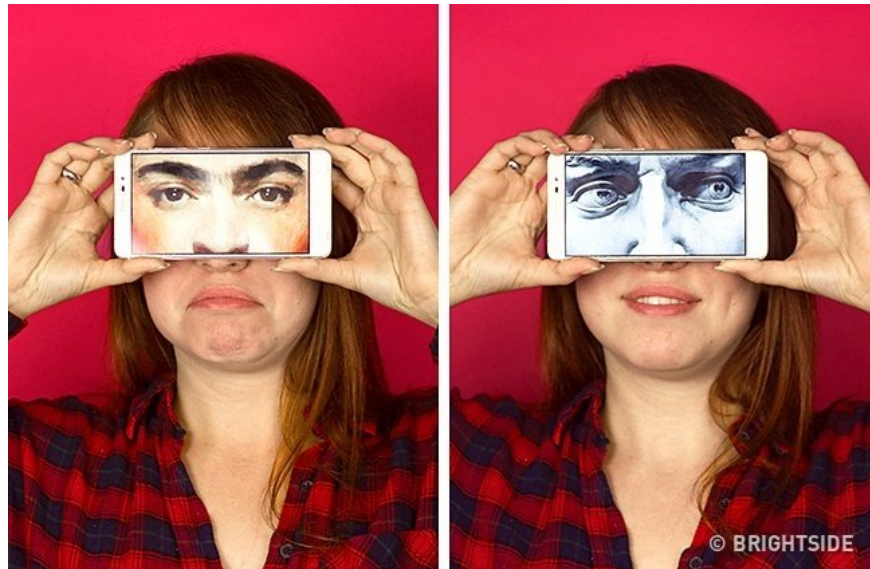
11. Use colored paper



What you need to do now is to put **colored paper next to the lens** . It will make your photos colorful and sparkling rainbow effects.

How to do it : Take some colored paper, place it near the lens to create a bright light. You can also shoot through to add a rainbow effect.

12. Replace a part of your face



You can use images taken from the web, cut it out and replace a face element. That is really new.

How to do it : Find a photo on the Web or add photos from another picture to your portrait. This effective tip depends on your imagination.
