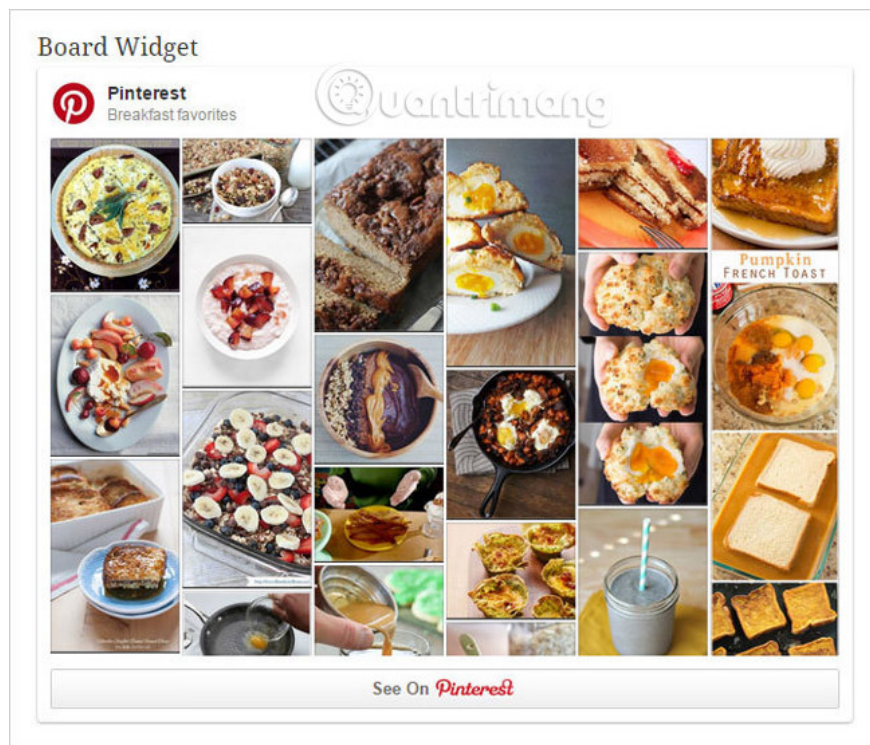

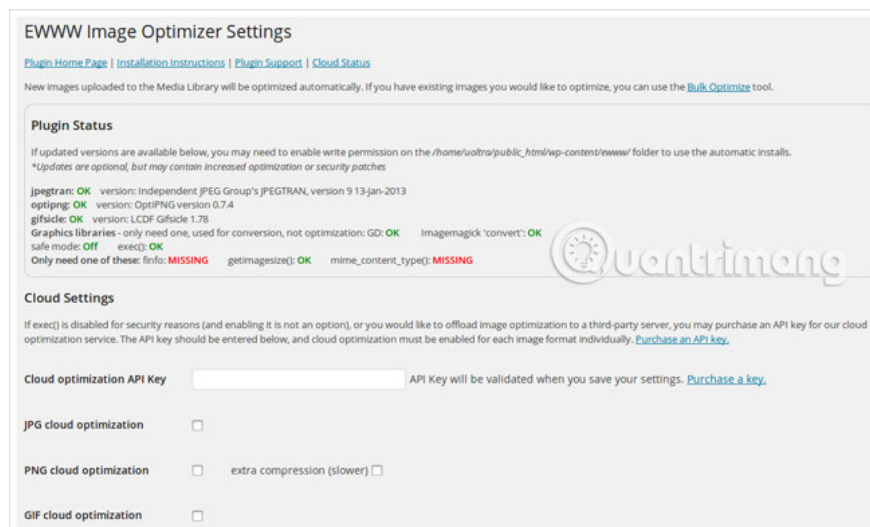
Pinterest AccessPress

EWWW Image Optimizer

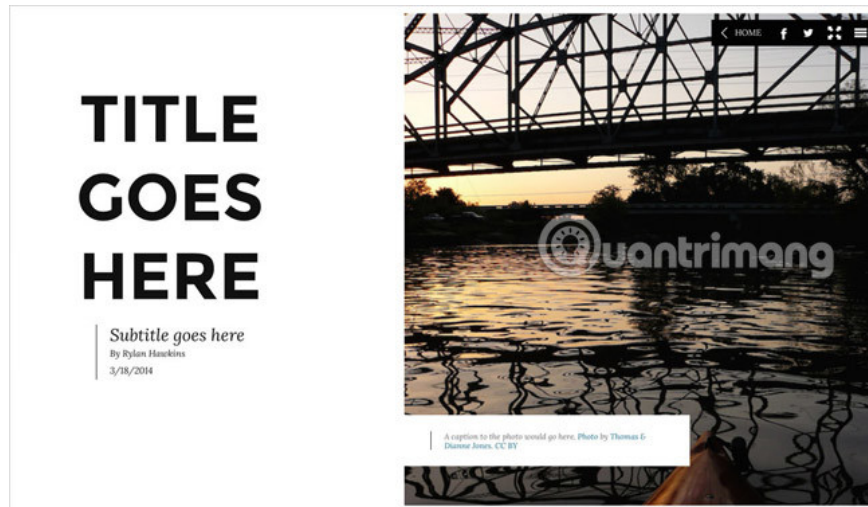

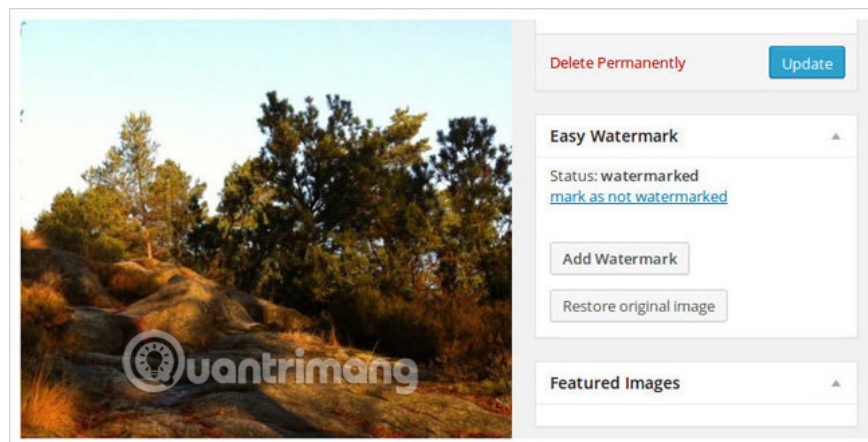
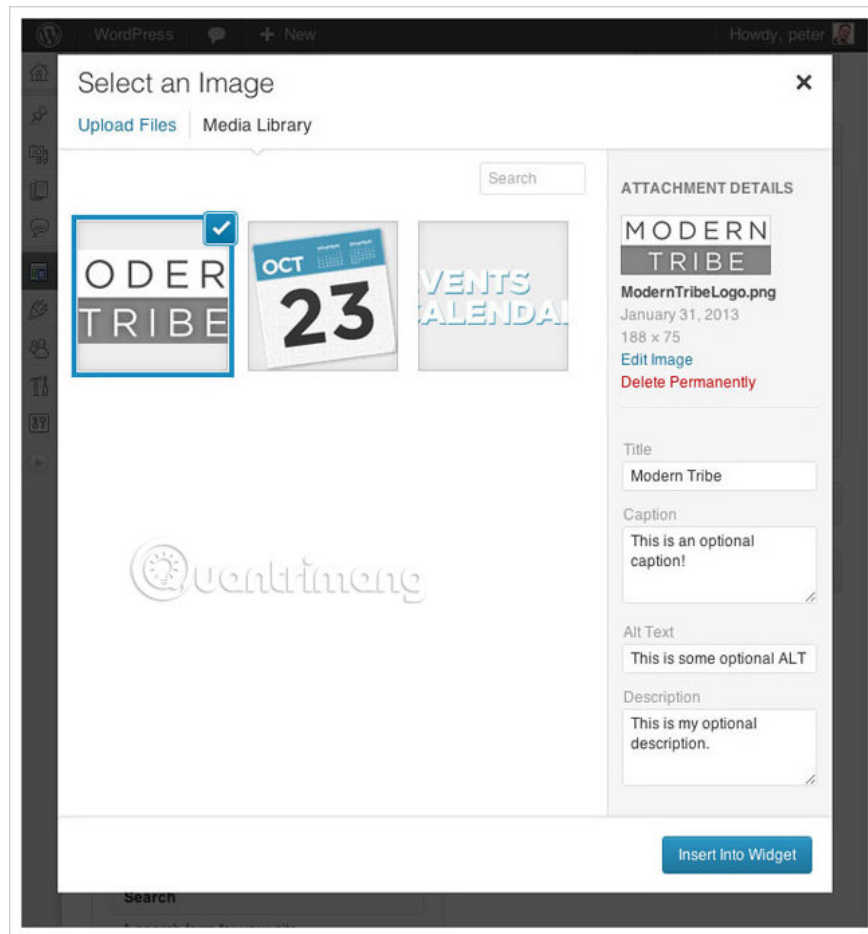


Image Widget

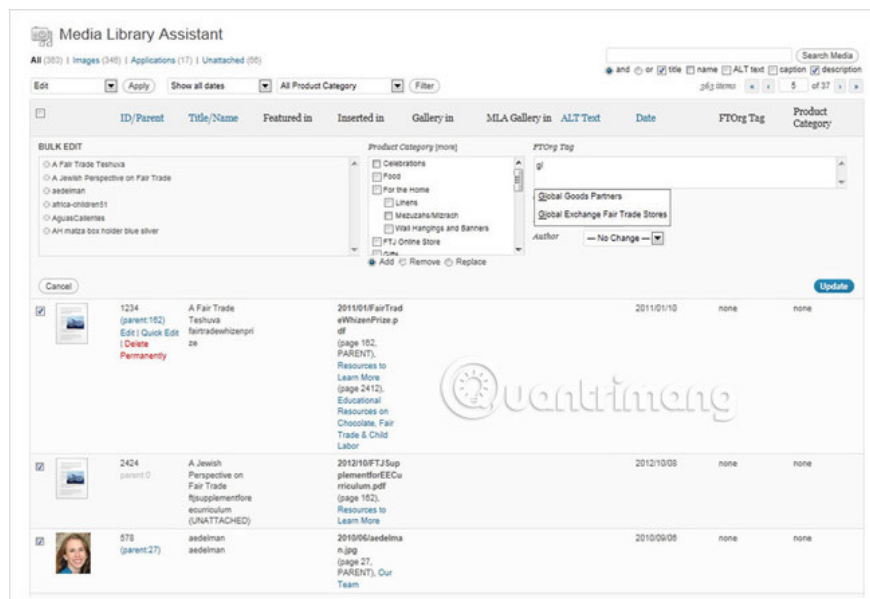
Post Thumbnail Editor

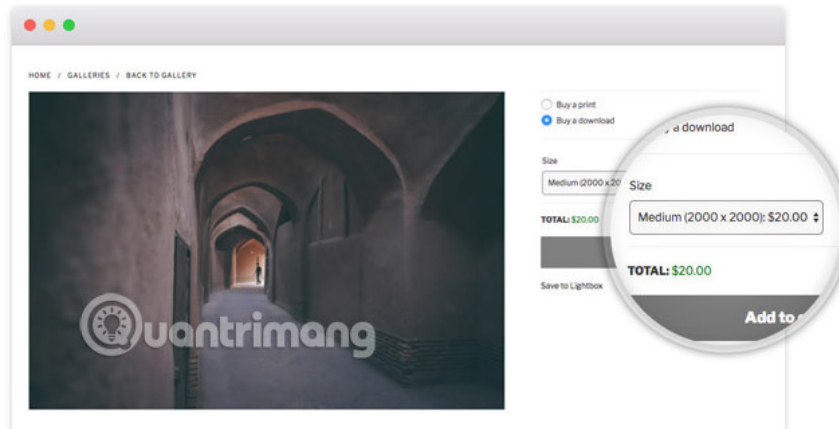
Media Library Assistant

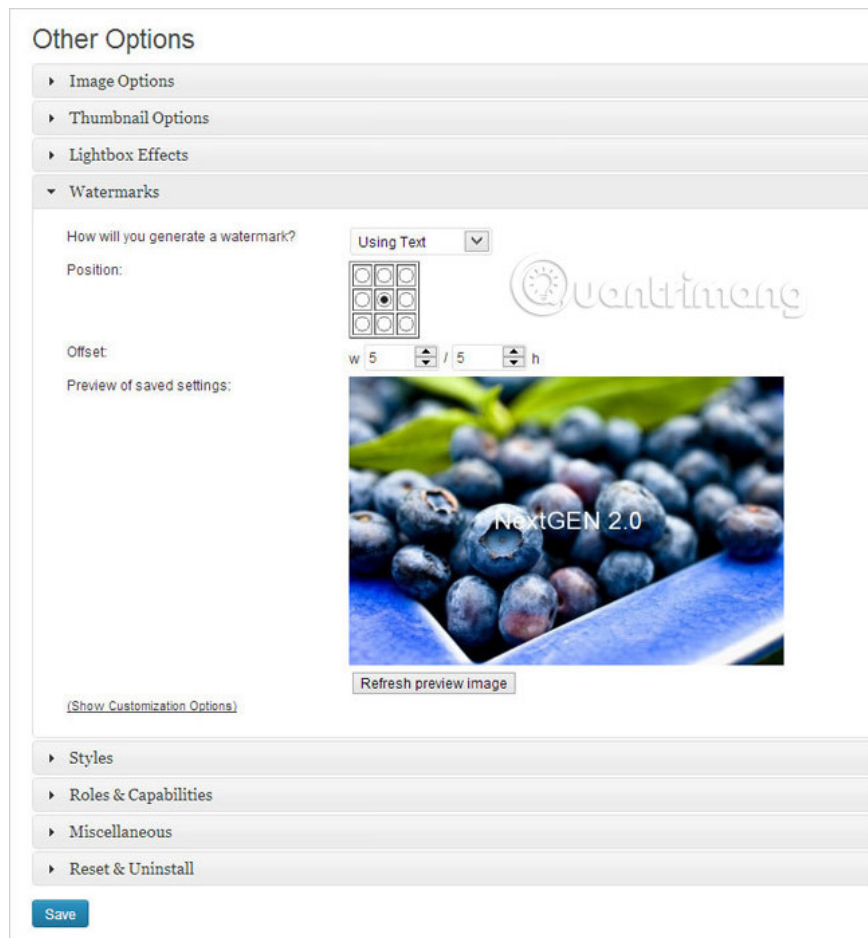
Sell ??Media

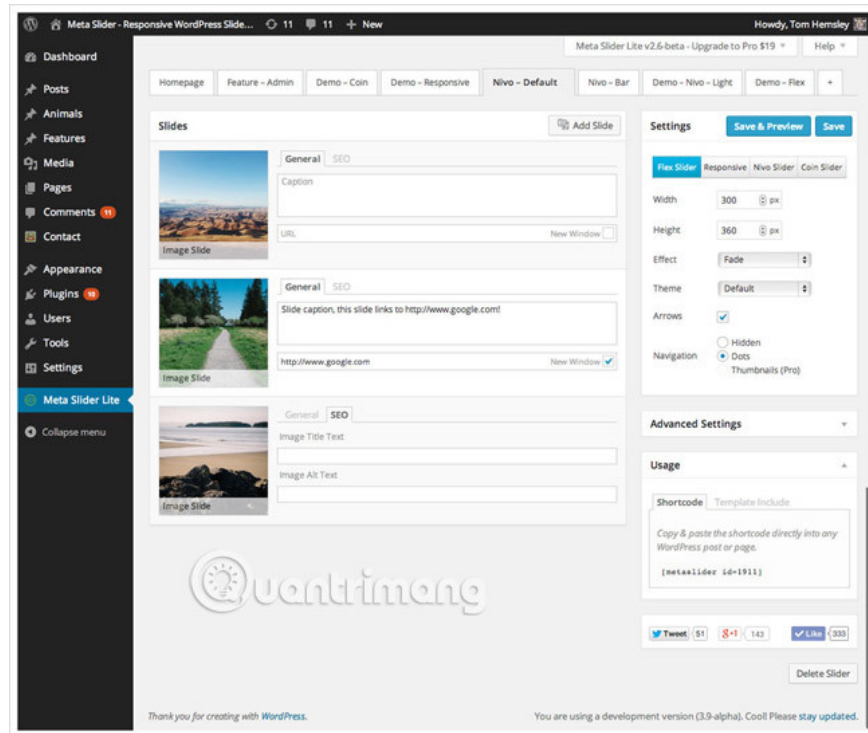
NextGEN Gallery

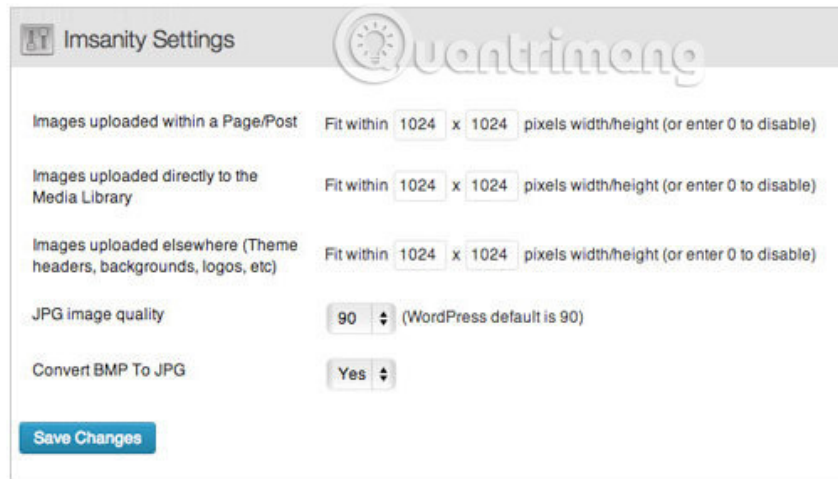


SEO Friendly Images

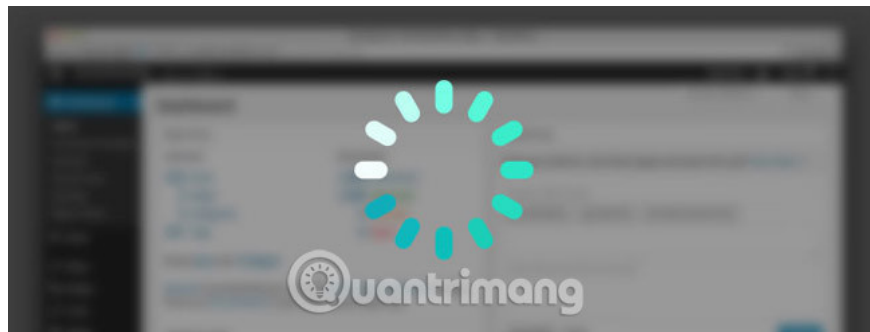
Imsanity

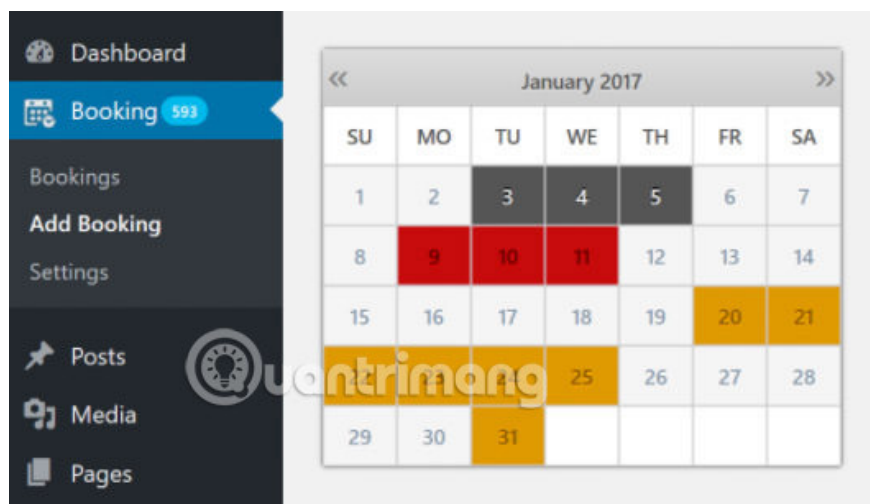
Lazy Load

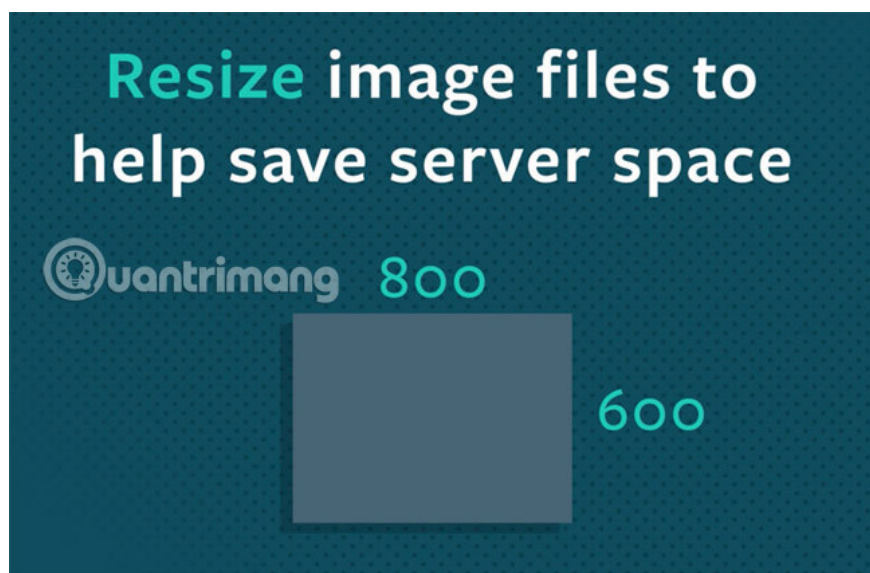
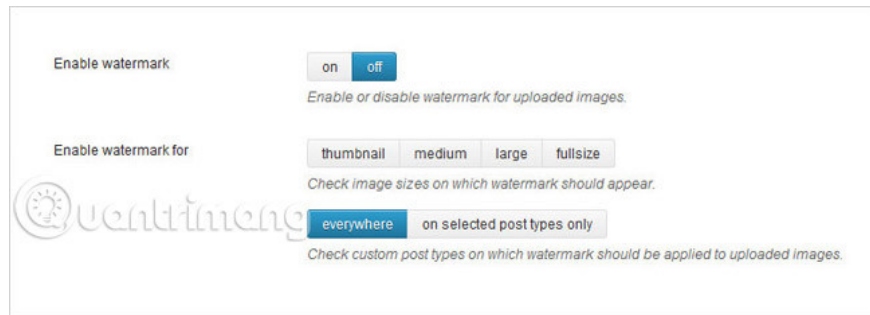


Image Watermark

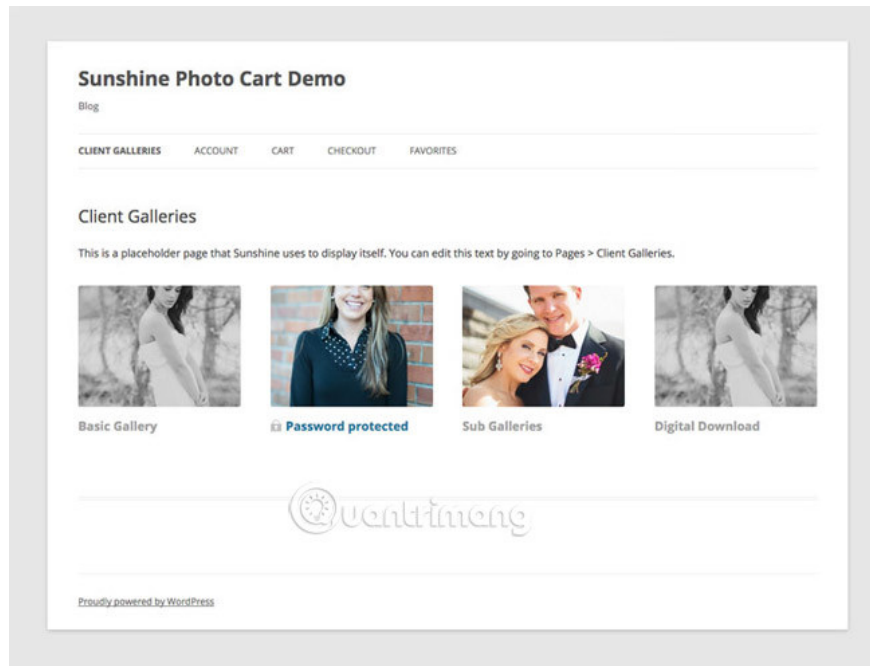
Photography Management
