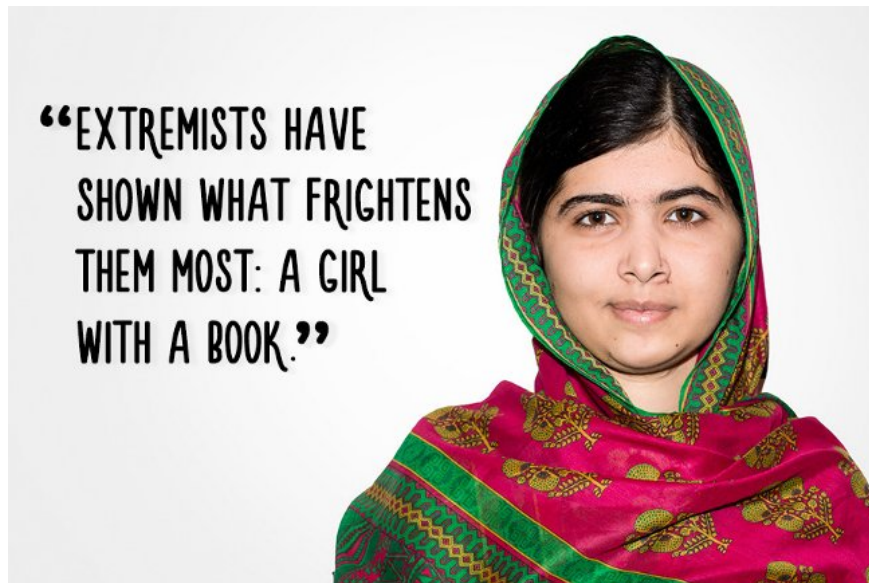

## # 1 Malala Yousafzai

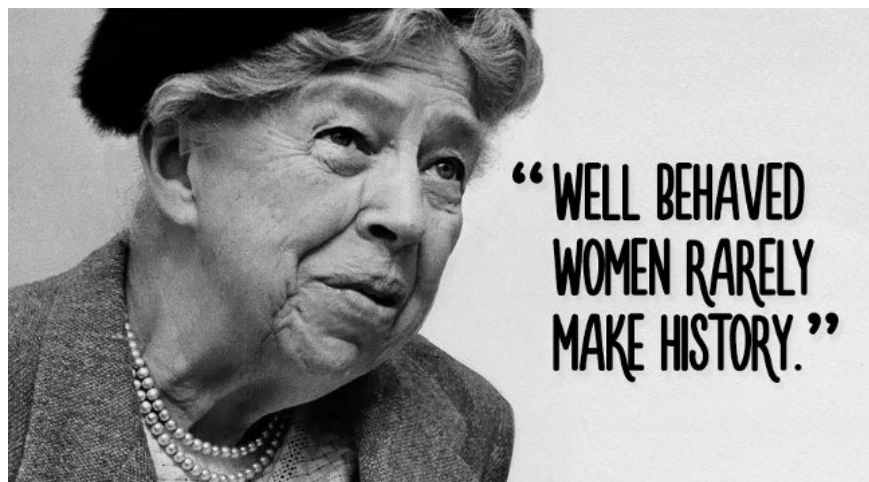

## # 2 Eleanor Roosevelt

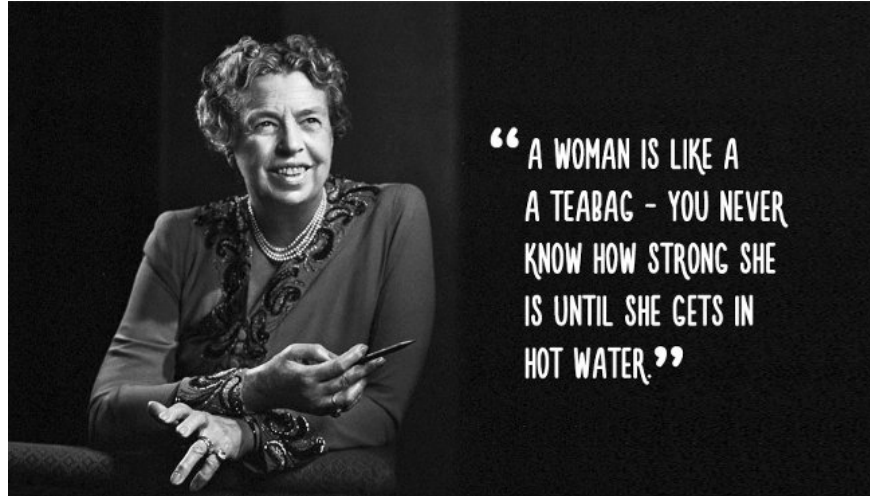

### **# 3 Aung San Suu Kyi**



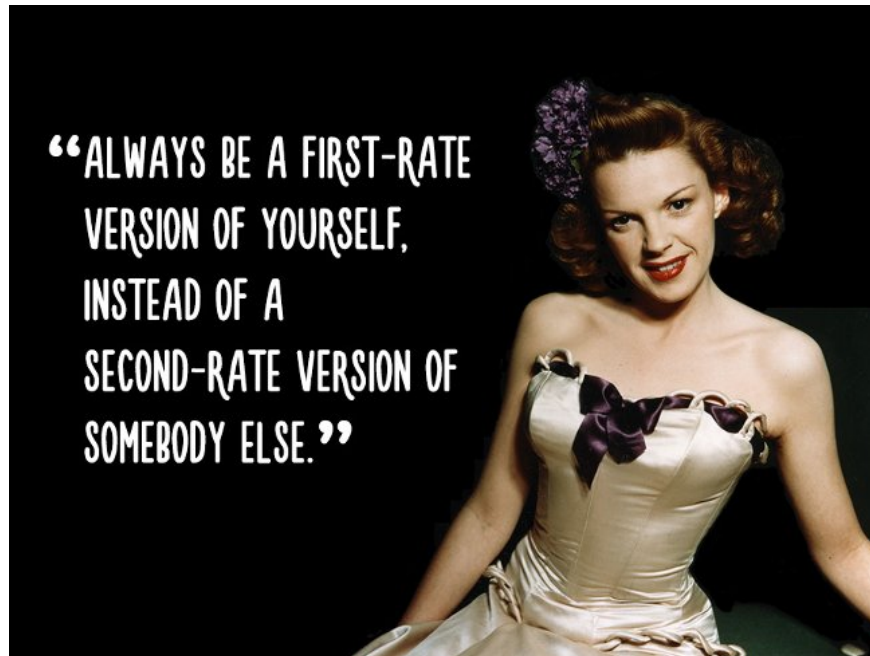

## # 4 Judy Garland

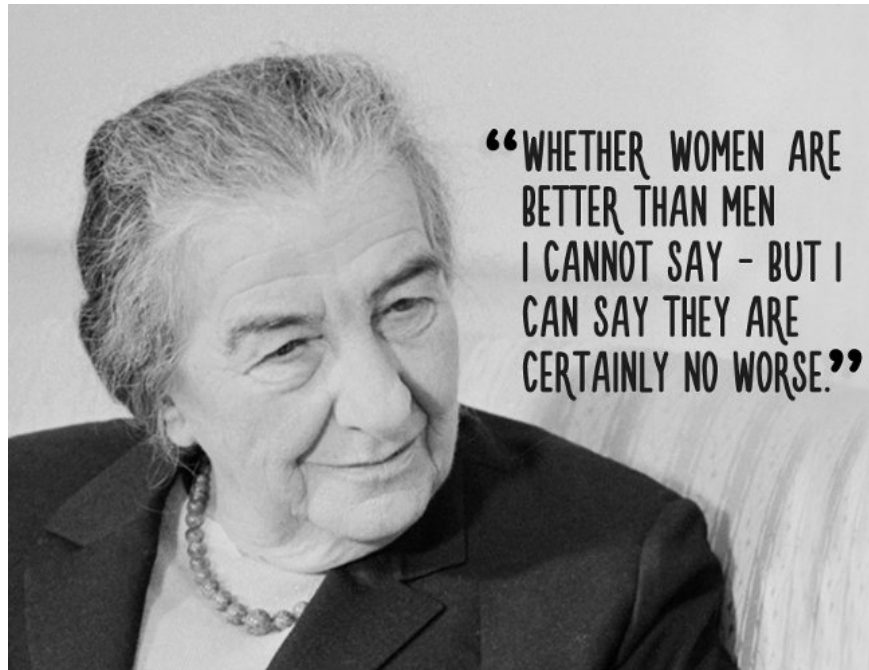

## # 5 Golda Meir

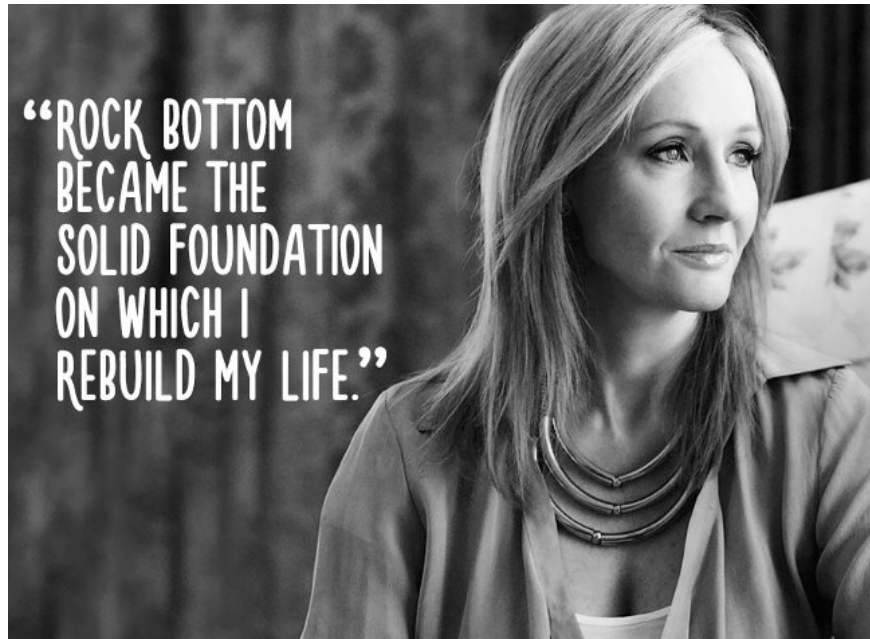

## # 6 Jk Rowling

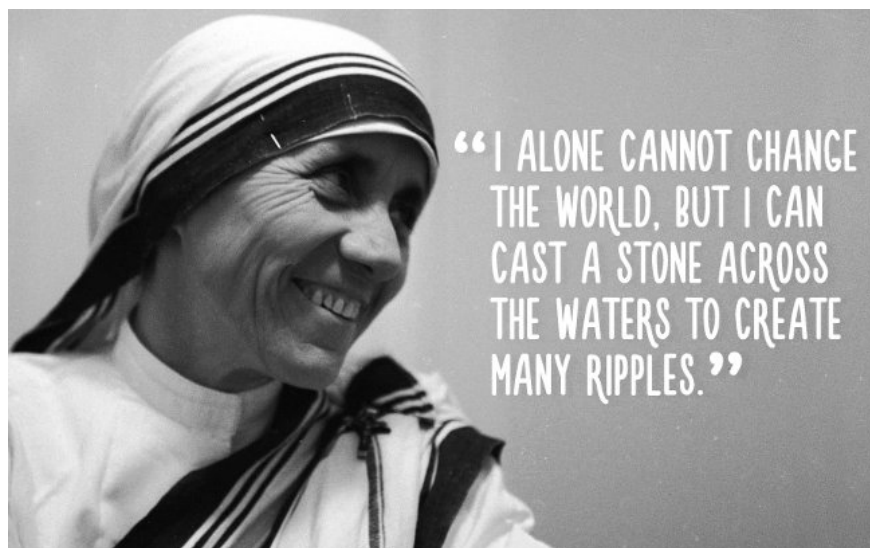

## # 8 Coco Chanel

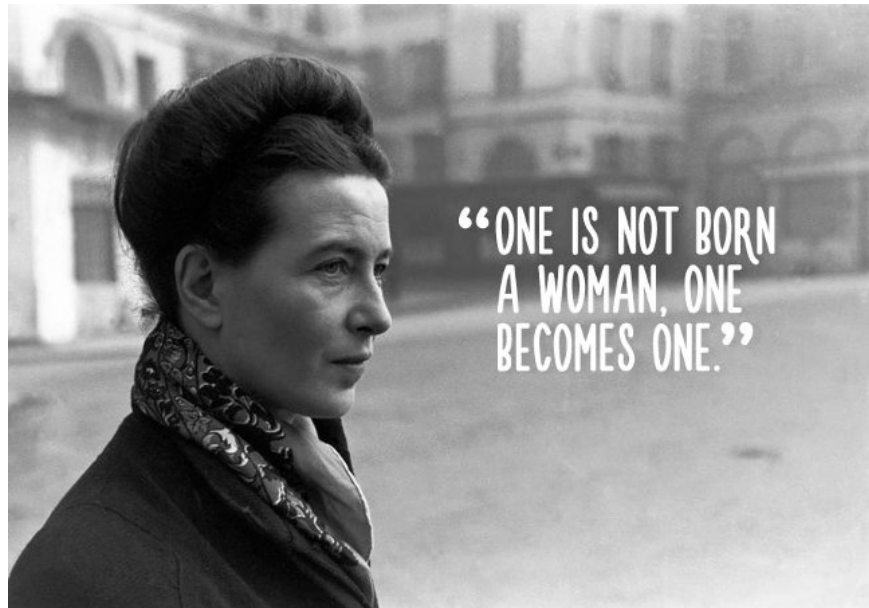

## # 9 Simone De Beauvoir

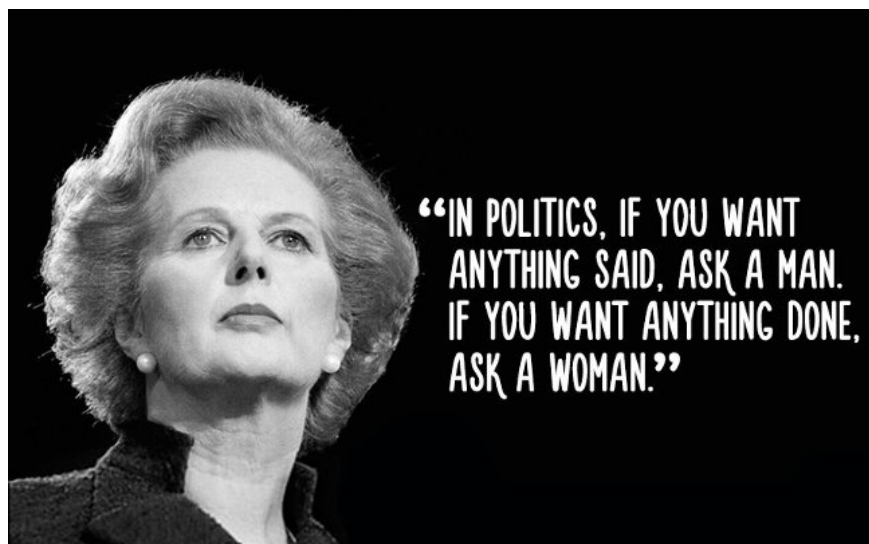

## # 13 Michelle Obama



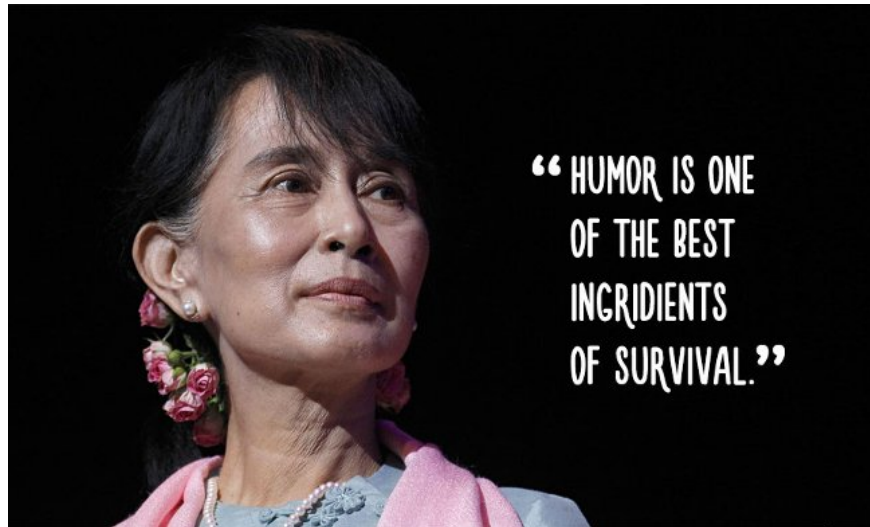

## # 17 Mae West

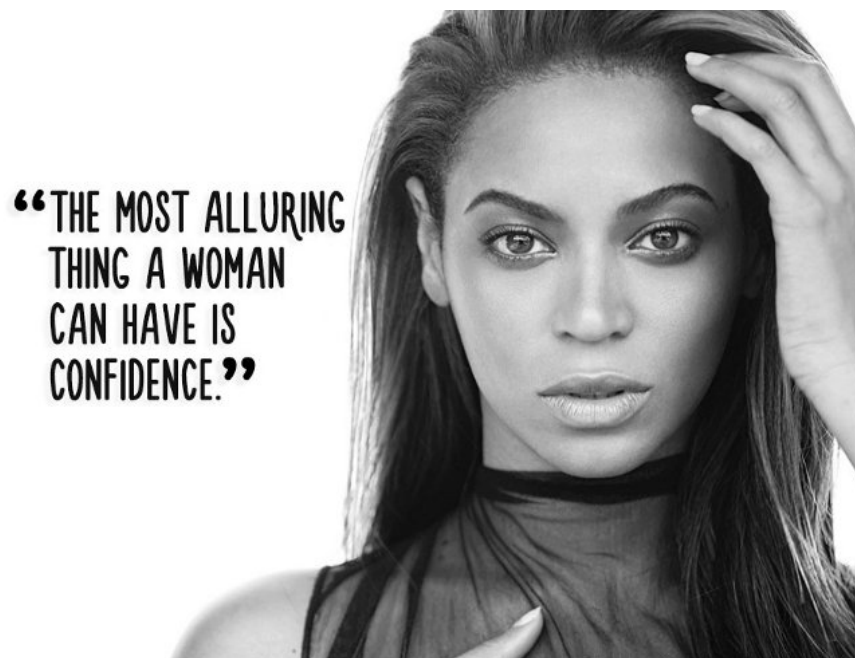

## # 19 Cher

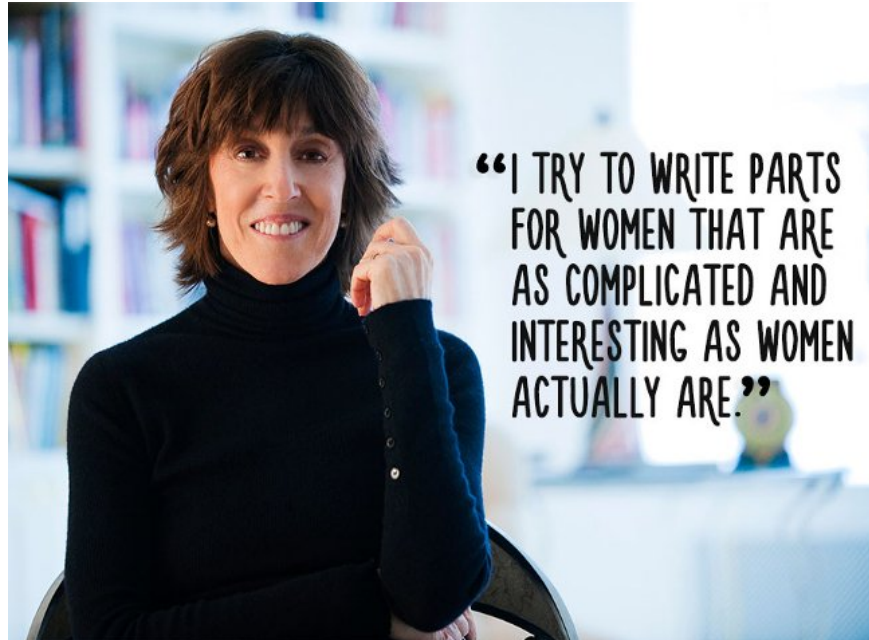
