

20 useful gardening tips not everyone knows

Not everyone says you know these useful and useful vegetable tips!

A lush, green vegetable garden is probably the wish of most housewives, especially with urban women. However, sometimes gardening with sisters is a difficult task, so to make it easier for women to take care of their small garden, our following article will share. Simple yet effective gardening tips that help you reduce the time to take care of plants.



I. Planting trees

1. Check the pH of the soil

To test the soil pH, you simply need to use dry soil mixed with distilled water. Then use vinegar and baking soda to check. If the soil mixture reacts with vinegar, the soil is alkaline, but if the soil reacts with soda banking powder, then the soil is acidic. If not reacting to any substance, this is neutral soil.

2. Protect young and small trees

Young and small trees are very difficult to live in the natural environment, because it is easily affected by the external environment such as mice, climate . So to protect young plants, you should use a small plastic bottle to cut. Do it in half, then shoot on the sapling to avoid the effects. Note: in hot days, you should not use a vase.

3. The covering layer for trees

Using a little straw, covering up the newly seeded soil, will help protect the tree, especially the roots and straw also help to keep the plants water, thus saving you time to water the plants.

4. Use wooden box

You can use wooden boxes to grow vegetables. Growing vegetables in wooden boxes not only increases the aesthetics of your family's garden but it is also easy to harvest. In spring, the soil in the box is also easier to moisten.

5. Use cork to plant trees



If you plant seedlings to hang them, you can use a few wooden wine stoppers, mix them into the soil to help plant pots reduce weight as well as save soil when planting trees.

6. Shoe cabinet / box

With old shoe boxes, you can take advantage of it to plant trees to make an interesting garden stand. This shoe cabinet / case will be very suitable for you to grow upright trunk / herb plants.

7. DIY fertilizer

With organic fertilizers it will be very good for plants. You can make use of family preparations such as banana peel, egg shell, coffee grounds . to make a good fertilizer for plants.

8. Handling spilled soil

If the planter has large holes to help the tree drain, but it causes the soil to fall out, use a coffee filter placed on the basin so that the tree does not fall out.

9. Make use of grass trimmed

Do not cut the grass too often, because it will make the grass grow stronger. If you cut the grass, instead of compressing it, take it over the tree to create a cover, return the nitrogen to the soil so you won't need to fertilize too often.

10. Water plants with bottles

Watering with bottles is the most effective way of watering. You just need to use a plastic bottle filled with water, poke holes in the bottle cap, upside down and bury it in the ground to water the plants. This way is suitable for small gardens.

11. Take advantage of vegetable cooking water

When boiled vegetables, if your family does not use all the vegetable juice, you can take advantage of the boiled water, wait for it to cool, then water it on the tree, this is a very good water for plants, rich in vitamins. Note, do not water plants with boiled vegetable salt or cooking oil.

12. DIY watering can

Instead of buying a watering can, you can take advantage of plastic bottles and pierce many small holes in the bottle cap that you already have a super-fine watering pot.

13. Make a fountain



Get a plastic bottle tied to a watering hose, then puncture many small holes at the bottom of the bottle with a garden spraying tool.

14. Choose plants that can withstand drought

For those who do not have the time to water often, but still want a garden, choose the plants that are tolerant like garlic, onion, lavender .

III. Kill the bugs

15. Kill snails

With snails, you can use cereals, because this is the favorite dish of this species. How to do it is simple, put some cereal in the snail's drive and they will die from dehydration when eating too much cereal.

16. Use eggshell to protect young plants



The young trees are sprouting, they can be eaten by snails. So use an eggshell to cover the germ to temporarily protect the snail at night.

17. Eliminate spider insects

Do you know that spiders are also a type that can help you eliminate dangerous insects for plants more than birds? So, when you see the spider web in the house, move them to the garden to help you catch the bug.

18. Spitting grass after it rains

Immediately after the rain, you should go to the garden to pull the grass for the tree, the soil is still moist so it will be easier to weed.

19. Be a bird's nest to lure birds to the garden



Using small branches and hay to form a nest to lure them to your garden. When a bird comes in the family garden you are not worried about being damaged by the worm.

20. Butterflies about the garden

Use some ripe fruits and leave them in a place where there is no sunlight in the garden, which helps attract butterflies into your garden.
