### 1. "How to spend money and how to make money completely different"



*"Saving \$ 2,000 when not choosing a first class ticket is like having someone pay me \$ 2,000. Would you accept to sit in an uncomfortable chair on the plane for 3 hours in exchange for the number? Is this money? "* An excellent plastic surgeon lives in Boston.

## 2. "I go to the ATM tree only once a week and pay everything in cash"

## 4. "We disgust waste"



*"Once, my granddaughter was about to throw away a pile of papers. I noticed that there were quite a few paper bags still usable. I told her to remove them so that when she needed to use it, it told me," Grandma. Oh, do you know that the paper bags are very cheap? "I said," Do you know just how much a penny will help you hold out when you need it? "* - Pat Brennan, co-owner by Brennan Builders - a construction company in Evans, Pennsylvania.

## 5. "Buy low prices - sell high prices"

*"In the spring of 2012, I read an article in the Wall Street Journal that Talbots could be acquired but after the deal failed, the stock price fell nearly 50% in just one day. That's when I spent \$ 5,000 to buy stock of Talbots. After that time, the price went up about 50% every day and I decided to sell them "* - partner of a very prestigious law firm in Washington. .

## 6. "We defy every challenge in our work"

*"When negotiating wages, I always end up with a request for a salary increase after about 9 months, instead of the usual 12 months. This proposal is always accepted because I try my best to prove that I deserve it. In addition, the remaining 3 months of the year are also opportunities for me to try for a new pay rise or bonus "* - Alan Corey.

## **7. "We are not as smart as you think"**

*"It is surprising that people think that because you are smarter, you will have money. Two days after selling the company, I was asked to be a speaker for a seminar that I had to work before. and tireless efforts for 6 consecutive years with the desire to set foot there "* - Peter Shankman - angel entrepreneur and investor.

*"Not all rich people hire the best lawyers and accountants to do paperwork for them. Many people still calculate their monthly taxes using regular software, like many people. Other in the world only "* - Partner of a prestigious law firm in Washington.

## 12. "Even with family and friends, we don't spend money indiscriminately"

*"72% of wealthy families - those with more than \$ 250,000 invested - think their children should pay at least part of their college tuition and nearly a third think that in the future, the number This should split equally 50:50 "* - according to a survey of 1,000 wealthy families in 2012 done by Legg Mason asset management company.

### **16. "We like to use acronyms"**

### **17. "Instead of giving people money, we give them jobs."**

*"The rich aren't really the ones who wear expensive clothes, carry brand bags or drive in. In Martha's vineyard, you'll see a lot of people living in houses that can be sold for a price. 10 million USD, still driving Toyota cars produced 10 years ago" - a plastic surgeon in Boston said.*

## **21. "Our home always has rooms for entertainment only."**



*"Your home may not have a ballroom but you can create a relaxing space for yourself by turning it into a room just for entertainment," said a real estate broker.*
