Socotra Island, one of the four great islands of the Indian Ocean in the Republic of Yemen, is considered the home of the strange Dragon blood sucker. In fact, the flora in Socotra is extremely rich, especially more than a third of the plants living here do not appear anywhere else on the planet.



Dubbed the hottest and harshest place on the planet with vast, vast fields and sulfur reservoirs, Danakil Depression in Ethiopia has a strange beauty.



The Tianzi Mountains in China were formed underwater 380 million years ago with thousands of towering mountains lined up side by side. This majestic natural landscape is the inspiration for the world-famous movie "Avatar".



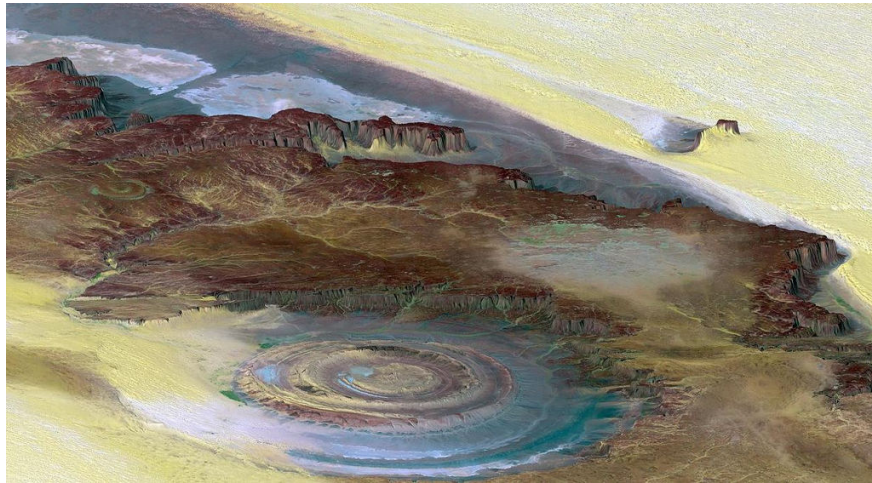
Wonders of "Giant's Causeway" in Ireland include 40,000 beautiful supersymmetric stone columns created by volcanic eruptions of 60 million years ago.



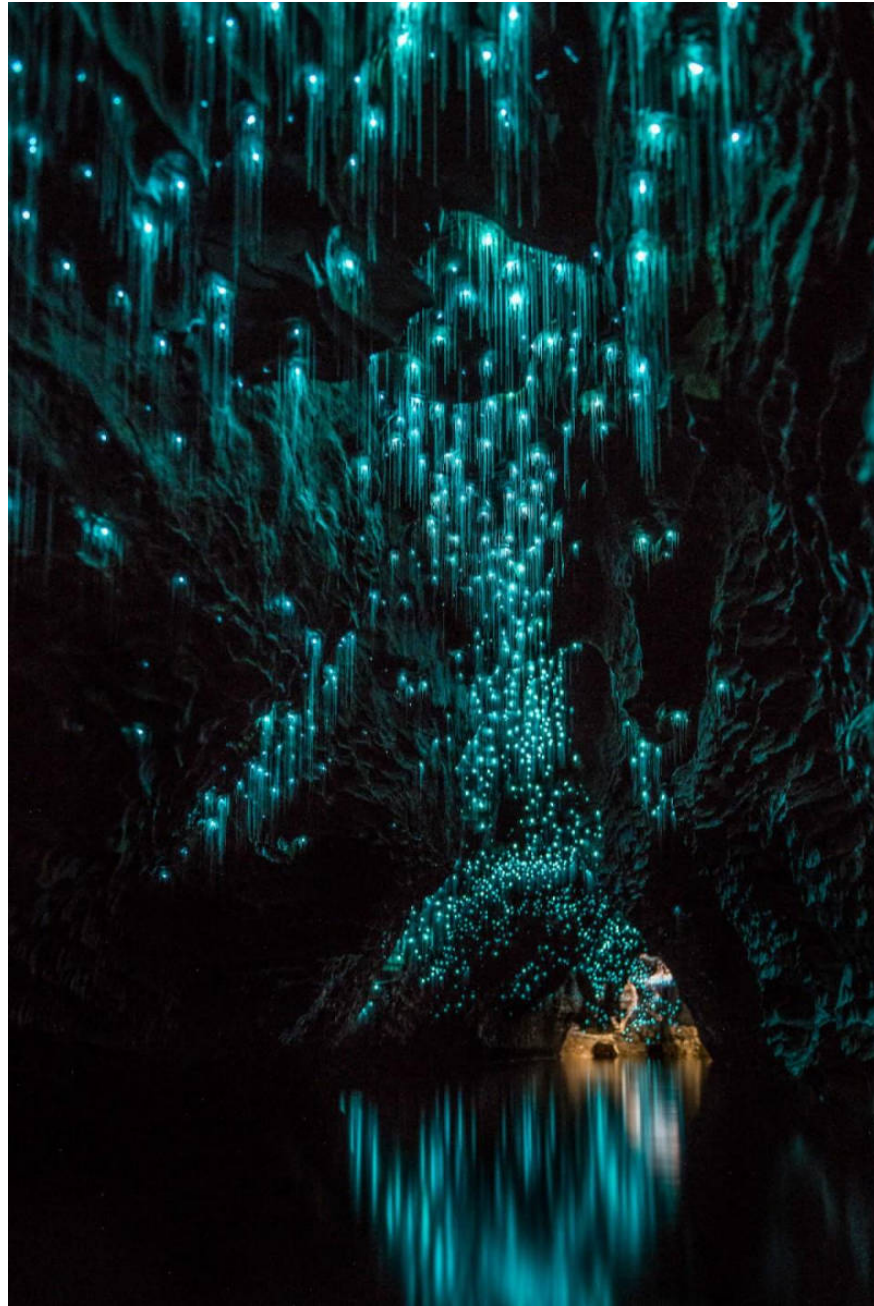

Formed from the erosion of red gravel stone 27 million years ago, the Zhangye Danxia rainbow mountain range in China surprised many people by the color, the veins changed from chestnut, magenta, lemon and stone to yellow, blue, orange .



Richat Structure in Mauritania, also known as "the eyes of Africa" ??or "the eyes of the Sahara" is an elliptical geological structure that spans 40km in diameter in the middle of the Sahara desert. center of western Mauritania, near Ouadane area. The origin of the "eye of the Sahara Desert" is the result of soil erosion from the end of the Primitive Period until the middle of the Ordovician Sandstone period.



Waitomo caves of Waitomo in the Waitomo town on the North Island of New Zealand, is a popular destination. Here, visitors like to step into the fairy tale with the sparkling, fanciful light of thousands of fireflies living and lighting in caves.



The Red Sea in China is beautiful and brilliant, like wearing an endless red carpet. This large area is covered by a type of seagrass that grows in salty alkaline soil. Starting in April or May, this weed starts to grow, grow and still retain green color throughout the summer. But in the fall, this grass changed into a bright red color.



"Hell gate" or "gate to hell" is located in Turkmenistan's Karakum desert, which has been burning for over 40 years, and there is no sign of soon disappearing.



Devil Tower is located in the North East of Wyoming, USA, is a mountain without a mountain formed about 65 million years ago by volcanic activities. The Devil's Tower, about 380m high, has a steep surface with many straight lines and a strange square.



Caves of Marble Caves marble, also known as "green cathedral" are located on a peninsula on Lake General Carrera in Chile. The entire stone wall of this submerged cave system has blue color and beautiful vortex lines.



Salar de Uyuni in Bolivia is the largest natural salt field in the world formed by the movement of the Earth's crust as a "strange wonder" of nature. When the summer comes, the field turns into a giant mirror reflecting the sky causing tourists to get lost in the clouds.



The Crystals Cave in Mexico contains giant selenite crystals deep beneath Naica, which Chihuahua has to surprise any adventurer.



Antelope Gorge, located on the land of Navajo, in Arizona, southwestern United States, is a sculptural work of nature.



The Chocolate Hill area in the Philippines consists of 2000 hills spread over an area of 750 km², which are likened to hats that face down on the green steppe surface. The hills are similar in size and have an average height of 30m to 50m. The most interesting point is that in all seasons the hills have the same color and change color according to the months of the year.



Whitehaven Beach, Whitsunday Island, Australia with crystal clear blue water and sandy beach is considered the whiteest in the world.



The ice ravine in Greenland is the longest gorge in the world to date with a length of 750 km, a depth of 800m and a width of up to 10 km.



Star sea on Vaadhoo island, Maldives sparkles like a mirror reflecting the starry sky above creating an extremely romantic setting on the beach. The cause of this interesting phenomenon is due to a kind of ephemera capable of emitting pale blue light naturally in the dark.
