Russia's fuel pipeline system has a total length of 259,913 km including condensate, gas, liquefied petroleum gas (LPG), oil, and refined products pipeline systems. Meanwhile, the circumference of the Earth is only 40,075 km.

## 13. Owns the longest river in Europe

The Volga River located in western Russia is the longest river in Europe, with a length of 3,690 km (not including small tributaries).

## 14. The highest mountain in Europe

Elbrus is a mountain peak located in the western Caucasus Mountains with a height of 5,642 meters, the highest mountain peak in Europe.
