## Advantages of wireless mice

**The birth of the wireless mouse has brought many benefits to users:**

1. No need for cumbersome wire connections, compact, easy to store and carry for use.
1. Works well even when 7m away from the computer.
1. Compatible with all types of PCs and laptops on the market today.
1. Very convenient for presentations and presentations.

## How to connect a wireless mouse to a laptop or computer

To connect a wireless mouse to computer devices, we can do it in the following 2 ways:

### How to connect a wireless mouse to a laptop via USB

This is the most common **way to connect a wireless mouse to a computer** because of its simplicity and speed. Furthermore, using the USB Unifying Receiver also allows connection to both PCs and devices that do not support bluetooth.

**The steps are as follows:**

## Step 1: Check the battery

Unlike wired mice, wireless mice will use batteries to operate instead of drawing power directly from the computer.

Before connecting, turn the bottom of the mouse over, remove the battery cover to insert a new battery. As for a wireless mouse with an included charging base, you just need to place the mouse on the charging base.

## Step 2: Plug the receiver into the laptop/computer

Notice that when you remove the battery cover, you will see a small USB plug. That is the receiver of the wireless mouse with the function of receiving waves for the mouse.

After inserting the battery and closing the lid, plug the receiver into the USB port on your laptop/computer. For wireless mice with a power button, you must turn on the power.

## Step 3: Set up the included Driver (if any)

Currently, most wireless mice on the market operate in a plug-n-play style (immediate use) without needing to install any drivers.

However, there will still be some types of mice that come with drivers. At this point, you need to install them on your laptop and then restart the computer so that the mouse can recognize the driver and operate normally.

## How to connect a wireless mouse to a laptop via Bluetooth

For mice connected by Wireless mechanism (without USB Unifying Receiver plug), you can **install the wireless mouse** according to the following instructions:

1. **Step 1:** You need to check and install a compatible battery for the mouse. Batteries used for wireless mice are usually AAA or AA type.
1. **Step 2:** Switch the switch on the bottom of the mouse to On mode.
1. **Step 3:** On your computer, press **the Windows + I** key combination . After the **Windows Settings** window appears, click on **Devices** .

Picture 1 of 2 ways to quickly connect a wireless mouse to a laptop

1. **Step 4:** At the **Bluetooth & other devices** interface , switch the virtual task in the **Bluetooth section to the On** state .

Picture 2 of 2 ways to quickly connect a wireless mouse to a laptop

1. **Step 5:** Click **Add Bluetooth or other device > Bluetooth** .

Picture 3 of 2 ways to quickly connect a wireless mouse to a laptop

1. **Step 6:** The screen will display all devices transmitting bluetooth near you. Now, search and click on the correct product code of the wireless mouse.
1. **Step 7:** Wait until the pairing process is completed.

**How to connect a bluetooth mouse to a Windows 8 laptop** also follows the same steps as above.

## Some notes when connecting a wireless mouse to a laptop

**Wireless mice are really convenient. However, during use you should also pay attention to the following issues:**

1. The Receiver's head is quite small and easy to lose. You need to store it carefully because it is an important part that plays the role of connecting the wireless mouse to the computer. It is best to store it in the mouse immediately after use.
1. In case your computer/laptop cannot detect the mouse, try turning the mouse off and then turning it back on. At the same time, you can also check whether your laptop has switched to bluetooth mode or not.
1. After using the mouse, you should turn off the mouse to help save battery life. In addition, you should also prepare some spare batteries so that use is not interrupted if the mouse runs out of battery unexpectedly.
