

2 ways to record macbook screen without software

Did you know that your MacBook can record your MacBook screen in 4K quality? TipsMake's article below will guide you through 2 ways to record your MacBook computer screen without software. Read this article to immediately update good ways!

Use keyboard shortcuts in macOS Mojave

With **macOS Mojave** , you need to press **Shift-Command-5** to enable **MacBook screen recording** . These features include, allowing you to record partial screen videos, full screen videos, and broadcast videos.

Record full-screen video

Click the full screen icon on the video recording function button, as shown below.

Click anywhere on the screen to **record the MacBook screen** while the screen is open or select **Record** on the function bar that appears on the screen.

After **recording your MacBook screen** , a thumbnail of the video will appear in the upper right corner of the screen and the video will be automatically saved. Users just need to click here to open the video.

Picture 2 of 2 ways to record macbook screen without software

You can use the tools included in this screen recording software for Macbook to trim the video. Additionally, a thumbnail can be dragged to save the video to the desired folder on the desktop.

Record the video portion of the screen

Click the **Record Portion** section button on the screen. Then, drag to select an area of ??the screen to record. To move the entire selection, drag from the selection.

To start recording, press the **Record** button in the on-screen controls.

To stop screen recording, click the **Stop Recording** button on the menu bar. Or press **Command + Control + Esc** .

Additionally, click **Options on the MacBook Screen Recording** Features panel to set the following:

1. **Save to** : is where you want the video to be automatically saved.
2. **Timer** : is to set the time to start recording video (choose 5, 10 or 15 seconds after recording).
3. **Microphone** : is for recording audio and video.
4. **Show Floating Thumbnail** : is to set whether to display the video thumbnail after recording on the screen or not.
5. **Show Mouse Clicks** : is to activate the black circular border when clicking the mouse during video recording.

Record MacBook screen with QuickTime Player

By **recording this MacBook screen** , you don't need to support the macOS Mojave operating system to still be able to record screen videos.

1. **Step 1:** Open **QuickTime Player from the Applications** folder on the user's Macbook. You continue and select **File** . Then, select **New Screen Recording** on the menu bar.

1. **Step 2** : Before returning to **recording your mac screen** , you can click the button with the down arrow next to the recording button to make the following settings:

Picture 5 of 2 ways to record macbook screen without software

1. To record your voice or any other sound while recording a screen video, select **Microphone** . During video recording, you can use the volume slider to adjust the volume as desired.
2. To have the mouse pointer have a black circle around the mouse tip, select **Show Mouse Clicks in Recording** .
1. **Step 3** : To start recording screen video, click the red **Record** button on the control bar. You can choose to record full screen or part of the screen in one of the following **ways to record the MacBook screen** :

1. To rotate completely, click anywhere on the screen.
2. Drag the mouse to surround the part of the screen where you want to record video, then select **Start Recording with in that area** .
3. To stop recording video, click the icon or press **Command + Control + Esc** to exit. The video will be automatically saved by the laptop.

After recording a video, QuickTime Player will automatically open **the MacBook screen recording** for you to see. You can edit and share as you like, saving it to an easier-to-find folder on your Mac.

Notes when recording screen video on MacBook

Below are some things to note when **recording videos of MacBook screens** that any user should know.

1. When you automatically save a recorded screen video, your Mac saves the video file as **Screen Recording day at time.mov**.
2. To cancel recording screen video, users should press **Esc** before selecting **Record** .
3. **You can open screencast** video files on your MacBook using QuickTime Player, iMovie, or any app that supports video viewing and editing.
4. Some applications, such as DVD players, do not allow users to record video of the screen of their application window.
