

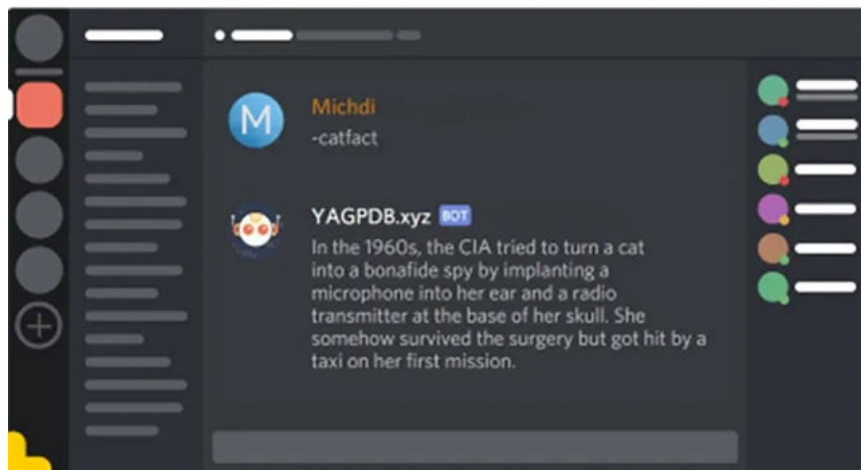
15 best bots to improve Discord server

There's a lot to love about Discord. You can use and manage this tool for free. Besides, Discord has VOIP support and thanks to its support for bots, it is also quite customizable.

Here are 15 of the best Discord bots you should consider using.

1. YAGPDB

If you are looking for a bot that can do a lot of things to a high standard, then YAGPDB (Yet Another General Purpose Discord Bot) is a great choice.



It has a series of self-assigned roles for moderation, allowing you to assign roles via reactions, assign multiple roles at once, or add roles to specific groups in your channel.

YAGPDB has a great auto-moderation setup for rules, allowing you to set them up and automatically remove, warn, and even ban violators.

Besides that, there are various cleaning parameters, quick feeds from Reddit and YouTube.

YAGPDB (Yet Another General Purpose Discord Bot) is an advanced configurable Discord bot that offers a range of useful features to help with server management.

Feed

1. Delivers Reddit feed quickly (within a minute)
2. Delivers YouTube feed quickly (within minutes)
3. Join/leave a message in a specific channel (configurable)

4. Direct message upon joining (configurable)

Self-assigned roles

This feature is very advanced. You can create yourself a role with the command or with the Role menu:

1. Group into multiple groups for multiple menus
2. Assign roles via response on a message (Role menu)
3. Different modes such as one or more roles at the same time
4. Advanced options like request roles or ignore roles for each group or role

Automated operating tools

YAGPDB has a configurable automator, for each rule you can set the automator to mute, ban, or ban after a specific number of violations within a certain time frame.

Custom commands

1. Trigger: Starts with, contains, exact same or follows a specific pattern
2. Dynamic feedback
3. Useful for automatic responses to questions, command aliases, or lots of other fun stuff

General censorship

1. Click out, ban and delete
2. Advanced cleaning parameters
3. Mute and ban timer
4. Modlog with enable, ban, mute and warning actions
5. Notify the person who has been warned, clicked out, muted or banned
6. Message log
7. Warning

2. Carl Bot

One of the most useful shortcut features in Discord is the reaction role, which allows you to enter commands and even emojis into Discord to make various changes to the server - like changing embed colors, prefix to server, etc. Carl Bot has 250 roles for you to test, among many other features.

Carl Bot is full of automation functions, making it one of the best moderation bots out there, and allows you to record name changes between people on your server, so you can make sure that no one can be naughty. There are a lot of other features here (automatic feeds and DMs when mentioning names, etc.).

There's quite a bit to learn with Carl Bot when it comes to custom commands and more advanced server searches, but if you're willing to put in the time, you'll end up with one of the better server/dashboard management bots. most today.

Why choose Carl Bot?

Reaction roles

1. High limit (250 roles)
2. Various modes: unique, verified, reverse, bound, temporary, etc.
3. Multiple roles with a single response
4. Fast speeds, limits spammers to prevent abuse
5. Use any emoji, even ones that bots don't have access to
6. Create neat embeds without having to enter each emoji and role
7. Messages self-destruct
8. Blacklist and whitelist roles to decide who can choose which role

Log everything

1. Message events: Deleted messages, edited messages, deleted messages
2. Discord invite link
3. Update members: Role, change name, change avatar, ban, unban
4. Members join and leave
5. Server updates: Channels, roles and emoticons
6. Ignore channels, members and prefixes (useful for spam bots)
7. Separate logs into separate channels to reduce clutter without losing information

Strong censorship

1. Modlog allows mods to be accountable for their modding actions
2. All the mod commands you could want, timed or not
3. "Drama channel" gives mods an easy overview of what rules are being broken
4. Fixed roles prevent people from leaving to escape being muted
5. Mark new members joining
6. Manage a series of roles
7. Displays past violations from members, along with reasons and responsible moderators

Suggestions allowed

1. Allow users to suggest things and let people vote on it
2. Send a message to the user who made the suggestion when a decision is made
3. Keep a separate log channel with suggestions along with mod feedback
4. Incognito mode to help combat bias
5. Limit recommendations to a specific channel

Detailed licensing system

1. Give each command its own set of rules
2. Manage a series of orders on the website
3. Add general rules
4. Redirect output, mute output, keep spam commands in designated bot channel
5. Use the bot to its full potential without ever bothering anyone

Automod

1. Punish "dirty" links, spam, attachments, and bad words
2. Choose a penalty for each broken rule
3. Delete inappropriate file formats

4. Mark a channel as 'media-only' to delete any messages without links or attachments
5. Whitelist certain roles and channels to ignore broken rules within them
6. Custom rate limits for a wide variety of rules

Powerful custom commands

1. Variables, including things like channel topic, number of members, and author ID
2. Random list, your own seeding options
3. Share your creations both on the site and with other creators in the support server
4. Execute commands, change their behavior, and override default settings

Welcome message

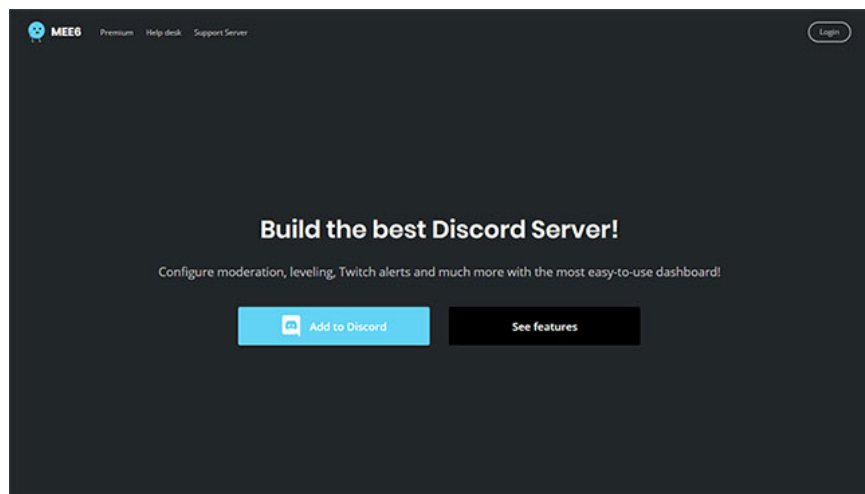
1. Send welcome messages, breakup messages, and ban messages
2. Send a DM message upon joining, separate from the regular welcome message
3. Supports embedding and turning!

User commitment

1. Send messages every x minutes and optionally ping a role
2. Quick announcement
3. Mention roles without them mentioning the feed
4. Save user information such as join date, creation date and nickname history

3. MEE6

There's a reason that MEE6 is one of the best Discord bots out there. It comes with extensive features and support. You can also upgrade to a premium subscription for more features.



A lot of Discord bots are designed to moderate servers, and MEE6 won't disappoint. You can set up automatic mod rules to fix problems like server spam. MEE6 administrators can also configure a system to automate penalties, if users frequently break rules.

Some outstanding features of MEE6 include:

1. **Say hello to new users on your Discord server** : Take advantage of welcome messages to inform newcomers about server rules, topics, or ongoing events. You can design your own welcome card or keep things simple.
2. **Easily create your own custom commands** : MEE6 gives you full control to create commands to suit your needs! Create automated commands to provision and remove roles, send messages in existing channels or in user DMs.
3. **Quickly set up streaming and social alerts** : Notify servers when you or your favorite content creators start streaming, uploading, and posting content. You can easily set up streaming alerts for Twitch, notifications when new content is uploaded on YouTube, as well as alerts for Reddit and Twitter.
4. **Allow users to freely choose roles by responding** : Reaction roles are ready to be placed on your server. Give your community the option to be pinged for new notifications, access other parts of the Discord server, or just to identify themselves, by clicking on the emoticon of your chosen server.
5. **Levels and XP in Discord server** : Use MEE6's system to identify and reward the most active members of your community. Give them a spot on the leaderboard and motivate them to compete for the first place! Automatically give roles when they reach a certain level as a reward to the most active members, giving them access to exclusive channels and special rights.

The bot is customizable, so you can create your own commands for users as well as personalized welcome messages. If you want users to set up their own roles, you can set up commands specifically for this.

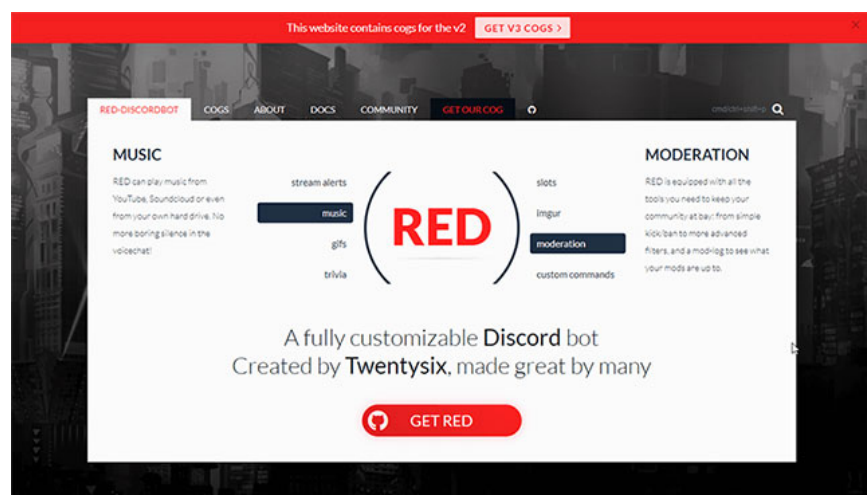
If you are hosting RED on your personal computer, you will soon notice that if you close the window or turn off the computer, RED will go offline.

There is a hierarchy for users. Regular users can upgrade to higher levels based on their server activity. You can set your own rewards, such as access to more space or new roles.

If you already know how to add a Discord bot to your server, you will have no trouble getting MEE6 running. Just invite the bot to your server to get started.

4. RED

If you want a truly customizable bot, consider RED. It is self-hosted, so you will need your own server.



RED operates with different levels of permissions. Each cog defines the level of permissions required for a command.

1. **Bot Owners** : Bot owners can access all commands across every guild. They can also use proprietary commands that can interact with global settings or system files. You are the owner by default.
2. **Server owner** : The server owner can access all commands on his guild, except system-wide commands or commands that can interact with the file system (available to bot owners).
3. **Administrator** : Administrators are identified by roles. You can set multiple admin roles using the commands `[p]set addadminroleand [p]set removeadminrole`. For example, in cog mods, administrators can use commands `[p]modset` to define cog settings.
4. **Moderators** : Moderators are one level above normal users. You can set multiple moderation roles using the `[p]set addmodroleand [p]set remove modrole`. For example, in the cog filter, a mod will be able to use various commands in `[p]filter`(such as adding and removing filtered words), but will not be able to modify cog settings with the command `[p]filterset`.

Tip : If you don't like the default permission settings for some commands or want to restrict a cog or command to a channel or member, you can use permission cogs.

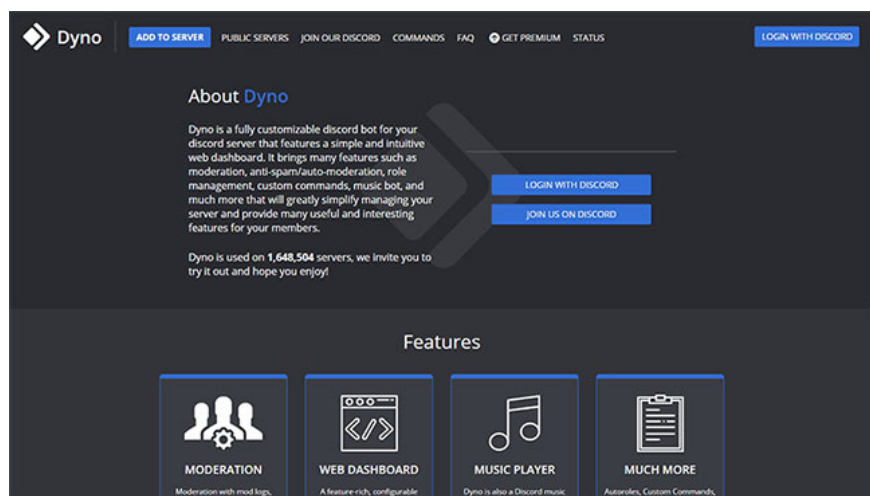
RED's modular approach means that no two servers running RED will be the same, but there are some core features. Like MEE6, moderation is a central feature, with commands to enable or ban, as well as message filtering.

There are also bots that play music, search for GIFs, automate server messages, etc. Like MEE6, you can also customize bot commands. You can even customize your bot's name and avatar to match your host's personal style.

You can extend RED with plugins coded in Python (aka 'cog'). You can search for community-created plugins on the RED website.

5. Dynos

Another attractive Discord bot worth considering is Dyno, used on over 1.6 million Discord servers. One of the biggest benefits of Dyno is its extensive web dashboard, which gives you complete control over customization.



You don't need to host it yourself, as everything is hosted and controlled by Dyno via the web dashboard. Extensible moderation tools, with custom triggers for automated moderation.

Dyno makes role creation very easy, allowing server administrators to create new ranks (linked to server roles). You can also perform server channel tuning phases with 'purge' commands, such as bulk deletion of messages based on user, server or age.

It's not just about moderation, you can set up a DJ bot with its own playlist, search for random events and even find random photos.

Dyno is a fully customizable bot for your server with web dashboard, moderation, autoroles, automod, reaction roles, starboard, etc...

The default prefix is **???** . Type **?help** for a list of commands. The prefix can be changed for your server using the prefix command and in the web dashboard.

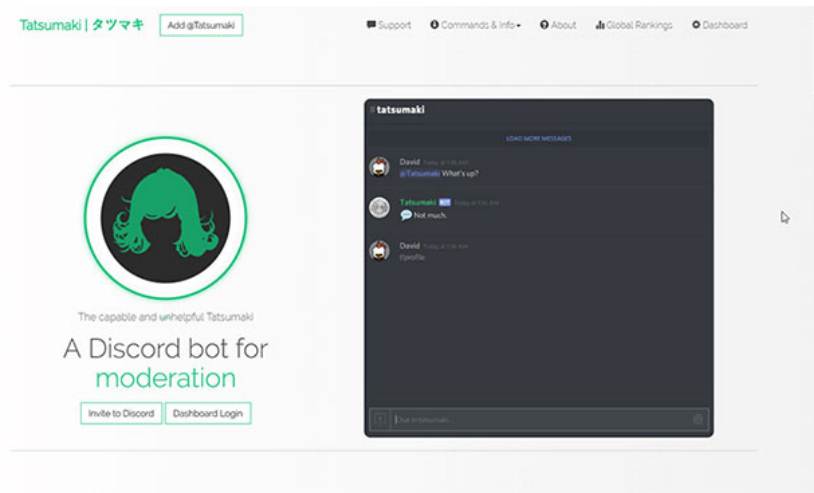
A fully customizable server moderation Discord bot for Discord servers with a simple and intuitive web dashboard. Server management is much easier.

1. **Dashboard** : Feature-rich, configurable website dashboard. You can easily enable, disable, and configure everything.
2. **Auto Delete : Customize which notifications are allowed in a channel with the Auto Delete module** , customizable with multiple filters to choose from!
3. **Automod/Anti-spam** : Dyno's Automod is perfect for keeping servers spam-free while you're away, so you can spend less time manually deleting and moderating. Also, check out the Autoban module to create rules for new members joining the server.
4. **Autoroles** : Assign roles to members joining now or later with Dyno Autoroles.
5. **Moderation** : Implement moderation with edit logs, warnings, mutes and bans, automatic sanctions, protected roles, etc.
6. **Custom Commands** : Create your own flexible commands that can perform special actions!
7. **Giveaways** : Create easily shareable, customizable giveaways, promote your Discord server by sharing them on social media, your other Discord servers, and everywhere!
8. **Forms** : Create forms with the form builder, allowing you to create quizzes with tons of options and a variety of Discord integrations!
9. **Twitch** : Let your members know when you or another member goes live on Twitch!
10. **Reaction Roles** : Allows users to assign roles themselves using the extended Reaction Role module.
11. **Welcome** : Welcome new members with a highly customizable message in DM or in the server!
12. **Much More!** : AFK status, auto-delete, notifications, ratings, reminders, etc.

Dyno is now used on 5,000,000+ servers! Dyno is updated regularly with new features and improvements.

6. Tatsumaki

'Interesting' is the most suitable word to say about the Tatsumaki bot. This bot is colorful, with many interesting features for server users to take advantage of and enhance their activities.



This is a bot that covers all the bases, with features designed to improve moderation and increase server usage, as well as giving users a variety of fun commands to experiment with.

Tatsumaki's moderation features require no configuration. They are ready to use, with commands for user control, message truncation, welcome message configuration, etc.

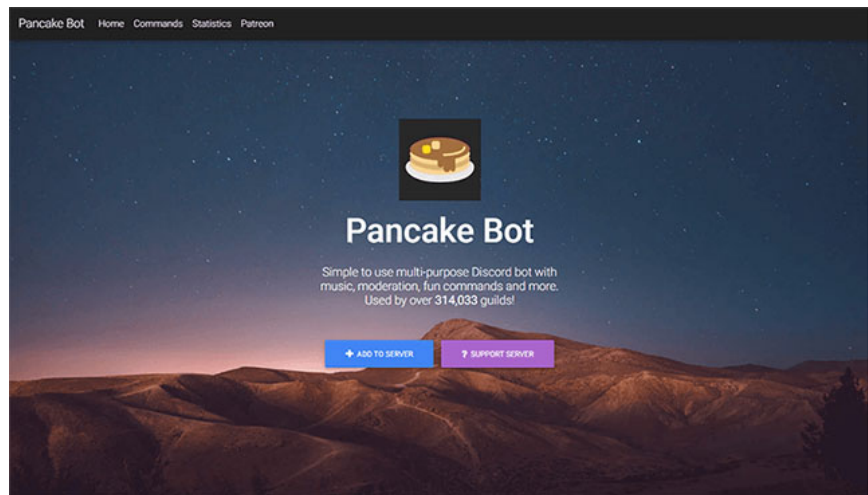
You can also use YouTube to search for information and play some games, as well as conduct server-wide polls. There is a broad hierarchy with XP available to users based on their activity.

The Tatsumaki bot is for the following types of Discord commands:

1. **XP, Levels, and Prestige** : You'll be able to encourage activity on your Discord server by allowing members to earn XP and conquer levels with a fun, intuitive leveling system. The reputation ranking system allows members to vote for another member of their choice. Reputation ratings are displayed prominently on the profile!
2. **Credits and customizations** : Currency in the form of credits allows members to purchase customizations for commands such as t!profile and t!rank. Members can customize their profile and rating screens by adding information and changing the background!
3. **Easily configure the bot on your server** : Modify the way Tatsu works to suit your server. Configure welcome messages, notifications, channels the bot will ignore, and other configurable options.
4. **Voting** : Start voting to decide issues, create polls for longer-term voting, and start sweepstakes.
5. **Integrations** : Check the weather outside, or Google, Urban Dictionary & AniList, all from within Discord.
6. **Organize** : Create to-do lists and set personal reminders to keep your digital life on track.
7. **Lots of fun** : Encourage friendly banter with fun commands. Display random images from subreddits with t!image. Text modifiers, randomizers, 8-balls, dice, actual commands, etc. are all available.
8. **Mini-games** : Go "hunting" and get fun rewards or take care of your own virtual pet!
9. **Server management** : Tatsu's moderation tools work efficiently, automatically connecting to Discord permissions. Maintain order by cleaning up the chat or reward/punish users by modifying their server scores.
10. **User management** : Log off the server and ban unwanted users, giving them an optional reason for doing so. Keep track of what's happening on your server by setting up an action log.

7. Pancakes

More than 300,000 servers use Pancake on Discord. The reason for this is because using Pancake is very simple, with a pretty good balance between interesting commands for users and extensive moderation rights for administrators. Pancake is different from an 'invite to start' bot, so you don't need to worry about server hosting issues.

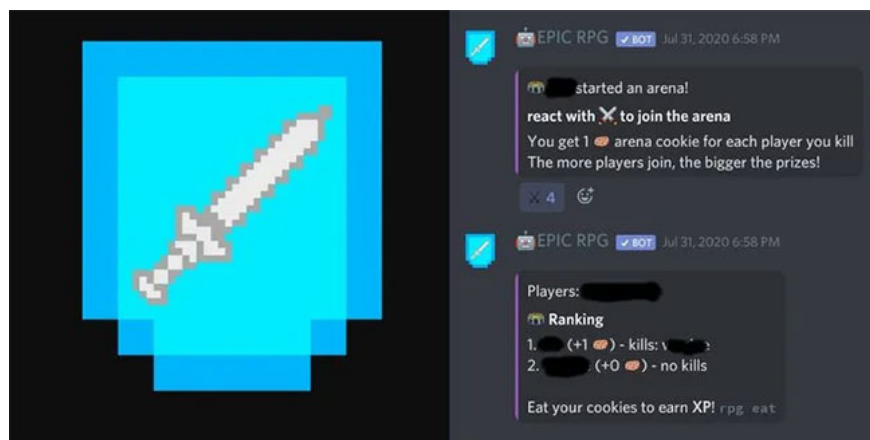


A customizable moderation system lets you control everything from voice chat to banning users, with a permissions system to set up moderation groups with various permissions.

There's an easy-to-use music streaming system with support from multiple sources, including SoundCloud and YouTube. Features, like image search, also help make the server a bit more vibrant.

With hundreds of commands available, everyone is sure to find a suitable option on the Pancake Discord server.

8. EPIC RPG



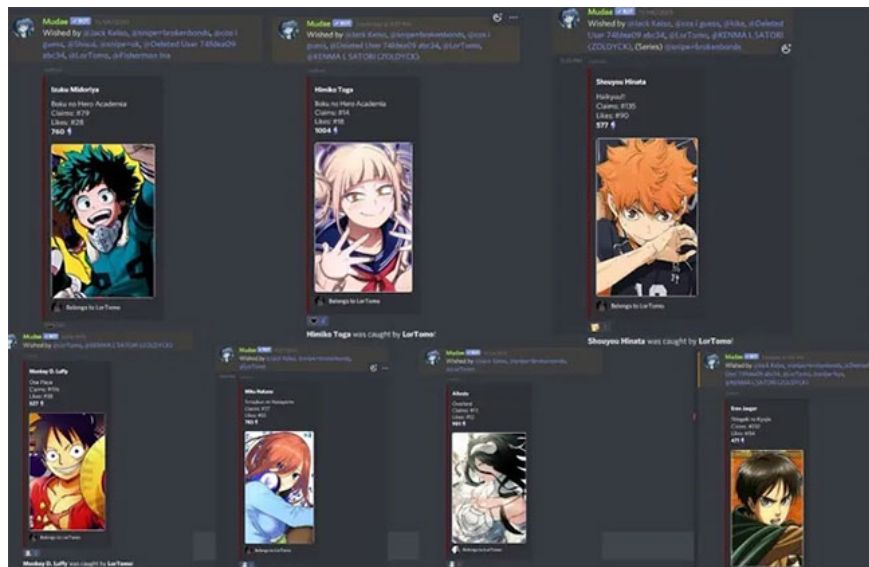
EPIC RPG is all about the fun factor, allowing channel members to participate in an evolving RPG!

Of course, Discord channels are community-based anyway, but adding a text-based game to them is a great way to encourage bonding, as users share levels, loot, stuff their rank in the rankings, etc. EPIC RPG itself is quite an exciting game, with many RNG events and battles that keep things interesting and unpredictable, always creating new stories to players share.

This is an in-depth little game and a great addition to gaming-related Discord channels.

9. Mudae

Not everyone loves anime, but if you are one of these people, you might really love Mudae. Mudae is for anime and manga enthusiasts. It's an interesting concept, where you collect famous anime and manga characters from comics, movies and TV shows, then 'marry' them.

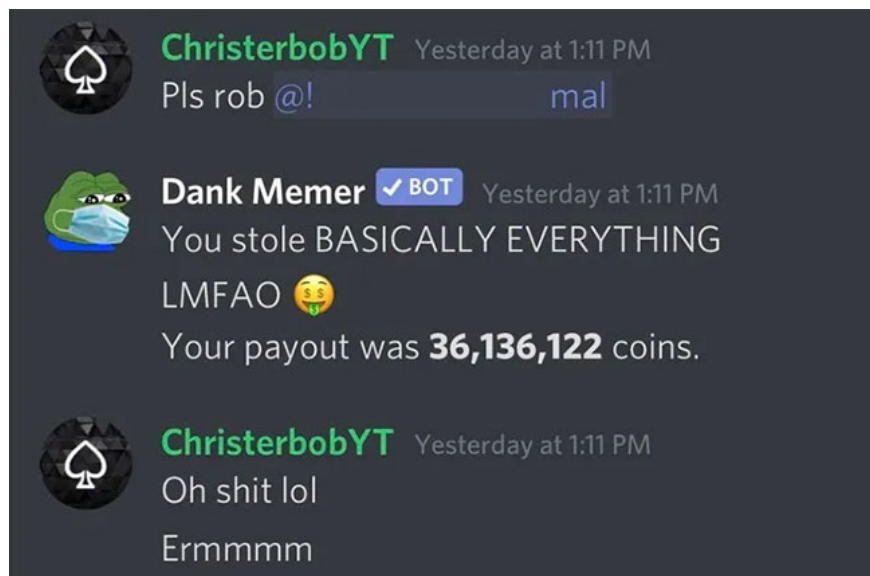


You build a harem of wafu and husbando anime characters, competing against millions of other players doing the same thing. You can trade characters, build your relationship with them and even catch Pokemon in a mini side game.

Completely strange to outsiders, completely attractive to fans.

10. Dank Memer

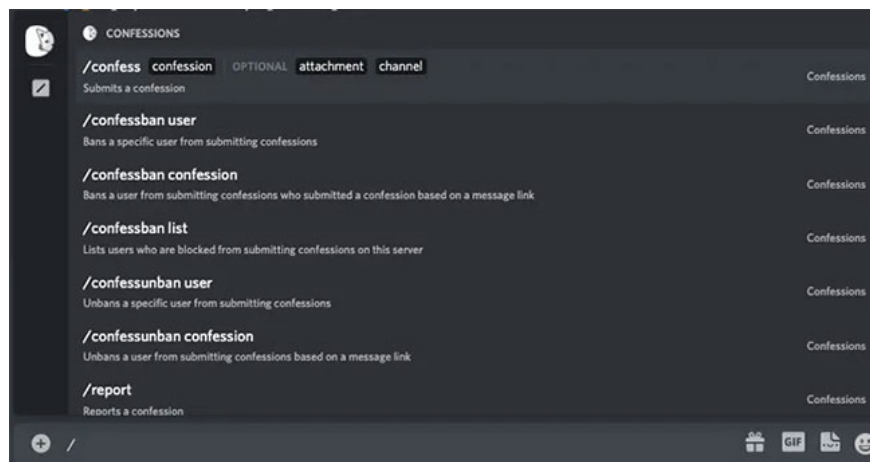
You can't fully immerse yourself in the world of Discord communities without participating in the world of memes. Dank Memer compiles the most popular memes from Reddit every day, so you can use your server with whatever's hot on the Internet, instead of making old, outdated jokes.



Not only memes, Dank Memer also has its own trading system. Plus there are pets and a variety of unique items. This is a cool Discord bot that will help increase engagement with your server.

11. Confessions

Confessions is a Discord bot that allows members of your server to anonymously post confessions about anything they like!



Confessions are also a fun way to play a detective game: Users can confess and other members of the server try to figure out who it is. Please note that if the channel's mods have the 'Premium' version of Confessions they will have a log of people submitting confessions, so don't give away too much information.

Discord is a great platform with a low (or even free) entry cost, suitable for both small and large communities. Bots like these help improve your server, adding features like music, games, and additional moderation to improve the experience even more.

12. Pollmaster

Pollmaster helps run all types of polls - multiple choice, emoji voting, anonymous voting - on the Discord server.



Everyone loves a poll. Whether you need to solicit opinions on joining a group or simply ask people about their favorite pizza, this is a great way to see what theme a given Discord server is taking.

It takes a bit to set up Pollmaster, but after taking the time to go through this step, it's the most comprehensive polling bot available for Discord. There are all kinds of functions, like anonymous voting, emoji voting, multi-choice or multi-select polls.

You can set deadlines for your polls and even assign different "weights" to people's answers depending on their role on the server. For example, people with higher rankings will receive more votes.

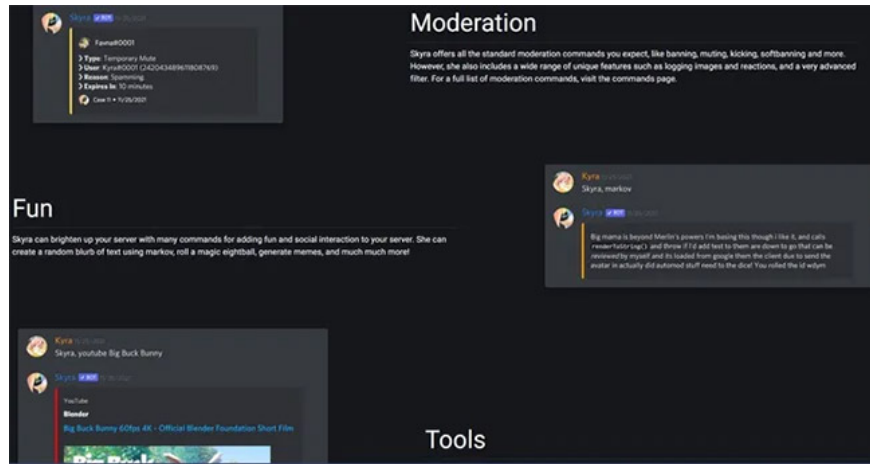
With Pollmaster, you can easily create and manage complex polls on your server. Here's a quick rundown of Pollmaster's features:

1. Polling works by reaction (user doesn't need to enter anything)
2. Anonymous voting is possible
3. You can hide the current vote count
4. Polls can be single choice, multiple choice, or limited to a specific number of choices
5. You can prepare polls in advance and schedule dates and times, or trigger them manually
6. Polls can be time-limited or can stay open until the creator manually closes it
7. You can restrict which role holders are allowed to participate
8. You can assign weights to roles to increase or decrease their votes
9. The polls still exist and will be available until you delete them
10. Personalized information for each poll by responding with ?
11. Everything can be done in private chat with bots to reduce spam on the server
12. Full multi-server support!
13. For advanced users: Command line support to create a full poll in one line

13. Skyra

Skyra is a great all-in-one powerful multi-purpose bot for servers. Skyra asks a very interesting question in the description: "Why have 10 bots doing one thing, when you can have 1 bot doing up to 10 things?"



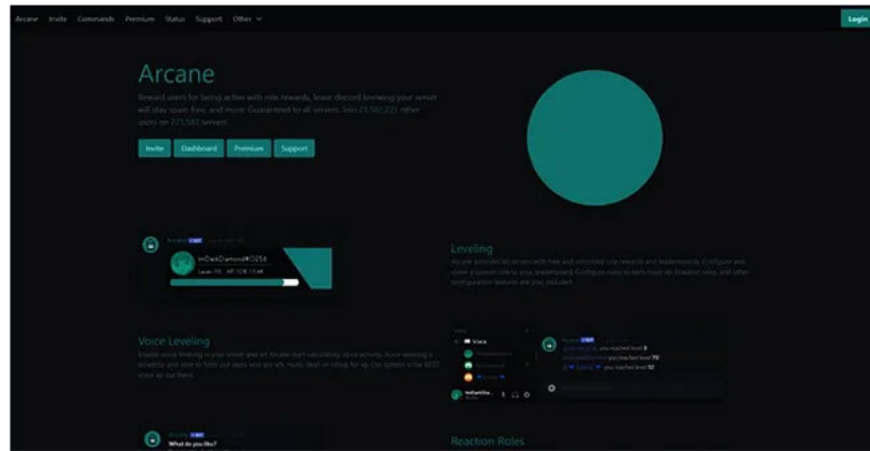
This bot has a ton of features including levels, music, memes, economy, a bunch of moderation actions and even a few simple games like Connect-4, Tic-Tac-Toe and errr, Hunger Games. You also earn points by participating in social content, which you can then use for profile banners or betting activities on the server!

Key features you will get with Skyra include:

1. Skyra offers all the standard moderation commands you'd expect, like ban, mute, kick out, etc. along with a bunch of unique features like recording images and reactions, as well as a filter. very advanced.
2. Skyra can make your server shine with many commands to add fun and social interaction on the server. Skyra can generate random text using markov, roll a magic ball, create memes, etc.!
3. Skyra puts many useful tools at your fingertips, from searching YouTube or Wikipedia, to searching for games on IGDB or Nintendo eShop, or even movies on TheMovieDatabase. Skyra can also create polls, quote messages, get full-size versions of user avatars, and more!

14. Arcane

Arcane is an upgraded bot with a better free version than the more famous MEE6. When it comes to bots that have various systems to 'level up' and reward members of a given server, MEE6 is probably the most famous, but if it comes to normal versions Arcane is probably Better choice.



Arcane Discord Bot is highly configurable, allowing moderators to manage levels, xp options, rewards, and everything else from one convenient dashboard. This bot also has reaction roles and many powerful regulation options.

Arcane includes a simple dashboard to manage rewards, upgrade notifications, and xp options. Everything needed for the experience is provided. Arcane offers full configuration capabilities and many other settings. If you like Arcane's features, consider supporting the bot and gaining access to even more modding by visiting Patreon.

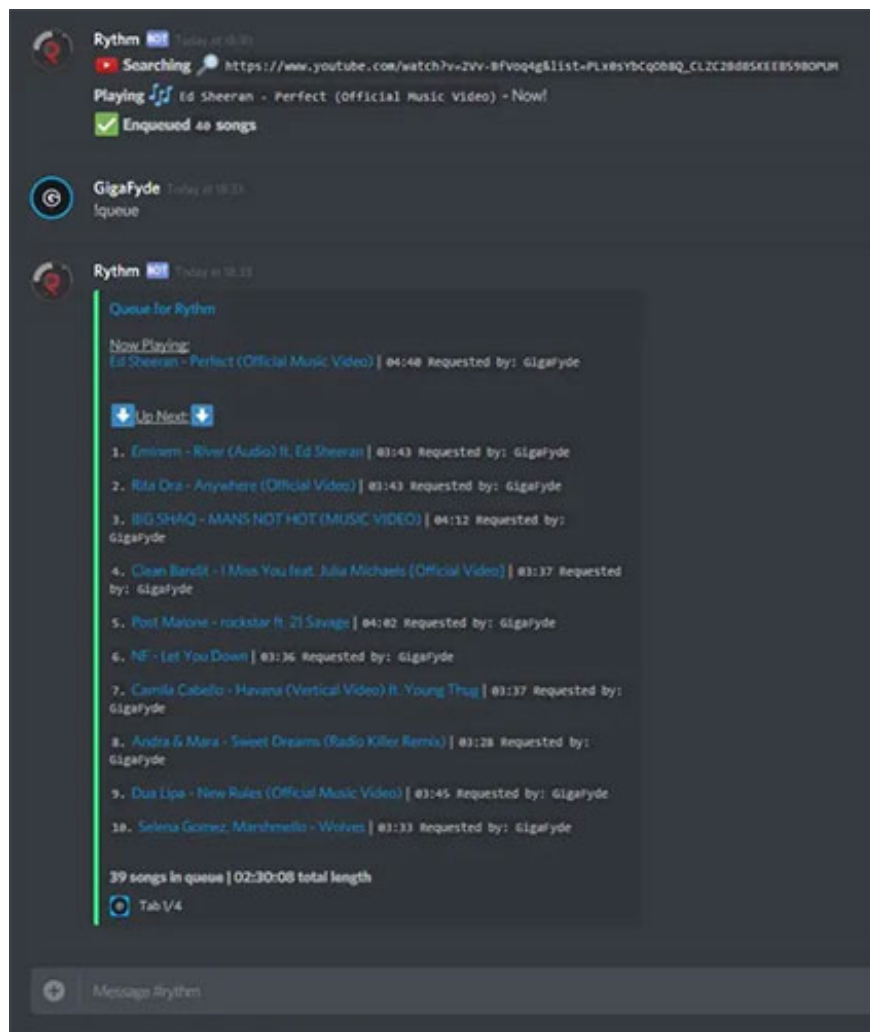
Arcane provides a complete moderation suite, perfect for your server. Arcane's powerful auto-moderation feature will keep your server clean of spam, ads, etc. Use moderation logging to keep moderators more accountable.

15. Rythm

It appears that the best music-focused Discord bot out there recently shut down after 5 years. This is in compliance with YouTube's shutdown order, perhaps related to the fact that the bot has linked to YouTube and allowed its nearly 600 million users to play music from YouTube videos in Discord.
