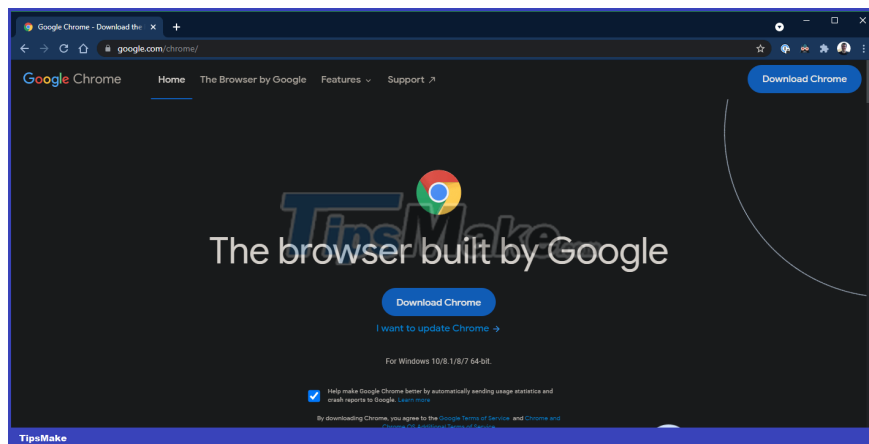


# 14 Windows applications and software needed on new machine

Additionally, Chrome's cross-platform synchronization feature allows you to continue viewing and opening the web pages you're working on across multiple devices.

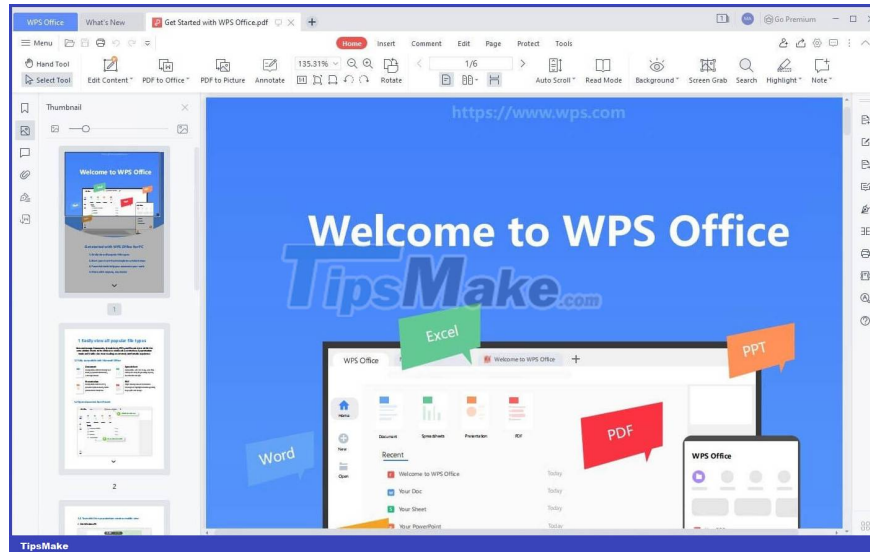

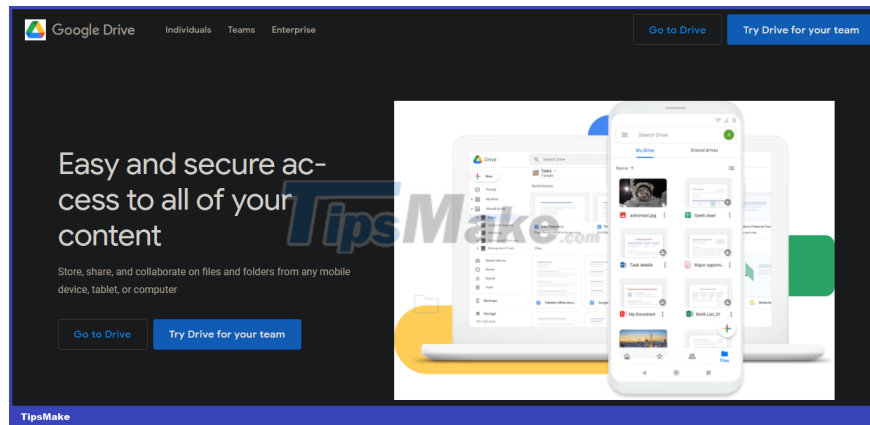

Whether you use it as a backup plan, or simply to share data with others, Google Drive is truly an indispensable application for Windows users.

Additionally, if you are a Microsoft follower, you can also refer to Microsoft OneDrive. This is a built-in utility on Windows. You just need to log in to your Microsoft account and choose a folder to back up and store data, Microsoft will take care of everything else. The only thing is, the storage capacity is not very generous, for regular users you can only have 5GB of free storage.

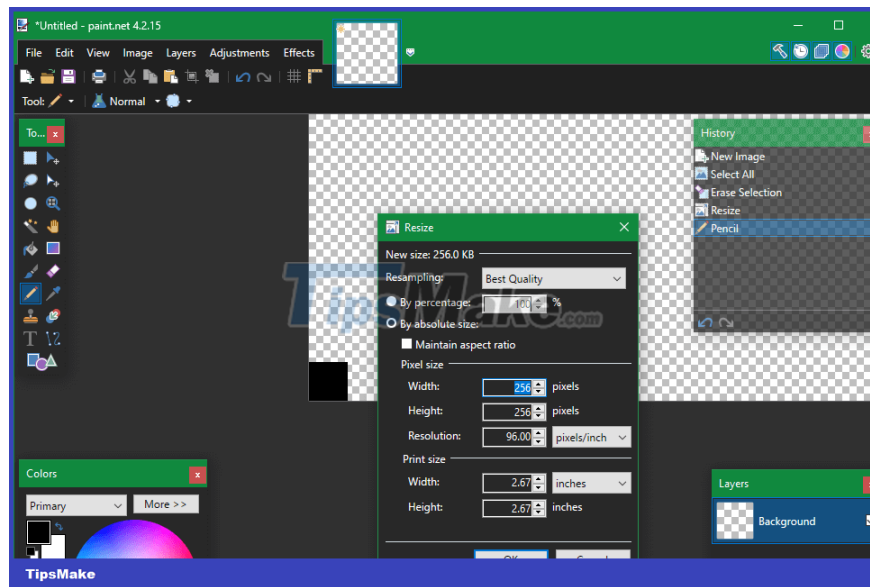

Spotify also has a dedicated Windows app, while Apple Music requires iTunes and Google Play Music is web-only. However, if you're invested in either of the Apple and Google ecosystems, the respective music app may be a better choice.

## Photo editing: Paint.NET



Whether you want to try manipulating images, need a way to blur sensitive information on screenshots, or want to retouch old photos, everyone should install an image editing program. Photoshop is the gold standard for this, but there are plenty of free tools that are more accessible.

Paint.NET is the top choice that this article recommends. It's much more powerful than Microsoft Paint but doesn't overwhelm you with tons of confusing tools. You can easily blur parts of images, automatically adjust photos to make them look better, add text and shapes to photos in just a few clicks. Many plugins allow you to extend the functionality of Paint.NET.

If you find Paint.NET too basic, GIMP is a more advanced solution.

## Text message: Zalo/Rambox



Chances are you're using at least one messaging service to stay in touch with friends on a daily basis. Currently, for Vietnamese users, Zalo is always the best. It supports texting, video calling, group calling, group chatting, cloud storage, task assignment. and many other utilities. Not only that, it also supports multiple platforms, meaning you can stay in touch and exchange work whether on your computer or on your phone while on the go.

That's domestic, what about international friends and partners? You can't install every messaging app just to communicate with one partner and another. In this case, Rambox is the most suitable choice. Rambox lets you add accounts from dozens of popular messaging services, including WhatsApp, Facebook Messenger, Skype, Telegram, Discord, etc. You can even add other web apps, such as Apple Music go there.

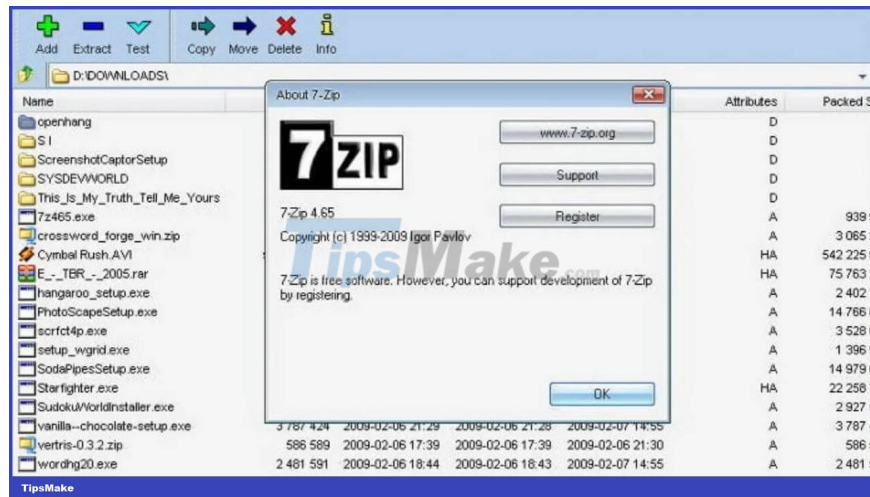
Simply add a new tab for every service you need, Rambox lets you update every group in one window. It includes a number of additional features that make it easier to manage different chat platforms, instead of opening multiple browser tabs or installing multiple applications. Therefore, it will make you more focused, making it easier to close or minimize one window (instead of half a dozen).

Although Rambox's free plan has some limitations, it offers more for free than competitors like Franz.

## **Compress and decompress files: 7-Zip**



Although Windows also provides a basic tool that can read, compress and decompress files, it is not capable enough to meet the needs when there are many different compression formats.

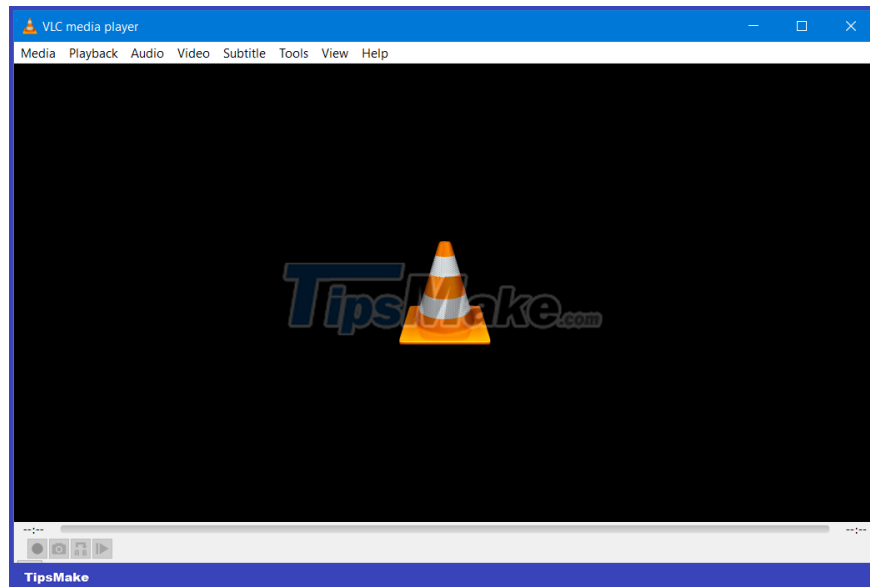
WinRAR may be the best compression software, but 7-Zip is the golden app in the free compression and decompression world. Not free, it's very compact, simple to install and doesn't bother you at all when you're not using it.

The only drawback of 7-Zip is its old and simple appearance. If you don't like its old style, you can consider using PeaZip, a similar tool with a more attractive interface.

## **Clipboard management: ClipClip**

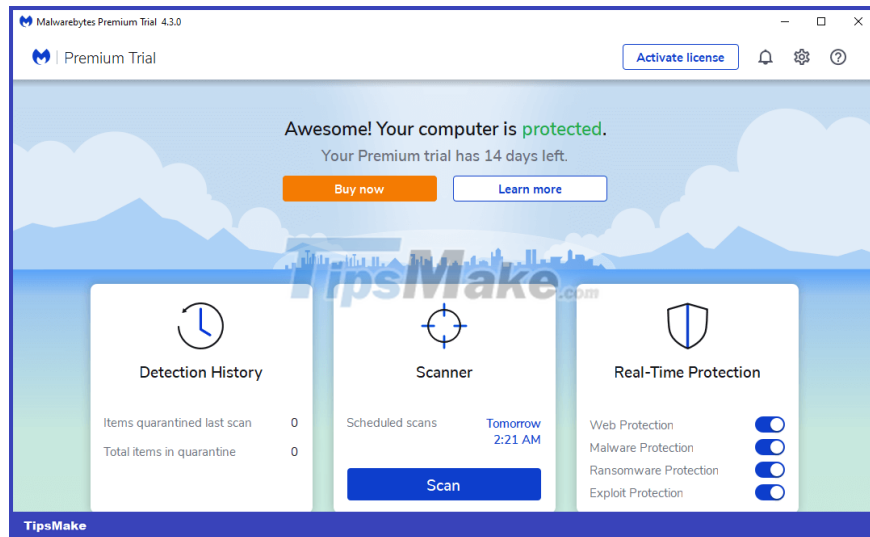
The clipboard manager is a pretty important Windows application, as it saves you a lot of time. Instead of just being able to keep the last copied item on your PC's clipboard, the clipboard manager allows you to manage several dozen copied items at once.

## **Security: Malwarebytes Anti-Malware**



Windows 10 and 11 already have Windows Defender built in - which is a good enough antivirus for most users. However, you should still install a secondary security program to supplement it.

In this regard, no application can beat Malwarebytes. The free version of Malwarebytes allows you to scan your system for malware, which regular antivirus software cannot catch.

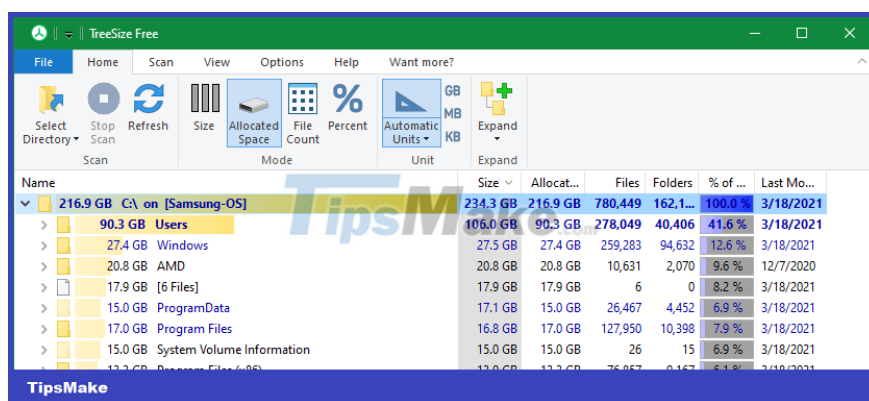
## Backup and recovery: SyncBackFree

## Automation: AutoHotkey

If you want more automation for your computer, then AutoHotkey is what you need. This is a custom scripting engine, allowing you to define your own commands, making it as useful as anything you desire.
