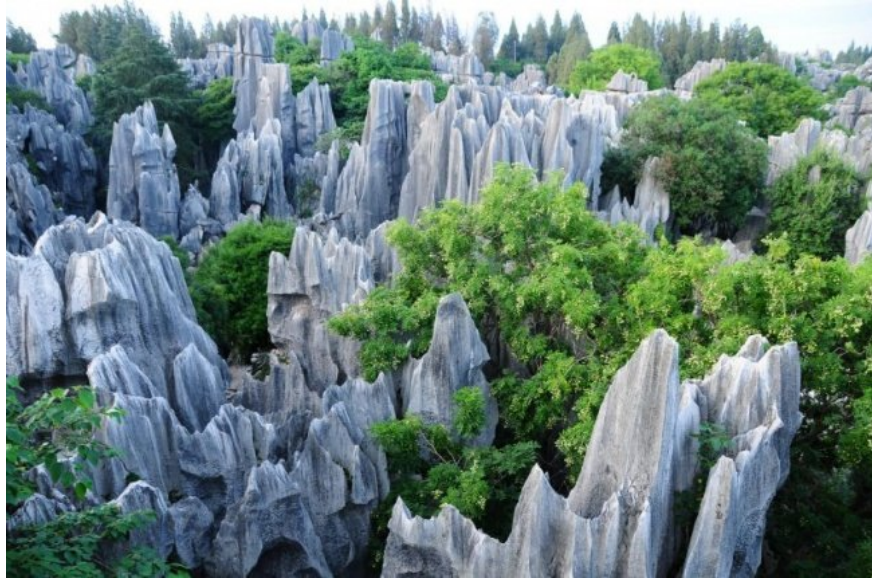
10. Ghost city
