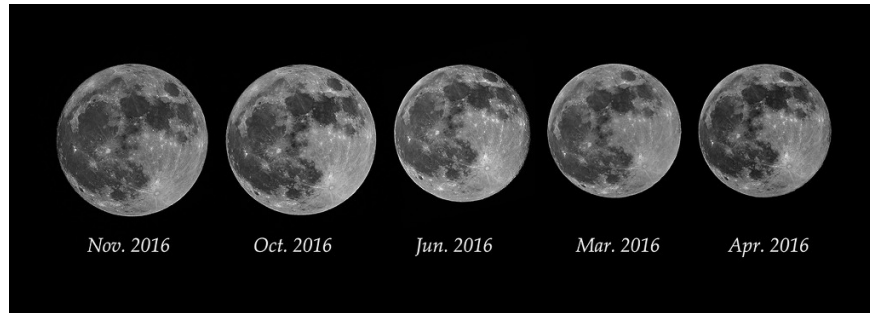

Super moon shines St. Croix River Crossing

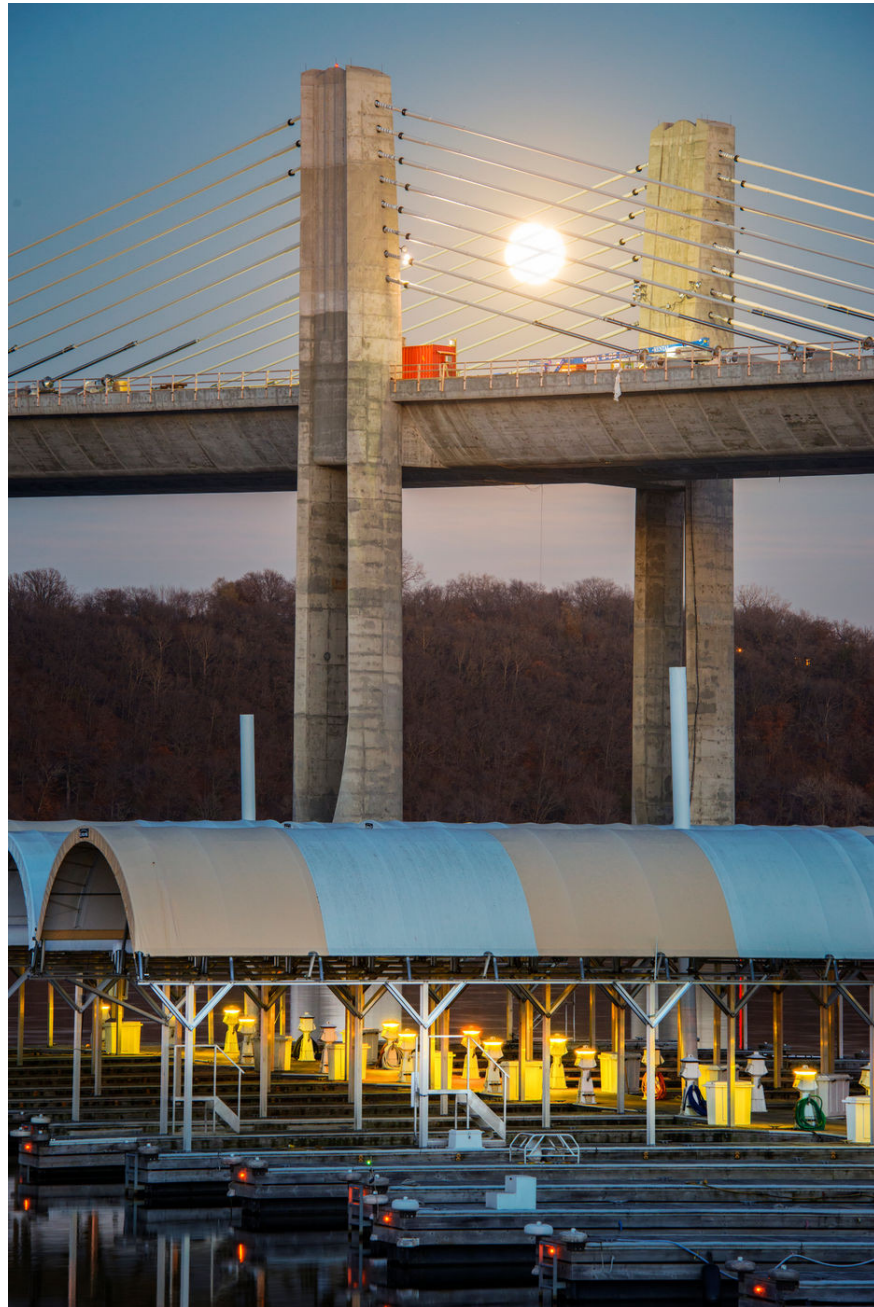
