These young men wore hooded sweatshirts, unarmed. When they rushed into the store, they quickly cut the anti-theft cord attached to the device and took away 26 devices, including MacBook computers, iPhone X phones, 8, and 7. The entire process took place in less than 60 seconds. and while Apple Store is still crowded.

Police said the suspect was believed to be colored men and was in the age of only 16-18. In addition to the 4 names who broke into the store, the thief group also has a fifth person, not appearing in the video, supposedly driving the group.

On June 21, the Apple Store in San Luis Obispo, California was also robbed. Police are investigating whether the suspects in these two cases are related.
