

2 ways to display battery percentage on Android 10 phones

Most Android 10 smartphone users want to check the battery percentage to know exactly how much power is left to keep their device running. This is similar to driving; every driver needs to know how far they have fuel left. Nobody wants to guess how much battery or gas is left in their phone or tank.

The developers of the Android 10 operating system have decided to disable the default display of the battery percentage. This means users will have to estimate the remaining battery level themselves.

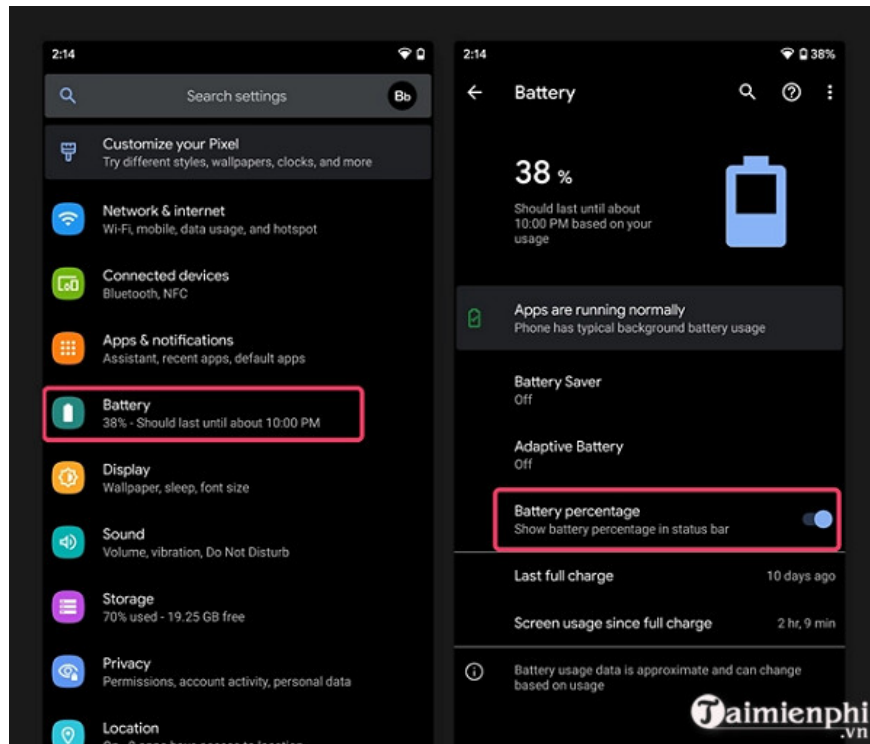


View the battery percentage display on your Android 10 phone.

Specifically, Android 10 brings several visual changes to the status bar and quick settings panel, one of which is the disappearance of the battery percentage from the top of the quick settings panel. Fortunately, there are still two ways to display the battery percentage in the status bar or quick settings.

1. How to set up the battery percentage display on the status bar.

Step 1: Open **Settings** on your Android 10 phone and go to the Battery section . **Step 2 :** Inside the Battery settings, you will find a toggle switch called **Battery percentage** that allows you to view the battery percentage in the status bar .

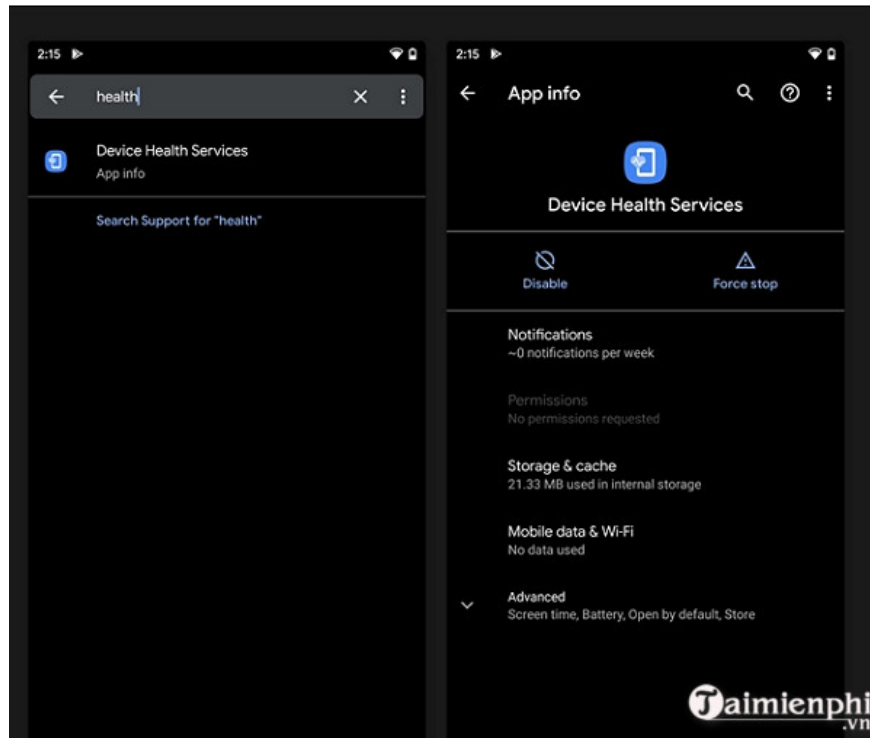


Step 3: Turn on the battery percentage display, and you will see the percentage shown on the status bar in the upper right corner of your phone.

2. How to display the battery percentage again in quick settings.

If you don't want to see the battery percentage constantly displayed in the status bar, you can follow these steps to enable the battery percentage in quick settings:

Step 1: Open **Settings** on your phone and type "**Health**" in the search bar. *Step 2:* From the search results, tap **Device Health Services**. You will then be taken to the app's settings page.



Step 3: Tap the Disable button and **restart** your phone. You will eventually see the battery percentage displayed again in the quick settings .
