However, after all the bitter - spicy - sweet - that, no one can stop writing. That said, passion and love with words can completely defeat things that seem to be extreme of pain and loss.

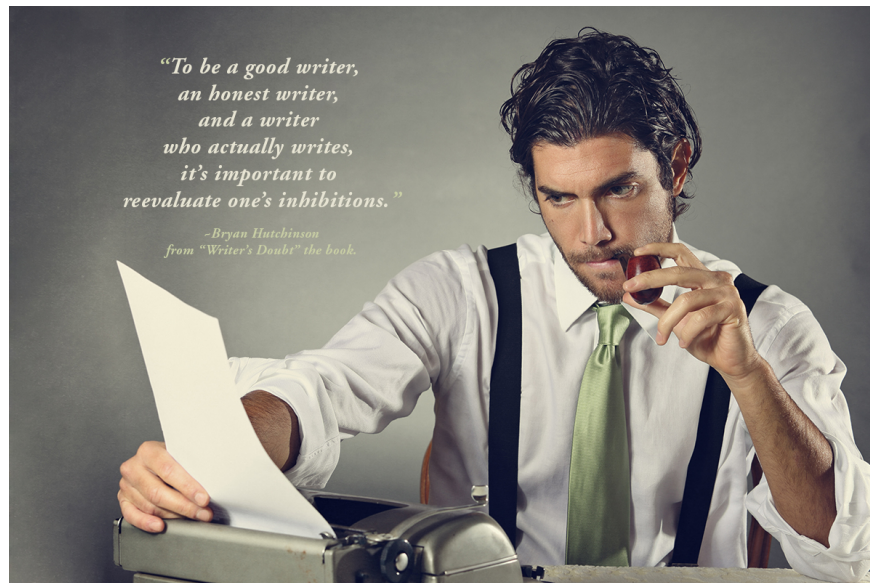
Here are 29 inspirational phrases about writing to help you gain more motivation and confidence to continue "lighting fire" for your pen. Don't stop, just write.
