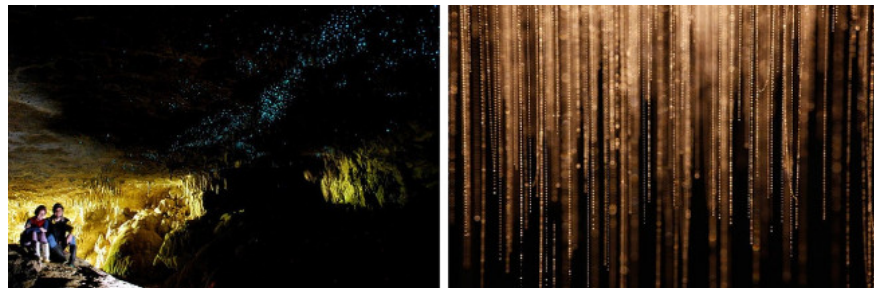

## 4. Ba Tu Cave, Malaysia



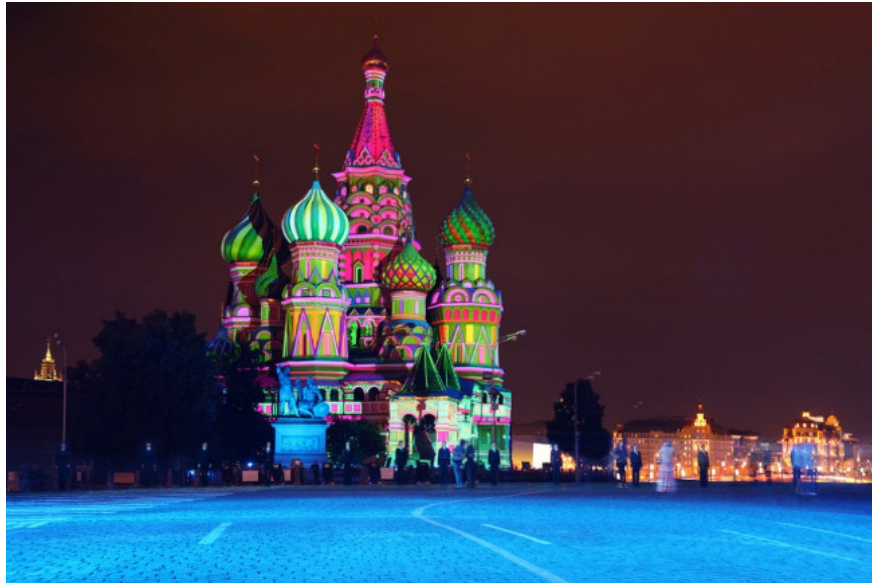
