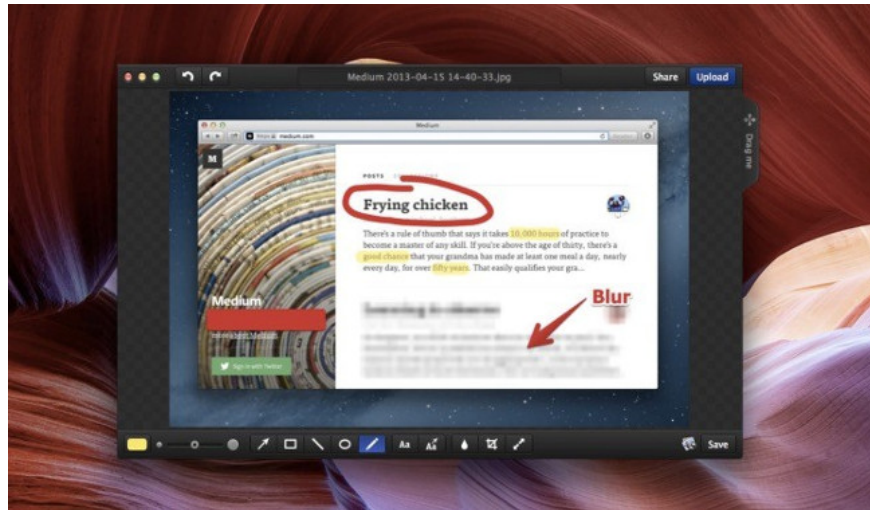

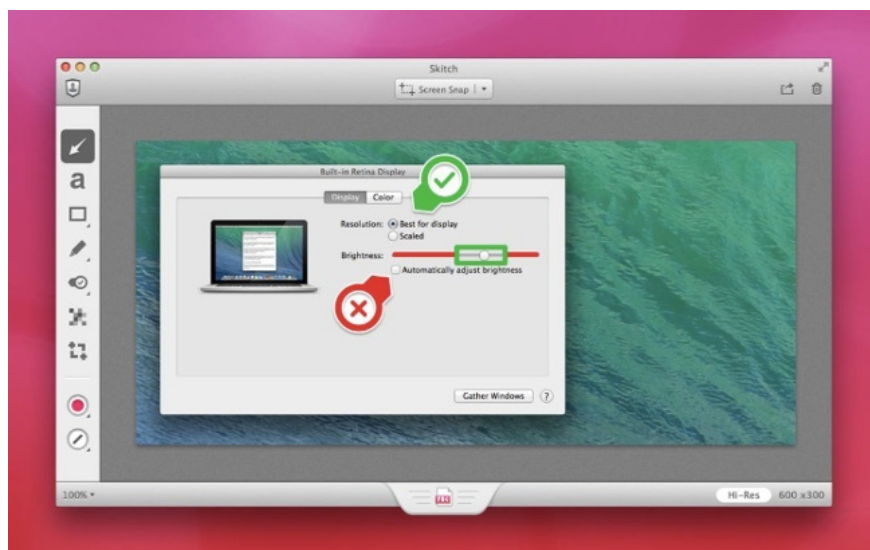
# 1. Monosnap



Monosnap is a unique powerful screen capture tool. Screen capture utility is very light and easy to use. You can capture an area or capture full screen from the keyboard and access the annotation tools right away when shooting. When you're happy with your caption, you can export the file to JPG, PNG or even send it to an external editor like Photoshop. In addition, the app can also capture screen video or "selfie" with the Mac's front camera. If you pay for the Pro version, you can also integrate apps with cloud services like Evernote. Very precise selection tools with perfect pixel zoom tools make it easy to select boundaries.

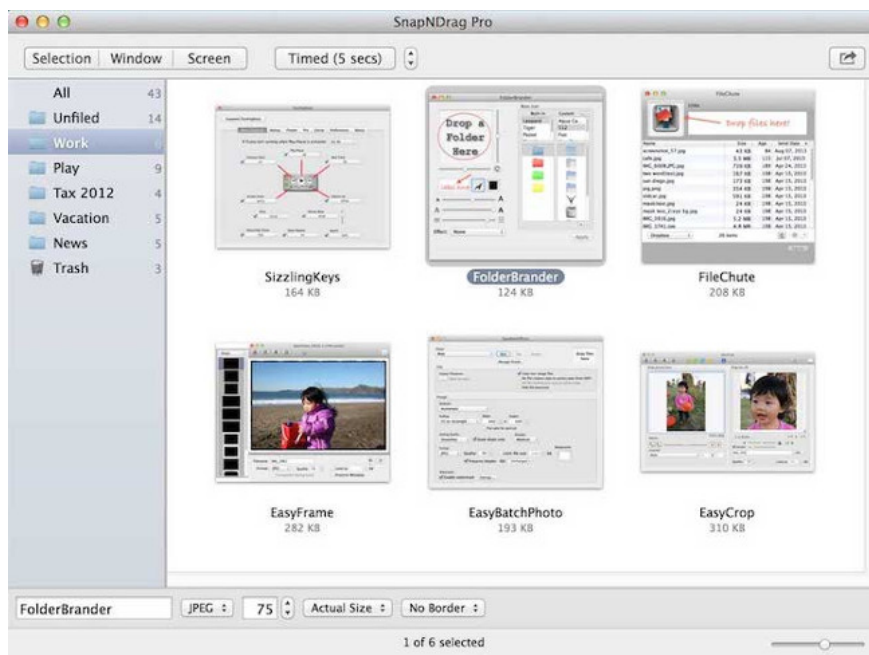
The downside of the application is that it is impossible to capture the application window, so you still need to use the default application. However, it is still a useful screen capture application that has all the tools of a screen capture application.

# 2. Sketch



Although Skitch is a bit 'old', it is undeniable that this is still one of the best photo annotation applications. It is perfectly possible to take screenshots, but the new annotation tools are where the application really shines. The image markup is very simple with a clear interface and enough options. This is an included tool to draw an arrow on any screen shot even if you use the default macOS tools.

### 3. SnapNDrag



The most favorite feature of SnapNDrag is probably the library. Instead of taking a screenshot of a Desktop screen or a folder, they will embed them in a library file. This will help you avoid cluttering directories with five different images of the same interface. When selecting the most suitable one, you can export it to the image format. In addition, you can capture different types of screen images with available timer and timing options. However, the application is not as strong as image notes like Skitch.

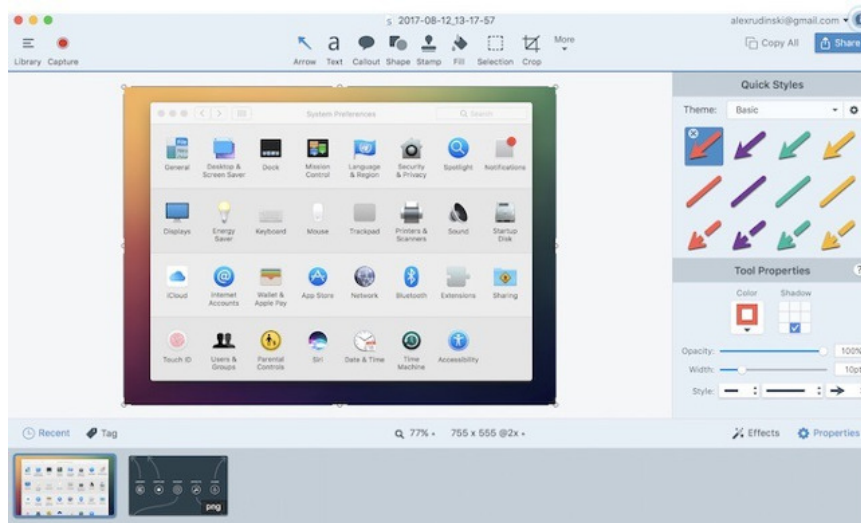
The main drawback of SnapNDrag is the cost. The full version of the app is \$ 10 and functions like resizing screen shots to arbitrary sizes will cost you another \$ 10.

### 4. Lightshot



Lightshot is a lightweight screen capture utility with limited functionality but useful. When you want to take a screenshot, you will use a drag tool. When you finish dragging, you will see utilities, you can use these utilities to annotate images. Then it can be saved to the user's hard drive or an online utility called prntscr.com and shared publicly. If you only need a screen capture utility with notes, Lightshot is a great option.

## 5. Snagit



Snagit is a professional screen capture utility at a reasonable cost. It may be the most powerful application on this list with a wide range of features and annotation options. The application is really useful for users who need to take screenshots continuously. The Pro version of the app costs \$ 50. If you want to use it, you can try it for 15 days for free with all the unlocked features. And if you like Snagit but cost a little bit higher than you, try Jing. This is the same developer app with Snagit but free and share photos via their social services.

## 6. Snapz Pro X

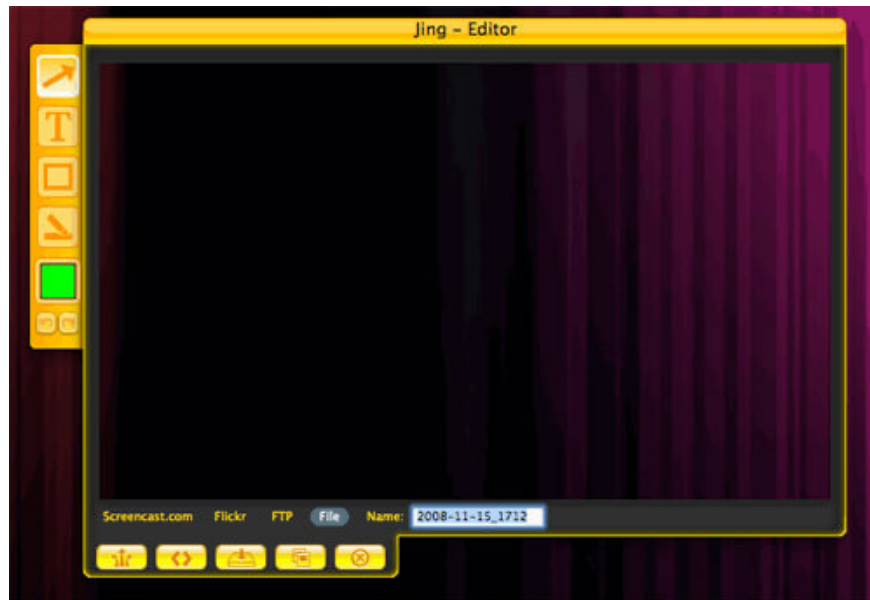


Snapz Pro X is a favorite application for many Mac users for a long time. This is one of the longest screen capture apps. In addition to powerful screen capture capabilities, the application can create videos from any part on the Mac screen. The application can capture the system output and microphone input, very suitable for creating instructions. You can use it to capture static screens and there are many other impressive features awaiting your discovery.

However, the cost of the application with a full version is 69 dollars. Unless you have to constantly create a video, choose a cheaper app.

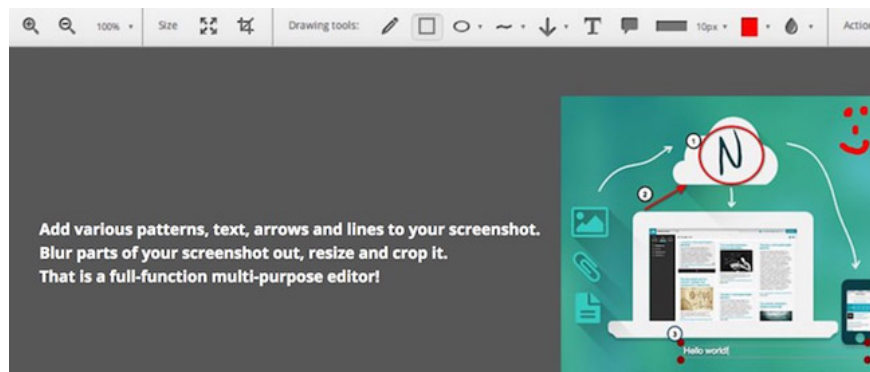
If you want the best screen capture application, Monosnap is a great choice. Users of 'power' can exploit more applications such as Snagit or Snapz Pro X and for those who only take simple and casual screenshots, they may prefer LightShot.

## 7. Jing Project



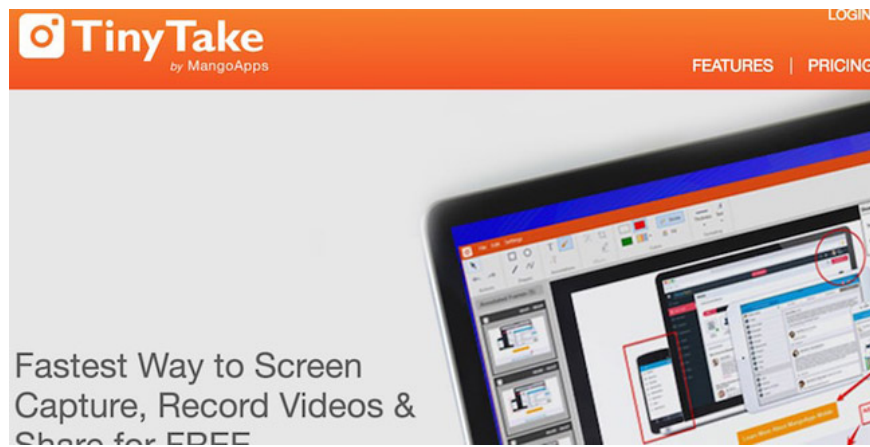
As a Techsmith project, Jing has the ability to perform screen capture and video recording. Besides, you can also sketch images and share them online.

## 8. Nimbus Capture



Nimbus Capture allows you to edit screenshots in an easy-to-use editor. After that, you can share screenshots or save online photos to Nimbus or Google Drive. It is compatible with major browsers including Chrome, Firefox, Opera, macOS and Windows.

## 9. TinyTake



Tinytake for Windows and macOS can take photos and record videos. Moreover, it also allows users to add comments to photos and share them quickly thanks to shareable links. You can annotate, capture with webcam and even store photos online.

## 10. Captur

Capur is a simple program for macOS that can capture screen in full screen mode or select. The program supports different formats for image storage.

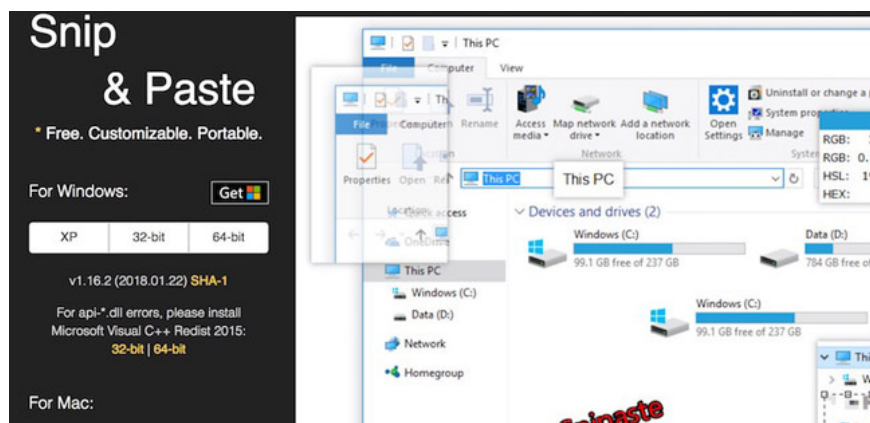

## 11. Paparazzi

Paparazzi! for macOS can capture entire web pages, can save with file size and name options along with support for formats like PNG, JPEG, TIFF and PDF.

## 12. Snipaste



Snipaste brings an intuitive shooting experience with color pickers and shortcuts. It allows images to be pasted as floating windows and allows users to annotate and edit later. Moreover, you can use it on Windows and macOS when writing documents.

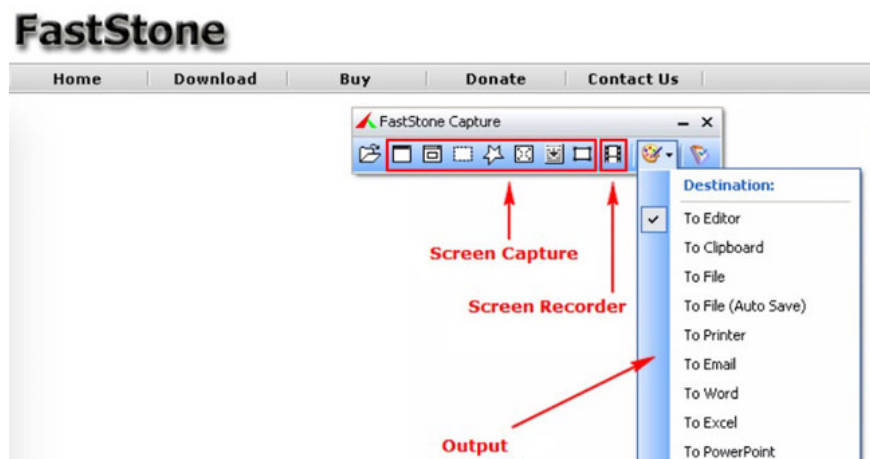
## 13. BrowseShot



BrowseShot allows you to take a full screen image or a scrollable area in PNG format. It is compatible with Safari browser and provides back / forward support.

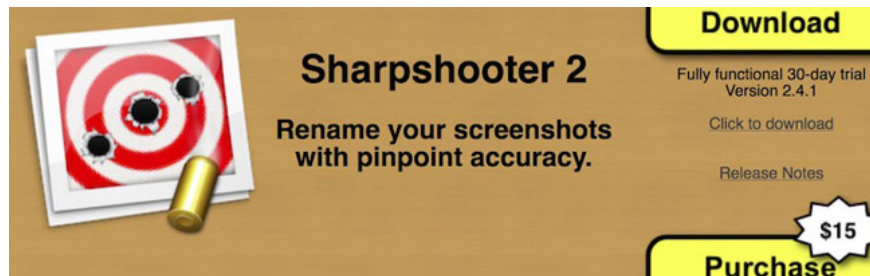
## 14. FastStone Screen Capture



Another application for Windows, FastStone Screen Capture allows you to capture and annotate anything including windows, menus, objects, and so on. and record the activities on the screen. You can export photos to the editor or clipboard or send email. In addition, you can add effects, watermarks, and so on. and save the image in one of the supported formats.

## 15. Sharpshooter



Sharpshooter for macOS is a simple screen capture tool that allows you to save photos in a variety of file formats. In addition, photos can be opened quickly in other applications.

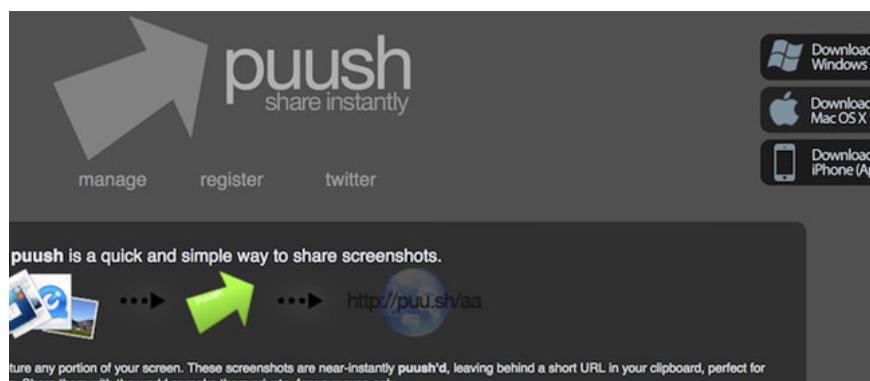

## 16. LICEcap

LICEcap allows you to record activities on the screen and save them as GIF on Windows and macOS. You can also pause and restart recording, and even insert text. Moreover, it also has a hotkey to capture and record screen quickly.

## 17. Puush



Puush allows you to capture and share screenshots on Windows, macOS and iOS platforms. It has drag and drop shortcuts and gestures to support snapshots. In addition, live uploaded images will have a shareable URL.

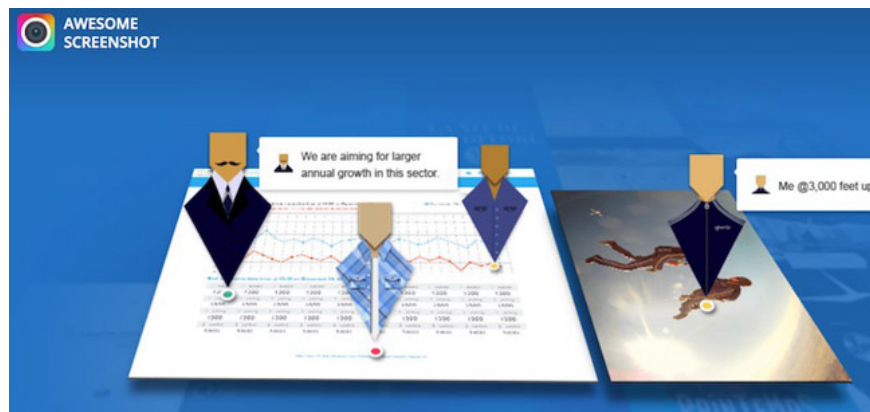

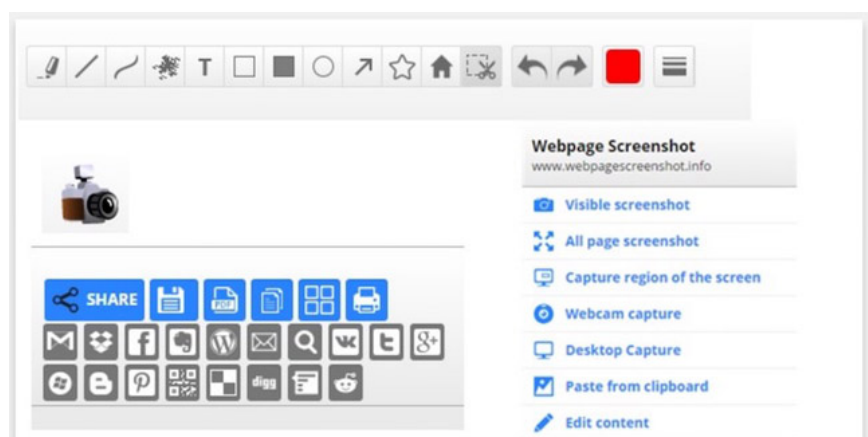
## 19. Awesome screenshot

## 20. Screenshot Extension



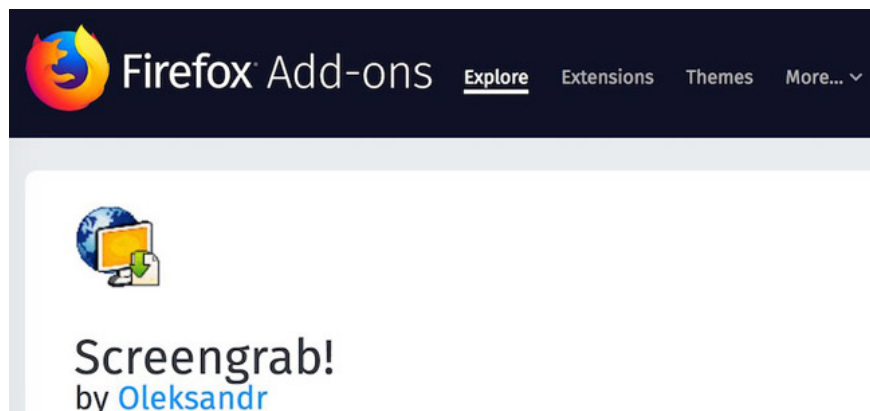

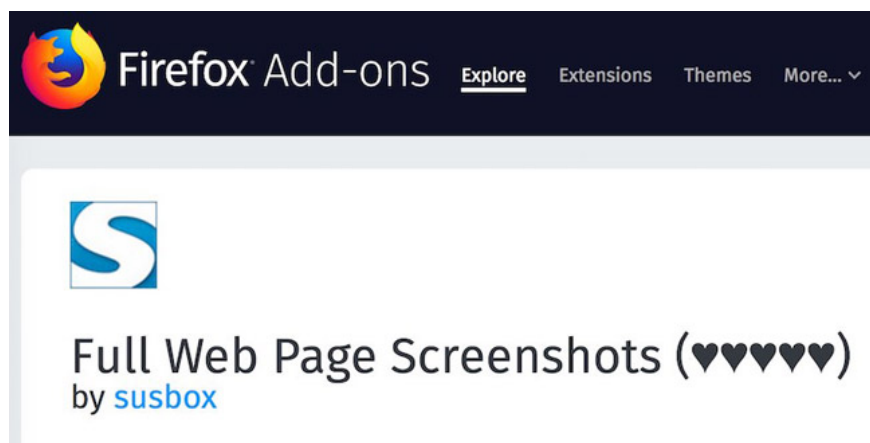
## 21. Screengrab



Screengrab is an add-on for Chrome as well as Mozilla Firefox. It can save web pages as images in PNG, JPG or BMP format. You can even capture part of the page, preview it and upload directly to photo hosting sites like Imgur, Snaggy, etc.

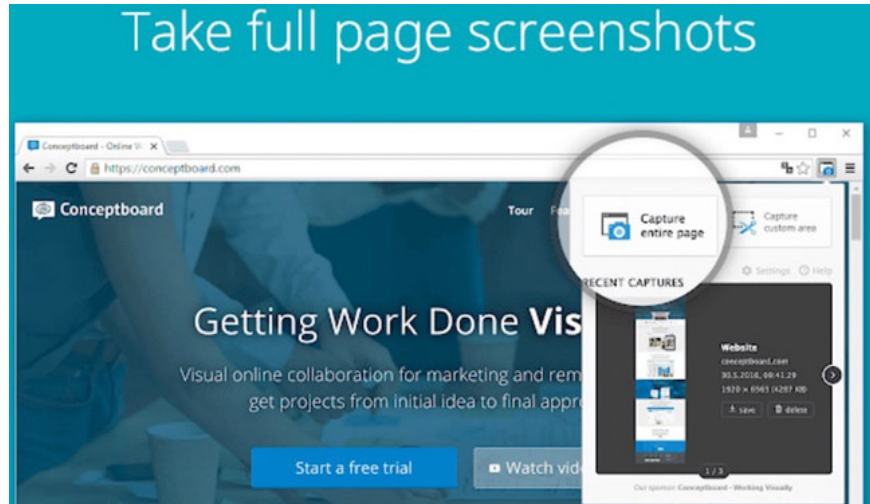
## 22. Full Web Page Screenshots



Another add-on for Firefox, Full Web Page Screenshots allows you to take screenshots and save them as images or PDF files and then send them directly to the clipboard. In addition, you can capture all tabs in one click and print, annotate, edit, email and upload.

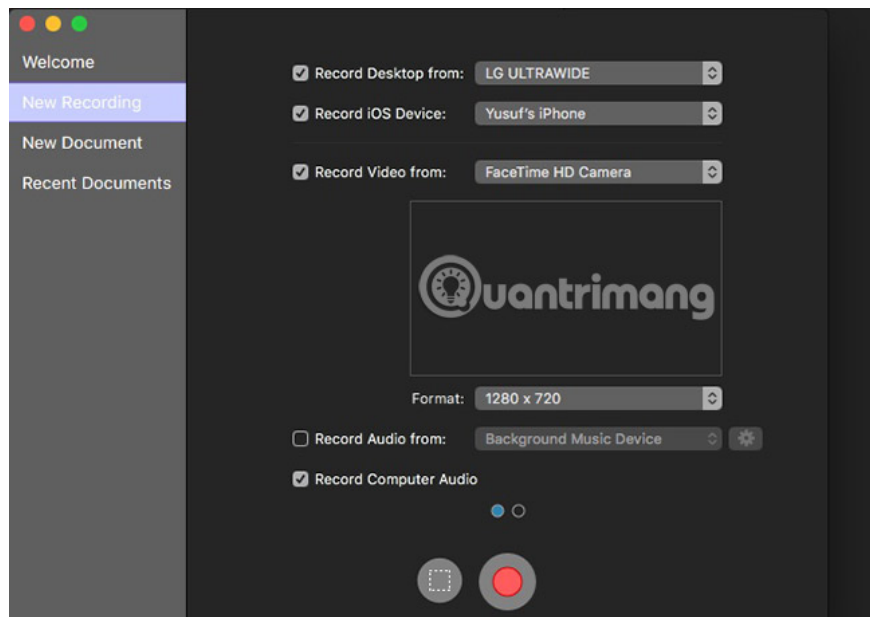
## 23. Full Page Screenshot



Full Page Screenshot is another tool for Chrome that allows you to capture and save images in PNG format. You can capture the whole or part of the site using this application.

## 24. ScreenFlow



The first aspect that you can easily see about ScreenFlow is the price. Is it reasonable?

That depends on the number of extensions you will actually use. Calling ScreenFlow is a screen recording tool, just like calling Mount Everest a sand castle.

Not only can you record multiple screens, but you can also choose to record from connected webcams and iOS devices at the same time. Combined with audio recording capabilities, you have the perfect setting for creating instructional videos.

Media files are recorded from all sources and then saved to a single timeline, where you can turn raw footage into professional video quickly and easily. The notes, annotations and video movements are at your fingertips with an easy-to-use interface.

Another particularly interesting feature is the touch callouts, which allow you to display touch gestures and gestures on the screen if you're recording an iOS device.

ScreenFlow also has many export options depending on where you want to watch the video after your completion. You will find presets (presets) from ProRes codecs to specific installation codecs for Apple TV.

If you are considering creating multiple screen logs from a variety of sources and you want to add some elements in post-production, ScreenFlow might be what you are looking for.

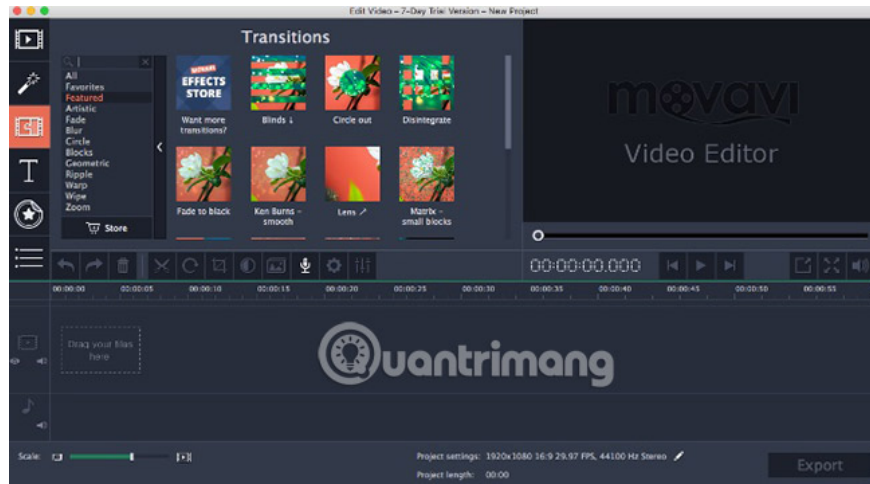
## 25. Movavi Screen Capture Studio



Movavi's Screen Capture Studio is one of the most appreciated screen recording tools. It has all the features of a great screen recording tool, with a full range of editing tools suitable for both casual and professional users.

Movavi is a reasonable choice, in terms of both price and functionality. It combines a large set of tools with an easy-to-use interface and can act as a full-featured snapshot and editor tool.

After the capture is complete, you can make some quick edits before saving or sharing directly to YouTube. If you need more advanced editing, you can open the snapshot in the video editor.



This editor is a typical timeline with a great set of editing tools, including the chroma key effect (green font effect in making movies). There is also a range of filter options, transitions and titles. And the editor even offers two modes, one of which is an easy mode to create fast movies. Movavi also has a store that contains a list of effects and transitions depending on the video you are producing.

Movavi really shines when it comes to available export options. You can fine-tune resolution, frames per second (FPS) and select specific formats. You can also choose from a variety of presets such as output for specific mobile devices or 4K TVs. Movavi also allows you to upload directly to your YouTube channel from within the editor.

## 26. QuickTime



If you don't need complicated editing, annotation, and filter features, Apple has a screen recorder that is included in macOS. QuickTime is a reliable video player, but it is also a fast and easy screen recorder that you don't have to pay to use.

Just open QuickTime Player, then go to **File> New Screen Recording** . You will see a screen capture menu pop up where you can select the screen area you want to capture. Select the dropdown icon next to the **Record** button, which allows you to select a microphone to add sound.



QuickTime has some essential editing tools like rotate, split and crop. You can also add clips if you want to combine screenshots with something you're referencing. However, you will need a video converter if you want to export in any format other than MOV format.

QuickTime is the perfect choice if you need to record your screen quickly and you don't require any annotation, filters or effects. Combine with the free Mac video editor if you need more options.

Finally, choosing any software depends on both your requirements and your budget. If you want to record your iPhone, iPad or Mac screen regularly, ScreenFlow will be a great choice.

Snagit provides an essential set of tools and makes it easy to share with other applications. Other payment options require some time to learn but provide flexibility when making changes. They also have a variety of

options to make your video look more professional.

Some of the screen recording applications mentioned above have a trial version. Check the software carefully before spending money to buy it.
