

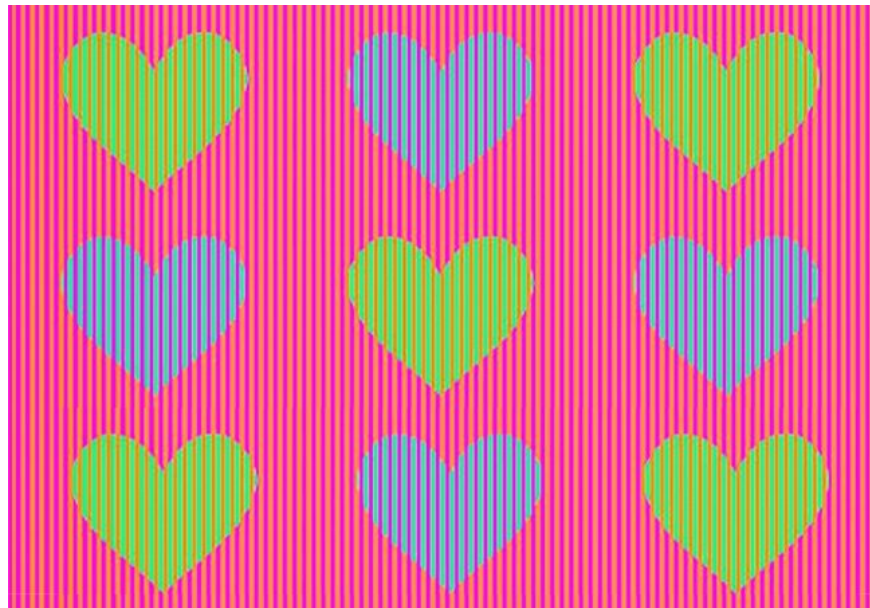

1. Do you see the blue heart?



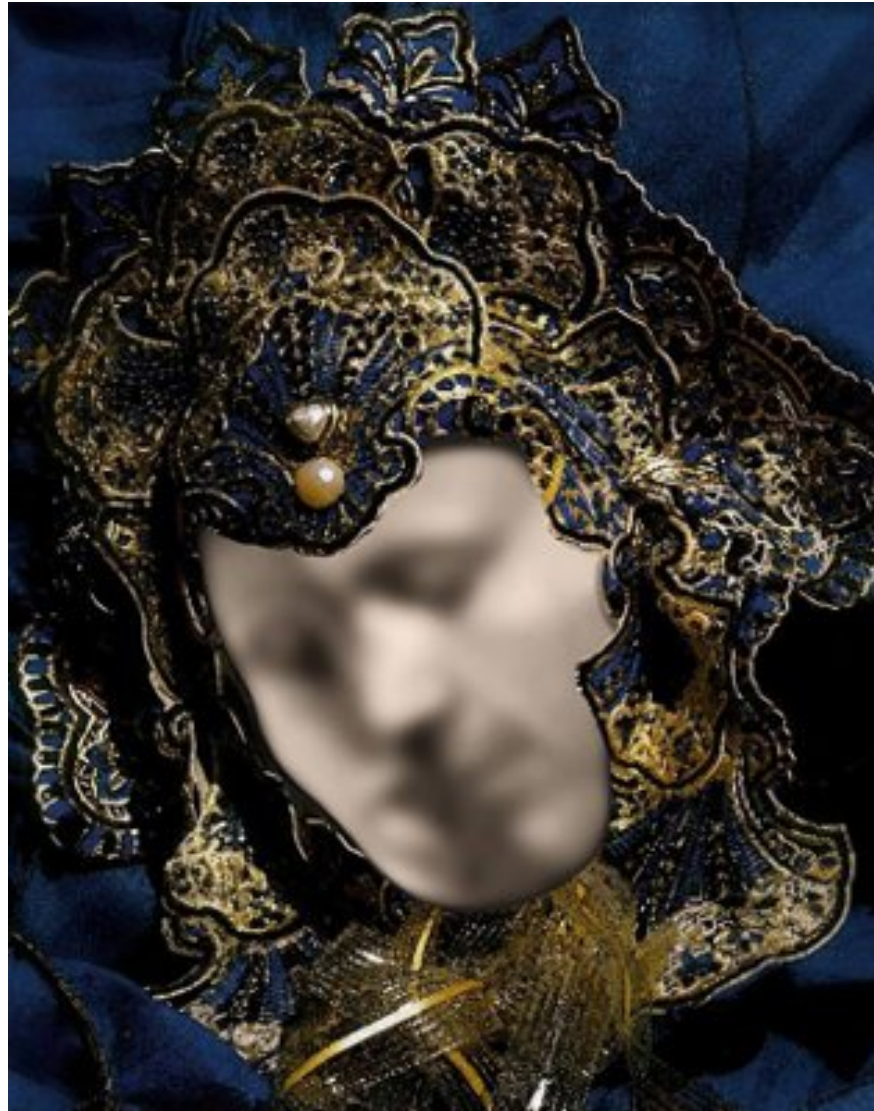

The truth is there are no blue hearts. In the picture only heart: pink, orange and green only. Don't believe your eyes.



There's no blue. There are only 3 colors in the picture:
pink, orange, and green. Don't believe your eyes.

2. Is this a carnival mask?



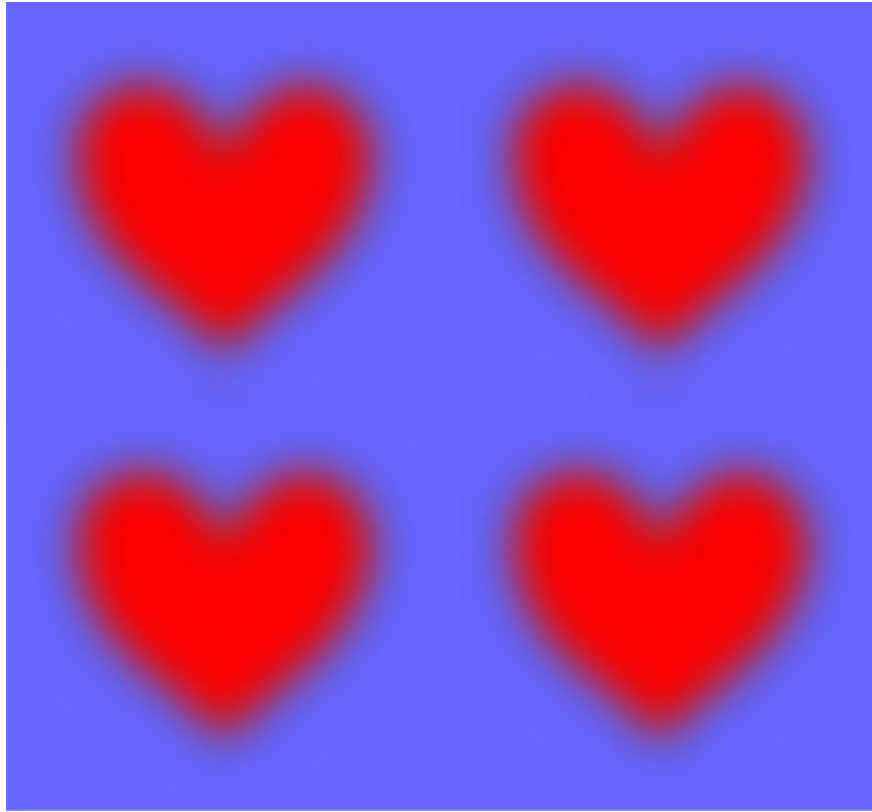

At first glance, there is no abnormality, but the blurred face inside the mask is actually two people kissing! Do you see



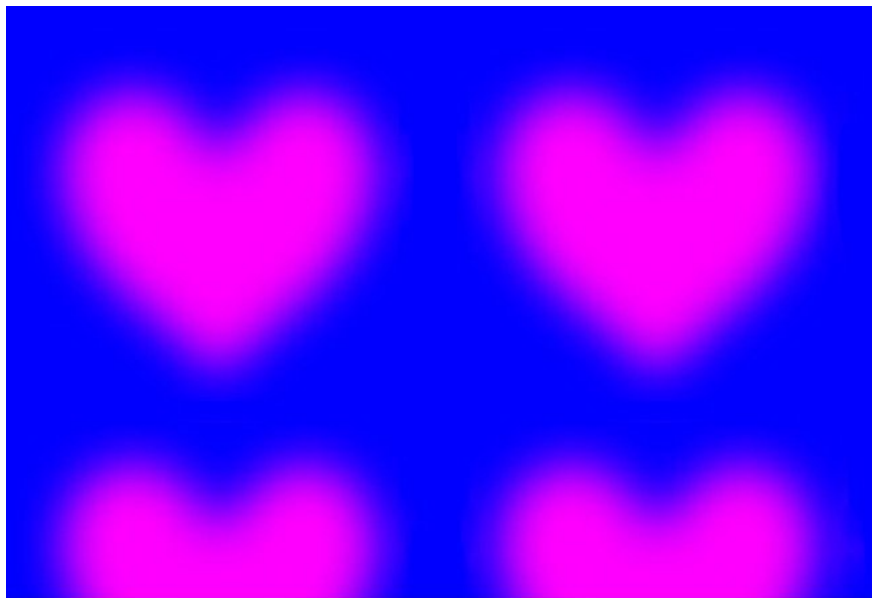
At first glance there's nothing unusual here, but the blurred face in the mask is, in fact, a kissing couple. See?

3. Are those hearts beating?



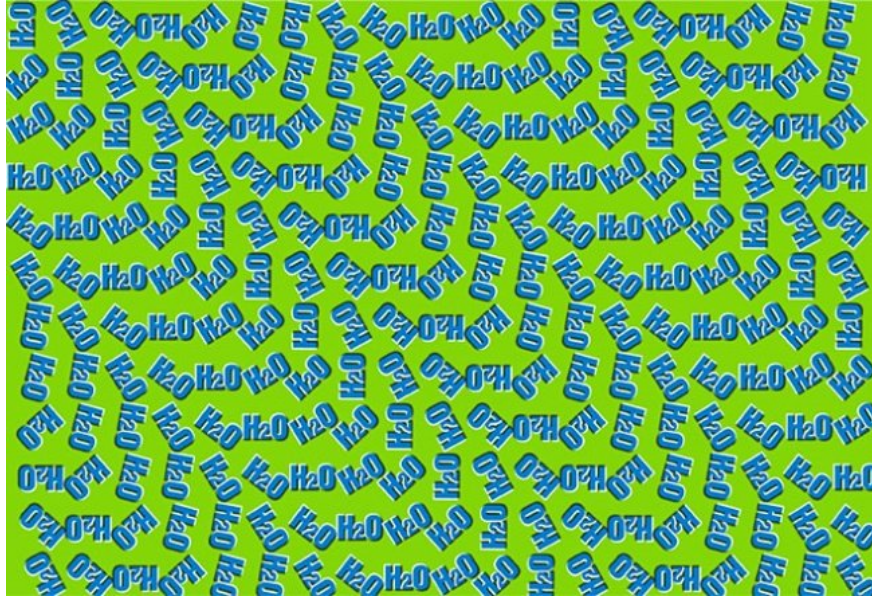

What you can see is vibration due to contrasting colors and eyes trying to focus on an object that doesn't move while they can't stop moving completely.



You can see the pulse because of the color contrast and your eyes trying to fix on an unmoving object while not being able to stop moving completely.

4. Do you see moving waves?



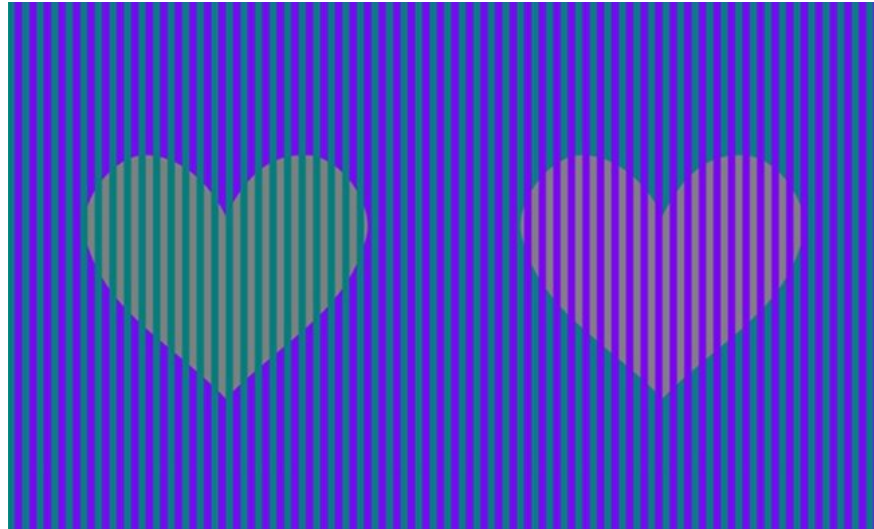

This is simply the art of using light and darkness. These "waves" are completely static: just focus on the center of the image, you will see all the movements stop.



It's all about the play of light and shadow. These "waves" are perfectly static: just focus on the center of the image, and they'll stop.

5. What colors are these hearts?



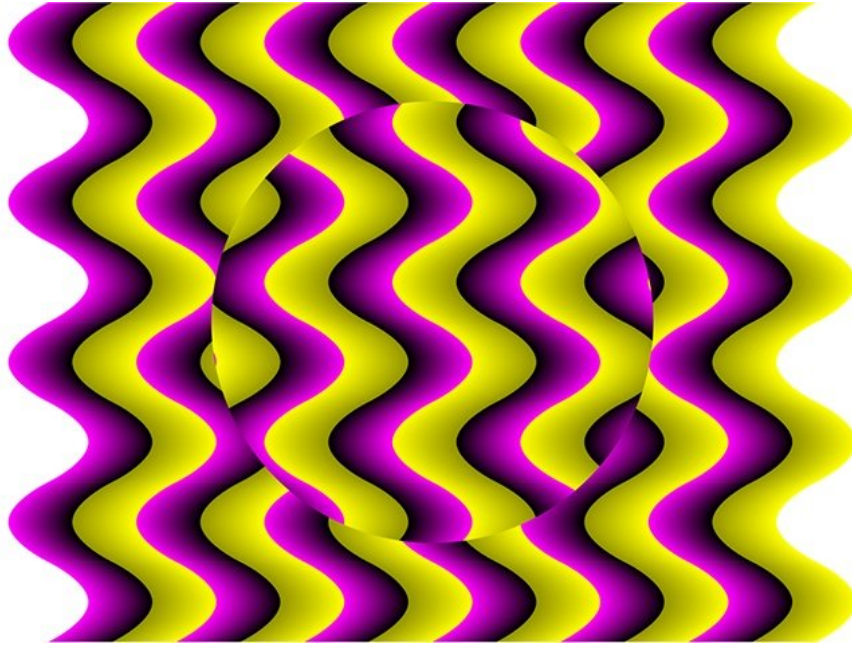

Do you think a pink fruit and a green heart? No, both are gray.



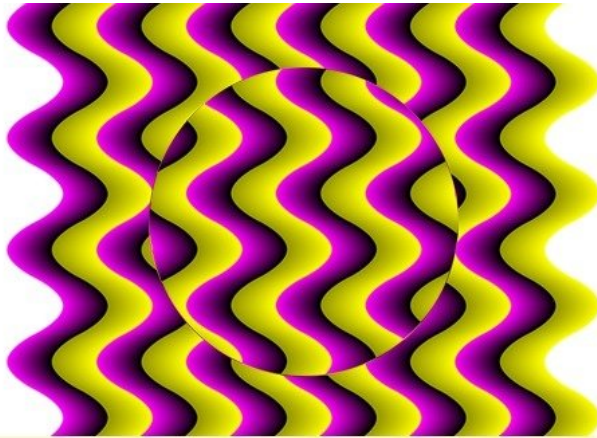
You thought one heart was pink and the other was green? Nope, they're both gray.

6. In what direction does the image move?

The circle moves to the right while the background image moves to the left. However, if you focus on one point, they all stop.



It appears that the circle in the center is moving right, while the background is going left. However, if you focus on one spot, it all halts.

7. Which text is darker?

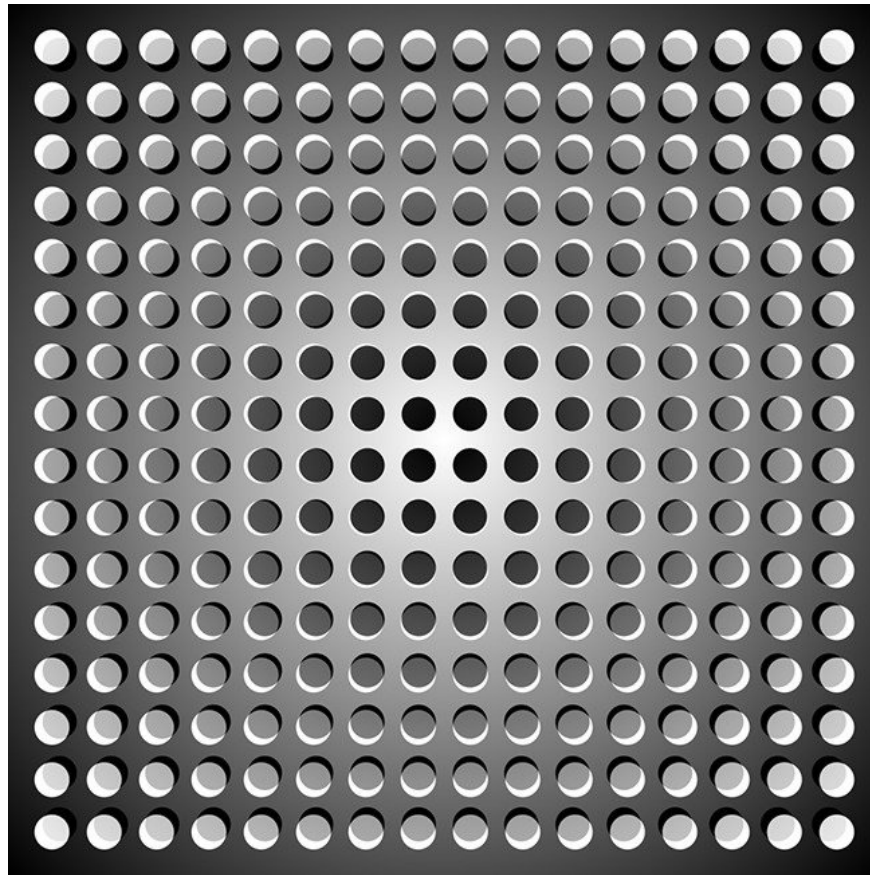
Both words have equal light! It's just that our color perception depends on the surroundings.

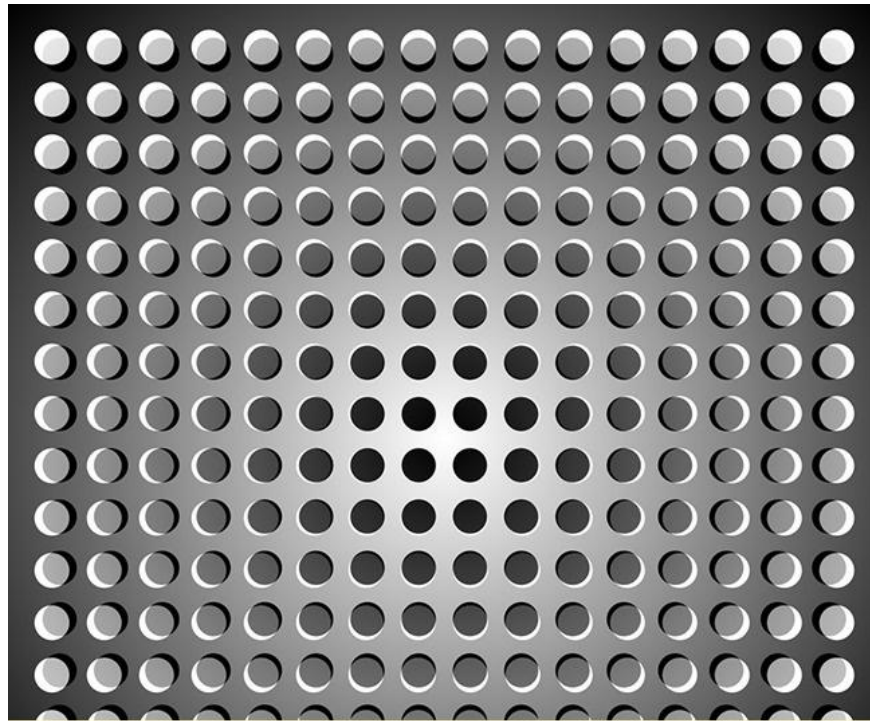
The text is equally saturated in both parts – it's about our perception of color being dependent on the surroundings.

8. Do you see the illusion of bending from inside to outside from inside?



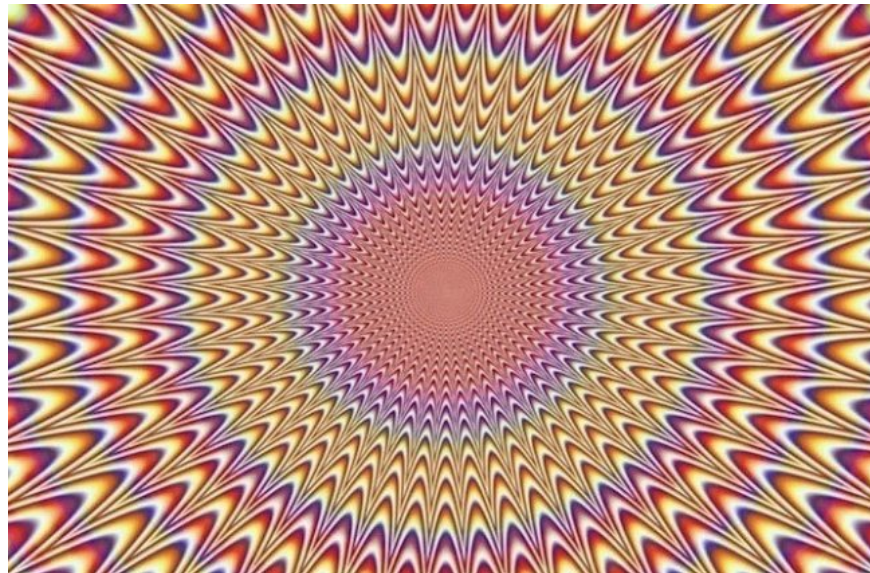

This illusion seems to make you feel the vibration and pull inside and out, in and out at the same time. Edit the look you will see everything stop.



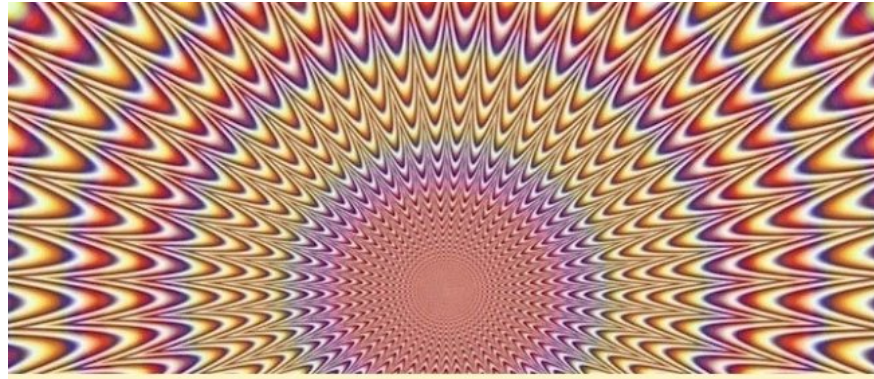
This illusion seems to pulse and draw you in at the same time. Fix your stare, though, and it halts.

9. Does this illusion pull you inside?



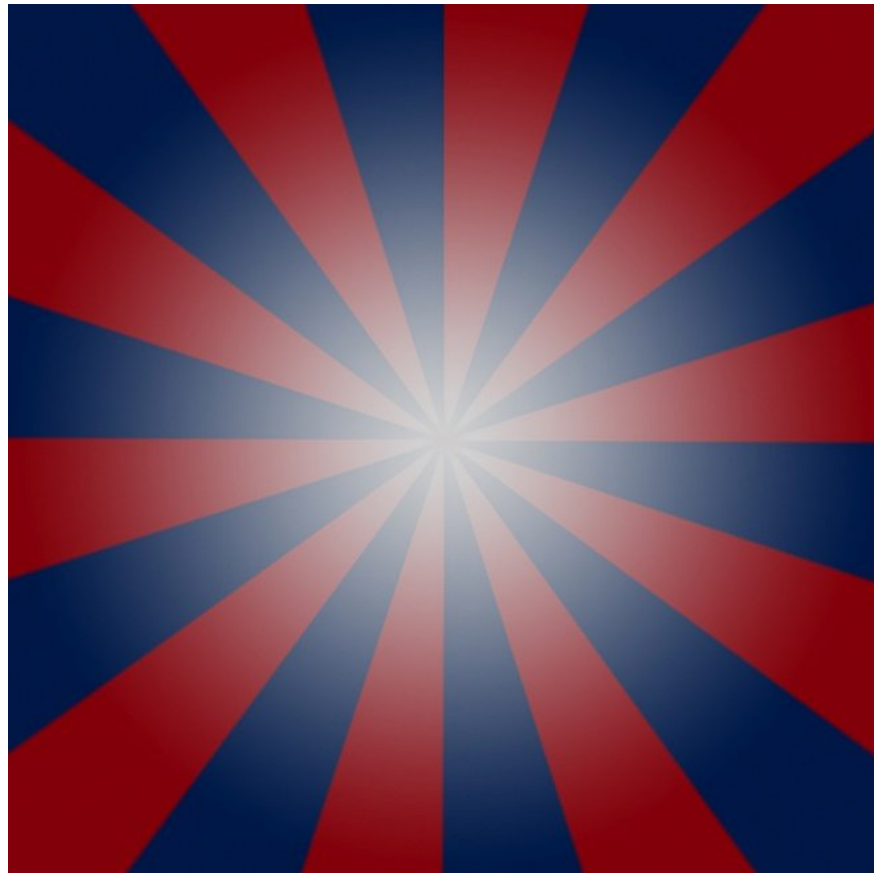

This photo uses different patterns and colors that make your vision disoriented. Correct your vision to stop the movement!



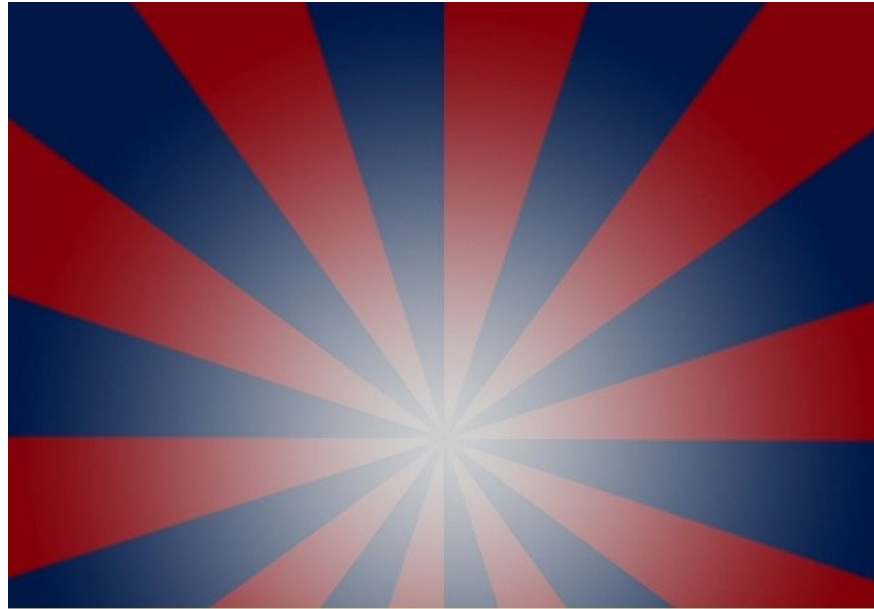
This one also uses different patterns and colors to disorient your vision. Fix your stare completely to halt the movement.

10. Does this photo become brighter or darker?



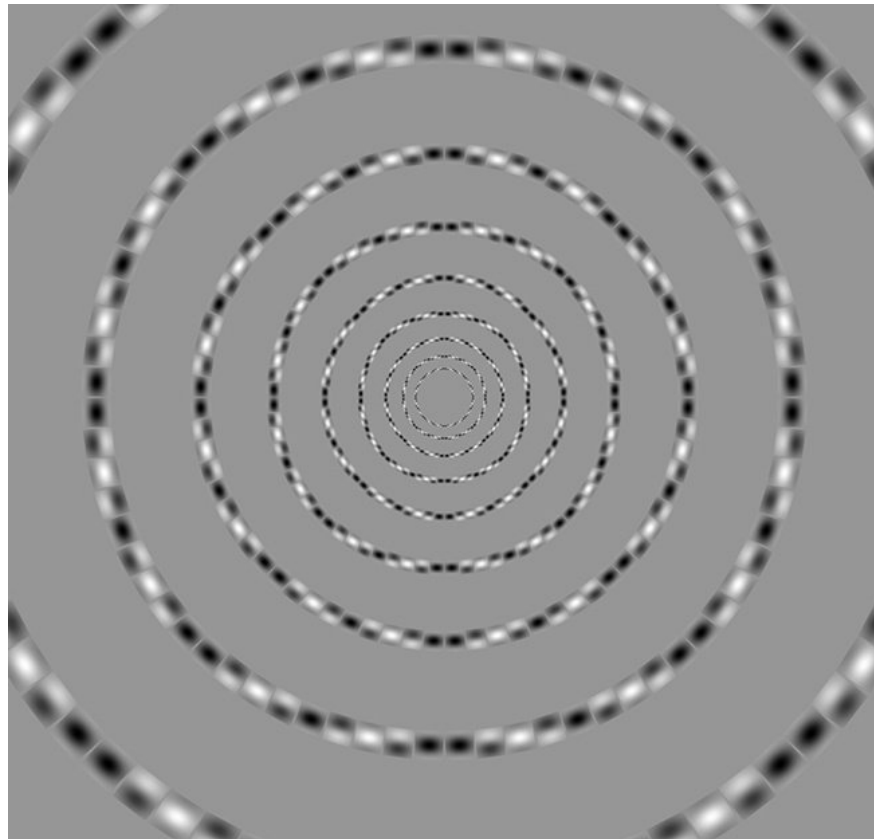

Stand away from the screen and slowly move closer, looking at the center of the image. With each step, the photo will become brighter. However, others saw the opposite, though it was fading with them.



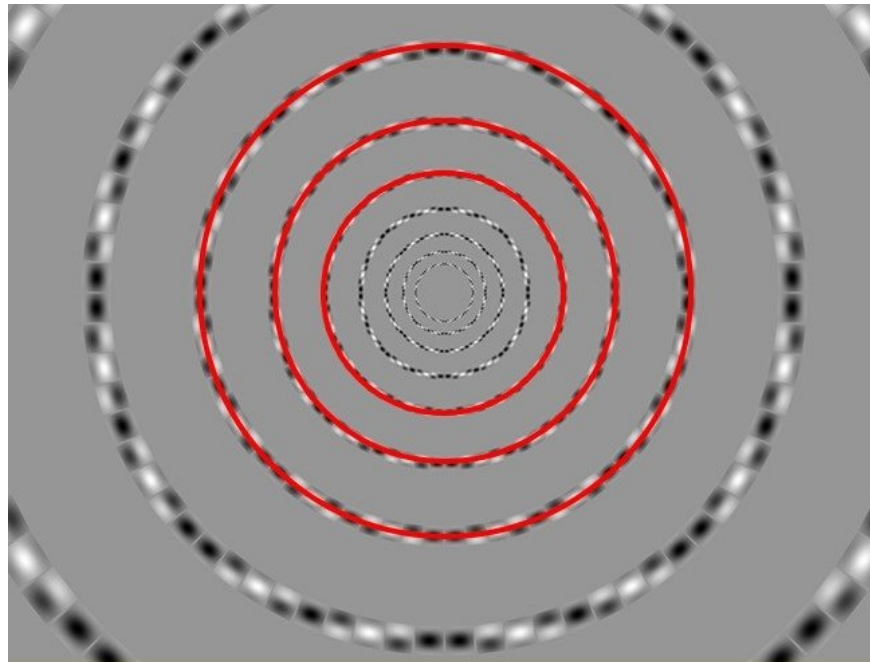
Stand away from the screen, and slowly come closer looking at the center. With each step the image will become brighter. Some say the opposite, though – for them it's fading.

11. Is there something wrong with this illusion?



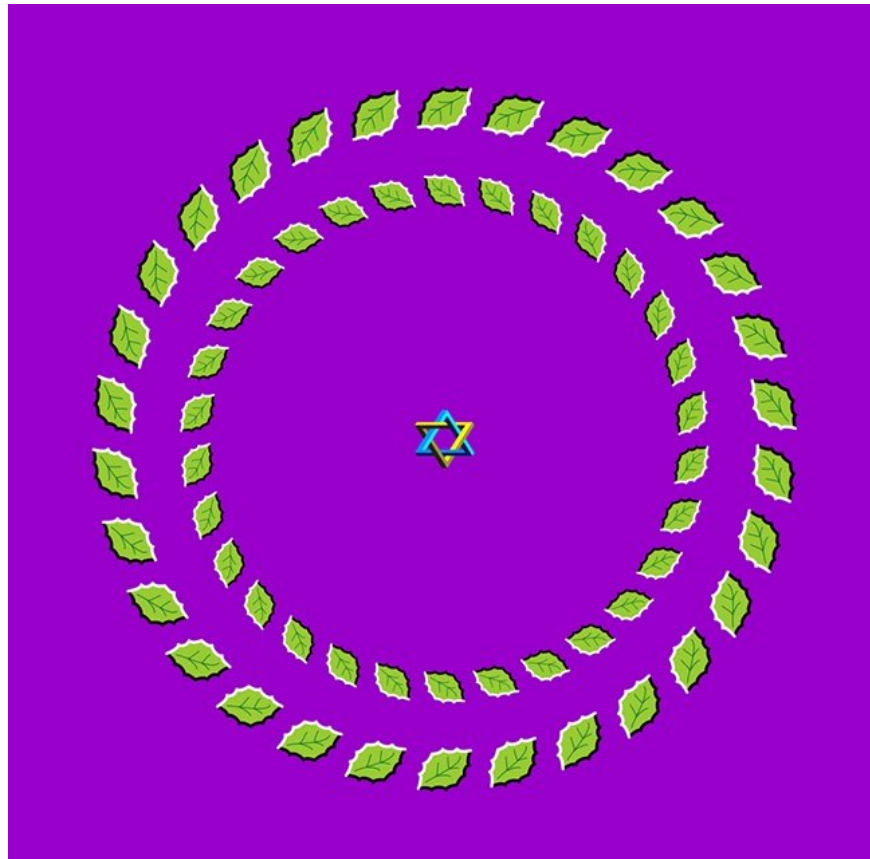

You have to realize that this illusion has dragged you in, creating an image of a tunnel.



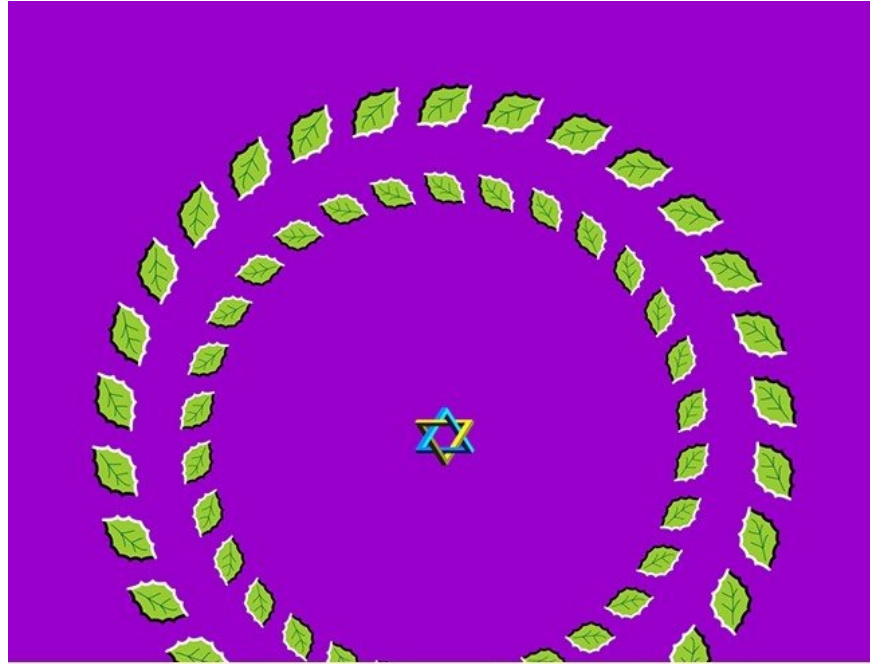
You must have noticed that this illusion draws you in, creating the image of a tunnel.

12. Is this picture moving or not?



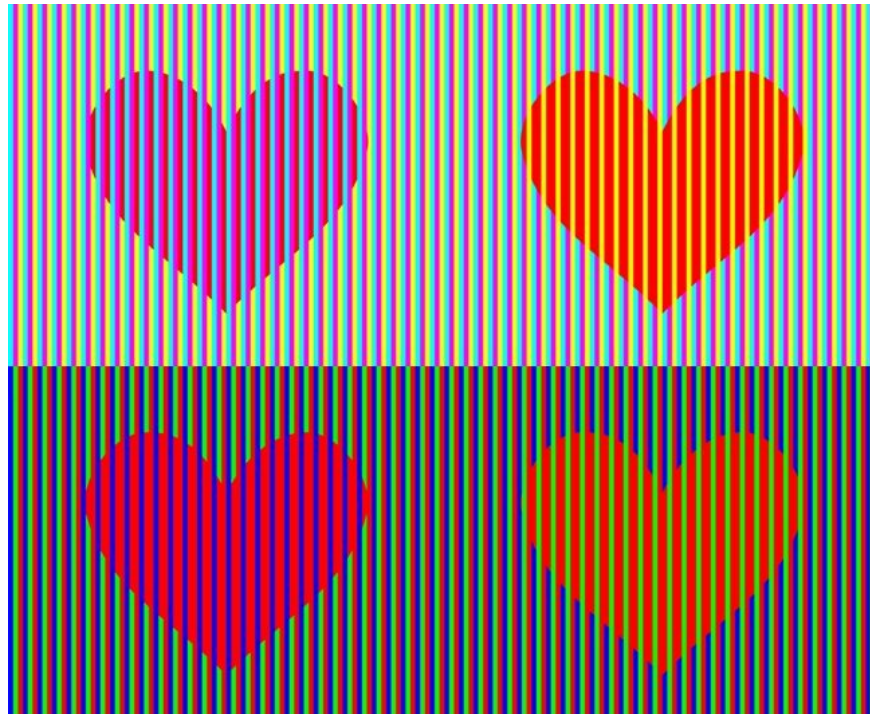

When moving the eyes around the leaves, the outer circle will " *widen* " and the inner circle will " *narrow* " again.



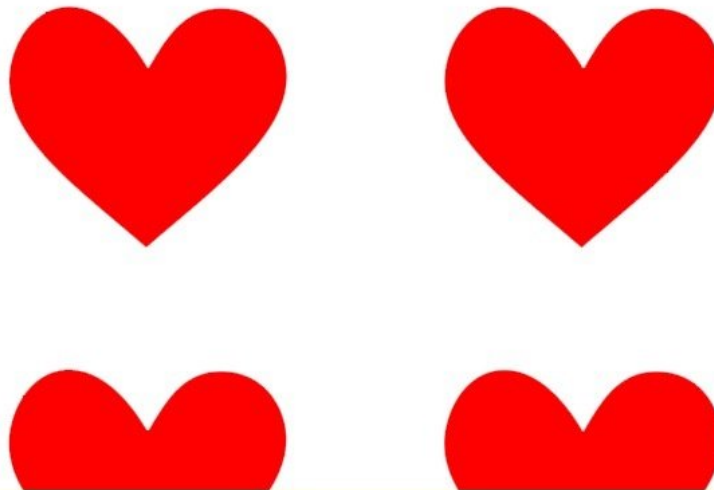
While you move your eyes around the leaves, the outer ring "broadens," and the inner one "gets narrow."

13. Which heart is red?

The correct answer is: Both. The eyes have fooled you again. What did we say about the surrounding environment?



Correct answer: all of them. Your eyes are deceiving you again. What did we say about surroundings?
