The works of famous Australian painter Vincent Fantauzzo are known worldwide. Heath Ledger's portrait photo was taken only a few weeks before the actor's death.

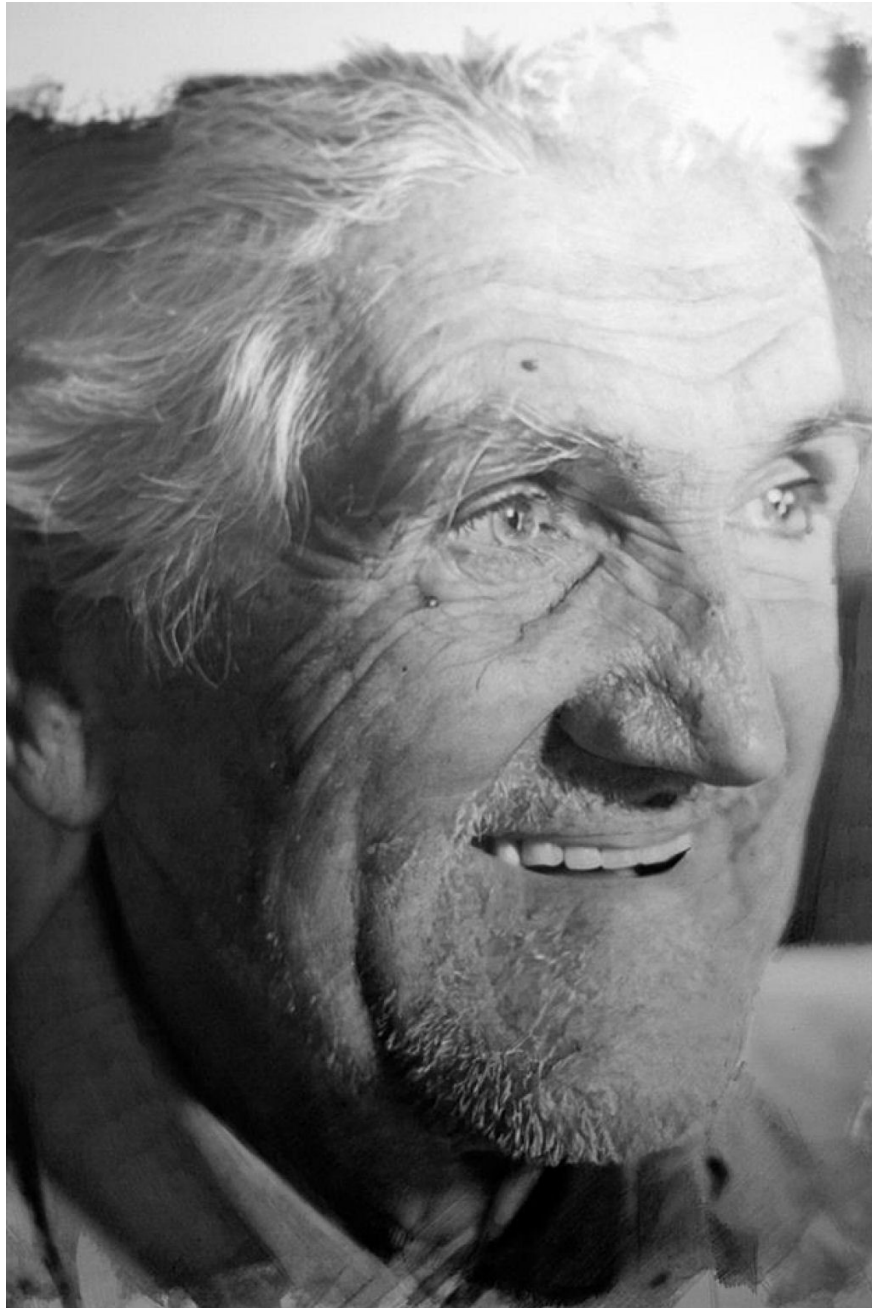
## **Kamalky Laureano**

There is no human image appearing in Cornell's artistic paintings, because he considers the rule of a world in nature as one of the ideal things.

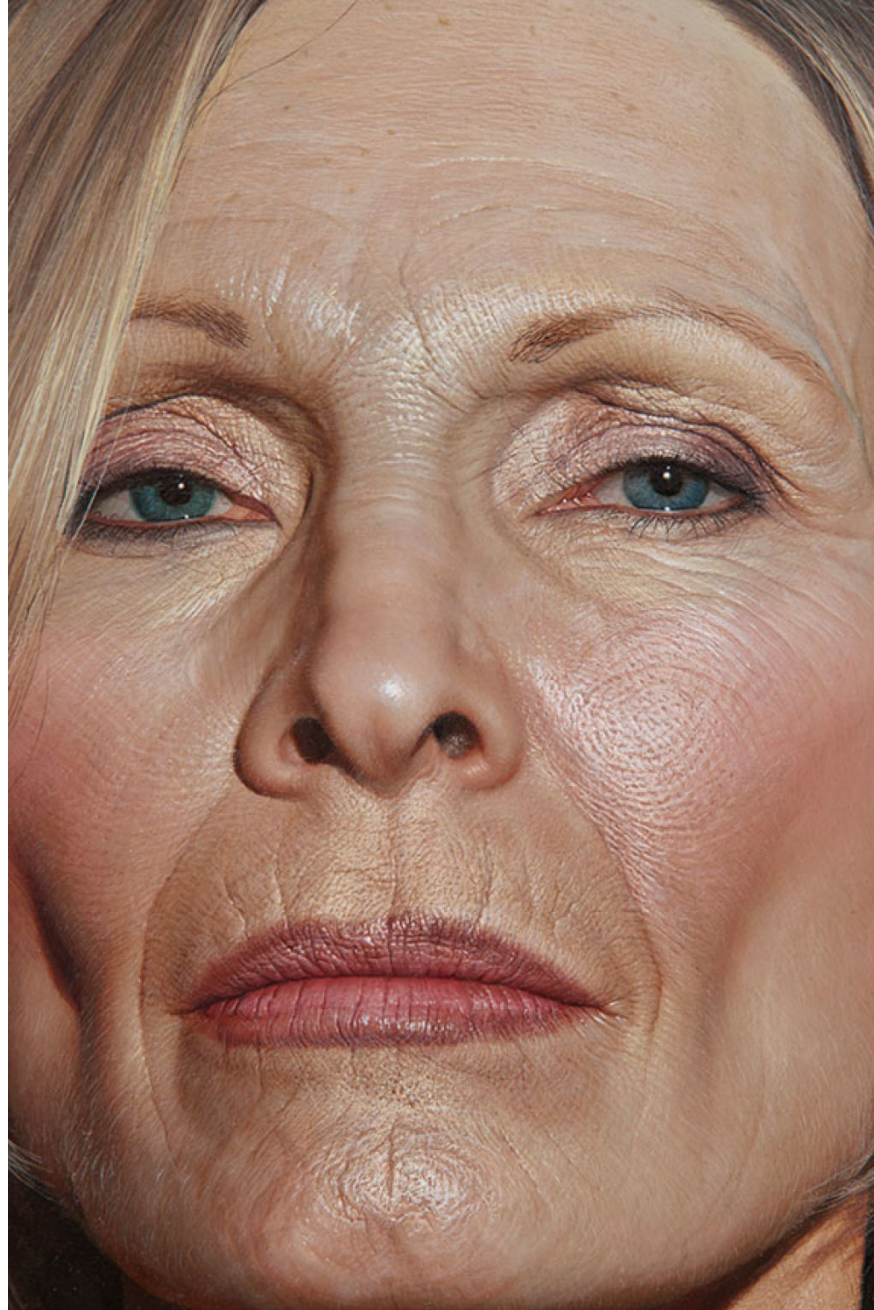
## Thomas Arvid
