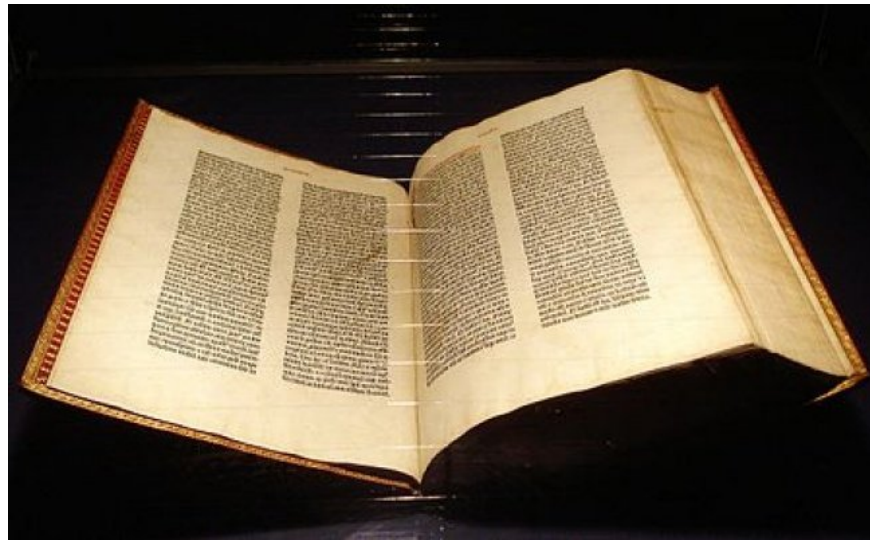

24. Bible Gutenberg

The Bible Gutenberg is also called the 42-line Bible, which symbolizes the beginning of the book printing in Europe. Johannes Gutenberg published printing in a printing factory in Gutenberg in the early 1450s.

The extremely rare and highly reliable first version is made of goat leather, and is also illustrated in a very beautiful way.

The second version is made on paper, very historical value, although the decoration style is quite simple and has been lost to the first few pages.

Historians say that there are 185 copies of the Bible in the world: 150 made on paper and 35 made of goat skin. However, today there are only about 48 copies left and most of them are incomplete.

23. Alcatraz Island

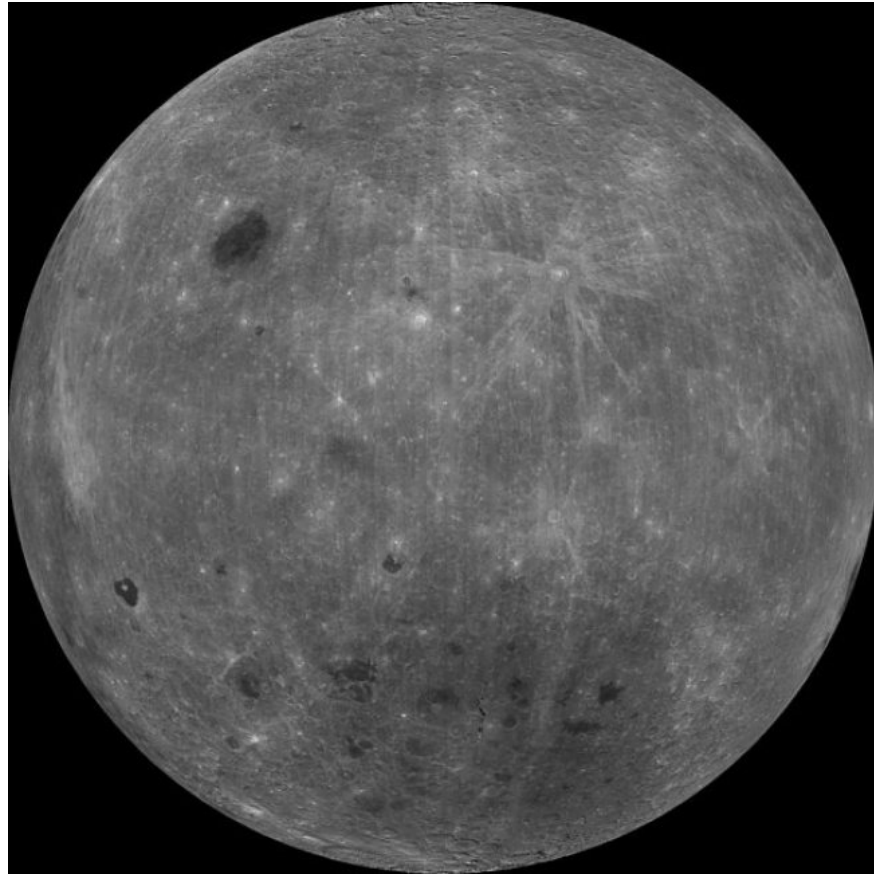

Garry Kimovich Kasparov is arguably the strongest player in history with the ELO 2851, the highest ranking in about 20 years from 1985 to 2005 and the undefeated world chess champion from 1985 to 1993.

This event is very disturbing: people are afraid that robots will conquer the world. But if you look at Deep Blue, do you think it's really dangerous?

According to Roman mythology, Penate is like gods and Kitchen Gods. People often return to Penate after the war or hunting. As a rule, each family will have 2 Penates.

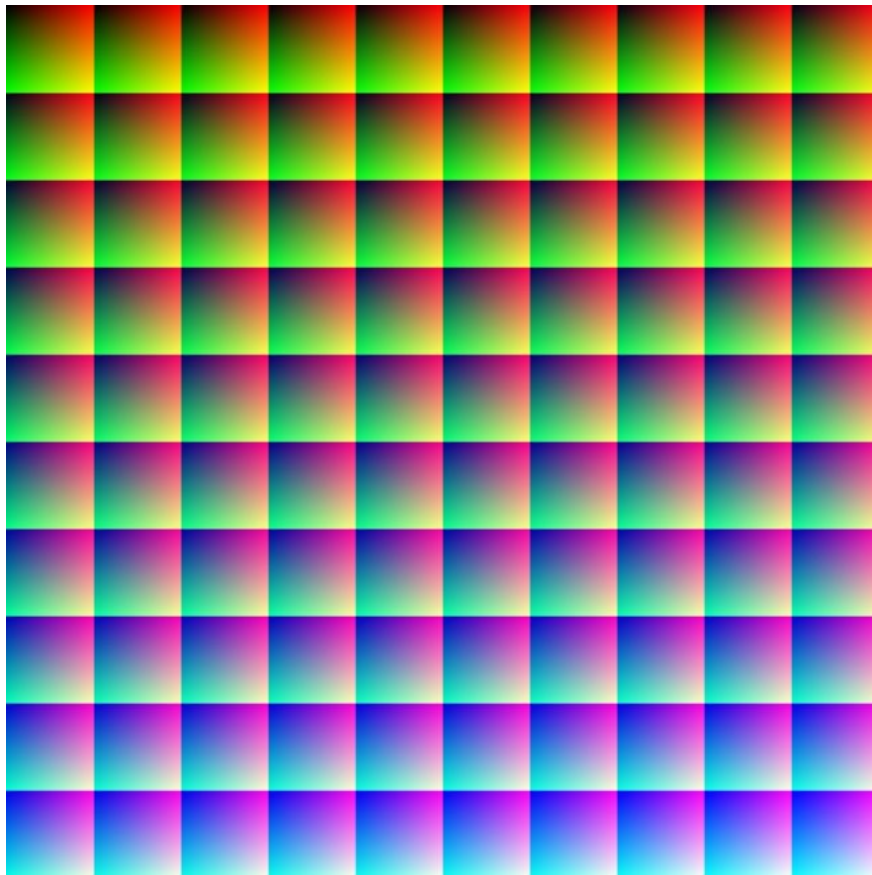
13. Floor heating system

This is the point that lies on the ocean farther from the mainland, compared to all the points lying on the remaining ocean. It is located on the South Pacific Ocean, 2688km from the nearest mainland.
