

# 25 unexpected facts about orange sure you don't know

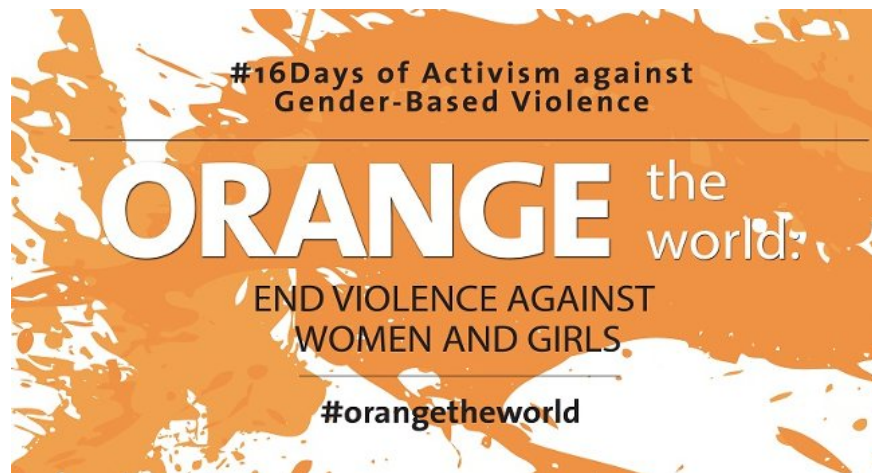
You wonder: Why is the orange, carrot or Golden Gate bridge orange? Let's see 25 unexpected orange facts!

1. The word "orange gold" or "orange" is derived from **naranga** Persian and **narang** sanskrit.

3. Orange yellow is a symbol of glory and fruits on Earth in the early Christian church and also known as the sun's rays.

6. According to the Bible, orange yellow is often related to saints - representing strength and courage.
7. Orange's famous slogan is " *bright future, orange future* ".

10. The color of the US Army information army is orange.
11. Orange gold is a popular color in world sports with American football teams: Chicago Bears and Cincinnati Bengals *or* baseball teams: San Francisco Giants - their main colors are orange.
12. The fruits of orange outer shells are usually not much in the world. Like Vietnam's oranges and Thai tangerines, the inside is orange-yellow but the outer shell is green.
13. The Dutch football team or "*Oranje*" often plays in orange clothes.
14. Fruits are usually orange-colored when the weather is cool, and in areas with a warmer climate, chlorophyll is retained so their shells are green.
15. The orange of canaries is not natural. Initially, the bird is blue-brown but when crossed they are yellow, combined with only eating red chili, their feathers become orange.
16. In the past, carrots were not orange in color, their common colors were purple. By the 17th century, the Dutch farmer bred between white root carrots - transformed into yellow and wild carrots - turned orange.
17. The 25th day of the month is called "*Orange Day*" by the United Nations campaign calling on Solidarity to end violence against women. These days to raise people's awareness and action to prevent violent behavior against women.



18. Consumer research has demonstrated that orange lawn mowers will easily see longer grass than green. This explains why in 1977 Flymo lawn mower was changed from green to orange.
19. Orange is the color of the Royal Family of the Netherlands. When the descendants of William of Orange, the orange color became the symbol of the Netherlands.
20. Vincent van Gogh once said: "*It will not be blue without yellow and orange*".

21. The violins prize of Antonio Stradivari is worth more than \$ 2 million at the auction. Some people said: "*The truth behind those great sounds is because they beat the orange varnish around the violin .*"
22. The costumes of astronauts wearing space inside the spacecraft are orange-yellow, but they must change before going out to match the chosen logo is thick white costume.
23. The **Golden Gate** Bridge in California, USA is covered with a so-called "*international orange*" color , which is also used in the aerospace industry as a way to highlight objects.



24. Primitive Buddhism often wears orange-colored robes because this is one of the popular dyes available. These Buddhists are not mistaken for Tibetan counterparts - wearing dark brown.
25. The orange ribbon is worn to support and raise awareness of cases and causes of self-harm, *Attention-deficit hyperactivity disorder (ADHD)* , multiple sclerosis. ( *Multiple Sclerosis* ) and animal welfare.
